SEC. 679. Any person desiring to procure a green grocer's license to sell fresh meats, fresh fish, market fruits and market vegetables shall pay to the City Treasurer a license fee of three dollars per month from the date on which he wishes his license to begin until the first day of October next thereafter, and leave with the Treasurer an application for such license, for which payment the Treasurer shall give him his receipt countersigned by the Comptroller. The Treasurer shall promptly deliver the application for such license to the inspector of green groceries, who shall inspect the building and the stall and other arrangements made for opening a green grocery, and if the building be constructed and furnished in compliance with this ordinance, the inspector shall make an endorsement to that effect upon the application and return it to the Treasurer, who, upon the return of the application with such endorsement thereon, shall issue to the applicant a green grocer's license, which shall be countersigned by the Comptroller and delivered to the applicant. If the building is not constructed and furnished in compliance with this ordinance, and the inspector makes an endorsement to that effect upon the application, the Treasurer shall return to the applicant the money paid upon the application.

SEC. 680. There shall be an inspector of green groceries who shall be elected biennially by the City Council, and receive a salary of eighty-five dollars per month, payable monthly. He shall furnish and keep for his own use in the performance of his duties, without additional compensation or expense to the city, a horse or bicycle. He shall, while on duty, wear a metallic badge with the words "inspector of green groceries" impressed thereon. He shall inspect and test from time to time all weights and measures used at green groceries, and no weights or measures found by him to be incorrect shall, until regulated, be used in any green grocery. He shall have a general supervision over all green groceries and over the sale of all meats, fish, fruits and vegetables throughout the city except at the central market, and he shall see that all the provisions of this ordinance, excepting only those provisions applying exclusively to the central market, are strictly complied with. He shall, at least once a day, and as much oftener as practicable, inspect each green grocery, together with the articles offered for sale, and as far as is practicable he shall inspect all meat, poultry, fish and vegetables of every kind offered for sale anywhere within the city excepting only at the central market, and he shall keep a correct written report of each inspection, which reports shall be
