THREE-YEAR WELFARE PLAN ALMOST TO A CLOSE

The three-year Welfare plan for the Windward Islands is almost to a close and according to information from a reliable source the final phase of a ten-year plan for the Windward Islands is now being worked out.

The "Welfare Road" (road from Cole Bay to the Juliana Airport), the "Juancho Yrausquin Boulevard" (road to Point Blanche), the new landing strip and new terminal building at the Juliana Airport, the "Claude Pier" (deep water pier at Point Blanche) are all projects of the three-year Welfare Plan for the Windward Islands.

All the money for these projects was supplied by the Government of Holland and the Government of Netherlands Antilles; partly as a gift and partly as a loan. One third of the money was given by the Government of Holland as a gift, one third of the money was given by the Central Government of the Netherlands Antilles as a gift and one third of the money was given as a loan from Holland.

It is very interested to note that up to the present, the Windward Islands have not received any aid whatsoever from the European Common Market.
