



# City delays decision on homeless shelter

After acknowledging imperfections with the proposed site for the city's one-stop homeless center, commissioners voted Thursday not to rule it out but to evaluate other locations as well.

"There is no location in this community, or probably any community, where people are going to enthusiastically embrace an institution," Mayor Pegeen Hanrahan said at the meeting.

Commissioners voted 5-2 against denying the current site at 3335 N. Main Terrace.

The center was proposed in 2005 and would provide counseling, housing and shelter referrals, meals, education, job training, laundry and hygiene facilities, limited medical services, lockers, and telephones.

The special hearing overflowed City Hall's auditorium with homeless advocates and North Main Street residents and business owners. While about 75 people signed up to comment, more than half left before speak-

ing. "I thought this was a 10-year plan to end homelessness, not a 10-year plan to talk about it," said Kevin Hachey, a UF student who spoke at the meeting.

Most suggested finding an alternative location for the shelter. Members of the Association of Businesses and Citizens of North Main voiced concerns over lack of sidewalks, adequate lighting and transportation.



## Senate plans rule revision

UF's Student Senate president said plans to revise Student Body statutes and the replacement-senator process are underway following questions surrounding another senator's residence.

Senate President Kellie Dale said the plans, which would need to be passed twice by the Senate to change the statutes, would clarify what qualifies a senator to represent District E, which under current statutes includes all ZIP codes not listed in Districts A, B, C or D.

That flexible statute allowed Sen. Sheldon Nagesh, appointed to District E in February,

to use his home address in Houston and a Gainesville P.O. Box as grounds for keeping his seat following accusations that he lived at his fraternity's house in District A.

Dale said she asked Audrey Goldman, chairwoman of the Rules and Ethics Committee, to make recommendations to clarify the statute after Nagesh's Wednesday hearing so the confusion wouldn't happen again.

Nagesh listed the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity house in District A as his mailing address on a resume, but he told the committee he lived in Melrose, a town about 20 miles away, and presented a bank record

# One year later, family remembers Dahlem

Sally Dahlem doesn't have to cry when she talks about her husband anymore.

Whether she's discussing his old hobbies or the last phone conversation they shared, she remains calm. Her eyes gloss, and she looks away, thinking — but for her, the time for tears has neared its end.

Today marks the one-year anniversary of the death of her husband, Lt. Corey Dahlem, the Gainesville Police Department officer who was hit and killed by a drunken driver.

Throughout the year, each week has brought a new set of challenges — frus-

trations over money, changes in tradition, doubts about the future.

And yet, with the year behind her, she can still remember her husband, tearlessly, with a silent strength only she can fully understand.


Their first date was more than 20 years ago. Corey, who at the time was a Florida State University fraternity brother, asked sorority sister Sally out to a midnight party for the university's Greek Week. Of course, Sally laughed, he didn't inform her of the two

# Bill would require student input on technology fee

UF students could get a chance to vote on whether a 5 percent technology fee is implemented, according to a bill passed Wednesday by the state Senate's Committee on Higher Education Appropriations.

The bill would allow each university's board of trustees to charge up to a 5 percent technology fee — about \$3 per credit hour for undergraduate, in-state UF students. The fee would not be covered by the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program, and universities could begin charging it in fall 2009.

The bill must be approved by the Senate, the House of Representatives, Gov. Charlie Crist and students at each campus through student elections.

If a majority of students at a particular university don't support the fee, it will not be implemented at that institution, the bill states.

The fee could generate up to \$37.3 million statewide if all 11 public universities charge the full 5 percent fee, according to a bill analysis. UF's share would be about \$7 million, said UF spokesman Steve Orlando.

Crist approved a similar technology fee in October 2007, but the Senate committee decided to redraft the proposal and include

the student-approval condition. UF's Board of Trustees, the university's highest governing body, voted in approval of the fee at its November meeting.

Student Body President Ryan Moseley said Student Government and the Florida Student Association, a group of student governments of which Moseley also serves as president, lobbied for the referendum provision.

"If we're going to charge students extra, they should have their voice heard on the issue," Moseley

said. He said he thinks most UF students would be willing to pay more money for improved technology. Moseley said he would form a task force in the next two weeks to determine which improvements the technology fee could fund.

Orlando said the fee is necessary to keep up with the rising demand to produce technologically savvy students. He said students should keep in mind that UF has one of the lowest tuition rates in the country, and a 5 percent technology fee wouldn't change that.

"I think we still, even with an increase like this, remain extremely competitive and affordable," he said.

**What's next for the technology fee?**

- The bill must be voted on by the state Senate.
- If the Senate approves the bill, the House will write its own version and vote on it.
- If the House and Senate agree, the bill will move to Gov. Charlie Crist.
- If Crist signs the bill into law, each university's board of trustees will decide whether to administer the fee.
- Students will vote on the fee as a referendum question at student elections, and if a majority of the students vote in support of the fee, it will be implemented.

# U.N. AIDS specialist speaks

■ SAYS UNIVERSITIES SHOULD HELP.

A shrill cry pierced the air of a hospital room in Zambia as a young woman fell to her knees, clutching a limp bundle wrapped in a white sheet.

Stephen Lewis turned around to see the woman collapsing into a doctor's arms, and his mind flashed back to the room he visited earlier, where dozens of infants lay crying.

Lewis, co-director of AIDS-Free World, spoke to an audience of about 60 in UF's Pugh Hall Thursday night about the role universities play in making medicine available to AIDS-affected countries.

At that hospital in Zambia, Lewis heard the same cry reverberating through the halls every 20 minutes as mother after mother mourned a daughter or son lost to AIDS.

This is one of the images that Lewis, 70, brushes his teeth to at night and sips his coffee in the morning.

This is the reason why Lewis, former U.N. special envoy for HIV/AIDS in Africa, has devoted his life to fighting the AIDS pandemic.

"I don't know how to convey this to you, but there are monumental lives at stake, and these drugs are everything to people in the developing world," Lewis said.

Hosted by UF's chapter of Universities Allied for Essential Medicines, Lewis agreed to come to UF to support the organization's push for humanitarian licensing of new drugs and technology developed by the university.

By participating in systematic humanitarian licensing, UF would be giving affordable generic brands the rights to use drugs in countries where needed, instead of giving those rights to powerhouse pharmaceutical

companies.

In Africa, more than 14 million women are infected with HIV, and about 500,000 children have the infection, Lewis said. Before those children celebrate their fifth birthday, about 400,000 of them are dead. The numbers could be reduced if Africans had access to affordable medicine, he said.

Lewis pointed out that while Africa has a rampant AIDS pandemic, it represents only 3 percent of sales for the pharmaceutical market. Name-brand drugs are unaffordable for most Africans, and the big pharmaceutical companies are more concerned with profit than with providing drugs where they're most needed, Lewis said.

In an interview before the discussion, Lewis said that he agrees with studies showing that today's youth are more civic-minded and socially responsible.

"There's a tremendous renaissance of interest and engagement among young people," he said.


For this reason, Lewis never gives up an invitation to speak at a university, even if it means flying from Canada to Gainesville.

Jon Arp, a fourth-year finance student, was moved by Lewis's discussion on AIDS and the descriptive details that made the problem concrete for him.

"He was probably one of the most engaging public speakers I've ever heard," Arp said. "And, his points can't be disputed."

UF student Gloria Tavera, a member of Universities Allied for Essential Medicines, feels that UF has an obligation to use its patents and technology to make drugs available to HIV patients.

"It is our conviction that universities, and specifically UF as a large research institution, can do more to increase global access to the essential medicines we develop through generic licensing to developing nations," Tavera said.



# UF changes insurance provider

After a year and a half of research and debate, the student health insurance committee at UF has agreed on a new insurance plan, which is set to begin in August.

UF has been with the current provider, UnitedHealthcare, for about two years, and the insurance committee decided it was time to solicit alternative proposals, said Kyle Cavanaugh, senior vice president for administration.

The committee voted to switch from UnitedHealthcare to Aetna, an American health care benefits company, Cavanaugh said.

Under UnitedHealthcare, students pay about \$1,400 per school year, excluding the summer session. The cost for similar coverage from Aetna is \$1,128, he said.


"Aetna is the leading student health care provider in the U.S.," he said. "By choosing Aetna, we were able to gain a major extension of coverage at a lower price."

Furthermore, Aetna has a \$500 per year allotment for prescription drugs while UnitedHealthcare has \$250, said Evan Shenkin, director of the student health care insurance

committee.

Shenkin said he was most adamant about the increase of included mental health visits per year from 20 to 40 visits.

"With the Virginia Tech shootings and other incidents occurring around different campuses, we felt that this has become an increasingly important benefit," he said.

Shenkin said most undergraduate students are covered under their parents' insurance policy.

As a result, only 6,000 undergraduates are enrolled in UF's student health care plan.

That number doesn't include international students, who are required to have health insurance, whether it be the university's or their own, he said.

Cavanaugh said that although UF doesn't require students to be insured, officials are looking into implementing a waiver system that would require every student to provide proof of health-insurance coverage.

# Dance to raise funds

About 650 UF students will participate in non-stop bop this weekend for Dance Marathon, a fundraiser that benefits the Children's Miracle Network at Shands Children's Hospital at UF.

The 14th annual Dance Marathon will kick off at 11:30 a.m. at the O'Connell Center Saturday. Dance Marathon has raised more than \$2.3 million in the past 13 years, including more than \$362,000 in 2007, the event's news release stated.

About 600 more volunteers will also be at the O'Connell Center to ensure that participants, who must stay awake and on their toes for the duration of the event, are dancing safely.

Jordan Bell, overall director

of UF's Dance Marathon, said the biggest difference between this year and past events is the event's length: This year, it decreased from 32 hours to 26.2 hours to accurately reflect the span of a marathon in miles.

Bell said the amount was shortened because staff members were scrambling for activities to occupy tired dancers for the event's entirety.

"We can accomplish the same goals if we shorten the time," Bell said.

Vocalists, breakdancers, line dancers, masseuses, Southwest Recreation Center fitness instructors and a magician are also scheduled to attend.







# On-campus housing rates increase \$65 a semester

■ RENT HIKE EXPECTED TO BRING IN EXTRA \$500,000 FOR UF.

Rental rates for on-campus residences will increase by \$65 per semester this fall.

Sharon Blansett, spokeswoman for UF's department of housing and residence edu-

cation, said increasing material costs for on-campus building renovations required a raise in rent.

The rate increase will take effect July 1, and Blansett said rental rates would increase by \$65 in August. She said she's not sure how much rental rates would increase between July and August, but it would be less than \$65.

Blansett said if the maximum number of students occupied on-campus residences — about 7,000 — the rent hike would bring

in about an extra \$500,000.

From there, the rate can either remain the same or go up the following academic year.

before," she said.

Still, this year's 3.4 percent increase is less than last year's 6 percent hike, she added.

Blansett said she wasn't sure how this raise compared to rate changes for off-campus residences, but the economy indicates it's a fair increase.

"It doesn't seem like any of our costs are going down, and I don't mean just the university," she said. "Not anybody's cost of living is going down."

She added that the department worked out the details with student officials in the Inter-Residence Hall Association, so it was not a surprise.

Parsons, a Stephen Foster resident.

Others were concerned that the site was too unattractive.

"It almost sounds like we expect them to be kind of in prison for most of the day," said Jim Wright, executive director of the Alachua County Coalition for the Homeless and Hungry.

Jon DeCarmine, director of the Office on Homelessness, said he would prefer a more permanent site that could provide overnight shelter.

"I support the GRACE Marketplace," DeCarmine said. "I support meeting people's basic needs. But I also believe

there are perhaps better locations out there."

Some were in favor of the center's proposed location. Many participated in a homeless-rights protest held outside City Hall before the meeting.

"We're just anxious to get something done," said Bernie Zeldin, an Interfaith Hospitality Network volunteer at the protest. "This is the one that's up now. Let's pass it."

Two other locations were brought up for consideration: a previously examined location on Northeast Waldo Road and a new possible location on Northwest 53rd Avenue.

and a mail receipt as proof. The committee deemed the Melrose evidence invalid but said his Texas address and a P.O. Box, both not covered by other districts' ZIP codes, make him eligible for his seat.

Nagesh said in a telephone interview Thursday that he has lived in his Melrose house since January. He listed his fraternity as a mailing address because he receives some mail there and sometimes spends the night. He would not say how

often he sleeps at the house, but he said it depends on the number of social activities during a given week.

"We have a big couch," he said. "And the boys are really lenient on that type of stuff."

Sen. Ben Cavaturo, who brought the charges against Nagesh, said he does not believe Nagesh lives in Melrose because he did not mention the residence until Tuesday afternoon. Cavaturo said revising the statutes wouldn't change the appearance that Nagesh doesn't reside in the district he represents.

other girls who would accompany them on their "date."

Rough start aside, the two went on to marry, conceive their first child and set off for Gainesville, the site of Corey's first job as a police officer.

With his position, she said, came the worry. Sally still remembers crying to her husband about his possibly dangerous midnight shift — and later, after Corey began to get carsick out on patrol, worrying that his queasy stomach would lose him the job.

"We would drive through Gainesville," she said with a laugh, "and he would point to spots and say, 'I threw up in that bush.'"

The carsickness soon subsided, and Corey was on his way to a 22-year-long career in law enforcement. Sally soon developed her own knack for health care, a field she still works in today.

Their children, Brandon, now 22, and Katie, now 19, also warmed up to Gainesville as they grew.

For years, the family continued the same routine. Corey worked his way up and became a lieutenant in 2003. Brandon moved south and enrolled at the University of South Florida. Katie enrolled at SFCC and moved into her own apartment, although her dad insisted on regular "quality time" lunches.

Corey's death changed everything.

For Sally, the final days of her husband's life will be eternally etched in her memory: the trip to Stein Mart that Sunday, when he gave her a hard time for shoe shopping; the last phone call they shared on Monday, when he prepared for a rowdy night patrolling University Avenue; the early morning phone call on Tuesday detailing her husband's injuries; seeing Corey alive

for the last time on Wednesday before he was taken off life support.

"You wish you would have had a chance to say something," she said. "You think, oh, if you would have only had more time to tell him you appreciated him."

The months after his death brought not only emotional struggles, but financial as well. Though Sally's full-time position supported her family, Corey's pension brought home only a third of his usual earnings. And "line of duty" federal death benefits, which Sally applied for months ago, have yet to surface.

The customs of the family's past have had to change, too. Corey was the bill payer, the dishwasher, the disciplinarian — and in his absence, the family has had to create new traditions.

Yet even as his seat at the dinner table remains empty, his presence lives on in their home's den-turned-memorial, replete with Corey's badge, gun, a Bible and numerous pictures. Elsewhere in the city, Corey's name can be seen on the 34th Street Wall, in a data tracking room at the police station and on the section of Northwest 17th Street that was renamed in his honor. Sally laughed that having his name all across Gainesville would have amused the long-time Seminole fan.

But as the one-year anniversary of his death comes and goes, and as life moves on for the Dahlems, Sally said she'll continue to remember Corey's past and stay strong for the family's future.

"I need to do it for Corey," she said. "He deserved it."

cleared of any wrongdoing.

Moore appears to be the logical choice to fill the void in the starting lineup left by Andre Caldwell, who graduated and is awaiting the NFL Draft.

But Moore said trying to replace the school's all-time receptions leader is the last thing on his mind.

"I'm not really going after any role at all," he said. "I am just trying to learn the offense and learn the routes and everything and learn how to read the DBs and everything."

"The thing I'm lacking is running the schemes and reading and stuff like that. In junior college, you didn't have to do that. It was just, 'Beat the man in front of you.' You don't have to worry about where he is going to be or anything like that, like disguised coverages. There isn't anything like that. You just have to show that you're better than the guy in front of you, and that's it."

Ingram said that Moore has a great chance to be a major factor from Day 1, but he expects him to see a lot of competition, particularly from redshirt freshman Deonte Thompson.

"You can just see that (Moore) wants it, and he's really trying to focus in on his job," Ingram said. "That's what our coaches want us to be: aggressive. They want us to want the ball, want to come in and watch extra film on your own. He's been doing all the little things."

"I think the problem is projection," Donovan said. "I have not heard that at all, and I'm not saying he is or he isn't. ... I don't know if I can give Marreese any advice right now."

Donovan said one of the main issues is deflecting any hype that may surround Speights. He said he can only hope the sophomore can learn to tune out the media and the hoopla, which may lead him down a dangerous path — one the two-time national champion coach has seen before.

"I had guys in Anthony Roberson and Matt Walsh who wanted to bypass their senior years," he said. "It comes down to the players and their choices."


Without directly saying it, Donovan could have been sending Speights a warning with this message.

Walsh and Roberson chose to leave UF early, which was a head-scratcher at the time. Now, the two are currently outside the ranks of the NBA.

Speights possesses a fine array of pro skills. His length, athleticism and hands give him a unique skill-set sure to translate at the next level. However, he remains a raw talent whose immaturity and conditioning remain a salient issue.

"I will support him," Donovan said. "No matter what happens."

Keating stepped in for three innings.

"We're light pitching-wise," O'Sullivan said. "We had to start Bamberg, because he's one of our better hitters right now. If he can give us two or three innings, he can stay in the game as a DH, but unfortunately it didn't work out for us."

With the NCAA introducing a condensed schedule this season, one of O'Sullivan's worries in the preseason was how his pitching staff would hold up through the grind of playing five games per week. It appears his fears are coming to fruition.

"There's no question," O'Sullivan said of the strain on his staff. "We've only got nine healthy arms and we're asking guys who haven't pitched since high school to pitch. We just don't have much and we keep ask-

ing the same guys to go over and over."

Friday night starter Billy Bullock is confident this is simply a rough stretch as the Gators make their way through a long season and not a sign of impending danger. Bullock will have an opportunity to help the Gators turn it around in their three-game set at Tennessee (17-10, 5-4 SEC).

"This kind of stuff happens when you go

through a season," Bullock said. "All you can do is just keep coming to the park every day, because this is just how baseball works. Guys aren't pitching as well as they did early, but I think we'll find a way."

# Gators prep for lone home meet

■ UF WILL HOST THE FLORIDA RELAYS THIS WEEKEND.

It's home sweet home for the UF track and field program this weekend.

The Gators will host the 64th annual Florida Relays Friday and Saturday at Percy Beard Track.

The meet is the lone home competition of the outdoor season for the Gators.

UF track and field coach Mike Holloway believes that competing on its home track will give his team the advantage in this weekend's meet.

"Being able to go out and run on the same track that we practice on every day is definitely an advantage," said Holloway. "Just knowing the track makes a big difference."

The meet is typically one of the largest in the south, and more than 40 teams will be represented.

After the first two weeks of outdoor competition, the Gators have racked up 27 regional-qualifying marks.

"We have actually exceeded our expectations so far this season," Holloway said. "Our goal is to qualify an athlete in every event."

Sparked by Willie Perry's stellar 2008 season, the men have led the way with 18 of the regional-qualifying marks.

"We expect that from Willie. He's one of the best sprinters that we have ever had here at the University of Florida,"

said Holloway. "Willie has had some troubles over the past year and a half, but he's really got his act together. If he stays focused and keeps doing the things that he is supposed to be doing, then you will see some special things from him this year."

Holloway has lofty goals for the junior.

"I expect him to be an All-American again this season, and I expect him to be competing for national titles," said Holloway.

Perry's time of 20.76 seconds in the 200-meter dash is the fastest in the nation this year.

The women, who have acquired nine qualifying marks so far, have been fueled by Lakecia Ealey.



## Track & Field

The senior ranks fifth in the country in both the 100- and 200-meter dash.

Freshman Rebecca Lowe has held the nation's best time in the 5,000-meter event for two consecutive weeks.

The native Australian posted the nation's top mark of 16:19.97 in the season-opening Snowbird Invitational hosted by Florida State.

The Gators have struggled all season in the hurdling events and have only managed to register one win all year. Holloway hopes that he can see some improvement in this weekend's meet.

"The hurdles are definitely an area that we would like to improve in, but I expect to see improvement across the board," said Holloway. "We expect to get better each weekend."

## Moore turns heads after transferring

Carl Moore owes his spot on UF's roster to his hatred of high school chemistry.

After receiving a D in chemistry, Moore, now a wide receiver for the Gators, failed to qualify academically to play football at a four-year school. He was forced to attend junior college instead.

"I'm not really one of those DNA, tRNA (people)," Moore said. "That's not me. I'm not really a science guy."

A couple years later, Moore said attending junior college was the best thing that could have happened to him.

"Me going to junior college is definitely a blessing, because it gave me a chance to grow up," Moore said. "I wasn't mentally prepared for D-1 football. My freshman year, I would have been running around, acting stupid, not being focused on football. Going to juco gave me the opportunity to grow up."

Since transferring to UF this off-season, Moore's maturity hasn't been called into question, and neither has his talent.

It hasn't taken long for the 6-foot-4 wideout to begin turning heads at practice.

"At one point in time, coach

Meyer was saying I had the best hands on the team, but I see Carl the same way," senior tight end Cornelius Ingram said. "Carl Moore has basically been doing the same, same exact thing."

Moore said he was being recruited by several Pacific-10 schools and Nebraska out of high school, but his stock really began to rise after a Tennessee scout saw him in a junior college game.

The Tennessee recruiter was there to see Woodny Turenne, who later signed with Louisville.


When Moore dominated one of the top cornerback prospects in the nation, it became apparent that he was a special talent.

Moore said Tennessee tried to offer him a scholarship on the spot without realizing he was only a freshman.

"They thought I was a sophomore, just because they figured a freshman wouldn't be able to do that to him," Moore said.

The five-star prospect was clearly coveted by UF, and his recruitment led to accusations of two separate recruiting violations.

UF officials investigated after the Gainesville Sun quoted Moore's girlfriend, Maranda Smith, as claiming that Meyer called her daily during the recruitment of Moore and Smith. Smith, who attended Sierra

(Calif.) Community College with Moore, is now a gymnast for the Gators.

UF also investigated after an article in the Sacramento Bee reported that Meyer phoned Moore moments af-

ter quarterback Tim Tebow won the Heisman Trophy and handed the phone to Tebow. That would be an NCAA violation.

Meyer has since been

### Gators head to UT without hurt McArthur

Brandon McArthur still can't shake the injury bug.

The first baseman had an MRI taken on his right knee Thursday after he stumbled over first base in a loss to North Florida on Wednesday.

Results of the MRI have not been released, but McArthur didn't travel with the Gators to their weekend series at Tennessee.

The senior will be examined again Monday, according to UF sports information director John Hines.

To compensate for the loss, freshman

second baseman Josh Adams is expected to take over at first and Clayton Pisani, who entered the season as a starter, should start at second.

McArthur had started a career-high 28 consecutive games after missing most of the 2007 season with an elbow injury. He is batting .314 with 24 RBIs.

McArthur's injury adds to the mount-

ing problems with the UF depth chart. The No. 19 Gators (20-8, 7-2 Southeastern Conference) are short on pitchers.

Only six players have thrown more than 20 innings, forcing coach Kevin O'Sullivan to use the same arms repeatedly. Early on, it appeared that UF would be able to withstand its lack of depth as it ran out to a surprising 18-4 start.

But the Gators have lost four of their last six games, allowing nearly nine runs per game in the losses.

O'Sullivan looked to an unconventional source in Wednesday's 11-10 loss to UNF. Designated hitter Dustin Bamberg received the start against the Ospreys and usual Saturday night starter Patrick

## Off-season to shake up UF's roster

In the wake of the Gators' disappointing season, it's time to do some math.

Nine plus five equals 14. Fourteen is one more than 13.

Why is any of this important?

Next season, UF is allotted just 13 scholarships.

Five recruits have signed with UF to play next season, creating a logjam and a serious problem.

Someone has to go.

"I have faith things will work themselves out," UF coach Billy Donovan said.

How things rearrange at this point is anyone's guess.

Speculation points first to center Marreese Speights, who is UF's only current player with a realistic shot of playing in the NBA

next season.

Speights was featured on draft boards earlier this year but has since fallen considerably.

NBADraft.net and Draftexpress.com don't list the big man in their mock drafts.

It's too early for more respectable news outlets to begin predicting, but it appears Speights will weigh his options.

"I'm going to talk to my family, my coach and see what they think," he said after Tuesday's loss to Massachusetts. "Right now, though, I'm not even thinking about it."

Speights must decide relatively soon.

Many incoming players arrive in the summer, and by the time they touch down in Gainesville, this situation should be solved.

Donovan commented about where he thought Speights could land and about his first-round potential.

# Gators get help from bench

A team's success is dependent on the collective contributions of each and every one of its players.

There may only be nine on the field at any one time, but there are 20 players on the roster for a reason.

"I would definitely say it's better to have more (players) than less (players)," said junior Brooke Johnson, who has played in 37 of UF's 42 games this season without getting a single start. "You always want to have extra players. You always want to have a back up."

The impact of the No. 3 Gators' role players will be felt this weekend

when UF (40-2, 12-1 Southeastern Conference) travels to Mississippi State (30-11, 4-7 SEC).

Johnson, who started 107 games over her first two seasons in an orange-and-blue uniform, has made her presence felt coming off the bench in pivotal games as of late.

UF coach Tim Walton has moved the career .174 hitter into a role where she can contribute almost every game without swinging the bat.

Against LSU last weekend and for much of the last two years, Johnson has been coming in to play the outfield in late-game situations where the Gators are trying to protect a lead rather than increase one.

"I come in, usually about the fifth inning or so, more for defense," Johnson said. "And maybe [I] get an opportunity to hit depending on the circumstances, but mostly it's for defense."

Walton, who has also used Johnson as a pinch-runner this season, says his junior defensive specialist is one of the best outfielders on the team due to her exceptionally strong arm and speed. Johnson sees most of her action in left field but will occasionally take an at-bat late in a game.

But the veteran knows that she can best contribute to a victory with her glove — something Walton says he is extremely proud of her for.

"I know that is what's keeping me playing — my defense — so I have to continue to work hard at that," she said.

Johnson isn't the only one who's contributing in a non-starting role.

Perhaps the biggest bench contribution has come from sophomore third baseman Corrie Brooks. Brooks has started all but three games this year after freshman Shaunice Harris went down for the season with a torn anterior cruciate ligament. Since taking over, Brooks has hit .261 and played a solid hot corner, arguably the most important defensive position on the field.

"It's definitely great to have that many players and have that much talent on one team," Johnson said.

# Weekend prepares UF for postseason

Winning isn't everything, at least not in regular-season men's tennis matches.

When the No. 11 Gators lost at No. 16 LSU 4-3 on Sunday, UF coach Andy Jackson was disappointed but not surprised.

"I definitely didn't feel like we took a step back," Jackson said. "We were disappointed, because it drops us two games behind the (Southeastern Conference) leader, but it wasn't from lack of effort or wasn't from lack of preparedness. Really, from a level of play, we just got beat."

"Still, that's not taking a step back, except in the standings. And the standings aren't as important as the direction you feel like your team's going in."

All season, this young Gators squad, flooded with five freshmen, has had one goal — to prepare to play its best in the NCAA Tournament by playing and beating high-quality teams.

UF (11-5, 6-2 SEC) will get two more chances to prepare itself this weekend against top-ranked opponents. The Gators will host No. 26 Auburn (9-9, 3-5 SEC) on Friday at 3 p.m. then will face No. 24 Alabama (14-8, 4-4 SEC) on Sunday at 1 p.m. Both teams defeated UF late last season. Although these are regular-season matches, Jackson said they will be critical for postseason success.

"I think they are monumental, because we didn't get to host (the NCAA first and second rounds) last year because we couldn't beat Auburn or Alabama," he said. "I feel like our magic number is pretty close to two. Any kind of combination of two wins out of our guaranteed next four (matches), I think that we're gonna host."

While UF is clearly battle-tested, the regular season doesn't hold much water if the team fails in the postseason.

"Tennis is very much like basketball," Jackson said. "It may not be fair, but the whole season's success is based on how you do at the NCAA Tournament. And the tournament hasn't even started yet, so basically our season hasn't even started."

The UF women's tennis team will look to clinch at least a share of the SEC regular-season title with a win at No. 34 Auburn on Friday or at No. 75 Alabama on Sunday. Two wins would give the team the title outright with one match remaining. UF shut out both teams last season.

The No. 3 Gators (14-1, 8-0 SEC) have won 11 straight matches, nine of which came against teams that were ranked No. 27 or higher at the time.
