

said company, and shall maintain two lights at the crossing of the cemetery shell road, in positions indicated by the Board of Public Works.

SEC. 1309. No locomotive, train or car shall be run on said track at a rate exceeding six miles per hour; and the person in charge of any locomotive passing along said Howard street shall cause the bell thereof to be constantly rung while passing thereon. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars or imprisonment not exceeding fifteen days.

SEC. 1310. Nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to render the City of Jacksonville in anywise liable to property holders or others for damages suffered by them in person or property by reason or in the course of so constructing or operating such railroad.

B. F. DILLON AND ASSOCIATES.

SEC. 1311. B. F. Dillon, his associates, successors and assigns, be and are hereby granted the right of way for the erection and maintenance of poles and wires, with necessary appurtenances thereto, for the purpose of transacting a general messenger delivery and burglar alarm business upon and over all streets and alleys in the City of Jacksonville, Florida; except that no poles shall be placed on Bay street between Market street on the east and Bridge street on the west.

SEC. 1312. The Board of Public Works of this city shall have the right to make any and all reasonable rules, regulations and directions as to the height and character and the placing and maintenance of poles and wires necessary to the protection of the city and its property, and to require, from time to time, such changes in the location thereof as may be, in its opinion, necessary to the best interest of the city.

SEC. 1313. The rights hereby granted shall take effect and be in force from and after the publication of this ordinance for the term and period of twenty years.

GALA WEEK ASSOCIATION.

SEC. 1314. The Gala Week Association organized for the purpose of providing Gala Week attractions to bring to the City of Jacksonville during one week in the fall of each year a large number of people, exclusively for the benefit of the City of Jacksonville, is hereby authorized to locate, erect and maintain during Gala Week in each year, in the streets of the City of Jacksonville, such booths, stands and other temporary structures as said association may deem advisable, and to use the same for the purpose
