SEC. 1357. Said company shall, without delay, prepare a map or plat showing the location of its poles and wires and lines, which shall be verified by the City Engineer and approved by the Board of Public Works, and filed and recorded among the minutes by the Recorder, and all subsequent changes and additions shall be verified, approved and recorded in like manner aforesaid.

SEC. 1358. Nothing in this ordinance shall be so construed as to prohibit or prevent any person or company not herein mentioned from exercising and enjoying any and all rights and privileges herein conferred upon or conceded to any other person or company.

CITIZENS GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY.

SEC. 1359. The Citizens Gas and Electric Company be and the same is hereby granted the right, privilege and franchise, and shall have power and authority to open the ground in any part of the streets or highways, and to cross any bridges, viaducts and culverts in the City of Jacksonville, for the purpose of sinking, laying, or repairing such pipes and conductors as may be necessary, or as said company may deem proper to sink, lay or repair, for the purpose expressed in the articles of incorporation of said company; and the said company after opening the ground in said streets or highways, shall be held to put the same again in repair to the satisfaction of the Board of Public Works; Provided, That the Board of Public Works, for the time being, shall at all times have power to regulate, restrict and control such acts and doings of said company which may in any manner affect the health or safety of the inhabitants of said city.

Privilege.

SEC. 1360. Nothing in this ordinance shall be so construed as to prohibit or prevent any person or company not herein mentioned from exercising and enjoying any and all rights and privileges herein conferred, upon due authority being properly granted.
