



# For now, frat ruling will not affect UF policy

## ■ ANTI-DISCRIMINATION POLICIES HINGE ON LAWSUIT.

Though Christian fraternity Beta Upsilon Chi was granted temporary recognition as a UF organiza-

tion last week, school officials say it is too early to know if the court-ordered recognition will affect UF's policies against religious discrimination for club membership.

The fraternity, which limits membership to Christian men and is known as Brothers Under Christ, or BYX, was granted a special motion to act as an official club while

their lawsuit against UF continues in court.

The fraternity is appealing UF's 2007 decision that denied the club recognition based on antidiscrimination policies.

Local chapter president Damion Dam said the status allows BYX, pronounced "bucks," to hold meetings, advertise on campus and

recruit new members during a rush week in the fall.

BYX will not apply for funding from Student Government because it charges membership dues, Dam said.

UF spokeswoman Janine Sikes said until the court reaches a decision, no changes will be made to

school policy, and all other clubs must still abide by the rules. The policy requires clubs to admit students from all religions, according to the Center for Student Activities and Involvement Code of Conduct.

It cites federal and state equal opportunity laws, orders and regu-

## UF ADMINISTRATION Machen plans to visit Iran in fall

UF President Bernie Machen might be among many Gators packing their bags for a study abroad stint this fall.

Machen accepted an invitation from the Association of American Universities, or AAU, to serve as a delegate to Iran in mid-November.

The AAU works to advance the international standing of U.S. research universities, according to its Web site.

Machen said Iran has a well-developed system of higher education, which will enable the universities to learn from one another during the week-long trip.

But Machen isn't making arrangements to have neighbors check his mail while he's away just yet.

The trip is contingent on

the political climate in Iran, so it's not guaranteed to happen, Machen said.


"I'm not going to go if it's too dangerous," he said.

Machen made a point to emphasize that politics would not be involved in the discussions.

"The people organizing the trip believe that there are real scientific interests that could be furthered," he said. "If that's not what's going to happen, then we're not going."


While politics won't be discussed, they will play a role in Machen's travel plans.

conscious way she lives.


"The earth we live on is finite," Englert said. "To live a sustainable lifestyle is to acknowledge and embrace our responsibility as stewards of this earth."

**Faculty and union file grievances against UF**

Eight UF faculty members have filed grievances against the UF administration concerning faculty layoffs and program mergers.

A grievance is a formal complaint claiming that a right has been violated.

The content and the names of those faculty who filed the grievances are confidential, wrote Kyle Cavanaugh, UF vice president for administration, in an e-mail.

The eight faculty grievances, filed throughout July, are from faculty targeted for layoffs, denied the right to apply for tenure or "arbitrarily and capriciously" reassigned, according to a Thursday statement from the United Faculty of Florida, a union that represents about 35 percent of UF's faculty.

The union also filed a grievance against the administration on July 21.

John Biro, president of the union's UF chapter, said the union filed its grievance concerning program mergers in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.

Throughout the summer, the administration's behavior has been marked by "secretiveness, hypocrisy, manipulation and misrepresentation," according to the union's statement.

It states the administration has rejected revenue-neutral alternatives to budget cuts, disproportionately targeted women and minorities for layoffs and made "major changes" to academic programs without adequate faculty consent.

Biro said he hopes a discussion with administrators will lead to some kind of compromise. Otherwise, a formal hearing will be held.

"I am not optimistic that (compromise) will happen because there is really no room for compromise when you are laid off," Biro said. "You are or you aren't."



# Woman sues UF frat

■ LAWSUIT STEMS FROM 2006 SECRET SEX-TAPING INCIDENT.

A woman filed a \$15,000 lawsuit against UF's Delta Tau Delta Fraternity and two UF students, one of whom she had sex with in the fraternity house while the other secretly videotaped the act.

The 20-year-old woman claims invasion of privacy, outrage and fraud among other allegations in the lawsuit, which was filed July 29 in Palm Beach County.

The lawsuit stems from a Nov. 5, 2006, incident when the woman and UF anthropology junior Benjamin Farias, 21, had consensual sex in his room in the fraternity house, according to a Gainesville Police report.

Farias arranged for his fraternity brother, UF accounting senior Kyle B. Kraft, 21, to videotape while hiding under a blanket on another bed without the woman's knowledge, according to the lawsuit.

Kraft videotaped the woman naked for more than 20 minutes before she spotted the camera lens protruding from the blanket, the lawsuit states.

The woman then wrestled with Kraft to take the videotape, and she reported the incident to Gainesville Police.


Spencer Mann, State Attorney's Office spokesman, said a judge found Farias and Kraft guilty of misdemeanor voyeurism in May 2007.

They served 10 days in jail, did 50 hours of community service, spent a year on probation and paid \$1,266 in fines, Mann said.

The woman was not a SFC or UF student, according to school officials.

In the lawsuit, the woman blames the fraternity for failing to supervise and control its members as well as neglecting to bestow a "general duty of care" toward the fraternity's guests.

Delta Tau Delta President Thomas Cockriel said Farias and Kraft have been suspended from the fraternity since spring 2007.

Cockriel deferred questions to Jim Russell, executive vice president of the fraternity's national chapter.

Russell would not comment on the specifics of the allegations in a telephone interview but said the incident "is not conduct that we would condone in any way."

Steve Orlando, UF spokesman, said UF conducted an investigation shortly after the incident happened in 2006 but ultimately found that the fraternity as a whole was not involved.

The fraternity's last legal run-in came in 2006, about four months before the taping, when two underage students were transported to the emergency room for drinking at the fraternity house in separate incidents, according to UF records.

The fraternity was put on social suspension through fall 2007 and could not recruit new members during spring 2006 and fall 2007, records showed. Orlando said the fraternity is in good standing.

The woman's attorney, Mark Auerbacher of Miami, did not return phone calls. Farias and Kraft did not return e-mails seeking comment.

# Gateway of Champions opens at Ben Hill Griffin

It was a humble debut for the gateway that will welcome 92,000 rowdy fans in just a few weeks.

The first floor of the James W. "Bill" Heavener Football Complex, commonly known as the Gateway of Champions, opened unceremoniously to the public Monday.

The southwest corner of Ben Hill Griffin Stadium, located at Gale Lemerand Drive and Stadium Road, has been under construction since February 2007.

Workers have been crafting an expansion to recognize the accomplishments of Gators football, said Greg McGarity, one of the project

managers.

The project finished on time and within budget, McGarity said, with a final price tag of \$28 million. Gator Boosters funded the project.

Once inside, fans come face-to-face with an interactive display of 20 UF football trophies commemorating individual player awards, SEC titles and two national championships.

Jason Siegel, who graduated from UF in 2001, pushed a button on the glass case of the 1996 Sears Collegiate Champions trophy, and a TV screen behind the crystal football played highlights from the season.

"I remember watching this game," Siegel recalled as an announcer spoke in the clip.

Besides giving fans an up-close look at

the trophies that they watched players kiss and hug on the small screen, the construction revamped offices by adding 30,000 square feet of new space, McGarity said. He said the head coach's office was updated for the first time in 20 years.

Now that the expansion is complete, UF athletes have more room to stretch in the stadium's weight room, which almost tripled in size from 7,500 square feet to 22,000 square

feet.

"Every athlete we have here will benefit," McGarity said.

In addition to celebrating the "orange and blue victorious," the new construction emphasizes another color: green.

The roof over the weight room is a partial "green" roof. A four-foot layer of soil planted with palms and lilies covers the roof, acting as an insulator to cut energy costs, said Bahar Armaghani, another project manager.

Even the building's clean-up was a green effort, as about 77 percent of the 1,660 tons of waste produced during construction was recycled, Armaghani said.

"There's something in it for everyone," McGarity said.

## Man caught spying

■ **POLICE: HE WATCHED A WOMAN VIA HER WEBCAM.**

A Gainesville man was arrested Thursday for secretly installing software on a woman's computer that allowed him to capture video of the woman and her friends via a webcam.

The Hialeah woman found unauthorized programs on her laptop, including "Webcam Spy Hacker," on July 28.

Gainesville Police officers then discovered that Craig Matthew Feigin, a 23-year-old Gainesville man, was selling the program on eBay, according to his GPD arrest report.

The software allows users to remotely control webcams and transfer still images from a video to a server for viewing.

According to the product's Web site, it is designed as a home-security method for catching adulterous partners and alcohol-drinking babysitters.

The woman said she allowed Feigin to fix her computer July

5. After finding the programs, she discovered about 20,000 pictures of her and her friends naked and clothed, according to the report.

Following his arrest, Feigin admitted to installing the programs on the woman's computer, remotely controlling her webcam and viewing pictures of her.

to the report.


Feigin was charged with modifying computer data and disrupting or denying computer system services, according to the report.

Spencer Mann, State Attorney's Office spokesman, said both third-degree felonies are punishable by up to five years in prison and a \$5,000 fine for each count.

He was admitted to UF last fall but is not currently enrolled, said Ron Wayne, a UF spokesman.

Feigin and his attorney could not be reached for comment.

He also admitted to doing the same to another woman's computer, according

# Students reflect on UF's first study abroad trip to India

## PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS WORKED, LIVED ON FARM.

Sitting outside of a coffee shop, Hanna Moerland sipped from a cup of tea and reflected on her state of reverse culture shock.

"I'm just enjoying the quiet," she said on the noisy balcony overlooking a Gainesville shopping center parking lot.

Less than a week earlier, the philosophy senior had been in a different, much louder place, where people packed the overpopulated city streets and the rural villages.

Moerland had just returned from more than six weeks of constant noise from buses, people and

mosque bells in a country where East meets the West: India.

A total of 23 Gators immersed themselves in a new culture during UF's first India study abroad program, which took place from June 1 to July 13.

Like most students on the trip, Moerland was looking for an atypical study abroad experience.

The UF in India program was dreamt up, taught and guided by married UF professors Travis Smith and Anita Anantharam.

But the trip wasn't designed to be a photo opportunity. It was meant as a tough experience.

The students stayed and worked in a rural, organic farm called Navdanya, which promotes environmental activism as well as farming that protects the land and the farmers who work on it.

Most students lived in huts. Everyone did laundry by hand and took showers from a bucket. Toilet paper and coffee were hot commodities.

As Smith said several times throughout the trip, "This ain't no summer camp."

Few students can say they've made a trek to a Hindu temple atop a mountain or have gone six weeks without a cell phone.

Moerland said she would love to do it all over again.

She knew she wanted to study in India the first time she heard about the opportunity.

However, many of her friends and family members were a little skeptical of her decision at first.

"My family was like, 'Why do you want to go to India? Couldn't you go somewhere else?'" Moerland recalled, laughing a little.

But she wanted to come back with more than the stereotypical European summer study abroad, complete with wild nights of partying.

"I could spend a summer in Gainesville drinking," she said.

The typical day on the farm followed a much different pattern than drink, sleep, repeat.

Each day began at 6 a.m. when the sun lit up the huts and dorm-like rooms the students slept in.

They packed in tea, yoga, breakfast and farm work all before the first class of the day.

After lunch, the students had silent time, a period of daily reflection.

Then it was time for more tea, class and farm work. A little free time ended the day.

Then sleep and repeat.

Smith said the program was intended to create interest in transformation of the self and the world.

Living without American conveniences was one of the biggest challenges — and rewards — for many of the students.

Amy Schweiss, a UF political science junior, loved the inner journey, but the talkative student grappled with silent time.

Schweiss did give up on one American vocal obsession, though — her cell phone.

"I was really into not having a cell phone," she said. "It was a little weird, like I was on the 'Real World.'"

Moerland, who traveled with Schweiss after the program ended,

had the same come-around with coffee.

Upon return to the U.S., Moerland has cut back on the caffeine.

At the farm, she was known to sneak around the kitchen for a cup of Anantharam's organic direct-trade Bolivian coffee, which was given to class discussion leaders as a treat.

Though the farm operated as the home base for the group, three weeks of the trip were dedicated to traveling.

The first excursion brought students nine hours away from the farm to Sankri, a more remote mountain in the foothills of the Himalayas.

The 7-kilometer, 45-degree hike was intense, even for those with experience, Anantharam said.

The group camped overnight at the top and carried on their daily routine of yoga and class.

The view and the remoteness brought a certain serenity that couldn't be achieved on the farm.

"Every student that made that hike said that that was their absolute favorite part of the trip," Anantharam said.

UF alumnus James Siler captured all of the adventures in his documentary about trip.

The film, with the working title "Next Item ... UF in India," will be screened at the Harn Museum of Art in September.

The documentary filmmaker shot more than 60 hours of footage, including interviews with students before and after the trip.

Though Siler had filmed a fictional picture in India before, he jumped at the chance to return.

He wanted to document the cultural experience and personal transformation of the unique study abroad program.

"We took some of ourselves out there," he said, "but we came back with something new."



## For God's Sake UF shouldn't recognize discriminatory fraternity

Last week, the 11th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals issued an injunction compelling UF administrators to officially recognize an organization that openly discriminates against people based on their religion or irreligion, as the case may be, as well as on the basis of gender.

The Beta Upsilon Chi fraternity, also known as Brothers Under Christ, requested official recognition as a student organization in 2007. Officially sanctioned student organizations and clubs receive benefits, including Student Government funding, the right to advertise on campus and the use of university facilities.

The Center for Student Activities and Involvement — the official administrators of UF student clubs — denied BYX's request for recognition last year because the group mandates that its members be Christians and bars women from becoming members. Both counts, the religious requirement and the banning of women from joining BYX, stand in violation of UF's code of conduct for recognition of student organizations. The code states that student clubs must be open to all students, not just the Christian male contingent.

In response to this egregious miscarriage of justice, otherwise known as "tolerance" and "pluralism," BYX sued UF for ... religious and gender discrimination? You read that right. An organization that unabashedly discriminates against non-Christians and women sued UF for religious and gender discrimination. How's that for irony?

Yet as much as we'd like to focus our incisive wit and sardonic commentary on this delectable morsel of sheer absurdity, we must instead turn to the serious consequences of endorsing discrimination in The Gator Nation.

College is a place for the no-holds-barred, free exchange of ideas. It is perhaps the last remaining venue for this once-prevalent American pastime. The plethora of ethnicities, nationalities, religions and most importantly, ideas, theories and philosophies existing on any given college campus is what makes a college education the bulwark of democracy and a free society.

If one backward-thinking group of students is permitted to clog up the conduit of diversity, tolerance and plurality that is so critical to the vitality of the college experience, the result will be akin to opening a Pandora's Box of bigotry and exclusion.

If Christian males can exclude all others from membership in a student organization, what's preventing the Ku Klux Klan, Neo-Nazis or any number of other misguided, unenlightened bigots from coming to campus to start their own officially sanctioned student organization?

We respect BYX's First Amendment rights to free assembly and free exercise of religion. And their presence on campus is part of that panoply of pluralism that makes UF such an exciting and intellectually stimulating place. But the First Amendment is multifaceted. Alongside the free exercise of religion is the freedom from the establishment of religion — that is, the separation of church and state. Overtly Christian organizations should not be receiving public funding to promote their religious beliefs. UF should be no more obliged to provide BYX funding and facilities than to censor their religious speech. Neither would be constitutionally or morally acceptable.

We hope that the courts will find in favor of the administration and prevent discrimination from taking root at our beloved university.

### Correction



## Guns on campus would prevent tragedies

About a month ago, Florida's new "guns-at-work" law went into effect. The law allows employees with valid concealed weapons licenses to keep their guns in their cars while at work.

I would be comforted by this news, but the law makes an explicit exception for educational institutions. In fact, by both state law and university regulations, our campus is theoretically a "gun-free zone." Similar restrictions are in place at practically every major American university.

Such restrictions have sadly grown even more widespread in the wake of the Virginia Tech and Northern Illinois University massacres. These murderous rampages were perpetrated in the face of numerous laws and regulations barring firearms from both campuses. Despite the fact that both gunmen acted in complete disregard for the law, universities across the nation have decided that the appropriate response to these unspeakable tragedies is to strengthen their campus gun restrictions instead of allowing students the means for basic self-defense.

To me, these events point to a simple conclusion: Students and faculty with concealed weapons licenses and legal possession of a firearm should be allowed to carry their guns on campus. But opponents of such a policy argue that doing so would only add another layer of unpredictability to unstable situations or that campus police are already able to properly respond and sufficiently protect students.

Such arguments represent a chronic and potentially lethal nanny-state mentality. To obtain a concealed weapons license in Florida and most other states, one must undergo extensive safety training and a thorough background check. Anyone with demonstrated psychological instability or significant prior criminal activity, characteristics of most spree shooters in the past, is simply denied a license.

Campus response strategies have undeniably improved since the Virginia Tech shootings, but there are still innumerable situations for which campus police are not and cannot possibly be prepared. There is only so much they can do if a gunman barricades himself in a classroom building,

as at Virginia Tech, or enters a packed lecture hall, as at NIU.

Perhaps this reality would be better illustrated with an example. On January 16, 2002, a gunman roamed the halls of Appalachian School of Law, executing at point-blank range the dean of the law school, a professor and another student. He then entered the school's common area, still brandishing his weapon.

Upon hearing the gunfire, though, two off-duty police officers taking classes at the school ran to their vehicles to retrieve their guns. Returning to the scene, they were able to subdue the gunman, ending his spree long before campus police were able to respond to the scene.

But what if Appalachian School of Law had been a "gun-free" zone and the students had been forced to leave their guns at home? What if the gunman had brought a backpack full of ammunition or a more powerful weapon to the scene? What if he locked himself in a building full of students and faculty? It's these questions that haunt me when I hear arguments against concealed carry on campus.

# SG, Naval ROTC team up to offer safe runs on campus

■ STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO CALL, REQUEST A NROTC RUNNING MATE.

UF's Student Government and the UF Naval ROTC are working together to help students feel safe enough to run after dark.

The program, called Safe Run, will provide students who want to run on campus between the hours of 7 p.m. and 10 p.m., Monday through Thursday, with a running partner from UF's NROTC.

The program begins Sept. 1.

Brian Prior, coordinator of Safe Run and

a volunteer runner, said the idea behind the program is that by running in groups, students are less likely to be attacked.

Samantha Sexton, a member of Student Senate's Student Safety Committee and a leader of the project, said the safety of student runners is an issue because UF is an open, public campus.

"There are conspicuous hiding places that predators, if they wanted to, could hide," Sexton said.

"We don't want our students to be discouraged from working out and leading a healthy life."

Ryan O'Mara, chairman of the Student Safety Committee, said plans for the program were "catapulted forward" after a

recent incident at Haile Plantation, where a jogger was attacked and raped.

O'Mara said by having an NROTC-trained runner by students' sides, the chances of a similar incident occurring on campus is "slim to none."

**On Campus** Sexton said students could schedule a weekly running appointment, which would eliminate the need to call before every session.

There are eight projected locations spread across campus where students can meet their partners: Beaty Towers Commons, Southwest Recreation Center, Lakeside Residential Complex, Hume Hall, the Racquet Club, Broward Dining,

Norman Field and Gator Corner Dining Center.

The program is free to UF students.

T-shirts for the NROTC runners, who are volunteers, will be funded by the Activity and Service Fee collected from tuition.

Students go through a background check performed by the U.S. Department of Defense to join the NROTC program, Prior said.

Students are asked to call NROTC at least one hour before they want to run, and a volunteer will take down their name, number and where they would like to meet their running partner.

To contact NROTC and schedule a run, students can call (352) 392-0973.

## Residents, businesses practice recycling and utilize public transportation

about reducing waste, serious about reusing materials and serious about recycling.

Sally Palmi, solid waste and recycling coordinator for the Alachua County Division of Waste Management, said both the city and the county have commercial recycling ordinances that require businesses to recycle.

"What we're doing in the city and the county right now is going to our businesses, apartment complexes and helping them understand the meaning of our ordinance and then also helping them to establish workable programs that are going to be successful," Palmi said.

Compared with the other 66 counties in Florida, Alachua County ranks in the top 15 for most waste recycled, she said.

"We're a pretty green community," she said. "People are always looking for ways to do better."

Apartment complexes are areas that could use improvement, she said.

Many places don't have easy access to recycling, so residents are often unaware or unmotivated to recycle.

"We want to reduce first, reuse what we can and recycle whatever is left over," Palmi said.

Waste Management educates the public about the three R's through programs such as the S.M.A.R.T. shopper, which teaches consumers to buy in bulk and buy recycled products.

In another program, Waste Watcher, a recycling superhero, teaches children to "Embrace Zero Waste," she said.

"We have to realize that our world is made up of limited resources," Palmi said. "And our population is growing exponentially in the world, and our resources are not infinite."

### Electric green

Gainesville residents can now do more to be green than unplugging appliances or turning off lights.

They can support alternative energy, such as solar energy and energy from the methane produced when burning trash.

Katie Weitekamp, spokeswoman for Gainesville Regional

Utilities, said the company has set alternative green energy as a priority.

"Gainesville City Commission is our board of directors," Weitekamp said. "[They direct] us to pursue not only maximum energy efficiency but also alternatives, including solar."

Although it is expensive for homeowners to convert to solar energy, so far 36 solar panel systems exist in Gainesville and 40,000 watts of solar energy have been produced for the few homes and businesses that have invested, she said.

"Not everyone on the block will be able to afford solar panels," she said.

But according to GRU's Web site, alternative energy benefits more than just those who pay for it.

In 2004 GRU kicked off its gas energy project, which burns trash to produce methane that is used as an energy source.

So far, the project has produced 11,136 mega watt hours of energy, Weitekamp said.

That's enough to power 976 homes for one year, she added.

### Green will get you there

Green crosses into transportation as well. Whether walking, cycling or riding the bus, there are greener ways to get around.

Theresa Harrison, Regional Transit System marketing and communications specialist, said riding the bus provides people an alternative transportation option.

The transit system's average daily passenger count ranges from 20,000 in the summer to 50,000 in the fall and spring semesters.

Each year public transportation use in the U.S. saves 1.4 billion gallons of gasoline, she said.

"In our community there are 42 seats on a bus. If that bus is full

of just seated passengers, that is 42 cars that are potentially off the road," Harrison said.

In a society that relies on cars, the switch to alternate transportation is moving slowly.

Palmi said Alachua County Public Works currently has more than 25 hybrid vehicles and two electric vehicles, and all diesel equipment is run on bio-diesel.

Weitekamp said GRU currently has nine hybrid cars, out of a fleet of 340 cars, trucks and SUVs.

Cycling is an energy efficient, nonpolluting way to travel, but takes time out of busy schedules.

Englert sold her car and now uses her bike as her primary vehicle.

### Green in Gainesville

Incorporating green into a lifestyle can mean something as small as carrying a reusable bag to the grocery store, or it can extend into every aspect of a person's life.

Liberty Phoenix, owner of Indigo, a green store in Gainesville, drives a hybrid car, buys cleaning supplies from her store, eats vegan and remodels her home with green products.

"I'm not extreme," Phoenix said. "I don't carpool. I don't ride my bike. I live out of town. There are definitely things that are, like, not feasible for my lifestyle."

A lot of people may jump on a bandwagon, but now is the time to get on, she said.

"My philosophy is the more, the merrier," Phoenix said. "Even if you're doing it to make money and you want to be green only because of that, the whole point is that you're doing something green."

Her store offers the community a place to become educated about green.

The free, or inexpensive, classes offered every Saturday teach patrons how to incorporate green products into their own lives, such as making a rain barrel for a source of renewable water.

Steve Nichtberger, owner of Flashbacks Recycled Fashions, is not sold on the whole green trend.

He said when his store first opened in 1986, it was considered as a Salvation Army.

Students would bring in clothes, but never buy them, he

said.

"People for years, especially when we started, used to come in here and say, 'Ew, I don't wear used clothes,'" Nichtberger said. "But I used to say to people, 'you don't sleep in hotel beds? You don't eat off restaurant forks? They are all used.'"

A washing machine can separate you and every bit of the past of that garment, he said.

"It wasn't until 1990, the 20th anniversary of Earth Day that recycled became the 'it' thing," Nichtberger said. "And then all of a sudden we were hip and happening."

He believes the popularity of


going green is being fueled by the economy.

People get paid the same amount of money, but prices are increasing, so since pocketbooks are being hit hard, green is suddenly a hot topic, he said.

"The whole idea of living green, that to me is like another one of these fads," he said. "To me I have always lived in harmony with my environment."

Whether or not he agrees with the buzzword green, he said it is making people aware.

The most we can look forward to is that this generation will start living consciously, so in 10 years we'll all be better off, he said.

# Neighborhood parking decals now available online

■ **DEADLINE TO PURCHASE DECALS IS SEPTEMBER 12.**

Parking in Gainesville just got a little easier.

Residents living in areas surrounding UF's campus can now buy neighborhood permits

and decals online without standing in lines at the Thomas Center, said Audrey Lewis, city treasurer. The parking passes apply to people who live in the city's controlled vehicular parking zones, including areas from University Avenue to Northwest Eighth Avenue and from U.S. 441 to Southwest Eighth Street.

This year's new permits and decals, which residents are required to purchase before the city's Sept. 12 deadline, cost \$17.50 each.

If residents choose to use the online service,

they must do so one week before the deadline or expiration date because of the time it takes to process requests and mail the orders, according to a release sent out by the city.

The decals and permits can be bought from the city's Web site, [www.cityofgainesville.org](http://www.cityofgainesville.org), under the "Online Decals" link on the lefthand side of the page.

Residents who rent property will need to pick up the mailed permits and decals from

their property owners or managers.

Decals for students living in UF sorority and fraternity houses that have provided member lists to the city are also available online, according to the release. They will be mailed to house directors.

Meal-only decals for sorority and fraternity members are not included in the online service. If residents have any questions, they should call the city parking decal office at 352-334-5024.

city funds to be used toward travel to countries under "terrorist watch," which include Venezuela, Cuba and Iran, he said.

"If I go, I will be paying my own way because it will be illegal to use any university funds," he said.


Presidents from other public and private American universities will join Machen, but the list of delegates isn't finalized yet, said Ann Speicher, AAU associate vice president of public affairs.

Wives of university presidents were also invited, and Machen said his wife, Chris Machen, plans to join him if the trip takes place.

Delegates were selected based on recommendations from the Iranian university presidents, who initiated the exchange, Speicher said.

Machen is optimistic about what can be accomplished in the trip.

"I do believe that the United States can help other countries and learn from other countries working at this level," he said.

lations as the basis for the requirement.

UF law professor Joe Little said part of the problem is that there are constitutional protections on both sides.

The First Amendment requires the university to acknowledge any group's right to assemble, but that same amendment prevents discrimination of religion, Little said. The fact that the court ordered UF to temporarily acknowledge BYX suggests the fraternity has a good argument, he said.

Sikes said the court did say why UF was ordered to recognize the club.

Timothy Tracey, legal counsel for BYX, said the fraternity is the victim of inequality.

Out of more than 60 religious groups on campus, 48 are Christian, and Tracey said he thinks many groups are unofficially discriminatory.

"Their constitutions say one thing, and they do another," he said. "BYX is unwilling to pay lip service to a rule they don't believe in."

Tracey said a ruling in favor of the club's restricted

membership would not open the gates to organizations discriminating against potential members based on things they can't choose, such as race or sexual preference. BYX is fighting for the right to admit members who choose to share their beliefs, Tracey said.

The fraternity, which was established in 1985 at the University of Texas, has locations in 21 campuses across nine states, but UF is the only school where BYX is not recognized, he said.

If the fraternity's goals are inhibited by non-Christian membership, Tracey said, BYX should be allowed to restrict who can join.

"It defies common sense for someone who totally disagrees with your beliefs to affect your club's goals," he said. "It's like having strip mining proponents in the Sierra Club."



# GPD officers find 16 firearms in UF student's car

Gainesville Police officers pulled over a UF student this weekend after they suspected him of driving under the influence.

Then they found 16 firearms in his car. Thomas Joseph Tilley, 33, was arrested at about 7 a.m. Saturday after police found him sitting in his Acura on the wrong side of the road without his headlights on near Southwest 16th Avenue and Southwest 13th Street.

An officer noticed Tilley was having trouble moving and couldn't roll down his window, according to a police report.

Tilley was unable to tell police his address or phone number but said he'd had "a few beers," the report stated.

Police began administering field sobriety exercises but stopped for fear that Tilley, who was unable to keep his balance, would hurt

himself.

He refused to give a breath sample.

During the tests, Tilley continually reached into his right front pocket.

A loaded handgun was later found in that pocket, according to the report.

Sixteen additional firearms were found in the Acura.

Tilley does have a concealed weapons permit, but police don't know why he had so many firearms in his car, said Officer Summer Hallett, GPD spokeswoman.

Tilley was charged with driving under the influence and resisting an officer by refusing to sign a citation, which are both misdemeanors.

# Iraqi students stop in Gainesville during U.S. tour

## They spent two weeks living with local families

It was more than an overseas field trip.

It was a chance for 25 visitors from a war-torn country to break down stereotypes and build life-changing relationships.

A group of Iraqi students spent the last two weeks in Gainesville as part of their month-long trip to the U.S.

The Gainesville chapter of Sister Cities International, a non-profit organization that establishes partnerships between U.S. and international cities, planned the trip.

Gainesville has been a sister city to Duhok, Iraq, for about two years.

The high school students, aged 17 and 18, came from various Iraqi cities.

"It was a real mix or snapshot of the Iraqi country," said Patrick Madden, president and CEO of Sister Cities International.

Gainesville is among nine U.S. cities with Iraqi sister cities.

"This whole program is about exposing the students to American life and culture," Madden said.

Steve Kalishman, president of the Sister City Program of Gainesville, said the goal was to have the young men and women experience Gainesville as typical American teenagers.

During their travels in the U.S., the students stayed in hotels while visiting Kansas City, Mo., and will do the same in Virginia and Washington, D.C., this week.

However, they stayed with host families in Gainesville, an experience Kalishman described as "the heart of the program."

UF medical student Avon Armaghani, 21, is a member of a host family that took in three Iraqi students.

Armaghani's family is originally from Iraq, and she visited the country in 2005 and 2006.

"It was really special to be able to have these kids here because we share this common bond," Armaghani said.

As a host, she spent time with the students and drove them to their scheduled Gainesville activities, which included visiting the Hippodrome Theatre, Lake Wauburg and City Hall.

"I kind of served as the soccer mom for the time being," Armaghani said.

The students had never been to a movie theater, so they went to see "Mamma Mia."

The students really valued outings that Americans often take for granted, Armaghani said.

She said she enjoyed the students' observations, such as their interest in bike lanes and merchandise receipts at stores.

Madden said he believes the students changed their opinions of Americans, who some felt would be standoffish.

While flying to their first destination, Kansas City, Mo., to attend a youth conference, the students said they were surprised when Americans talked to them.

When the program mixed American and Iraqi students together, they talked about the same things: their school curriculum, what's on TV and what's on

their iPods, Madden said.

"We have a lot more in common than we have different," he said.

Madden said he hopes the students realized that too.

"It opens their eyes to other cultures and people," he said. "They take that with them through life."

Besides sharing light-hearted moments, Kalishman said the Iraqi students also shared "horror stories" of growing up in Iraq.

He said some students have witnessed terrible displays in the streets back in Iraq, such as beheaded, bullet-riddled bodies in the streets, car bombings, and people being rounded up, tied together and burned to death.

Most of them have lost at least one family member or friend; many have lost more.

"It's just been horrific for kids to have to grow up like that," Kalishman said. "The fact that they came here and seem well-adjusted and fine is just amazing to me."

A high level of security surrounded the Iraqi students while they visited Gainesville.

No one involved with the program was allowed to reveal

where the students live in Iraq, their names, ages or physical descriptions.

Some people in Iraq might attack the students and their families if they knew they were associating with Americans, Madden said.

"We're trying to protect their identities and their images in a world where everyone has a camera and everything can be put on the Internet and disseminated very easily," Kalishman said.

Kalishman said the fact that Iraqi students visited would have been a big deal if word got out.

"This would have been national news if we had the opportunity to promote it," he said.

Despite increased security measures in Iraq, Kalishman said he wants to help plan a trip to Duhok, Iraq, for Gainesville residents next summer.

SFC students, UF students and host families have expressed interest in traveling overseas and visiting the students they now call friends.

"I would be more than willing to go because these kids are really amazing kids," Armaghani said. "They're very inspiring, and I would absolutely love to see them again and be able to see how they live."





Percy Harvin's No. 1 jersey may be fitting a little tighter than last season.

Since rehabilitation from an April heel surgery left the junior speedster unable to run for much of the summer, the preseason All-American needed to find another way to push himself during the off-season.

What he found was an open weight room door, a new body and a new nightmare for the rest of the Southeastern Conference.

Harvin, who came to UF weighing 180 pounds, has spent the last four months squatting, curling and lifting his way to a chiseled 205-pound frame.

"Percy is an unbelievable athlete," senior long snapper James Smith said.

"He benched 405 this summer. I saw it."

At first glance, Harvin looks more like a running back than a wide receiver.

That, of course, is also by design.

The Virginia Beach, Va., native rushed for 764 yards on 83 carries as a sophomore in 2007.

## Ronnie Wilson returns to team

Forty-five minutes before the sun showed its face, the UF football freshmen were stretching, sprinting and sweating.

The Gators opened fall practice Monday with the freshmen and walk-ons participating in early morning drills and the rest of the team taking part in the afternoon session.

The highlight of the 6 a.m. practice was the return of former starting offensive lineman Ronnie Wilson. Wilson, who was suspended from the team after firing a firearm into the air in April 2007, played with the defensive linemen despite playing left guard in 2006. He only has walk-on status right now and is working to officially re-join the team.


Wilson was unavailable for comment, but did release a statement through the University Athletic Association in which he apologized for his actions and was thankful for another chance.

Redshirt senior defensive lineman Javier Estopinan, who played with Wilson in 2006, could line up alongside him if Wilson completes

his comeback.

"(He has to) get back on everybody's good side and try to get confidence from everybody," Estopinan said. "He's paying his own way for school, so he's like a walk-on now. He's just got to earn his rights again."

Also notable from the freshman practice was the blazing speed of freshman Jeffrey Demps. Demps — who runs a just-over-10-second 100-yard dash — caught a pass and took off down the field, leaving linebackers and corners in the dust. The play elicited a joyful scream of "speed, speed, speed" from UF coach Urban Meyer.

Demps should be a versatile player for UF this season, and the fact that his position on the Gators roster is simply "athlete" shows he can play many positions.

In the afternoon, the focus was on wide receiver Percy Harvin. The junior had heel surgery in the spring but has recovered and will be ready

## Expect stronger D-line

A championship reincarnation is breeding.

At least according to defensive end Carlos Dunlap. After the defense, and especially the line and secondary, struggled last season with youth, inexperience and injuries, the Gators have a message for the rest of the nation: They're back.

"We're going to be just like the national championship line," Dunlap said. "That's what you can look for."

Dunlap said the line should be "two, possibly three times better" than last season.

If that lofty goal happens, Tim Tebow will barely have time for a sip of Gatorade as the defense will constantly get the Gators juggernaut offense back on the field.

"Everyone says we're the weakest," he said.

The defensive line is certainly one of the areas of biggest improvement, but rifts can be seen throughout the defense.

# Jheranie Boyd does not want spotlight, attention

Jheranie Boyd doesn't buy into the hype.

As one of the nation's most talented and most recruited wide receiver prospects, Boyd lives his life in the spotlight.

But if the Gastonia, N.C., native could have his way, there would be no lights. No headlines. No expectations.

Constantly called, perpetually e-mailed and unable to dodge the never-ending barrage of text messages, Boyd is in high demand for a 17-year-old soon-to-be high school senior.


"It can be a lot to handle," Boyd said.

From head coaches to Internet recruiting pundits, seemingly everyone wants a piece of the 6-foot-3 Ashbrook High prospect.

"My phone is always blowing up, man," Boyd said. "Sometimes I wish it would just stop ringing for a few days."

As a junior, Boyd caught 47 passes for 1,151 yards and 11

touchdowns. He averaged 24 yards per catch last season and boasts a self-proclaimed 44-inch vertical leap. Boyd, who holds scholarship offers from UF,

North Carolina, Clemson, Alabama and Auburn among others, made his first trip to Gainesville for July's Friday Night Lights football camp.

The 184-pound Boyd showed why he was chosen to be an Under Armour All-American.

Sprinting past, leaping over and reaching around some of the nation's most talented prospects, Boyd made easy work of the camp's defensive backs.

"I don't want to sound cocky or anything, but I didn't have too much trouble with the corners out there," Boyd said. "I just used my speed to run by them."

Boyd came away from the camp just as impressed with UF as everyone else was with him. He said that what really stuck out about the Gators was the personal attention he received from the coaches.

"At all the other schools I've been to, I had to go up to the coach's

office, or someone brought me to the coach," Boyd said. "But when I got here, coach [Urban] Meyer was waiting downstairs for me."

One of UF's top targets for the 2009 recruiting class, it looks as if a commitment from the North Carolina standout may come sooner rather than later.

"It's going to be tough to beat Florida right now," he said.

If the soft-spoken Boyd does eventually land in Gainesville, he is going to have to get used to a whole new level of exposure — something that he says he is ready for.

"I wouldn't mind playing out here under these lights," Boyd said.

to play. He didn't participate too heavily in Monday's practice.

"He came out today and opened it up a little bit," Meyer said.

Meyer added he was not concerned as much about Harvin's heel, but instead if another part of Harvin's body reacted negatively to the surgery.

UF is most thin at safety, and to help that load, Meyer moved freshman wide receiver T.J. Lawrence to the secondary. Meyer was also confident that freshmen Will Hill and Ahmad Black would be able to handle the load.

Defensive lineman Torrey Davis and safety Bryan Thomas were not listed on the roster handed out at practice. Meyer said Davis was "dealing with some academic issues and other issues," while Thomas was rehabbing from having a cyst removed from his knee. Thomas will be ready when school begins on Aug. 25, Meyer said.

The Gators have open practice every day until Saturday, at which point the remainder of preseason practice is closed to fans and the media. Monday's practice was UF's earliest of the preseason, but the team will have six more days with both morning and afternoon sessions.

Bottom line: It's time to put up or shut up.

But just like last year with a laundry list of first-year starters, it'll be much of the same this year.

Defensive end Jermaine Cunningham, linebackers Brandon Spikes and Dustin Doe, defensive backs Joe Haden and Major Wright and tackle Javier Estopinan (if healthy) are the only ones that have probably nailed down starting roles.

The rest — while many do have some experience — have not had starting roles.

Even Wright and Haden are only sophomores, and they're already viewed as leaders for the developing defense.

"It goes from me being young to having to grow up a lot," Wright said.

More players than just Wright are going to have to grow up. While Dunlap's pass-rushing abilities have been compared to former Gator and NFL first-round draft pick Derrick Harvey, his run defense isn't as solid.

Besides Estopinan, that pretty much goes for the whole line.

After Estopinan tore his ACL last season, UF's rush defense was noticeably weaker.

"Everything starts in the trenches," Dunlap said. "If the trenches perform well, then the offense will perform well, and the defense will put points on the

board also."





Coach Urban Meyer can thank strength and conditioning coach Mickey Marotti for making one of the nation's deadliest offensive weapons even more of a threat.

"Just look at him. He looks like a completely different person," Marotti said.

Some have questioned whether Harvin has sacrificed any of his 4.3-second 40-yard dash speed in pursuit of his newfound

strength — a discussion Gonzales laughs at.

"I'm not worried about it at all," he said with a smirk. "Not with him."

Harvin caught 59 balls for 858 yards and four touchdowns last season. In 2006 he had three rushing touchdowns, and he's scored 15 total touchdowns so far in his career.

He is almost fully recovered from the surgery that repaired his injured right heel, a problem

that has bothered him since high school, and should be ready for the start of the season.

Initially diagnosed as tendonitis by the UF medical staff, pain from the injury persisted and eventually caused soreness in his knee and hip.

Despite his overwhelming

success, Harvin has failed to appear in every game in either of his two seasons in Gainesville.

He missed time as freshman in 2006 because of an ankle injury and was held out of two games last season due to migraine headaches.

He couldn't even travel with the team to South Carolina.

A fully healed and rebuilt Harvin could go a long way in propelling the Gators to success in the 2008 campaign.

"Any time that you can add a guy like Percy back into the mix — that type of a playmaker — it's a tremendous advantage," Gonzales said.

"I'm excited to have him healthy again and back out here."

When asked if there is a limit to the amount of weight the coaching staff would like to see Harvin gain, Marotti replied simply.

"We're at that point," he said.
