



## Clean up for potential Wal Mart property

The LaBelle City Commission was visited by Justin Hoffmeier, environmental attorney representing Ben Moore, whose property on SR 80 west of town is likely to be the site of a Walmart one day. Mr. Hoffmeier told the commission that Mr. Moore has filed with the Department of Environmental Protection for the property to become a Brownfield site (a commercial or industrial area that is deemed to be contaminated),

The site was previously a citrus grove, he said, cyanide is present in the dirt. The contaminant could also be naturally occurring from limestone.

The water there is not contaminated, but nothing can be built on the property as it is. He added that Mr. Moore will probably need

to haul off all the soil - a considerable expense.

Mr. Hoffmeier said he has met with adjacent residents, and met all requirements by the city to obtain a resolution from the city, so he can seek FDEP's approval in order to declare the property a Brownfield.

He said Mr. Moore has not yet closed on the property but is moving forward.

The resolution will allow him to seek state incentive funding so the property can be cleaned to target levels, which would be paid for through corporate tax credits.

The resolution supports the Brownfield designation for the property as a creator of job and job development.

According to Mr. Hoffmeier, Walmart loves the site and is simply working through the process to get the area cleaned up.

City Attorney Angela Hill advised that a resolution supporting the request would be of benefit to the city, and cause no detriment. She noted that it would be the city's best chance to clean up the property.

The board approved the resolution, 4-0. Commissioner Tommy Smith was absent.

## Downtown

City Planner Shellie Johnson took the opportunity to explain more about the city's ongoing Main Street project. Volunteers have formed a nonprofit group called the LaBelle Downtown Revitalization Corporation so they can qualify to apply for grant funding.

The group is planning another wharf walk in the fall, similar to the one put on when phase two was completed. Ms. Johnson said the Arts of Inland group will take part and is planning a chalk art demonstra-

tion to highlight the city's cultural and historical theme.

She added that the group may be receiving donated pavers to dress up the downtown by creating some small intersection projects. The plan is to sell the bricks to individuals and groups and possibly have some cornerstones available for corporate sponsorships.

The group is hoping to apply for a \$20,000 Lowe's grant to supplement the paver project.

A website for the project is also in the works.

According to Ms. Johnson, the Downtown Revitalization Corporation still has a lot of work ahead, but is in very good shape to apply for a Main Street grant, given the work already done. The 42-page document must be completed by the end of July, and would provide access to statewide technical support.

If they can secure the initial grant, a \$10,000 second year grant from state would then be available.

## Kiwanis request

Chris Soud, LaBelle Kiwanis Club treasurer, asked the commission to waive hook up fees for a \$15,000 sewer project. The Kiwanis Club supports the community with \$50,000-\$60,000 in scholarships and donations to summer camps and the library, among other donations. The board did not feel it could waive the fees, but said the city would pay the hookup fee for the club. The motion was made by Commissioner Greg Bone and seconded by Commissioner Hilda Zimmerly. It passed unanimously.

## Bears and Barbecue

Coordinator for the big Bears and Barbecue benefit coming up on July 19 reported to the board. Lonnie Brick said he has about 30 vendors lined up and 15 teams for the barbecue competition. The event will include a muscle car show, monster truck show and bands. He said as many as 5,000 motorcycles could show up at Barron Park. He asked for and received permission to close several streets, including Lee, DeSoto and Main, during the event.

Spina Bifada and cannot use her legs.

James said they prayed a while longer about the little girl, but in the end there really was no question. They had the same compassion and love for both of them as for the two God gave them directly.

James said it's very important to complete these adoptions quickly because of their special needs.

He said that, according to Eastern European law, if a special needs child is not adopted by the time they're four, they must be committed to a mental institution for life.

The Hollands expect some difficulty in integrating these special children with their own, but they've already begun the process. Seeing their pictures, little Gracie already calls them Bubba and Sissie and put their pictures on her little toy refrigerator.

The family also has advocates on their side and a support system to help guide them through this experience.

"We were blown away with this fundraiser," James said. "We never had any idea of asking for help." He said they just understood that this is what they are supposed to do, so it would happen.

"It's amazing how LaBelle is rallying around us," he added. "Everywhere we go someone is asking what they can do to help."

Their friend Stephanie Conner, daughter-in-law of Tom and Joyce Conner, is spear-

heading the fund raiser

There's a lot of uncertainty surrounding these adoptions. The couple recognizes that they're stepping out on faith. When they arrive at the airport in Eastern Europe they will be met by a guide.

After several appointments they will plead their case before a judge who will make the decision. James said they don't anticipate any problems with the adoption since the children are special needs and therefore not truly welcome in their own country.

The Hollands expect to fly out in 6-8 weeks. The paperwork has been submitted and is being translated. Once they arrive in Eastern Europe, they should remain there for a week to a week-and-a-half before returning with the rest of their family.

A Moore Haven man is dead after being struck by a vehicle on SR 78 June 15, at 1:28 a.m.

According to the Florida Highway Patrol, 40-year-old Nicolas Garcia of Okeechobee was driving a 2005 GMC Savana eastbound on SR 78 approaching the intersection of Lake Drive W. He had two passengers, 16-year-old Isaac Garcia, and 11-year-old Alexis Garcia.

Gary Lee Walker, 50, was lying down in the eastbound lane approximately 380 feet west of Lake Drive. Mr. Garcia attempted to swerve around him, but the trailer he was towing drove over Mr. Walker. FHP reports that Mr. Walker was under the influence of alcohol at the time.

Everyone in the Garcia vehicle was wearing a seatbelt at the time and no one in the vehicle was injured.

# Input on bear management

FWC to hold public workshops for input on managing bears in south Florida

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) will hold three public workshops in June and July to discuss management of black bears in south Florida and how people can get involved in working with the FWC on local bear issues.

Under the FWC's Florida Black Bear Management Plan, approved in 2012, seven bear management units (BMUs) will be established throughout the state.

The BMU approach will allow the FWC to manage bears based on the characteristics of bears, people and habitat in different parts of Florida. The first steps are being taken to create the South BMU to manage the bear subpopulation in the Big Cypress National Preserve and surrounding areas.

Workshops will offer the public a chance to provide input on local bear issues and allow interested individuals to sign up to be active members of the South Bear Stakeholder Group. The meetings will be from 6:30 to 8 p.m. at the following locations:

- Sunrise, June 25 - Sunrise Civic Center Ballroom, 10610 W. Oakland Park Blvd.

- Naples, June 26 - Collier County IFAS Extension Office, 14700 Immokalee Rd.


- Lehigh Acres, July 1 - East County Regional Library, 881 Gunnery Rd.

"The workshops will give the FWC a better understanding of the local perspective on bear management in south Florida," said Dave Telesco, FWC Bear Management Program coordinator. "Participants at the workshops will be able to interact more with FWC staff than during a regular meeting. We will be listening more than talking."

The South BMU includes Broward, Collier, Hendry, Lee, Miami-Dade, Monroe and Palm Beach counties. Three other BMUs already have been initiated: the West Panhandle BMU in fall 2013 and, more recently, the Central and East Panhandle BMUs in spring 2014.

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# Beware the dangers of naegleria fowleri

The Florida Department of Health in Hendry and Glades Counties cautions those who swim frequently in Florida's lakes, rivers and ponds during warm temperatures about the possible presence of *Naegleria fowleri*.

Contact and infection with this amoeba is rare, but the organism targets a person's brain and usually results in death. Adverse health effects on humans can be prevented by avoiding nasal contact with the waters, since the amoeba enters through the nasal passages.

Since 1962, there have been 34 reported cases of *Naegleria fowleri* or "brain-eating amoeba" in Florida.

It can cause Primary Amebic Meningoencephalitis (PAM) disease which usually leads to death once a person becomes infected. As a precaution, health officials provide the following guidance:

- Avoid water-related activities in bodies of warm freshwater, hot springs and thermally polluted water such as water around power plants.
- Avoid water-related activities in warm freshwater during periods of high water temperature and low water levels.
- Hold the nose shut or use nose clips when taking part in water-related activities

in bodies of warm freshwater such as lakes, rivers, or hot springs.

- Avoid digging in or stirring up the sediment while taking part in water-related activities in shallow, warm freshwater areas.

- Please note exposure to the amoeba may also occur when using neti pots to rinse your sinuses of cold/allergy-related congestion or conducting religious rituals with tap water.

Use only boiled and cooled, distilled, or sterile water for making sinus rinse solutions for neti pots or performing ritual ablutions.

If you experience any of the following symptoms after swimming in any warm body of water, please contact your health care provider immediately: headache, fever, nausea, disorientation, vomiting, stiff neck, seizures, loss of balance, or hallucinations.

It is essential to seek medical attention right away, as PAM usually becomes fatal within five days of exposure.

Remember, this disease is rare and effective prevention strategies can allow for a safe and relaxing summer swim season.

This kind of challenge is not for the faint of heart. One has to dare to be different. It is easy to have a bad attitude, to feel sorry for yourself, to keep a chip on one's shoulder, or even to give the "silent treatment." However, being a person who genuinely seeks God's heart requires God-like action.

It will cost you hard work, but it will be worth it in the end.

# Iamurri named head softball coach for Buccaneers

June 12, 2014 – FORT MYERS, FLA. – In the softball world, mention the name Robert Iamurri and there's instant recognition of a proven coach who consistently takes teams to state championships.

Starting July 16, Iamurri officially takes the helm as the head softball coach for the Florida SouthWestern State College Buccaneers. "In our search for a head softball coach, we received over 130 applications from around the country.

"He really is the perfect choice for (FSW's) new program," said Pat Murphy, head softball coach, University of Alabama.

"He has won many, many championships; he can teach pitchers, hitters and defense. FSW really made a good choice in selecting him as their coach. I hope he'll send me some players."

Iamurri and his Buccaneers team will call the City of Palms Park home for their games, starting in the Fall 2015, followed by the start of the regular season in the Spring 2016.

They wear uniforms daily and have the same pay structure as the military.



# Florida SouthWestern State College gets \$6.5M for renovations

June 1, 2014 –FORT MYERS, Fla. – Today, Governor Rick Scott signed the 2014-15 state budget, which includes \$6.5 million for renovation projects at Edison State College,

which will become Florida SouthWestern State College on July 1.

“The funding for our renovation work means the science classes our students need will continue in an environment that helps them reach their educational and professional goals,” said Dr. Jeff Allbritten, President, Edison State College, soon to be Florida SouthWestern State College. “This allows us to keep pace with the current and future technological and scientific lab requirements.”
