

that death was not caused by any infectious or contagious disease, and also setting forth the cause of death.

Report to health officer.

It shall further be the duty of said person or common carrier bringing any dead body as aforesaid, to report the arrival of said body immediately to the health officer, and to obtain a permit from him for the retention of said body in the city, or for its re-shipment to any other point.

Transfers to be at cemetery.

Dead bodies passing through the city requiring change from one coffin or case to another, must be transferred at a cemetery in the discretion of the health officer.

Penalty.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction before the Municipal Court, be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars or more than five hundred dollars, or by imprisonment for ninety days.

Betaining on premises things detrimental to health.
Ib., Sec. 7.

SEC. 702. No person shall keep or suffer to remain upon his or her premises, or upon any premises owned, used or controlled by him or her, in any dwelling, store, warehouse, or other building, or upon any vacant lot, or in any yard or other place within the corporate limits of the City of Jacksonville any nuisance to the annoyance of those residing or being in the vicinity thereof, or any unwholesome or decayed or decaying animal or vegetable matter, or any other matter or thing detrimental to the health or comfort of residents.

Depositing offal, trash, garbage, etc., in street or lot

No person shall throw, place or deposit, or cause to be thrown, placed or deposited, any offal, trash, garbage or filth of any kind into any of the public streets, roads, alleys, lanes or thoroughfares or vacant lot, or into or upon the premises of any other person within the city limits.

Depositing animal matter in water courses.

No person shall throw or place or deposit the bodies of dead animals, or animal matter of any kind, in the St. Johns river, or in any creek or water course within the city limits.

Occupant to keep premises and half of street clean.

It shall be the duty of every occupant or owner of any premises within the city limits to remove or cause to be removed from his or her premises and from one-half of the street, highway, road, alley or thoroughfare in front of such premises, all trash, garbage or refuse material of whatsoever kind, and place same in barrels, boxes or other suitable receptacles; such barrels, boxes or receptacles to be placed at the edge of the sidewalk in front of such premises. When the barrels, boxes or receptacles are emptied by the scavengers the owners thereof shall remove them or cause them to be removed inside of the fence line.

Penalty.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall, on conviction before the Municipal Court, be punished by a fine of not less than one or more than twenty dollars, or be imprisoned for not less than one or more than twenty days.
