Glades logs sixth fatality

Glades County has seen its sixth fatal crash this year. In all of 2012, there were a total of four. According to the Florida Highway Patrol, the one-vehicle crash took place June 7 at 5:17 p.m. on CR 721 north of SR 78.

The FHP reports that a 2008 Dodge Avenger was traveling north on CR 721 when it left the roadway and continued north on the east shoulder of CR 721 through two private driveways. It collided with two concrete poles and continued north when it overturned several times. The driver was ejected completely from the vehicle, which came to a rest on its roof, facing west. The driver ended up east of the vehicle.

According to FHP the crash was not alcohol related and the victim was not wearing a seatbelt at the time of the crash.

Identification of the deceased was pending notification of next of kin.


Tallahassee to LaBelle

Bomb threats lead to arrest

On Wednesday, May 29, 2013, Hendry County Deputies responded to five separate complaints reporting that they had received phone calls from an automated female voice stating, "A bomb will detonate in 15 minutes. I suggest you evacuate."

At 2:08 that afternoon, deputies first responded to the LaBelle Middle School after receiving the automated call.

Eleven personnel still present on the school campus were evacuated and a search was conducted for any

suspicious items.

LaBelle Middle School was cleared by law enforcement personnel after they found nothing suspicious.

Beginning at 6:37 p.m., within a six minute period, Hendry County Sheriffs Deputies were dispatched to four additional locations.

The first was Handy South, Located at 1040 State Road 29, BP Gas station located at 280 W. Hickpochee Ave., Sal Cal Pizza, located at 732 South Main Street, and Winn Dixie Grocery Store, located at 906 South Main Street.

All four businesses received calls from an automated female voice indicating that

there was a bomb on the premises and it would detonate.

Business operators safely evacuated their locations and law enforcement officers searched all areas for any suspicious devices.

None were found.

One of the local businesses targeted was able to capture the phone number the call was generated from, along with a name.

Hendry County IT Director Ryan Purdy, who oversees Hendry County Sheriff's Office technology, was able to determine that the phone number used was a default number for Skype.com.

During the investigation, Purdy along with Hendry County investigators, were provided with the account information.

Investigators were able to determine that 14-year-old Jourdan Dampier of LaBelle utilized a laptop computer in conjunction with the Skype account to generate the automated messages to local business.

In an eleven-hour period, authorities say Dampier attempted to initiate twelve bomb threats.

However only five of the calls were successful.

On Wednesday, June 5, 2013, Hendry County Investigators took Dampier into custody and charged him with five counts of False Bomb Threats.

Dampier is currently being held in Fort Myers, at the Juvenile Detention Center.

CR 78 closure postponed until June 17

Hendry County Engineering reports that the previously scheduled closure of CR78 in North LaBelle between Old CR 78 and Nobles Road has been rescheduled to June 17 (one week delay).

The road will be closed to through traffic (including school buses) for the 220 day construction period.

One Harvest Food delivered for local families

LaBelle area families and individuals who purchased discount-priced One Harvest food packages last week received their food Saturday, May 25 at Carlson Memorial United Methodist Church. There were 31 packages purchased during this initial phase of the program and many people are expected to be repeat purchasers, according to Claire O'Donnell, coordinator of the One Harvest program in LaBelle.

One Harvest packages include a variety of frozen vegetables and meats available in several size boxes which enables families and individuals to pick a package that best suits their needs and budget. Participation in the program requires no qualification forms so anyone who wishes can purchase them. Also, there is no limit to the number of packets a person can buy.

Ms. O'Donnell explained that the costs are lower, not the quality of the meats and vegetables. Costs are lower because people volunteer to haul the distribution packages to LaBelle and then working in the delivery

site. Also, site locations are donated which saves on rents and other expenses. The program in this respect is similar to previous food programs that served LaBelle but One Harvest has added numerous improvements including the choices available and higher quality. One Harvest does not totally eliminate a person's need for grocery shopping. Food packages do not include bakery goods, produce, paper and household products, or dairy products which are available at local grocery stores.

"We anticipate that the next packet delivery date will be in late July," Ms. O'Donnell said while discussing the One Harvest program. "One Harvest is a nationwide program and has been available in areas like Bonita Springs for quite a long time. The Jacksonville warehouse has refrigerated trucks that deliver the packages to each regional site. As the number of orders increases so will the frequency of people being able to make purchases."

The menu of packages and the price of

each for July will be posted within the next three or four weeks. Residents may check the Carlson Memorial website at www.carlsonumc.org or call the church office in La-

Belle. As food costs continue to increase the One Harvest program is being heralded for its role in keeping people from going hungry during hard economic times.

County sets road priorities

County Engineer Shawn Parker laid out the county's priority list for FDOT's Capital Improvement Program. With the ongoing widening of SR 80 and US 27/SR 80 improvements, the top priority is the PD&E for US 27 from the Palm Beach County line to CR 720; followed the SR 29 right-of-way from Spencer to just north of Cowboy Way; and thirdly, construction of that portion of SR 29.

The priority for the County Incentive Grant Program is Helms Road Extension (\$4.5 million with no county match). From Intermodal funds Airglades Industrial Park expansion of wastewater plant and spray field (requiring a 50/50 match). In the Small County Incentive Program: CR 78 (a farm to market road, evacuation route and major traffic corridor) resurfacing, striping, signage

upgrades, drainage and shoulder work; and from Small County Road Assistance: Fort Denaud Road, Francisco Road in Clewiston and WC Owen Ave. in Clewiston.

The county is hoping to get Enhancement dollars for various sidewalks, entrance signs and street lighting on SR 80 as well as funding for Helms Road SR 29 intersection improvements.

LaBelle museum

The board approved a request from LaBelle Heritage Museum to extend its lease on Lee Street for the Rider buildings, formerly used as the museum, to be moved. With the acquisition of the old Poole house on Bridge Street, and its opening as the main museum building, the organization is attempting to move the Poole buildings onto its new property. The board granted the museum another six months to make it happen.

"Our father did not leave a financial empire for us to carry on. Many things that a dad normally does with his sons, ours was unable to do. He was unable to teach us many things that a dad normally teaches. But he did leave us something that he had. He left us with a love of God, a love for the Bible, a love for people, an understanding

of worship and an inability to hate. We feel that he has left us only those things that will last. So we stand here before you as his sons and declare publicly that we will follow his God."

There you go, dad. Now go make it a happy Father's Day by putting something into the lives of your children that will carry them through tough days ahead.

Prepare for hurricane season, burn yard trash

As residents prepare for Hurricane Season, they are urged to trim trees and remove yard trash BEFORE a storm threatens. This tip is to prevent objects from becoming dangerous projectiles during a hurricane. In rural communities, tree and shrub trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, trees and tree stumps start to accumulate. Some rural residents do not have access to county or commercial solid waste collection service for yard trash.

Rural residents have two options: (1) Self-hauling yard trash to the neighborhood trash and recycling centers (2) Burning yard trash. Yard trash burning might be a cost effective solution to hauling the debris away. Burning small amounts of yard waste does not require an authorization from the Florida Forest Service, but you should check with your local city, county or Florida Forest Service officials to see if there are any restrictions in your area.

Many people do not know or are not aware of Florida's outdoor burning regulations. Familiarize yourself with the burning regulations in your area. If you are to burn here a few tips to keep in mind:

- Never leave a fire unattended, and make sure it is out before you leave
- Keep a shovel and water hose handy
- Don't burn on windy days or when the humidity is below 35 percent.

- The yard trash material intended to be burned must be generated on the premises of the burn site.

- The fires must not cause smoke, soot, odors, visible emissions, heat, flame, radiation, or other conditions to the degree that they become a nuisance or safety hazard.

- The fire must be started after 9 a.m. and be out by one hour after sunset.

- Your fire must be contained to an 8 foot diameter pile or non-combustible barrel and must be at least 25 feet from forests, 25 feet from your house, 50 feet from a paved public road and 150 feet from other occupied buildings.

- If your fire escapes, you may be held liable for suppression costs and damage to the property of others. Wildfires can occur all year round in Florida. During the summer months wildfires typically are smaller in size due to the wet season.







How to get approved for a mortgage
