RUMANIA'S NEW SUBJECTS ARE NOT SATISFIED

"Carpet Bagger System" is Being Practiced by Unscrupulous Civil Officials Aided by Occupation Armies.

Indications are That Unless Situation Improves, Transylvanians May Seek Means to be Re-Annexed to Hungary.

(By The Associated Press) BUCHAREST, June 29. That the carpet bagging system known to the South after the Civil War has been applied by the Rumanians to their new provinces of Bessarabia, Bukovina and Transylvania, is the burden of complaints that the minority population of these provinces are sending to the allied governments. It is charged that these provinces have been loaded up with dishonest civilian officials, who work in connection with the armies of occupation to bulldoze and terrorize the local inhabitants. It is even charged that the wealthy landowners are being arrested in the hope that they will either desert their lands and sell their homes far under the real value.

According to Dr. Nicholas Lupu, recently minister of the interior, the army of occupation in these provinces should have been removed after four years of war soldiers respect the rights of nobody, he said.

In Bessarabia, where the army is kept as a protection against the Bolsheviks, the charges of misadministration have been many. It is also charged that the military administration has prevented the just operation of the law providing for the division of the land.

The gravest charges come from Transylvania and the Hungarian frontier, where the nationality of the people has long been a question. On these members of the Hungarian nobility who have persisted in retaining a half a dozen estates or possessions, who practically hold their prisoners. While they are able to operate the estates, they are not permitted to receive visitors or mail except by permission of these soldiers. Many instances are cited where the head of the house has been arrested and harassed that he had to flee, leaving his home in the possession of his wife and daughter, much after the manner of the Russian and Polish landlords during the early stages of Bolshevik rule.

The Dispute is Understood to Be On the Program of the League of Nations for an Early Consideration by the League.

(By The Associated Press) RIO DE JANEIRO, June 29. The Bolivian and Paraguayan dispute involving Chile, Peru and Bolivia is not the only South American problem which may go before the League of Nations for settlement.

There has existed for years a controversy between Paraguay and Bolivia over a strip of territory in the heart of South America as claimed by the state of California. This territory is understood to be on the program of consideration by the League.

AGITATING SINCE 1918

Apparently this delegation did not faithfully represent the attitude of all the islanders for other islanders have been agitating for self-determination and permission to join with Sweden since the beginning of this year.

The Swedish government recently took up the subject with the great powers and asked the government of London to submit the matter to the League of Nations.

Sweden has since then been agitating for a self-determination vote to be held in the islands.

On June 1 a delegation of the county council of Aland, empowered by 90 per cent of the population of the islands, visited Stockholm and was received by King Gustave. The king assured the delegation that Sweden was making all possible efforts to obtain a decision which would be based on the will of the islands themselves.

POLYGAMY WAMES IN PHILIPPINES

Education of Girls. Think to Improve Morals in the Middle Pacific Islands. Says Retiring Governor of Mindanao and Sulu.

MANILA, P. I., June 28.—Practice of polygamy in the Philippine Islands is being reduced through education of girls of the outlying provinces according to Frank V. Carpenter, retiring governor of the Department of Mindanao and Sulu.

Mr. Carpenter is here to turn over administration of his office to the Secretary of the Interior who will act through the Bureau of Non-Christian Education in accordance with a new territorial law which the Sultan of Mindanao has renounced his pretensions to temporal sovereignty but gained recognition as ecclesiastical head of the Mohammedan faith in the Sultan archipelago.

Religious Practice Limited

It is important to note, says Carpenter in one of his messages written as governor, that this law includes a limitation as to religious practice which necessarily includes the abandonment of polygamy. There can be no question that it will disappear as the relative number of persons of the sexes reach an approximate ratio of equality.

An effort to improve upon the people of the Sultanate in the invalidation of polygamous marriages heretofore contracted the prohibition at its time polygamy or the disannulment of divorce must unavailably result in the active rejection of a proposal to the rather than submit to a privation of their religious liberty matters they believe to be fundamental and sanctioned by divine authority.

Christian Association Helped. Mr. Carpenter said that girls of prominent families in Mindanao and Sulu are being sent to Manila for the schools where they associate with Christian girls and gradually become imbued with the indigenous ideas held by the natives here strictly to their own Mohammedan religion as their fathers is said would be desirable if they abandoned it. When they return to their own people their influence tends to eliminate polygamous marriages according to Carpenter who predicted that the practice will be virtually wiped out in the course of a few years.

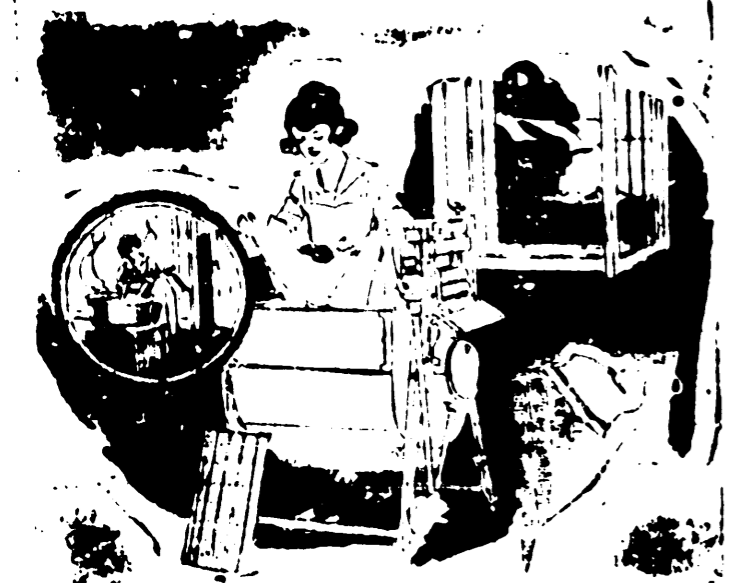

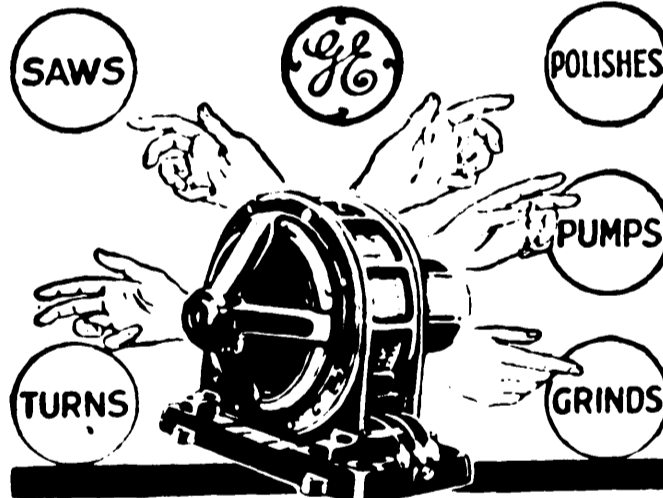

OFFER DRAFT FOR AN INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE

Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Switzerland and Holland Present Draft for Permanent Court of League of Nations to League's Secretariat.

THE HAGUE, June 5. Court of International Justice of the League of Nations as it has been offered to the Secretariat of the League in the name of Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Switzerland and Holland, has been made public by the Dutch government. It is the result of the conference held in the Peace Palace at the Hague in February.

To Have 15 Judges. According to the plan the court would consist of 15 judges and 12 substitutes, who must all be recognized authorities on international justice. Its members would be chosen for nine years, the substitutes for six.

The members would be elected without regard of their nationality and no more than two judges of the same country would hold office in the court. They would be eligible but they would have to resign when 70 years old. They would then have a right to a pension, which, like their salary would be fixed and paid by the League.

To Adjust Differences. The duties of the court would be to adjudicate differences between nations and it would be competent to act on all cases in which its decision is asked.

The permanent Court of International Justice is provided for in Article XIV of the covenant of the League of Nations. The Council of the League of Nations at a session in London in February announced that a committee of 12 distinguished international jurists, including Elihu Root of the United States had been named to prepare plans for the constitution of the Court. Mr. Root accepted the invitation as did Lord Phillimore of England, Baron Descamps of Belgium, Dr. Loeb of Poland and M. Vesitch of Yugoslavia. No plans as formulated by the committee for the organization of the court have yet been announced.

TO EXPLAIN MURKIN

(By The Associated Press) PHILADELPHIA, June 5. Three emissaries from Thrace are touring this country to assist in the explanation of the position of the Greek inhabitants of Thracian territory surrendered under the peace treaty by Bulgaria and Turkey. They are members of the Thracian Commission to the United States.

The members of the mission are Anagnostis Constantinidis, secretary, University of Paris; Nicholas Kallias, Constantinople; Dr. Paleologos, Georgian National University of Tiflis.

In Philadelphia they spoke in churches of various denominations and at luncheons arranged in their honor.

CROWN JEWELS ARE NOW BACK IN LONDON TOWER

(By The Associated Press) LONDON, June 5. The crown jewels, which were removed to a place of greater safety during a recent succession of daring burglaries about London, have now been returned to their accustomed place in the Tower.

That fact is regarded as hardly likely to prompt anyone to try to steal them, but it is somewhat alluring on the regime in 1671, recalled by this incident, should be the only one on record, considering the manner in which his subjects was rewarded. 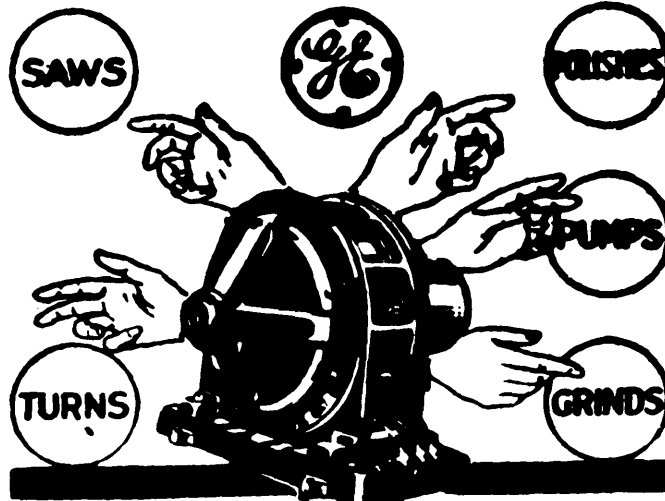

RECOMMEND RIGHT OF LABOR TO ORGANIZE FREELY

CHICAGO, May. More fraternalism in industrial and business life was recommended by the Commission on Social Reconstruction of the Unitarian General Conference. The Commission was appointed at the recent Unitarian Conference in Baltimore and its report has drawn up a statement of principles on which its members believe social reconstruction should be based.

The statement declared that all concerned in industry, the manager, the producer and the consumer are partners and that the community has a right to insist that the industry be carried on not for the sole benefit of any of the partners, but in the interest of all. It did not attempt to prescribe any single form of industrial organization. It recommended that the hours of labor should be reduced to the lowest point compatible with adequate production but qualified this statement by adding that "in the present emergency the world needs a maximum production."

The commission recommended that the right be recognized of both industry and labor to organize freely and bargain collectively. It asserted that all wage earners have a right to a wage sufficient to support their families in health and comfort. It declared that much industrial unrest is caused by poverty and that a great deal of poverty could be eliminated by better distribution of workers, control of immigration, encouragement of thrift, encouragement of investing and managing ability and by providing funds for home building.

Laws were recommended providing for increased taxation of land values with the purpose of bringing into use land held for speculative purposes as to promote home building for the development of a graduated inheritance tax and income taxes and also legislation for the control of monopoly prices.

Among the ideals set forth by the commission were the raising of educational standards, universal opportunity for education, a campaign against such diseases as tuberculosis, prevention of exploitation of child labor, segregation of the feebleminded in institutions and social insurance.

The commission also set forth as an ideal the creation of machinery by which governments can be democratically controlled and made responsive to the public will. It also suggested a world federation of peoples based on mutual abrogation of special concessions and mutual obligation of general service.
