Three arrested in Pioneer

After stealing a car in Lee County, three teens went for a joy ride ending up in Pioneer Plantation.

After they got the vehicle stuck in a driveway, they asked for help in removing it, later admitting to Investigators it was their intention to steal the victim's vehicle. They stopped at the Shell Station located at the intersection of Hendry Isles Blvd and State Road 80 where they attempted to rob a man by placing a gun to his side demanding money. The victim refused to give up his bank bag and instead grab the barrel of the gun. The suspects pulled the trigger of the gun three times, but the firearm failed to fire.

The three young men ran into a wooded area and were later located by K-9s. Hendry County deputies, and K-9 units, Lee County Sheriff's Office helicopter, deputies, and K-9 units, Clewiston Police Dept K-9 units and Florida Highway Patrol assisted in locating the suspects.

All three suspects were taken into custody. After interviewing the suspects, 17-year-old Charles Hill was charged with, Attempted Armed Robbery, Attempted Carjacking, Possession of Stolen Vehicle, Aggravated Assault with a Firearm, Destruction ampering with Evidence, Petit Theft, and Grand Theft.

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Helms Road development on the table

At the July 10 LaBelle City Commission meeting, the board held a public hearing on a request for a rezoning that would allow a development at the southeastern corner of Helms Road and SR 29. Sitting as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) the city commissioners heard plans to put in a Planned Unit Development (PUD). The intention of an "Employment Village" is "to promote the coexistence of employment-generating industries, residential develop-

ment and commercial services."

The property was annexed into the city in 2006 and was classified in the Employment Village Future Land Uses category in 2011.

The 277-acre site is surrounded on the north by vacant land; south and east pastures and ag, west by multi-family (Green tree). Plans call for three units per acre multi-family units only. Developers intend to locate commercial uses along SR 29 with industrial uses on the eastern side and residential in the middle.

Green space will buffer the residential space from the commer-

cial and industrial uses, and will include a park area. The focus will be on a pedestrian and bike community, resulting in less traffic on the public roads.

City water will be available but the developer will need to supply wastewater service.

The board will hear the request at its August meeting.

Farmworker housing

City Planner Shellie Johnson told the board of a plan to develop farmworker housing at the old FPL site on Cowboy Way. She said she doesn't know much about the developer yet, but he has a good rep-

utation for quality. It appears the developer wants to use the road frontage for commercial uses, and the rear of the property for dormitory style farmworker housing.

It was suggested that the city ask the developer to seek a Planned Unit Development, which will allow more control of the project for the city.

Fire Department

Assistant Chief Art Perez reported there were 52 calls for service in June, which is about average for the summer.

Abuse Counseling & Treatment, Inc. known as A.C.T is a non-profit organization that offers a circle of support services for victims and their families of Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault and Human Trafficking. We have purchased a building through a grant and are presently working on remodeling that building. It is the Hendry-Glades safe shelter. It will also have a Rape Crisis Unit which will allow local law enforcement forensic exams for their victims, instead of transporting them to our unit in Ft. Myers. Our 24 hour hotline number is 239-939-3112.

Because we are a nonprofit organization we are governed by very strict set of guidelines. We have a Board of Director's that oversees our daily activities. We cannot host fundraising events that are not self-sustained. We must have the funds secured to host the event before that event can take place. Lonnie Brick had an idea. He collected vendors and charged \$50 fee, BBQ competitors and charged \$100 fee. He decided

to offer a cash prize and trophy to the winners, 1st – 3rd place and called it Bears & BBQ. The Bears were collected for local law enforcement and the donator got a BBQ taste tester band for \$5. He wanted this event to happen and to benefit our shelter, but the cost to put the event was well beyond the collected funds.

When the people and business's Hendry-Glades County heard what he was trying to do they rolled up their sleeves, poured out their hearts and made the first annual Bear's & Barbeque possible. A.C.T. staff stepped in to help him out. Unbelievable donations of services, gift items and monetary donations started coming in until we had reached our goal, which was to be able to cover the expense of the event and start a yearly tradition. I am, as well as A.C.T. and the survivors that we serve, in debt to each of you.

He also said two fire trucks passed a regular pump test while one did not. The one that failed was due to breakage of a lever on a Viet Nam-era tender. It can be fixed when the correct part is received.

A military surplus brush truck expected to be passed along through the Department of Forestry will not be coming after all. The fire department will continue to maintain the trucks it has, old but effective vehicles.

The board opted to ask members of the Variance Board to serve on a reinstated Fire Advisory Board. An appeal by a terminated volunteer necessitates reinstating the board, which will intervene in disputes concerning terminations, discipline, evaluations, industry standards, budget and salary grievances, etc.

The original board lapsed around 2003.

HCSO

Lt. Richardson told the board that summer slow down time and in the city deputies are working on speeding in neighborhoods and running stop signs.

Water plant

Tim Taylor gave a quick account of the new water plant ribbon cutting earlier that day. He said it was operating well and was

done ahead of schedule and under budget.

Commissioner Hilda Zimmerly asked about security for the new plant. She learned it is surrounded by a chain link and barbed wire fence and will soon be protected with cameras as well. Breaking into a water utility is a federal offense under Homeland Security.

Commissioner T.A. Smith asked about the old plant and was told it has been refitted with a reverse osmosis membrane and will serve as back up. It will increase the flexibility of the system.

In other business

- Two policies for the city employee handbook were approved:

First, a rule specifically disallowing talking on the phone or texting while driving on city time, was approved;

and second, the board changed its drug testing policy for sensitive jobs only, to align with state law.

- Commissioner Smith asked if there as anything new to report on the Missouri Street apartment complex that upset neighbors previously. Ms. Johnson said the developer is working with FPL to move some power lines.

- The regular city commission meeting for August has been moved up one day to August 13 to allow commissioners to attend the League of Florida Conference.

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Chikungunya confirmed in SE Florida

TALLAHASSEE – The Florida Department of Health today confirmed the first cases of locally acquired chikungunya (chik-en-gun-ye) fever, one in Miami Dade County and the other in Palm Beach County. Chikungunya is a disease spread by bites from infected *Aedes aegypti* or *Aedes albopictus* mosquitoes. If a person is infected and bitten by a mosquito, that mosquito may later spread the infection by biting another person. Chikungunya is not contagious from person-to-person, is typically not life threatening and will likely resolve on its own.

“The Department has been conducting statewide monitoring for signs of any locally acquired cases of chikungunya,” said Dr. Anna Likos, State Epidemiologist and Disease Control and Health Protection Director. “We encourage everyone to take precautions against mosquitoes to prevent chikungunya and other mosquito-borne diseases by draining standing water, covering your skin with clothing and repellent and covering doors and windows with screens.”

Aedes mosquitoes are day-biters which can lay eggs in very small water containers. Early detection of the symptoms and preventing mosquitoes from multiplying and biting will help prevent the disease.

Symptoms of chikungunya include sudden onset of high fever (>102 F), severe joint pain, mainly in the arms and legs, headache, muscle pain, back pain and rash. Symptoms appear on average three to seven days after being bitten by an infected mosquito. Most patients feel better after a few days or weeks, however, some people may develop long-term effects. Complications are more common in infants younger than a year old; those older than 65; and people with chronic conditions such as diabetes and hypertension.

If you experience symptoms of chikungunya fever, consult with your health care provider immediately and protect yourself against further mosquito bites. A person infected with chikungunya should stay indoors as much as possible until symptoms subside to prevent further transmission. Avoiding mosquito bites while you are sick will help to protect others from getting infected. Use mosquito netting to protect children young-

er than two months.

Chikungunya fever does not often result in death; however, some individuals may experience persistent joint pain. There is currently no vaccine or medication to prevent chikungunya fever.

DRAIN standing water to stop mosquitoes from multiplying.

- Drain water from garbage cans, house gutters, buckets, pool covers, coolers, toys, flower pots or any other containers where sprinkler or rain water has collected.

- Discard old tires, drums, bottles, cans, pots and pans, broken appliances and other items that aren't being used.

- Empty and clean birdbaths and pet's water bowls at least once or twice a week.

- Protect boats and vehicles from rain with tarps that don't accumulate water.

- Maintain swimming pools in good condition and appropriately chlorinated. Empty plastic swimming pools when not in use.

COVER skin with clothing or repellent.

- Wear shoes, socks, long pants and long-sleeves.

- Apply mosquito repellent to bare skin and clothing.

- Always use repellents according to the label. Repellents with DEET, picaridin, oil of lemon eucalyptus and IR3535 are effective.

COVER doors and windows with screens to keep mosquitoes out.

- Keep mosquitoes out of your house. Repair broken screens on windows, doors, porches, and patios.

Fox appointed to committee

On July 15 Florida Governor Rick Scott appointed Deputy Chief Assistant State Attorney Amira Fox to the Judicial Nominating Committee. The purpose of the JNC is to select and submit the names of qualified individuals to the Governor for appointment to the bench to fill vacancies within the Florida court system. The JNC investigates each applicant to confirm eligibility.

In her role with the State Attorney's Office, Fox currently heads the Homicide Unit, Economic Crimes Unit, and Special Prosecutions which include public corruption and police shootings. She also assists with the day to day running of the office throughout the circuit.

Fox graduated from American University in Washington D.C. in 1987 with degrees in

International Studies and Economics. She received her law degree from The George Washington University in 1990 and then began her career as an Assistant State Attorney with the 20th Judicial Circuit. She worked in the misdemeanor, juvenile and felony divisions of the State Attorney's Office before becoming head of the LaBelle office in 1998. In 1999 she became the first female head of the Collier County office.

Amira joined the Wilbur Smith Law Firm in 2002 where she specialized in criminal defense. She formed her own practice with a partner in 2004, Fox & Ramunni, P.A., where she specialized in criminal defense and family law. Amira rejoined the State Attorney's Office of the 20th Judicial Circuit in 2012.

Saul David Alinsky (January 30, 1909-June 12, 1972). Occupation: Community organizer, writer, political activist, socialist democrat. Notable works: *Reveille for Radicals* (1946); *Rules for Radicals* (1971)

He is generally considered to be the founder of modern community organizing. He is often noted for his book *Rules for Radicals*. From that book here are Saul's thoughts on how to create a social state:

There are 8 levels of control that must be obtained before you are able to create a social state. The first is the most important.

1) Healthcare – Control healthcare and you control the people.

2) Poverty – Increase the Poverty level as high as possible, poor people are easier to control and will not fight back if you are pro-

viding everything for them to live.

3) Debt – Increase the debt to an unsustainable level. That way you are able to increase taxes, and this will produce more poverty.

4) Gun Control – Remove the ability to defend themselves from the Government. That way you are able to create a police state.

5) Welfare – Take control of every aspect of their lives (Food, Housing, and Income)

6) Education – Take control of what people read and listen to – take control of what children learn in school.

7) Religion – Remove the belief in God from the Government and schools.

8) Class Warfare – Divide the people into the wealthy and the poor. This will cause more discontent and it will be easier to take (Tax) the wealthy with the support of the poor.

Any of this sound familiar? Contrast a different way of thinking... The average age of the military man is 19

years. He is a short haired, tight-muscled kid who, under normal circumstances is considered by society as half man, half boy. Not yet dry behind the ears, old enough to buy a beer, and old enough to die for his country. He never really cared much for work and he would rather wax his own car than wash his father's, but he has never collected unemployment either.

He's a recent High School graduate; he was probably an average student, pursued some form of sport activities, drives a ten year old jalopy, and has a steady girlfriend that either broke up with him when he left, or swears to be waiting when he returns from half a world away. He listens to rock and roll or hip-hop or rap or jazz or swing and a 155mm howitzer.

He is 10 or 15 pounds lighter now than when he was at home because he is working or fighting from before dawn to well after dusk. He has trouble spelling, thus letter writing is a pain for him, but he can field strip a rifle in 30 seconds and reassemble it in less time in the dark.

He can recite to you the nomenclature of a machine gun or grenade launcher and use either one effectively if he must. He digs fox-holes and latrines and can apply first aid like a professional.

He can march until he is told to stop, or stop until he is told to march. He obeys orders instantly and without hesitation, but he is not without spirit or individual dignity. He is self-sufficient.

He has two sets of fatigues: he washes one and wears the other. He keeps his canteens full and his feet dry. He sometimes forgets to brush his teeth, but never to clean his rifle. He can cook his own meals, mend his own clothes, and fix his own hurts.

If you're thirsty, he'll share his water with you; if you are hungry, his food. He'll even split his ammunition with you in the midst of battle when you run low.

He has learned to use his hands like weapons and weapons like they were his hands.

He can save your life - or take it, because that is his job.

He will often do twice the work of a civilian, draw half the pay, and still find ironic humor in it all.

He has seen more suffering and death than he should have in his short lifetime.

He has wept in public and in private, for friends who have fallen in combat and is unashamed.

He feels every note of the National Anthem vibrate through his body while at rigid attention, while tempering the burning desire to 'square-away' those around him who haven't bothered to stand, remove their hat, or even stop talking.

In an odd twist, day in and day out, far from home, he defends their right to be disrespectful.

Just as did his Father, Grandfather, and Great-Grandfather did, he is paying the price for our freedom. Beardless or not, he is not a boy.

He has asked nothing in return, except our friendship and understanding. Remember him, always, for he has earned our respect and admiration with his blood.

Are you enjoying living in America? Grateful for your freedom to go to church, or not, whichever you choose? Have you thought about how God has blessed our nation as He has?

Where do you suppose those liberties originated? From a community organizer? From one who is passionate about inflating our national debt to an astronomical figure? Did that freedom come from one who is against people having guns?

Perhaps the things we enjoy in America and people in Cuba will paddle 90 miles to Key West to possess came from a promoter of class warfare and one who is determined to divide the people into one of two groups - the wealthy and the poor.

Thomas Jefferson said, "A government big enough to give you everything you want, is strong enough to take everything you have."

Each year, millions of plastic containers which could be recycled are not. At the bottom of each bottle is the recycle symbol, and inside that symbol is a number. Not all plastics are the same, so it is important to pay attention to the numbers game.

So how do you know what goes into your recycling bin? First you need to check with your local city or county (go to their website or call) to see what they accept in your local recycling program. Some accept #1, 2 & 5 plastics; others include #3 & 4. Your local government contracts with a recycler. Together they determine if there is a market for a particular plastic container and what is the best program for your community. After all, recyclables are commodities and it is more economically

viable to process some recyclable materials rather than others.

Be mindful when purchasing items and make sure they are in a recyclable container. If they are, then you can recycle by the numbers!





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

Retailers ready for expanded back-to-school tax holiday

TALLAHASSEE – Florida's Back-to-School Sales Tax Holiday is bigger and better this year, and the Florida Retail Federation is working to educate consumers about some important changes in tax-exempt items. This year, the sales tax exemption for clothing items has been increased to \$100 or less per item (up from \$75 or less per item in 2013). In addition, the sales tax exemption for personal computers and certain computer-related accessories will be on the first \$750 of the sales price. Retailers say that will expand the list of tax-exempt items, and they expect an average increase of at least 30 percent in store traffic over the weekend because of the sales tax holiday. (Download the FRF's one-page flier here.)

FRF President and CEO Rick McAllister said that Florida's strong job numbers are a good predictor of continuing growth in retail sales.

In all, Florida residents are expected to save at least \$40 million over the three-day holiday, which was passed unanimously by the 2014 Florida Legislature and signed into law by Gov. Rick Scott. Combined spending for back to school and college is expected to reach about \$5 billion in Florida, and tax-exempt sales will account for an estimated \$600 million of that spending.

During the tax holiday weekend, there

will be no state or local sales taxes due on the first \$750 of the sales price of personal computers and related accessories purchased for noncommercial home or personal use. The term "personal computer" includes any electronic book reader, laptop, desktop, handheld, tablet, or tower computer, but does not include cellphones, video game consoles, digital media receivers, or devices that are not primarily designed to process data. The term "related accessories" includes keyboards, mice, personal digital assistants, monitors (except those with TV tuners), modems, routers, and nonrecreational software.

Clothing and shoes up to \$100 will be tax exempt, along with school supplies up to \$15. That includes pens, pencils, erasers, crayons, notebooks, notebook paper, legal pads, binders, lunch boxes, construction paper, markers, folders, poster board, composition books, poster paper, scissors, cellophane tape, glue or paste, rulers, computer disks, protractors, compasses, and calculators.

According to the National Retail Federation's 2014 Back-to-School Survey conducted by Prosper Insights & Analytics, the average family with children in grades K-12 will spend \$669.28 on apparel, shoes, supplies and electronics, up 5 percent from \$634.78 last year.

Tai Chi - Moving for Better Balance is a 12-week, evidenced-based fall prevention program, developed by the Oregon Research Institute's Dr. Fuzhong Li to develop better balance and strength in older adults. The program has been recommended by the Center For Disease Prevention as a way to prevent falls and has been proven to reduce the number of falls for seniors by 55%. The Area Agency on Aging for Southwest Florida provides these classes to seniors free of charge at various locations such as senior centers, church community rooms and retirement communities. The CDC says one in three adults aged 65 or older will fall each year, and one-third of those will suffer serious injuries. Participating in exercise classes like Tai Chi has been shown to prevent falling in older adults. The Tai Ji Quan program has also been offered at the L.J. Nobles Senior Center in LaBelle for the last two years with five different classes having been held there.
