



YOU'RE NOT ALONE WHEN IT COMES TO DOING RESEARCH FOR YOUR PAPERS AND PROJECTS.

Here are fast and easy ways to get help!

IN-PERSON (OLD-FASHIONED WAY)

Every library on campus (all nine!) has a research assistance desk where you can talk to a librarian about your research needs.

IM A LIBRARIAN (SUPER CONVENIENT WAY)

Use our online chat service to send instant messages to a librarian who's waiting to help you. Ask-A-Librarian is accessible from the library's homepage, www.uflib.ufl.edu

DO IT YOURSELF (SELF-SUFFICIENT WAY)

Help is only a few clicks away on our website. Every subject taught at UF has a library research guide. Find yours under the "Finding Help" tab on the library's homepage.

Did you know that your UF Libraries are organized by subject? That's why all the science-y books are in the science library, all the music books are in the music library, all the education books are in the education library, and so on!

Library skillz

You need 'em, we teach 'em!

THERE'S A COMPUTER RIGHT HERE. LOG ON AND OPEN AN INTERNET BROWSER. CLICK THE HOME BUTTON TO GO TO THE LIBRARY'S HOMEPAGE.

Use this computer to practice the VERY IMPORTANT library survival skill of looking up books. Type the title of one of those books you see on the shelves into the library catalog search box.

Important things to notice

Where does the book live? (There are 9 libraries, after all!)

What's its call number and can I text it to myself? (omg, YES!!)

Is the book checked out, or can I go get it? (If it's checked out, you can put yourself in line for it by clicking on the "request" link you'd see.)

Critical to library survival is learning how to work the moveable shelves! Look up this video on YouTube to see how they work <http://goo.gl/ktFP> or scan this QR code with your phone to watch.

ALL BY YOUR LONESOME






Comfy chairs and Florida views

Printing, scanning & copying

MAKE SURE YOU PUT THE MOULAH ON YOUR GATOR VENDING ACCOUNT. NO PRINTING OR MAKING COPIES WITHOUT THE MOULAH.

You can print from library computers!

MAKE SURE YOU HAVE \$\$\$ ON YOUR ACCOUNT

Every library on campus has black/white printers and copiers. Architecture and Marston libraries also have COLOR printing/copying! Color = \$.50/page, B/W = \$.10/page.

SCANNING WORKS GREAT, TOO!

You can scan articles and book chapters and email them to yourself or save them on your USB drive instead of photocopying. Saves paper and moulah!

MAGNIFIERS!


If you need to magnify text to see it better, you can use the 3 special magnifiers over there to the right. MSL and EDU libraries have them, too. There's more ADA equipment in the two media rooms in the hallway around the corner.
