Repairing
streets.

SEC. 1296. The said City of Jacksonville shall in no case be liable for any damage which may be sustained by digging or other unavoidable work, in repairing or laying gas, water or sewer pipes now running or to run along any streets in Jacksonville; but the said city shall in no case tear up or undermine said tracks to lay down any new pipes or ducts for gas, water or sewers without relaying said tracks. Nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to render said city in anywise liable to property owners or others for damages suffered by them in person or property by reason of or in the course of so constructing or operating such street railway.

SEC. 1297. The said company and its agents shall be under the same police regulations and liable to fine or imprisonment as other persons for violating the ordinances of the City of Jacksonville,

Double track.
Ib., Sec. 11.

SEC. 1298. The said company shall have the right, at any time when business demands, to lay and operate a double track on any of said streets, after obtaining permission by ordinance so to do.

Contract.
Ib., Sec. 12.

SEC. 1299. Before said Main Street Railroad Company shall begin the construction of the electric system, as herein provided for, it shall enter into a written contract, to be prepared by the City Attorney, and to be filed with the Recorder, agreeing to be bound by all the terms, stipulations and conditions of this ordinance. And the privilege hereby granted is confined to the streets stipulated in section 1288, and it shall be necessary to obtain permission, to be granted by ordinance, for the use of any other street or part of street.

Appliances to
be used.

SEC. 1300. The granting of this franchise is upon the express condition that the said Main Street Railroad Company obligates itself to construct, equip and operate a first-class electric street car line, and shall use and adopt all safeguards and appliances in constructing its wires and poles and operating its line as are generally adopted and used in other cities operating similar systems; and after fifteen years from the passage of this ordinance, the Council and Mayor may, by ordinance, require and compel the said street railroad company to adopt and employ such improved methods of applying electricity as a motive power as may have become generally acknowledged and adopted by other cities as a safer and more improved method than that being used by the said street railroad company under this ordinance.
