

use of the Board of Trustees for the Waterworks and Improvement Bonds.

SEC. 3. That in addition to the levies in the preceding section of this ordinance, upon all the property within the city of Jacksonville as assessed upon the 1900 city assessment roll of the taxable property in the City of Jacksonville, approved and adopted by the City Council, on each dollar of valuation assessed there is hereby levied for judgments against the city a tax of two mills.

SEC. 4. That, in addition to the levies in the preceding sections of this ordinance, upon all the property within the City of Jacksonville and within one thousand feet of a water main or hydrant, as assessed upon the 1900 city assessment roll of the taxable property within the city of Jacksonville, approved and adopted by the City Council, on each dollar assessed there is hereby levied for waterworks and fire protection a special tax of four and four-tenths mills.

SEC. 5. The Comptroller, in estimating and carrying out the taxes assessed upon the assessment rolls shall set down in separate columns and under separate headings the amounts of taxes for the several purposes for which such taxes are levied by the City Council, as follows:

First—To the right of the columns of valuation, under the single heading "Ordinary Corporation Purposes," shall appear in three columns the amounts of taxes assessed for ordinary corporation purposes; the first column under the sub-heading "One and Nine-tenths Mills, other than Board of Public Works and Bond Trustees," containing the amounts of taxes levied for ordinary corporation purposes to be used for purposes other than for the use of the Board of Public Works and the Board of trustees for the Waterworks and Improvement Bonds; in the second column, under the sub-heading "Seven Mills, Board of Public Works," containing the amount of taxes levied for ordinary corporation purposes for the use of the Board of Public Works; and the third column under the sub-heading "Seven-tenths Mills, Board of Bond Trustees," containing the amount of taxes levied for ordinary corporation purposes for the use of the Board of Trustees for the Waterworks and Improvement Bonds; to the right, under the heading "Four and Four-tenths Mills, Waterworks and Fire Protection," shall appear in a column the amount of taxes levied for waterworks and fire protection; to the right, under the heading "Two Mills, Judgments Against the City," shall appear in a column the amount of taxes levied for the paying of judgments against the city.

SEC. 6. That the Board of Public Works are hereby directed and required, as soon as practicable after the first day of May, 1901,
