SEC. 227. Any person who shall wantonly or carelessly ride or drive any animal or vehicle of any kind in such manner that any other person, animal or vehicle shall be struck or injured, shall be deemed guilty of disorderly conduct, and on conviction thereof, shall be punished by fine not exceeding fifty dollars and costs, or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days and the payment of costs of conviction.

SEC. 228. All hackney carriages, cabs, omnibuses and other vehicles for the carriage of passengers are hereby required when on any street or highway of the City of Jacksonville, at night, to have and carry a lantern with a light therein on each side of the front portion of such vehicle, so that the same can be plainly seen from the front and each side of such vehicle. All licensed vehicles shall have plainly marked on the side of the lantern of such light the number of such vehicle in figures not less than two inches in height, so that such number can be plainly distinguished from the sidewalk on each side of the street.

SEC. 229. Any owner, agent or driver of such hackney carriage, cab, omnibus or other vehicle, who shall fail to comply with, or shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court, be fined in a sum not exceeding fifty dollars, or imprisonment for not more than thirty days.

Sale of toy pistols, etc., forbidden.

SEC. 230. No person shall sell or keep or expose for sale within the City of Jacksonville any toy or toys designed and intended for the purpose of exploding any explosive or detonating material, whether such toys be of the shape or kind commonly known as toy pistols or otherwise.

No person shall sell or keep or expose for sale any fulminating, detonating or explosive material for use in or in connection with any such toys.

Use of dangerous toys forbidden.

SEC. 231. No person shall discharge or explode within the city limits any of the toys mentioned in section 230.

SEC. 232. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding twenty days, in the discretion of the court.

Small birds protected.

SEC. 233. Whoever shall willfully kill or wound, or shall attempt to kill, capture or molest, within the city limits, any mocking-bird, red-bird, thrush, woodpecker, dove, or other wild bird, shall, upon conviction before the Municipal Court, be imprisoned in the city jail not longer than twenty days, or fined not more than twenty dollars.
