SEC. 244. No person or persons shall injure, deface or destroy any fence, gate, building, sign, seat, tree, shrub or flower within any City Park, or on any public street, or any private property, within the corporate limits of the city, or on any property belonging to the city, outside the corporate limits, or hitch any horse, mule or other animal to any tree on the public streets, or post any bills on the trees or fences along the public streets.

Provided, That bills may be posted on fences by permission of the owner, and trees along the public street may be trimmed by the owner of the property abutting, by permission of the Board of Public Works. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined not exceeding fifty dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding twenty days.

Merchandise,
vehicles, etc.

SEC. 245. No person or persons shall place, or cause to be placed, or allow to remain in front of his or their premises any merchandise, goods, show cases, barrels, wagons, carts, omnibuses, carriages, or other vehicles or articles of any description, on any sidewalk or street within the limits of the city, excepting barrels or boxes used as receptacles for garbage, as required by ordinance; Provided, however, That merchants and others may occupy with articles and packages of merchandise portions of said streets and sidewalks for the purpose of loading and unloading the same from vehicles for such reasonable time as may be necessary for so doing, and in such manner as not to obstruct or impede the course of travel thereon; Provided, Licensed auctioneers may be permitted by the Mayor to sell on the street such articles of property as cannot be gotten inside their stores.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by fine not exceeding twenty dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding ten days.

Building
material.

SEC. 246. No person or persons shall place or deposit, or permit the placing or depositing of any building materials on any sidewalk or in any street of this city, unless such materials are for use in buildings in the vicinity in the course of erection or repair, and for the deposit of such materials not more than one-third of the width of the street in front of such building shall be occupied. Within three weeks after the completion of the roof and exterior of such building, all building materials then remaining shall be removed from the street and sidewalk. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined not exceeding two hundred dollars or be imprisoned not exceeding ninety days.
