



Kevorkian sounds off at UF

Talk focuses on legal system

Despite vehement opposition through e-mails and protests prior to his UF appearance, Dr. Jack Kevorkian was met with applause and cheers as he discussed criminal-system reform and what he deemed the most important U.S. amendment at the O'Connell Center on Tuesday night.

The speech was postponed for half an hour because the audience of roughly 5,000 people took longer than expected to pack themselves into the venue.

Kevorkian couldn't discuss euthanasia in detail because it would violate his parole terms, he told the audience. His lawyer looked on as he spoke.

But Kevorkian did mention assisted suicide's frequent and accepted use in ancient Greece and Rome.

"I think they were way ahead than we are now," he said.

Today, the government — not the medical community — decides which

health practices are acceptable, he said.

"You can't dictate medical procedures by law," Kevorkian said. "They change all the time."

He expressed his disapproval of the legal system, particularly punishment by imprisonment.

The United States needs a more humane legal system, he said.

"All law can do is stop you from the right you have naturally. That amendment is the greatest power in the world."

He suggested a sanctuary system, in which a person accused of a crime is permitted to work out a deal with the victim and his family in private.

Imprisonment is a violent punishment, Kevorkian said, and "violence breeds counter-violence."

But he said the biggest problem with the law is its failure to follow the Ninth Amendment.

The amendment, authored by James Madison, the fourth American president, states that U.S. citizens have other rights not listed in the Constitution.

"All law can do is stop you from the right you have naturally," he said. "That amendment is the greatest power in the world."

Because the amendment is often ignored, society has become "tyrannized and sheep-like," Kevorkian added as he waved his fists in the air.

Not all of Kevorkian points were met with support. He evoked a mixture of applause and boos when he spoke out against the voting system.

"Everyone should refuse to vote," he said. "That'll send the tyrant a message."

Using the 2000 presidential election as an example, Kevorkian said presidents are not elected but, rather, appointed.

Black people are the only citizens in the United States with power, he said.

"They're acutely aware of their loss of rights," he said, using slavery as his prime example.

Protesters send chilly message

While a sold-out crowd greeted Dr. Jack Kevorkian at the O'Connell Center on Tuesday night with a warm welcome, about 60 protestors stood outside in the 40-degree weather to deliver an icy message.

The protestors, some dressed in black to match what they deemed a dark mood, held white posters with the words, "DEATH is not welcome here" written in bold, black lettering.

Standing in a straight line along a waist-high gate enclosing the protest zone, activists spanning three generations gathered to protest Kevorkian's speech, which was sponsored by Accent, Student Government's speakers bureau.

Kevorkian was convicted of second-degree murder in 1999 for assisted suicide. He was released from prison after



■ **Lawmakers want state money for stem cell research**

TALLAHASSEE (AP) — Lawmakers will push to spend state money on embryonic stem cell research again this year now that a citizens initiative on the issue appears unlikely to get on the November ballot.

Rep. Franklin Sands said Tuesday he plans to file legislation that would require the state spend \$20 million a year for 10 years on grants to researchers doing studies using stem cells, including those using embryonic stem cells, the most controversial type.

Sands sponsored a similar measure the last two years, but it didn't pass.

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority celebrates centennial

The country's first Greek organization founded by black college women celebrated its 100th anniversary Tuesday afternoon on Turlington Plaza, attracting a crowd of about 100 supporters.

Members of UF's Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, known as AKA, kicked off the centennial celebration with a procession of 20 rosebud-holding, soul-music-singing women, each depositing a flower into a vase held by the sorority's president.

The sisters wore salmon pink and apple green sweaters — the sorority's colors — as they performed in front of the crowd.

After paying tribute to the sorority's founding members with a candlelight ceremony, members recited a poem and two songs. Petra Dix, AKA president, said members stayed up several nights preparing a colorful AKA informational display and learning new songs and chants.



UF emergency text-message system passes test run

UF's first attempt to alert students about campus emergencies through text messaging was successful, university officials said Tuesday.

Out of 44,000 students who provided contact information to UF, more than 42,000 received the trial text on their cell phones at about noon, said UF spokesman Steve Orlando.

"Right now it's looking really good," Orlando said of the preliminary response. "It appears right now that it was a good choice to do this."

The text told recipients the message was

a "test of the UF emergency message system" and directed students to the Office of Information Technology's Web site if they had any problems.

UF established the system in the wake of the massacre at Virginia Tech in April, when the school's officials were criticized for not responding quickly enough to the shootings.

All UF students were required to update their emergency contact information by Oct. 22. Mobile Campus, UF's text-messaging provider, used students' provided cell phone numbers to send the alert.

Billy Gower, an economics junior, was in his constitutional history class at 12:16 p.m. when he received the message.

"It was definitely convenient," he said. "That's the best part about it."

However, Gower said, if there were a real emergency he hopes to receive more information in the text message, such as a safe location or resources to call.

Orlando said UF has several prepared messages for emergencies, but character restrictions limit how much information the text can include.

He said in an emergency, students could visit the UF Web site or watch TV news reports to learn more information after receiving an emergency text.

Omar Syed, a UF biology senior, said he received his message at 12:19 p.m.

He thinks the text-messaging system is the best way to get in touch with students in emergency situations.

"It made me feel good that I'm part of the loop," Syed said. "Sometimes you never get phone calls, but you can get texts."

Orlando said students received the message at different times because Mobile Campus can only send 1,000 text messages at once.

UF officials will meet today to review the system's success, he said. UF plans to test the system annually and will send non-emergency information through messages, too, such as reminders about school holidays.

Online voting may still be an option on SG spring ballot

■ GROUP GIVEN MORE TIME TO PREPARE PETITION.

A UF student organization with one purpose — to make online voting a permanent fixture of Student Government elections — has two more weeks to garner the more than 5,000 signatures needed for a petition.

The UF Supreme Court ruled

Tuesday that the Student Body constitution's definition of days should translate into calendar days instead of school days. The former would give the student group, Students for Online Voting, or SOLVe, more time to collect the signatures.

The group has until Jan. 29 to submit its petition to the SG supervisor of elections. The signatures would have been due today if the definition hadn't been clarified.

SOLVe has been collecting signatures since November and has 4,000 so far.

The group needs signatures from

at least 10 percent of UF's student body, which is roughly 5,000 students, to secure a spot for the online-voting amendment on the ballot for SG elections Feb. 26 and 27.

Student Government

If a majority of UF students vote 'yes' on the amendment, online voting will become an SG standard.

Sam Miorelli, SOLVe's executive director and a mechanical engineering junior, said the group will aim to collect 1,000 more signatures than the petition requires — just in case.

Miorelli said he's confident the dozen UF students collecting signatures will reach the goal in time.

"The remarkable thing about it is you've just got to tell people what we're doing, and people are happy and even eager to sign," he said.

Ryan Day, SG deputy chief of staff, filled in for Sarah Krantz, SG supervisor of elections, at the hearing. Krantz was out of town.

Day said the supervisor of elections doesn't choose the petition deadline, and Krantz announced what she thought was the right date, he said.


He said he thinks Tuesday's ruling was based on a Florida Supreme Court case ruling in the 1980s, which featured conflict over the same wording problem of "no later than" a certain number of days.

If the UF Supreme Court continues to rule on the issue based on precedence, he said he doesn't think the amendment would make it to the ballot.

Florida law has ruled online voting unconstitutional, he said.

The SG court will release a formal written opinion about the case within the next few days.

Scam threatens UF inboxes

An identity theft scam circulated through the UF GatorMail inboxes of students, faculty and staff Tuesday.

The fraudulent e-mail asked recipients to submit personal information under the pretense that the university was asking for verification of their account.

The message asked recipients for their e-mail username and password, date of birth and other information.

Upon receiving the message, Marc Hoit, interim chief information officer, sent an e-mail to students warning them of it.

Hoit stressed the importance of the password, which allows access to personal information, registration and other processes that should remain private.

"Your password is your first

defense for keeping all of that information safe," Hoit said in a phone interview. "Never respond to anyone who asks for a password."

If students have responded to the e-mail, they should log on to GatorLink and change their passwords immediately, Hoit said.

If they cannot, they should contact the UF Computing Help Desk as soon as possible.

This particular attempt at identity theft is known as "phishing."

According to the UF Web site, phishing is a type of scam in which predators lure people to fraudulent Web sites posing as known, trustworthy sites. The user's information is then taken

under false pretenses, usually with the goal of financial gain.

The organizers of the scam are being pursued, but there is little chance that they will be found.

"They do all sorts of things that make it very difficult to track," Hoit said.

The message's subject line read "VERIFY YOUR UFL EMAIL ACCOUNT NOW" and claimed to be from the "Ufl.edu Team."

Hoit learned of the e-mail when he received one this morning. Students and staff also forwarded the message to him as they received it.

In the future, students and staff members should always be suspicious if an e-mail asks for secure information.

"The policy is that you never share that with anyone, not even our help desk people," Hoit said.

"Anytime you see that message, it should be a flag."

Senate reduction on spring ballot

UF students will be able to choose whether to reduce the number of Student Senate seats when they vote in the Student Government spring elections on Feb. 26 and 27.

A constitutional amendment limiting the amount of Senate seats was approved Tuesday, securing a spot for it on the SG ballot.


The amendment would set the range of seats each semester from 40 to 50 instead of up to 60.

There are currently about 45 senators holding seats from the past two elections, or about 90 total. Eight SG position appointments were also approved unanimously Tuesday at the Student Senate's weekly meeting, which only lasted 15 minutes.

UF law students Brian Aungst, Steven Adamczyk and Ian Kaufer were appointed as SG Supreme Court Justices. UF law student Luis Delgado was appointed as SG's Student Honor Court chancellor.

UF students Nicolette Nowak, Zareen Vaghaiwalla, Nicholas Zaitlik and Elan Saad were appointed as SG cabinet secretaries.





## Draws mixed reaction

White people must learn to unite, Kevorkian added. When he was booed as he derided various aspects of the law, comparing the United States to Nazi Germany, Kevorkian echoed the sounds of booing into his microphone. At the end of his speech, the audience granted him a standing ovation.

**On Campus** During the question-and-answer session after his speech, Kevorkian said he helped kill about one out of every five patients who asked to die. The ones he turned away didn't show enough medical evidence to justify ending their lives, he said.

Katie Schweiss, an English senior and supporter of Kevorkian, said she was surprised at the speech.

"That was insane," Schweiss said, laughing. "It was not at all what I expected."

Kelly DeLucia, a UF business graduate student, said she's not a Kevorkian supporter, but she's not against his ideas either.

"It was interesting to try to understand his thought process and his belief system," DeLucia said.

## Nearly 60 protesters come from around Florida

eight years in 2007.

The protest was mostly organized by Pro-Life Alliance, a UF student group traditionally known for its anti-abortion stance, and members of Gainesville churches and visitors from Ocala and Orlando joined the students.

Besides disagreeing with Kevorkian's message, Ben Burwell, a UF sophomore and member of the alliance, said he doesn't think his tuition money should be used to host a convicted murderer at UF.

"He is not a doctor, and I'm embarrassed that our school, which has such a prestigious medical school, has invited someone here who claims to be a doctor but had his license revoked," he said.

Kevorkian was paid about \$50,000 for his speech, and most of that money came from UF students' Activity & Service Fees.

Mark Schrimsher, 51, drove from Orlando to protest. He said he graduated from UF in 1979 and sent his four children to his alma mater.

Schrimsher, the regional director for the Center for Bio-Ethical Reform, held up a 13-foot-by-6-foot banner to show how he thought abortion and euthanasia were connected.

The banner, almost as tall as Schrimsher, featured a picture of an aborted fetus with the words, "Don't let kids ruin your career," next to a large picture of Kevorkian and the sentence, "Don't let parents ruin your retirement."

"I'm against murder. I believe in the Ten Commandments. One of them says, 'Do not kill.'"

Schrimsher's organization also paid to fly a plane above the O'Connell Center waving a message expressing, "Planned Parenthood kills your babies; Dr. Kevorkian kills your parents," he said.

Schrimsher said he talked to some people who planned to listen to Kevorkian, but no one was rude or offensive while he protested.

One man he talked with flew from California to see Kevorkian, an event the man described as "about as important as seeing the shuttle lift off," Schrimsher said.

He said another memorable character was a man imitating protesters.

Richard Adams, an O'Connell Center supervisor who was in charge of the protest zone, said the man he dubbed "the anti-protesting protester" was his only out-of-the-ordinary sighting that night.

"He was screaming about freeing Nelson Mandela, stopping apartheid and saving the whales," Adams said.

At one point, he said the lone anti-protester's message turned from saving the whales to shaving them.

Ronnie Morrison, 77, said she didn't notice any people outside the protest zone shouting comments. But she said she wasn't surprised at that behavior. Morrison said she didn't understand how anyone could support Kevorkian's actions, which she said are clearly wrong.

"I'm against murder," Morrison said. "I believe in the Ten Commandments. One of them says, 'Do not kill.'"

# Same Story

## SG tries to stall online voting amendment

Each Student Government election cycle, it comes up in heated debates.

Committees are formed, independent reports are commissioned, petitions are drafted and consultants are hired.

In one instance, a student body president prepared a slide show about it.

And just about every time we think we might get closer to what the majority of UF students have wanted for years, it's shot down before it even gets to the Student Senate floor.

So what is this elusive controversy that always gets SG so riled up?

Online voting.

And it's back. So, get ready to hear more of the same.

On Tuesday, the UF Supreme Court ruled that Students for Online Voting, or SOLVe, a group collecting signatures to amend the UF Student Body constitution, did not actually exceed the time needed to collect the required number of signatures.

The group now has about two more weeks to submit its petition.

SG Supervisor of Elections Sarah Krantz had "miscalculated" the number of days the group had to submit the proper paperwork and announced what she thought was the correct date.

Everyone makes mistakes.

But given the history of this issue, we're really not that surprised.

In 2005, a petition signed by more than 1,000 students in favor of placing online voting on the ballot was denied by the SG Supreme Court, which convened in a secret meeting.

And while Dean of Students Gene Zdziarski later invalidated the court's decision, citing a possible violation of Florida's open meetings laws by the court, the issue of online voting was still noticeably absent from the spring ballot.

You would think that SG would just concede the fact that the majority of students would prefer to vote in the comfort of their own homes — and in their underwear if they so choose — through the secure GatorLink system.

You would also think that they would want to implement the cost-efficient voting method as soon as possible to get more students involved in the whole electoral process.

Well, you would be wrong.

Despite all the lip service that has been devoted toward making SG more accessible to the student body at large, we can't help but suspect that there is an ulterior motive behind stopping online voting in its tracks.

And it has nothing to do with maintaining consistency with legal precedence, which was the explanation offered by Ryan Day, SG's deputy chief of staff, on Tuesday.

As it turns out, we only have to look across town to see why so many in SG are vehemently opposed to online voting and why they are doing nothing tangible to see it become a reality besides bickering over semantics.

In spring 2001, SFCC students started using the electronic method of voting. Not only have they been ahead of us for years, but their voter turnout more than doubled from 400 to 812 the first time online voting was used.

While SFCC has nowhere near the amount of students as UF, we'd venture to say that a similar success could easily take place here.

Maybe that's what those in control of SG are so afraid of.



## Bush and Iran: Déjà vu all over again

**Text message notice raises concerns**

The announcement of the new emergency text message system stated that “because cell phone numbers provided will be used only in the event of an emergency, they will be kept private and are exempt from Florida’s public records laws.”

Why then was there a notice in Tuesday’s text to see the Mobile Campus Web site for more information? This is concerning.

We already receive enough advertising due to public records laws. Our phone numbers were supposed to be private and UF has breached this by providing them to Mobile Campus. Even if they have promised not to use the information for other purposes, I still question the legality and ethics of this decision.

Second, if this system is run through Mobile Campus, what happens in the event of a real emergency? I doubt that the security needed for a potentially life-saving system is in place in a program previously used to send pizza coupons.

While a real emergency text might not be “sponsored” by Mobile Campus, UF has already left doubt as to where this information would be posted in a real emergency.

Gators struggling to survive in a hostile environment, Lucas hit a 3-pointer right before the first-half buzzer sounded, bringing his team to within seven and giving UF some much-needed life.

Lucas was also responsible for the shot that gave the Gators their first lead at 61-59 and again at 63-61. Against Auburn, he poured in 7 of the team's final 9 points and hit several baskets as the shot clock neared expiration.

Lucas and the Gators will undoubtedly face their biggest challenge yet in the Rebels, whose only loss came on the road to a sixth-ranked Tennessee squad many consider to be the strongest in the conference.



### Men's Basketball

"This is a team that is unquestionably one of the best in the SEC," Donovan said. "They were a team last year that really started to surge and get some great wins. ... It's a tough place to play, and it should be another great challenge for our guys."

The biggest concern for Donovan is on the front line, where the Rebels boast a talented and experienced group of players led by senior center Dwayne Curtis, who is averaging 14.9 points and 8.2 rebounds per game.

"Perhaps more so than any other team, they have incredible frontcourt players that are experienced, athletic and could score," Donovan said. "It's going to be a collective, difficult, hard challenge for our guys to rebound the basketball."

Leading the way for Mississippi is Orlando product Chris Warren, who is contributing almost 16 points per game in his freshman season. UF will also face former Gators guard David Huertas, who transferred after the 2005-06 season.

The Gators should be at relatively full strength, with some speculation still surrounding forward Dan Werner and his status for the game.

Donovan said he expects Werner to play but is taking things day-to-day in practice. Werner sprained his foot against Alabama, but played 30 minutes off the bench against Auburn and managed to score 11 points.

(once by the coaches, once by a unanimous team vote) for his practice tirade directed at assistant coach Ron Adams. Noah made it into the game — with 2:54 left in the first quarter to a dash of applause and a pinch of boos — and played more spirited than any other Bull.

That's not saying much though, as Coach Jim Boylan called his team's play uninspired after the game.

And that was a kind analysis.

Noah's perceived troubles are part self-inflicted but part scapegoat, too. The Bulls are 14-22 and one of the biggest disappointments of the early season. They made the conference semifinals last season but are a ways away from sniffing the playoffs right now. Coach Scott Skiles got fired after the slow start, and Boylan is now trying to piece together the rest of the season.

A team wrought with a recent winning tradition is far from figuring things out. But one man can pin down Noah's troubles, for what it's worth.

"I know what Jo's biggest problem is," UF coach Billy Donovan said. "Jo's biggest problem is Jo just wants to

win, and when he sees things that are getting in the way of winning, Jo has a tendency to maybe become somewhat demonstrative or loud or speak his opinion. I will never believe that his suspension has anything to do with him being selfish. If anything, it has to do with him wanting to win."


If Chicago keeps losing, Bulls fans will begin to whisper "bust" when referring to Tyrus Thomas and Noah, whom the team may have taken at No. 2 in the 2006 draft. His perception as a high-energy, hustle guy would make him a fan favorite in most cities (like Noah-clone Anderson Varejao in Cleveland), but not in Chicago.

Noah needs to affect winning, not stand from a Wrigleyville rooftop during a Cubs game, cheering for the opposing team. Noah needs to produce like a top-10 pick, not bring in Dunkin' Donuts for Bulls veterans when he was supposed to grab Krispy Kremes.

He started his climb back into the team's good graces in Orlando, as his coach offered some praise.

"Hopefully, it was a learning experience for everybody," Boylan said of the suspension. "I was proud of the way Jo took the punishment."

## Lucas leads Gators into matchup with Mississippi

Weighing 150 pounds and listed as a generous 5-foot-11 inches, UF guard Jai Lucas has made a habit of playing big.

Lucas said his dream of playing basketball was never halted by his size, although he once thought he might be headed in a different direction.

"The doctor told me when I was

5 that I was going to be 6-9," Lucas said. "I don't know where that happened, but after I saw my brother stop growing, I was like I'm going to be stuck at 5-10 too, just like him. I'm 5-10 really, but nobody believes me."

Lucas' real size can be found in his heart and his fearless demeanor at the most opportune times.

Thornqvist said Cohen played in a tournament in Arizona on Tuesday, and the outcome



## Noah's first NBA months disappointing

ORLANDO — You could say Joakim Noah was doomed the day he set foot in Chicago.

"Damn, I hated Michael Jordan," Noah, representing disgruntled Knicks fans everywhere, told reporters following the 7-footer's pre-draft meeting with the Bulls in June.

Mistake No. 1.

Since that workout, little has worked out for Noah, picked No. 9 by the Bulls in the 2007 draft.

The exuberant former UF star developed a knack for tardiness at practices, struggled to learn the playbook and, most notably, ruffled feathers after a heated exchange with an assistant coach last week.

Outsiders wonder just what he learned, if anything, in three years at UF.

Noah addressed his tumultuous rookie season after Tuesday night's 102-88 loss to the Orlando Magic.

"I miss it, I miss Florida," said Noah, who scored 12 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in 23 minutes off the bench for his first career double-double in his first game action in a week. "The toughest adjustment is losing. I've never really lost like that before in my life. Of course sitting is hard. I'm not getting a lot of playing time on a consistent basis. But at the same time, those aren't things that I can control."

Noah averaged 4 points and three rebounds in 12 minutes per game entering Tuesday. He hoped to see the floor for the first time since being suspended two games
