Picking the Winner of Richards-Ryan Bout

THAT \$10,000

At a rough estimate there are ten thousand real fans in the world who are lovers of the Istmus, and at the present time every one of these are trying to decide on the winner of the big welterweight championship battle between Eddie Ryan and Terry Richards, which is carded for the opening of the New Pan-American boxing arena next Saturday evening.

There isn't the least doubt in the minds of these light fans but that the battle will be the most classic affair ever fought in this section of the country between two welterweights. The records of both fighters speak for themselves. Both Eddie Ryan and Terry Richards have long been favorites with the lovers of the game down here.

Both have always given the fans the best that was in them in the ring, and the meeting on next Saturday night at the cozy up-town arena will be watched with interest by every sport follower on the Isthmus of Panama.

Both Ryan and Richards are in grand form and fit for the battle of their careers. Eddie has seven years with him at his own gym every afternoon and the way he is slugging them around daily makes his many admirers wear a glad smile.

"The fight will not go over twelve rounds," said one of the well-known authorities on the game yesterday, after watching Ryan in his workout; "but it will be a hour of a fight while it lasts."

Terry Richards is working out every evening at the new boxing club and the crowds that have soon flocked in his daily stunts predict that he will win.

Not alone will these two fisty stars battle for the largest purse ever offered for a welterweight battle on the Istmus, but they will fight for the opportunity of meeting several of the top notch boys from the states who are expected to be at the ring side to challenge the winner.

The promoter of the big show desires to call the fans' attention to the fact that the boxing program on next Saturday evening will be the best balanced and ever offered for their approval. Ryan and Richards will tip the scales at about the same weight. They are both wonderful clever boxers, good mixers, game as they make it, and both can hit and will trade punch for punch from bell to bell.

The new arena, which has cost the owners several thousand dollars, will be all ready to accommodate the monster crowd on Saturday evening. The new electric lighting system and the new electric fans were tested out yesterday. They work perfectly. And the promoter is making every arrangement to seat the big crowd with ease and comfort. "My sole ambition is to present to the Istmo lovers down here a real bout," said Promoter Sed yesterday. "Our new arena has cost an awful lot of money, but it will help the manly art in Panama and I will not stake anything but the very best in the boxing line."

A glance over the preliminary battles will satisfy the fans that the main battle will be surrounded by the best talent to be had. Raul Ansel, the big French fighter will star in the semi-windup. The big fellow has been resting up for the past two months, and he wants another

THE IMPORTS

Much discussion has been caused by an apparent failure of the League officials in not securing the services of capable umpires. The cause is mostly traceable to the president of the league who has the sole power in appointing the umpires. In this respect and knowing the president of the league as a personal and sporting acquaintance of the highest caliber, a few words of explanation is in order.

In the first place, without the knowledge of W. E. Foster, the president of the P. C. B. B. L., the fans voted to bar the umpires from any benefits in the injury fund. This he considers unfair and the old and efficient umpires on learning of this move, refused to apply for assignments under the present discriminating rules. In the second place, with the increased price of admission, the umpires rightfully thought that they were entitled to an increased rate for their services. The present executive of the league, looking at the claims of the umpires from a purely unselfish standpoint, agreed with them. If the rates that he has proposed is put in effect, the fans will have the pleasure of seeing such sterling umpires as Dockery, Bohler, Riley, Donohue and Humphreys in action in the near future.

PLUCKY POLAND

The health authorities of Alaska, for instance, do not start a campaign of general vaccination when they read of an epidemic of small-pox in Italy. However, if there should be an epidemic in Seattle or one of the Canadian ports nearby, general vaccination would probably take place as a protection.

Panama is not taking any steps towards overcoming the spread of Bolshevism, because the disorder, or whatever it may be called, is far away in Russia. If Colombia or Costa Rica turned Bolshevist and the Bolsheviks came across the border to spread their doctrine in Panama by force of arms, then Panama would have to take active steps.

Poland has had to fight the Bolsheviks for Panama and the rest of the world, because it was not a danger, far removed from that plucky little country. It was on the border and sending its hordes of armed marauders into that country. It was a case of fight or die, or a surrender worse than death. Poland has been fighting and paying the price.

The price has not been paid in money alone and the lives of soldiers. The future and growing generations of Poland have been drawn upon. The innocent little children, the hope of the country's future, have had to pay the highest price.

Children in Poland have been found by American relief workers digging in the snow for grass, weeds and roots to eat.

Contrast that with your own happy, protected children. Compare it with the life and condition of our own children here on the Isthmus. The poorest stray dog on the Isthmus gets more to eat than some of the little children of Poland, and in addition to starvation they must also face the bitter cold in poor rags.

The ghastly harvest of disease and death in Poland, especially among the children is awful to think of. If those children were here at our doors we would give our last penny and share our last crust with them.

Two dollars will save the life of one of the children.

How much more than that will you spend during this new year for luxuries and things that you might be better off without. With millions struggling against disease and starvation, and thousands dying for want of actual necessities with luxuries unknown, and saving of lives the great present, you must give, give all you can.

The case is before you, not only of Poland, but of all of war-stricken Europe. Imagine if you can what it would mean if conditions were reversed.

In all the centuries has so great a need existed?

Has greater opportunity for the good fortune of a chance to help distress ever existed?

How many lives will you save?


