Each person or firm engaging in the business of a pawnbroker, or conducting a pawnbroking shop, in the city, shall keep a record, and upon demand shall make a report to the Chief of Police or his representative, of every article or thing pawned to or purchased by him or them. Said record and report to specify the article or thing, such as number, mark and all other such details as will make identification of such article or thing clear and positive; and such person or persons aforesaid shall hold their shop subject to visitation or inspection by the police, and upon refusal of any pawnbroker at any time to submit to such visita-
