SEC. 1272. The said company shall, within five months after the passage and approval of this ordinance, run its cars for the accommodation of passengers to the extremities of its tracks as now laid on Bay street and its Riverside line and its East Jacksonville line, not less often than once every ten minutes between the hours of 6 a. m. and 7 p. m., and not less often than once every twenty minutes between 7 p. m. and 11 p. m. And after the construction of the extension of its Riverside line, as provided in this ordinance, it shall run its cars on the extension to the extremity of the Riverside track not less often than once every twenty-five minutes between the hours of 6 a. m. and 9 p. m., and not less often than once every forty minutes between 9 p. m. and 11 p. m.

Fare.

SEC. 1273. The fare charged by said company from any point on its main line or a branch attainable by one continuous passage within the city limits along said main line and branches, shall not exceed five cents. No fare shall be charged for children under five years of age when accompanied by a person paying fare.

Ib., Sec. 7.
Tracks.

SEC. 1274. Said city of Jacksonville shall in no case tear up or undermine said tracks to lay down new pipes or ducts or sewers, for any purpose, without relaying said tracks.

Ib., Sec. 8.
Police
regulations.

SEC. 1275. Said company and its agents shall be under the same police regulations and liable to fine and imprisonment as other persons, for violating the ordinances of the City of Jacksonville.

Ib., Sec. 9.
Double tracks.

SEC. 1276. Said company shall have the right, at any time when business demands, to lay and operate a double track on any of said streets, after obtaining permission so to do from the City Council by ordinance.

Certain city
officials to ride
free.

SEC. 1277. The City Marshal and all police officers and firemen, in uniforms, of the City of Jacksonville, shall be passed free over any of the said lines.

Ib., Sec. 11.
To pay portion
of repairing
viaduct.

SEC. 1278. And it is a condition and consideration of the rights and privileges hereby granted, that the Jacksonville Street Railroad Company shall pay its proportion, ascertained as provided by law, chargeable against said street railway, of the cost and expense of maintaining, repairing and keeping in repair the viaduct extending from Bay street across to Riverside avenue.

SEC. 1279. Before this ordinance shall become operative, the said Jacksonville Street Railroad Company shall enter into a written contract to be filed with the Recorder, agreeing to be bound by all of the terms, stipulations and conditions of the ordinance, such contract to be executed
