## Rotary learns of court challenges

The LaBelle Rotary Club recently heard a presentation from Honorable John E. Duryea Jr., of the 20th Circuit Court, who was assigned to Hendry County in July 2011, and The Honorable James D. Sloan, Hendry County Judge for the past 18 years, gave an overview of the Challenges and Solutions of the 20th Circuit Court. A few of the highlights of their presentation showing changes from 2006 were: Depositions up 71%; Court filings up 43%; Criminal Court Dispositions up 65%; Circuit Civil filings up 81%; Probate Court Dispositions up 12%; Unified Family Court filings down 33%; Hendry Real Property Filings increased 226% between 2006 and 2009. ## Joint redistricting meeting November 8

Hendry County Commissioners have made a decision on their preferred redistricting map. The action was taken at the board's regular October 25 meeting.

The county commission expects to have a joint redistricting meeting with the school board Nov. 8 at 5 p.m. at Clewiston City Hall.

It is felt that, although it isn't necessary, it is much simpler for the residents if both the county commission and school board districts are the same.

Before the Nov. 8 joint meeting, school board members will meet one-on-one with Supervisor of Elections Lucretia Strickland to familiarize themselves with the board's preferred plan and to register their own changes.

Ms. Strickland said she does not anticipate any problems with concurrence by the school board.

## Pain management clinics


Last December the board enacted a one-year moratorium on the establishment of pain management clinics in Hendry County.

The commissioners opted for a 90-day extension to come up with very stringent regulations.

## Public hearings

The commission gave the go ahead to rezoning property owned by the Pereiro family from General Commercial to Planned Unit Development (PUD).

their property, on SR 29S to accommodate additional uses. Originally these uses included truck stops, body shops, road service, carwash facilities, sale, rental, service and repair of mobile homes and trucks; however, staff did not recommend approval of all these uses.

The Pereiros do not intent to develop a truck stop or body shop in the future or sell moibile homes, but staff did concur in allowing road service, carwash facilities and trucks to appropriate uses.

The request was approved with additional restrictions for buffering. Commissioner Karson Turner warned that the county needs to keep its eyes on the situation. He is concerned it could turn into a salvage yard.

The board agreed to allow the offsite removal of spoil from a private residence on Ft. Denaud Road. Special conditions were applied to accommodate several neighbors.

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## COMPUTER CORNER

### The importance of updates

If you're a Windows user, and most of us are, you're used to seeing the periodic request to install updates. For some, this is a tiresome and annoying process which often causes the computer to reboot just when you'd rather it didn't.

The truth is, when security and other important updates are available, you really should download and install them. More times than not, these include important patches to your system which help keep you and your data safe and make the operating system more stable.

For Windows users, enabling automatic updates is the way to go; doing this will ensure that you've got the latest updates as they become available. If you use Office products like Word and Excel, they'll have their own set of updates and they're just as important as the ones for the operating system.

To find out exactly how to set your Windows system to get and install automatic updates, use your friendly search engine (like google.com, bing.com or yahoo.com). Searching for "Windows XP enabling automatic updates" produced great results for Windows XP. If you're running Windows Vista or Windows 7, just substitute your operating system for Windows XP to get fast and easy answers.

Macintosh users enjoy an operating system that does automatic updates by default, so it's likely that our Mac friends won't need to set anything special to ensure updates.

# United Way Hendry-Glades at halfway mark

The United Way of Hendry and Glades 2011-2012 Campaign has reached 50 percent of its \$200,500 goal through the fundraising efforts of Pacesetter companies. “Ashamed, I looked down at my own tattered and torn clothing, covered in stains. I was dirty. A foul smell seemed to consume me and I couldn't shake the grime that clung to my body.

## Career Corner

### Interview Tips

This week we will cover more examples of common interview questions, their theory and suggestions on how to craft appropriate responses.

Because so much time is spent writing resumes and cover letters, filling out applications and stressing about a phone call or e-mail acknowledging the receipt of that application, preparing for an interview is usually, and wrongly, the last thing a candidate prepares for. There are two types of interviews: traditional and behavioral. Identifying the type of interview you find yourself in is easy after the first question or two.

Traditional interviews ask straightforward questions such as “why are you the most qualified candidate for this position?” Usually, this is the last question an employer will ask, which makes the answer possibly the most memorable if delivered well. The first thing to remember when answering this question is to stick to your resume. Highlight your skills and abilities for the job which you are applying. Don't stray towards clichés or begging statements such as “I want to move out of my parents house” or “my girlfriend is expensive.”

Start by repeating your branding statement. A branding statement, otherwise known as an elevator speech, is a 30 second sales pitch of why someone should give you a pay check. Think of yourself as a product being advertised on the radio;

why should they purchase your product or what skills and abilities can you offer the company? Next, briefly state why you like this company and how your vision matches the company's goals and direction (which you read about on their Web site). End with a short example of a success you achieved for an old employer and suggest that you can achieve similar success with this employer.

A behavioral question may sound like “what would your old boss or co-workers say about you if we called them?” Employers are looking to see how you view your old co-workers, not how they view you. This question allows the interviewer to see how you treat people you work with and what you say about them when they're not around. To answer this question, reply with how much you learned at your old jobs and give one or two specifics on something exciting you learned while working there. Finish by saying that you hope your old co-workers enjoyed working with you as much as you enjoyed working with them. If the last job ended poorly, state what you learned from that experience and how it makes you a more valuable employee.

Whatever the question, limit your answer to 45 seconds or less. Try to smile a lot and look each interviewer in the eye. When you're finished with your answer stop talking. Many interviewers try to elicit more information if they stall between questions, don't be baited and give more than you want. 

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# Small business hopefuls get guidance at ECC in LaBelle

At the end of the six-week program, graduates will have the opportunity to apply for small startup grants and microloans to help launch their new business ventures. Program managers hope that by providing


small business training and avenues for funding, the Southwest Florida MicroEnterprise project will spark economic growth in our community.
