Yokosuka Welcomes Royal Canadian Navy Submarine HMCS Chicoutimi



YOKOSUKA, Japan (October 18, 2017) – The Valiant-class yard tugboat Seminole (YT 805) assists the Royal Canadian Navy Submarine HMCS Chicoutimi (SSK 879) as it pulls into Fleet Activities (FLEACT) Yokosuka for a port visit. The visit by the Victoria-class submarine marks the first time since the 1960s that a Canadian submarine visited Japan and the first Asian deployment for the class by the Royal Canadian Navy. COMMENT:

Do not turn off the A/C until the temperature hits below 60 degrees. The towers get too hot and not everyone likes to open their windows due to bugs and spiders getting in. Recommend keeping the A/C running until mid-November.

RESPONSE:

Thank you for taking the time to provide us your comments via ICE. We understand your frustration and concern completely and apologize for the inconvenience. Climate control operations, air conditioning in "summer" and heating in "winter" follow Department of the Navy energy policy. Air conditioning was turned

off the week of October 10th, to ensure that the system undergoes proper and necessary maintenance during the four-week "Shoulder Season" (timeframe between the A/C turn off and heating turn on). The A/C shut off time was determined using the forecasted average outdoor temperature of 63 degrees Fahrenheit and trending colder. If

air conditioning was left on until mid-November, heating would not begin until mid-December. If you have more concerns, please contact the Housing Customer Relations at 243-9067. Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation.
