Southwest sector plan approved

At their June 3 meeting in LaBelle, Hendry County commissioners unanimously approved amendments to the Southwest Hendry County Sector Plan, refining the basic outline for development in the 23,600 acre area located west of Felda.

The 19,675-acre west side is bounded by Collier County on the south, Lee on the west with the northern boundary adjacent to the Lee-Hendry Landfill and Rodina Sector Plan and to the east with the Felda Community Planning Area. It is intended to include industrial, commercial and neighborhood uses.

The East Area is approximately 3,925 acres and abuts the Dinner Island Ranch Wildlife Management Area.

It will link with the Panther Glades Florida Forever Project and will be dedicated to natural resources, agriculture and residential density of one dwelling unit per 100 acres.

Vice President Real Estate for Kings Ranch and Consolidated Citrus, Mitch Hutchcraft, explained

Voting faster, easier

Technology is supposed to make things work faster and better. It doesn't always work that way, but the Hendry County Elections Office is confident its new Electronic Voter Identification (EViD) will do just what it promises.

This year will be the first time the Hendry County Elections Office will use this new technology and it's expected to reduce waiting time at the polls by half.

With a swipe of the voter's driver's license EViD will print out your election statistics on a slip of paper similar to a grocery receipt. In a few

West Point: It's about learning to lead

Around the world, West Point has a rock solid reputation as the best in building leaders. That's why LaBelle's John Marotti wanted to go there. Still, he had no real idea of just what was in store for him. Going into his senior year at the Point, John looks back and says his Plebe (freshman) year was the "toughest of my life."

Going from LaBelle, into the Army and basic training, hardened by time in the field, dealing with

no air conditioning - for a time he said he questioned his decision to go there. But one day at a time, he made it through, struggling, learning, growing.

John is majoring in electrical engineering, the technical circuitry infrastructure underlying modern technology in all homes, computers and electronic devices. After graduation, he will be a Signal Corps Officer managing and overseeing communication assets of the Army, troop communications with base and so on.

It's a fundamental tenet for all who go through West Point: "You

shoot, you move, you communicate."

Like all West Pointers, after graduation he is committed to serving five years in the Army. How long he stays in the Army depends on many factors, he said. It's way too early to tell.

He enlisted because he wants to give back to his country. He said he likes to serve America - likes what we have - and wants to protect it for all those to come.

West Point, he feels is a way to move forward. It's a unique experience.

seconds the voter's county of residence, registration number, name, address, party affiliation, race, birth date and original date of registration is printed out, along with their precinct number, address and county commission, city, school board, state House and Senate Districts and Congressional Districts.

The slip is a quick way to identify voters for early voting and on Election Day.

It uses that information to print out the correct ballot for each voter, who then proceeds to the voting booth as usual. In effect, the voter is checked in electronically at the Elections Office.

The voter signs the EVID sig pad for comparison to and verification with their photo identification. Supervisor of Elections Brenda Hoots said this sig pad produces an excellent quality, true signature.

Voters still must vote at their regular precinct except if they're early voting. Then balloting only occurs at the two Supervisor of Elections Offices - one in LaBelle (25 E. Hickpochee Avenue) and one in Clewisiton

(100 S. Olympia Street, Suite 504).

Elections Office employees are using the EVID for registration drives to register voters and also to highlight potential problems for individuals (including changes of address, party etc., that need to be updated). Ms. Hoots feels it's a "good exercise" for election day for employees and voters.

If for some reason the EVID wont read the magnetic strip on your identification, elections workers can also use the voter's date of birth, verified with a photo ID, to retrieve the voter's information from EVID.

Ms. Hoots said the program will be a great help, especially in the primary elections when many people get in the wrong line by party.

She said she has had very positive reactions so far to the system.

This year Hendry County's precincts

have been consolidated from 23 to just ten, so the new system should result in faster lines.

The \$42,800 EVID system was purchased out of Ms. Hoots' budget and one will be located at each poling place in the county. Voters are asked to please bring a photo ID.

Qualifying by petition is over, but potential candidates may still qualify to vote for office by paying a fee till June 20 for all offices coming up for election this year.

Dates to remember:

Primary Election August 26, 2014. Register by July 28 for Primary.

Early Voting Dates: August 11-23 for primary.

General Election November 4. Register by October 6 for General Election. Early Voting Dates: October 20-November 1.

Check with Elections Office for times.

that plans for the area will protect wildlife, natural resources, agriculture and property rights, identifying water and transportation needs as well as natural resource management needs.

He said planners worked with all property owners in the area to complete the plan. Only two property owners opted out.

Julianne Thomas from the Conservancy of Southwest Florida lent that group's support to the Southwest Hendry County Sector Plan.

She said most of the issues her environmental group saw had been addressed in these new amendments, leaving only one philosophical issue: whether one owner

could change the future land use map for other owners. In order to opt out of the approved plan, a property owner would have to go through a comprehensive plan process.

Nancy Peyton of the Florida Wildlife Federation said her group also supports the plan.

She said the plan will connect wildlife habitat in the West Sector with CREW and the Okaloacootchee Slough and improve some of the deadliest road sections for panthers in Southwest Florida, along CR 846.

County Commission Chairman Karson Turner praised the plan, saying it's "just the kind of development we need."

experience, he said, with other countries sending soldiers to train there and some cadets also going abroad to study, making it an international effort. West Point gives you a new perspective on life, he explained, and it will enhance your future leadership experience.

The first year you learn to follow. It was kind of counter-intuitive for him, a disappointment.

"You go to West Point to learn to lead. It's hard to follow," he said, but leadership development comes with experience, he learned. "You learn to follow first, then to lead."

West Point is full time active duty service that never stops. It's hands-on experience for a lifetime.

The learning begins on Day One as a Plebe, learning to follow. Your sophomore year you are assigned as team leader to a freshman, responsible for developing the new cadet. You may not realize it at the time, he said, but it's great experience for learning how to lead.

John is now a platoon sergeant in charge of 30 subordinates. He manages his team, keeps proper discipline and sets standards. He's actually an "enforcer" of sorts,

His dream of leading is becoming a reality. At the beginning of next term, he will

become a First Sergeant of a company in charge of four platoons.

John says he's changed since walking through the doors at West Point. He's more calm and collected - able to make more analytical decisions in "very high stress situations."

Having responsibility for 40 soldiers in simulated combat while being "attacked" by other cadets; having to make the decision to attack or retreat forces you to use those difficult, hard-won day-to-day lessons.

His college work has been the easiest part, he comments. He attributes going from LHS and taking higher classes at Edison for his AA degree helped prepare him for the transition.

To John, attending West Point is a great opportunity and all about work but tells anyone interested in following his pathway to West Point that they need to remember to stay on process to get in, It's a mountain of registration and acceptance work, but worth it if you really want it.

At 21, John Marotti is much the same young man who left his hometown of LaBelle three years ago, but more experienced, more able to face challenges. He is well on his way to being the man envisioned when he left.

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Emergency Management: Safety first, second and last

You may have missed "Hurricane Jones" last month, but don't be alarmed. Although it was a fictitious storm, it was an important exercise honing the skills and knowledge of local emergency responders.

Monday and Tuesday, May 19 and 20, two teams of county employees worked 12-hour shifts preparing for, and dealing with the onslaught and aftermath of "Hurricane Jones."

During the recent exercise, Hendry County and the state faced a Category 4 storm. The EOC tracked the storm, which was lined up for Hendry County but veered off somewhat. The result was that the exercise took personnel through dealing with the high winds and rain such a weather event would produce.

Emergency Management Director Lupe Taylor said Hendry County Emergency Management took part in the statewide test. She called it a "good exercise" with a lot of participation by partners throughout the county, including representatives from both cities.

Ms. Taylor said the county is still working through a radio problem, caused by the fact that Clewiston Police Department is not

completely equipped with the new 800 radio system. However, the CPD is in the process of rectifying that situation.

The Hendry County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is coming off the traditional pencil and paper record system, Ms. Taylor said the EOC did an excellent job using its new software, Town Square IT software, to record the entire event. However, she said they were careful to keep the tried and true pencil and paper method - just in case some-

thing unthinkable should happen with the computer system.

"We can still get the job done," she said, adding that they are continuing to work on the technology side.

For instance, damage assessment can now be input using an iPad or smart phone as well as computers. Pictures of damage can even be attached to the paperwork for the appropriate property in just one visit.

The new software makes the process much faster and easier. It used to take a week to input information, now it's just a click.

There are 17 Emergency System Functions (EMFs) - personnel categories that carry out vital services during emergency situations, such as transportation, communication, engineering, public safety and so on.

It's a big job. All participants incorporate their previous training in such a dry run and Mr. Taylor said she's gotten some good feedback on the exercise.

The agencies that took part in the exercise were: Hendry Co. Sheriff's Office, Clewiston Policy Dept., Hendry County School Board; Hendry County Health Dept., Hendry County HR, Hendry County Engineering, Hendry County PIO, City Of LaBelle, City of Clewiston, Red Cross, Hendry County Ag Extension Office, Hendry County Road and Bridge, Port LaBelle Utility, Hendry County EMS and Hendry County Administration.

Shelters

The Persons with Special Needs (PSN) Shelter is at West Glades School. Remember, you must be ready to go when the Goodwill bus arrives to pick you up. If you have a friend or family member who can bring you, even better. Remember, you must bring your supplies including water, food, blankets, pillows, etc. and, of course, your medications. The shelter is staffed by The Florida Department of Health in Hendry County employees, but you must have a caregiver with you when you arrive.

At this time, five residents are approved to go to the PSN and three residents are registered to go straight to the hospital in a qualifying emergency. There are eight PSN applications pending. If you have medical issues and would need to go to the PSN, you must register every year for a spot in the PSN.

For the general population, LaBelle Middle and Clewiston Middle Schools are the primary shelters for the county - first to be opened in a designated emergency. Then come Country Oaks and Eastside/Westside in Clewiston.

As always with such emergencies, complacency is a big enemy.

Ms. Taylor reminds everyone to have at least three days worth of food, water and supplies for each member of your family so you can make it through till power comes back on or help arrives.

Not so, this time. The following was written by Steven Levy and recited by him on CBS Sunday Morning Commentary. I was impressed and challenged and hope you will be, too.

"I don't like getting pushed around for being a Jew, and I don't think Christians like getting pushed around for being Christians.

"I think people who believe in God are sick and tired of getting pushed around, period. I have no idea where the concept came from, that America is an explicitly atheist country. I can't find it in the Constitution and I don't like it being shoved down my throat...

"Or maybe I can put it another way: where did the idea come from that we should worship celebrities and we aren't allowed to worship God as we understand Him?"

"I guess that's a sign that I'm getting old, too. But there are a lot of us who are wondering where these celebrities came from and where the America we knew went to.

"In light of the many jokes we send to one another for a laugh, this is a little different: This is not intended to be a joke; it's not funny, it's intended to get you thinking.

"In light of recent events... terrorists attack, school shootings, etc... I think it started when Madeleine Murray O'Hare (she was murdered, her body found a few years ago) complained she didn't want prayer in our schools, and we said OK.

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

Rotary learns about medical research

Cecil Akin, made a presentation on the Masonic Medical Research Laboratory (MMRL) which is regarded as a world leader and one of the most highly respected cardiology institutes in the world. Recently they established a Stem Cell Center focused on regenerative medicine and development of human models of disease using new technology employing induced pluripotent stem cells, which preclude the need for use of embryos. Pluripotent stem cells are often termed 'true' stem cells because they have the potential to differentiate into almost any cell in the body. The MMRL provided the first direct evidence linking Sudden Death Syndrome (SIDS) to an abnormal heart rhythm. It is now estimated that 10-15 percent of SIDS is due to arrhythmic disease. They identified drug combinations for the management of atrial fibrillation which affects over 2.5 million Americans and is reaching epidemic proportions. This new class of drugs has provided a shift in the therapy of atrial fibrillation, one of the major causes of stroke in the United States. The MMRL has a current campaign, entitled "Every Heartbeat Counts."
