GRENADA CONSTITUTION SUSPENDED

The British Government has dismissed the Grenada Government led by Mr. Eric Gairy and has suspended that Colony's constitution. The British Government said that Gairy had broken the law of spending Government's money. The Administrator, who is a Jamaican, has been given wide reserve powers to govern the territory with power to appoint an of-

ficial as Minister of Finance. According to the report of the Commission of Inquiry Gairy and his Ministers had induced civil servants in condoning financial irregularities.
