Dear Dr. Castro :

We write to you to express our feelings and concerns in this important occasion to the cuban nation.

Our most sincere best wishes to the cuban people on the occasion of the official festivities celebrating one more anniversary of the 26th of July. Needless to say we very much applaud and are grateful for your very recent energetic action against cuban officials involved in drug trafficking.

We also take advantage of this opportunity to ask that you please consider, as a humanitarian gesture, to suggest to the pertinent cuban officials to grant exit permits to the wife and stepson of Candido Fernandez Amador, so that they may join him in South Florida. They are Ileana Rivas Noval (ID # VI-L 338767, born 5-15-54) and Rafael Arece Rivas (ID # III-F 591812, born 10-20-76).

We would be most appreciative of you acknowledging our request and we thank you in advance for your kind attention.
