Laying at wharf extending into waters of street.

SEC. 223. Any owner, agent or master of any steamboat, vessel or other water craft, arriving from any port, exceeding five tons burthen, which shall land or lay at any wharf or dock which extends in whole or part over the waters of any public street of the City of Jacksonville, and which shall lay at any such wharf or dock a longer time than ten hours, shall pay to the City Marshal one dollar if over fifty tons, and fifty cents if less than fifty tons for each day of twenty-four hours, or part thereof, and should such owner, agent or master of any such steamboat, vessel or other water craft, refuse to pay the above-mentioned amount to the Marshal when so demanded, the said owner, agent or master shall, upon conviction before the Municipal Court, be fined not less than twenty dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each offense.

Leaving lumber, etc., in slip.
Ib., Sec. 5.

SEC. 224. No wood, timber, lumber or building material shall remain in any public slip or street for a longer period than ten hours in the twenty-four. Any person owning or having charge of any timber, lumber, wood or building material, and permitting the same to remain for a longer period than ten hours in the twenty-four in any public slip shall, on conviction before the Municipal Court, be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding ten days, in the discretion of the court.

Penalty.

Wharves obstructing slips.
Ib., Sec. 6.

SEC. 225. No person shall build or cause to be built any wharf or other structure that shall obstruct or in any manner interfere with the full and free use of any public slip; Provided, That nothing in this section shall interfere with a twelve-foot driveway to the wharves, and if any wharf or other structure which now obstructs or interferes with any public slip without permission having been heretofore granted by the Council, such wharves or other structure shall be immediately removed by the person or persons owning or claiming the same. In case any such person or persons shall fail to remove such wharves or structure within ten days after the approval of this ordinance, the Mayor shall be authorized to order the removal of the same at the expense of the owner or owners thereof, the amount of such expense, together with all fees and charges to be recovered for the use of city in any court of competent jurisdiction; that no vessel or vessels not occupying shall obstruct the free use of any slip or slips by projecting into or over the same, and any captain or any person having the charge of any vessel violating the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction before the Municipal Court, be
