UF lacks alert system equal to USF's

■ **USF REACHED 97 PERCENT OF ITS CONTACTS WITHIN FOUR MINUTES.**

After the threat of an armed gunman on University of South Florida campus ended

without harm Friday afternoon, UF said its response system is similar, adequate and improving.

USF used text messaging, Web site updates and intercoms to keep students and faculty aware of developing information, tools which UF uses or plans to use.

During the recent gun scare, MoBull, a text alert system named after USF's horned mascot, reached 97 percent of their contacts within

four minutes, said Lara Wade, USF spokeswoman.

UF took 20 to 30 minutes to contact most students in recent tests, UF spokesman Steve Orlando said.

On Campus

Students at USF were first alerted of a possible gunman by a voice over loudspeakers, four of which broadcast from the top of parking garages for maximum coverage, Wade said.

UF is installing a speaker system, which should be completed within a year, according to William Properzio, director of UF's Environmental Health and Safety Department.

The speakers will be installed in classrooms and outside areas, such as the Plaza of the Americas. The system will cost about \$1 million, Properzio said.

According to Orlando, speaker installation

UF dethroned as No. 1 party school

UF's year-long reign as the top party school in the nation ended abruptly at noon Monday, when it was announced that Penn State University had taken the infamous title.

UF slipped to No. 2 on the list, published each year by the Princeton Review in its college guide, "The Best 371 Colleges," which hit shelves today.

The ranking means UF has high levels of drug and alcohol use, a popular Greek system and students who don't spend much time studying, according to survey results from 122,000 students at 371 colleges.

If UF had retained its No. 1 position, it would have been the first school to do so since 1995, when the University of Rhode Island completed a three-year run in the top spot, according to

Robert Franek, the author of the college guide.

Steve Orlando, UF's spokesman, said he was relieved UF had been dethroned.

"People who do what I do at universities dread this announcement coming out," he said.

One reason UF may have slipped to the second spot this year is that students didn't hold as many sports championships, he said.

When the last rankings came out, UF held three national championships — two in men's basketball and one in football.

"We figure people had a lot to see in the top spot, according to

Universities collaborate on 'supercomputer' project

A new supercomputer at UF is making it easier to do everything from researching cancer to predicting the weather.

The computer, named Novo-G, is about 10 to 100 times faster and uses five to 10 times less energy than

conventional computers, making it the most powerful in its class.

The computer at UF was finished and became fully functional last week.

Novo-G is easily customizable for specific tasks, said professor Alan George, director of UF's reconfigurable computing center.

George explained that while con-

ventional computers are inflexible, computers like Novo-G can be modified to operate more efficiently.

George contrasted traditional computers, which he said are

like toy blocks that have been glued together, with the highly modifiable Novo-G.


"If you're good at it, you can have an Eiffel Tower one minute... and the White House [the next]," he said.

The project was a collaboration between UF and George Washington University, Brigham Young Univer-

sity and Virginia Tech University, as well as about 30 other business partners, including NASA, Intel and the National Security Agency. George said UF's center will continue to research Novo-G to better understand the system.

"When it's all figured out, it'll be in Best Buy," he said. "But we're a long way away from that."

Man with three warrants arrested for almost hitting officer with car

After almost hitting an officer with his car in a Shands at UF parking garage, a Marion County man was arrested by University Police Department Friday.

At about 5 p.m., UPD got a call from the Alachua County Sheriff's Office stating Maonucle Evans, 21, who had three outstanding arrest warrants, was at Shands at UF visiting a patient. Officers found Evans in a nearby parking garage driving a white Buick, said Detective Michael Metz.

When a UPD officer saw that Evans was trying to exit through the entrance, he stood between the car and the entrance gate. Evans attempted to drive the car into the officer but then reversed, Metz said.

Evans was finally stopped, taken out of the car and handcuffed. He was arrested and charged with two felonies including aggravated assault and driving with a suspended license.

The NCAA on Monday asked Circuit Judge John C. Cooper to dismiss a lawsuit filed by The Associated Press and other news organizations seeking the records under that law.

Cooper will hear that motion and others on Aug. 5.

He agreed, though, to delay a final two-day hearing that had been set to start on that date until Aug. 20-21.

The NCAA sought the delay because two of its key witnesses — both executives of the organization — will be unavailable on the original dates as they'll be attending NCAA meetings on those days.

Man sleeping in Dumpster gets picked up with trash

TAMPA, Fla. (AP) — Authorities said a man, who had been sleeping in a Dumpster, sustained minor injuries after he was picked up by a garbage truck along with the trash.

Authorities said that when firefighters and paramedics arrived, they heard Kevin Hallaran, 52, banging on the metal sides of the sanitation truck asking for help.

Hallaran had been sleeping inside a Dumpster behind a restaurant Sunday night and had been unknowingly dumped along with the garbage from restaurants and other businesses into the truck early Monday.

A sanitation department employee had not yet activated the truck's compactor after he mis-

takenly dumped, Hallaran inside.

Authorities said the compactor would most likely have killed Hallaran.

US turns off electronic billboard in Havana

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Obama administration has turned off an electronic sign at the U.S. diplomatic mission in Havana that had displayed pro-democracy and human rights messages to Cuban passers-by and riled the government for the past three years.

The State Department said Monday that the sign, a news "zipper" on the fifth floor of the sea-front American Interest Section in the Cuban capital, was shut down last month amid the administration's efforts to engage with Cuba's leadership that has already seen some U.S. sanctions eased.

"We believe that the billboard was really not effective as a means of delivering information to the Cuban people," spokesman Ian Kelly told reporters.

He noted that since the sign was first erected in 2006, the Cuban government had taken steps to obscure it from view.

Show to end summer season

The UF School of Theatre and Dance will wrap up its summer season by bringing perspectives from Israel, Africa and the Big Apple to the Nadine McGuire Theatre and Dance Pavilion.

"Sylvie, An Evening of Dances and Tales" will open Wednesday night, incorporating the works of UF professor Neta Pulvermacher and 24 of UF's Summer Dance Intensive students.

"We decided to bring the world here," said Pulvermacher. "The idea is to think globally and dance locally."

Focusing on her upbringing in Lehavot Habashan, a kibbutz in northern Israel, the show features her award-winning dance "Five Beds/Children of the Dream."

A kibbutz is a collective community based on agriculture.

"You share your life with 16 to 18 peers," Pulvermacher said about her upbringing. "It meant that from birth, rather than live with your parents in same house, you only saw them every day in the afternoon."

Pulvermacher began dancing at 14 years old and found her calling one year later when dancing and choreographing at an area school close to her kibbutz.

"Dance and theater have the capacity to reach and touch beyond words," she said. "It has other means of expressing ideas, thoughts and feelings."

In 1986, one year after graduating from The Juilliard School in New York City, Pulvermacher formed her own dance company, The Neta

Dance Company.

Since joining the staff at UF three years ago, Pulvermacher brought her own life experiences to the stage.

"Sylvie," a piece inspired by Pulvermacher's recent trip to Senegal, is her most recent work.

"Dance and theater have the capacity to reach and touch beyond words. It has other means of expressing ideas, thoughts and feelings."

The title of the piece comes from during her trip when she taught choreography to dance instructors from across Africa.

"Before I left they threw a potluck in my honor and roasted a whole goat," she said. "Sylvie was the name of the goat."

The 24 UF students will be joined by four of Pulvermacher's dancers from her New York City studio, two of whom are UF alumni.

"There's an array of music, dancing, singing and yelling," said Miriam Rosenberg, a UF senior dance major. "It's an emotional journey."

The show opens Wednesday at 7 p.m. at the Nadine McGuire Theatre and Dance Pavilion in Studio Theatre G-6.

An additional show will be at 9 p.m.

The performance runs until Friday with two shows per night. Tickets are \$13 for students and \$17 for the general public and can be purchased at the University Box Office or www.ticketmaster.com, according to the box office Web site.

celebrate," Orlando said.

It's also possible UF President Bernie Machen's attempts to curb alcohol consumption have had an effect on UF's reputation, but it's hard to tell, Orlando said.

"This is anything but a scientific survey," he said.

Machen, who is in Indonesia meeting with university leaders, could not be reached for comment Monday.

In addition to three other No. 2 finishes, UF placed first in one of the survey's 62 categories: Best Career Services. The ranking means students rated UF's job placement services highly.

UF was ranked No. 13 in Best Career Services last year, the first year the ranking was used.

Wayne Wallace, director of UF's Career Resource Center, said he thinks his hard-working staff and the center's use of student surveys have a lot to do with the level of satisfaction.

"I think that being responsive to student interests and needs has really been the key," he said.

And, he said, 99 of the 100 companies Fortune Magazine listed as the best ones to work for this year conduct recruitment at UF.

UF's other No. 2 finishes were in the categories Best Athletic Facilities,

Students Pack the Stands and Jock Schools, which measured popularity of sports and fraternities.

Last year, UF finished first in Students Pack the Stadiums and Students Study the Least. This year, UF dropped to eighth among schools that study the least.

In the category of Lots of Beer, UF ranked No. 4.

Students had mixed feelings about UF's drop in the party school ranking.

Nicole Frankel, a music and pre-health sophomore, said she was glad UF was no longer No. 1.

"I think [being No. 1] has kind of a negative connotation," Frankel said. "The university is taken a little less seriously,"

But freshman Alex Patel said she didn't believe that Penn State was actually a bigger party school than UF.

"I don't think it's true. I get texts about parties every night," Patel said. "They must be partying a lot, like severely," she said.

Jake Marika, a sociology sophomore, said he doesn't think the ranking means much.

"Whoever says they party the most parties the most," he said. "It's bound to change every year."

However, he said, the ranking might make Machen focus less on student drinking.

"Maybe it's a good thing," he said, "because Bernie will be less likely to get his panties in a bunch."

already began at the law school.

Orlando also said a low number of UF staff are set to receive alert text messages compared to other major Florida universities such as University of Miami, which can contact 88 percent of its employees through text in an emergency.

This may account for the disparity in delay time between UF's text system and USF's MoBull.

UF also uses "reverse 911" which allows the Alachua County Sheriff's Office to send telephone messages, or text-to-speech, to every phone in specific buildings on campus.

"In a recent test it took us anywhere from five to 10 minutes to reach three buildings," Orlando said.

UF uses the ConnectED service to text information to students and faculty in case of an emergency, Orlando said.

However, ConnectED, a product of Massachusetts-based Blackboard Inc., can run into trouble when many people in the same area use its service simultaneously.

"It's like trying to make a phone call at a Gator game," Orlando said.

Phone reception dead zones are also an obstacle to UF's text alert system.

"Until recently I didn't even get cell phone service at my desk," Orlando said.

Beyond alert systems, Orlando stressed students should be aware of their surroundings.

"If you observe something [weird] in a friend, report it," he said. "Tell somebody."

Above all, Orlando said UF's Student affairs and counseling staff as the most important part of campus safety.

"If we can address something like that early on, we stand a much better chance of preventing a bad situation later on. Prevention is always a better path," he wrote in an e-mail.

UF allots \$5M for construction of business center

Most incubators at Shands at UF are occupied by newborns, but thanks to an \$8.2 million grant, UF is building a different kind of incubator.

The grant for the Florida Innovation Hub, a business center for startup companies, was announced Friday along with plans for building the 45,000-square-foot facility, according to a UF press release.

UF will contribute an additional \$5 million to the project and will obtain this money mainly through royalty income earned from sources like faculty research, said Win Phillips, UF's vice president for research.

Scheduled for completion in December 2011, the building will provide office space, laboratories and conference rooms for several budding technological businesses and companies connected to the UF community.

Ed Poppell, UF's vice president of business affairs, said that as soon as planning is finished, workers will begin construction on the facility, which will hopefully be within the next six months.

The building will be constructed on what is now a parking lot on the northeast corner of Shands at AGH site, Poppell said.

The facility will also house UF's Office of Technology Licens-

ing and UF Tech Connect, which finds technology from research that is patentable and promotes the licensing of these technologies to the market.

Phillips said that UF developed

the idea of a building a new incubator after seeing the success of a similar hub in Alachua County, which opened in 1995.

He said that various business sectors will use the facility, in-

cluding chemistry, agricultural and engineering fields.

Phillips said the hub will provide constant communication between companies in the building and people who license technology and the ability to share resources in order to save money.

"There is no question that a company's ability to succeed is far greater in an incubator," he said.

The federal Economic Development Administration awarded the grant, which is one of the largest of its kind ever given by the EDA's Atlanta regional office, said EDA regional representative Philip T. Trader in the press release.

"We expect it to be extremely successful," he said.

Katie Haney, a health education and behavior senior, agrees with Phillips and said she thinks the hub is going to continue to improve the UF business community.

She is also optimistic about the new jobs that these future companies will create for Gainesville residents, she said.

"As a soon-to-be graduate, I think it's a great idea," Haney said. "It's something that is going to make Gainesville an even better place to live."

Florida drivers discouraged from texting while driving

For now, Florida nicely asks drivers to stay off their cell phones and just drive.

Through its "Stay Alive... Just Drive" campaign, Florida is taking a softer approach than the six states and the District of Columbia that ban the use of hand-held cell phones while driving. Another 17 states have partial bans.

Monday the Florida Highway Patrol began distributing brochures and pamphlets

during routine stops to educate drivers about how to avoid and eliminate distractions while driving, FHP Capt. Mark Welch said.

FHP teamed up with the "Stay Alive... Just Drive" program to campaign after Gov. Charlie Crist declared July as Distracted Driving Awareness Month, Welch said.

Jay Anderson, the executive director of the campaign, said the program asks people to pull over to do anything other than drive while behind the wheel.

The most visible distraction while driving is cell phones, but laptops, iPods, grooming,

eating and disciplining children are also major problems, he said.

Anderson said one problem is that young people are in constant communication and don't stop when they drive.

State News "You have to ask yourself if the risk is worth it while you're behind the wheel," he said.

A typical distraction lasts about three seconds. A car traveling 45 mph can travel half the length of a football field in that amount of time, he said.

"Failure to pay attention results in pre-

ventable crashes," Anderson said.

There were 1,796 crashes in Florida in 2003 that were caused by distracted drivers, according to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles Web site. Twenty percent of drivers were reported as having been on their cell phone.

Tips to avoid distraction include: pull over to text or talk on the phone, read the newspaper at home, limit the amount of time spent messing with the radio or CDs and scan the roadway ahead, according to the department.

July 31, 1984: UF swimmers have led the U.S. Olympic swimming team to victory, winning medals in four of the nine meets to date.

One Gators competitor, Tracy Caulkins, broke her own previously held American record in the 400-meter race, coming in at 4:39:24, nine seconds before the Australian silver medalist's time.

Mike Heath, another of the Gators Olympians, has already received two honors on the platform: a silver medal in the 200-meter freestyle and gold in the team 800-meter freestyle with a world-record finish.

July 31, 1973: The Gainesville Eight finally stand trial against

the charges of conspiracy with plans of violence, almost a year after their arrests at the 1972 Republican National Convention in Miami.

Members of the group are veterans of the Vietnam War, which they were protesting.

According to the indictment, the men met in Gainesville after their separate tours of duty and allegedly began to formulate their plans to "organize numerous 'fire teams' to attack with automatic weapons, fire and incendiary devices police stations, police cars and stores in Miami Beach."

The trial is in Pensacola, Fla.

In Gainesville, members of the group Vietnam Veterans Against the War plan a march as a demonstration of their support for the defendants.

Already Aware

Editorial Board calls to ban texting and driving

Texting while driving is a scenario that is familiar to most students at UF, and the concept of cell-phone-addicted-screaming-girl is a trope that is ubiquitous in our current pop culture. (We recently saw it in an episode of the Jonas Brothers' TV show, so like, even babies know about it. Don't ask.)

What should also be familiar, though, is the fact that nothing strikes fear into the heart of a passenger faster than the sight of his or her driver (and possible gatekeeper into the afterlife) lower his or her chance of a safe arrival with each staccato of the fingertips.

To counter this, six states and Washington D.C. have enacted a strict ban on texting while driving and made it a ticketable offense. Florida, however, has not taken it that far. Instead of outlawing the practice, Florida is attempting to kill the habit with "awareness."

We don't think this is the best approach. People are aware of the danger inherent in many activities but continue to do them anyway (Camel Light, anyone?). It is obvious to everyone with half a brain that driving without a seat belt isn't such a hot idea, but some of us still won't wear one until we are busted with a \$70 fine.

So why doesn't Florida follow suit and ban texting while driving? Put simply, fear of big government. We understand this concern, and it seems reasonable to let people make their own decisions and worry about the consequences.

Try telling a girl (possibly the cell-phone-addicted-screaming-girl) that drunken driving isn't a good idea, but she won't get in trouble if she downs 97 cosmos at XS before jumping into her lime green Volkswagen Beetle to head to the "after party" with her "ladies." We don't think she'd listen.

One might ask, "Well, if we ban texting, what's to stop drivers from being distracted by iPods in their cars?" and it would be a legitimate concern. However, texting requires more reading and more constant attention than song selection. Pill will not ensure immortality

Want to live longer? As it turns out, we may have the answer. A report in the July 10 issue of Science showed a dramatic difference between the lifespan of two different sets of Rhesus monkeys in a 20-year study. The results were so shocking that scientists already began seeking additional funding for another 20 years of research.

One scientist called the findings "simply incredible." In the study, nearly three times as many control monkeys than test monkeys died, a remarkable achievement even in the most selective of environments.

So what is the magic formula for long life? Calorie restriction. Boy, that's exciting. After 20 years and millions of dollars, researchers at the Wisconsin National Primate Research Center at the University of Wisconsin-Madison showed us all 38 starved monkeys live longer than their slothful, indulgent counterparts.

By decreasing the test monkeys' diets by 30 percent fewer calories, the Rhesus monkeys were shown to have 70 percent fewer instances of cancer, heart disease or other age-related conditions. Furthermore, test monkeys exhibited greater mental capacities and energy levels while the control monkey's exhibited noticeable signs of aging: wrinkles, hair loss and slumping posture.

And it seems as though the good news doesn't end there. Researchers at the National Institute on Aging's Interventions Testing Program matched this study by showing that the common drug Rapamycin exhibits similar effects of calorie restriction. Alas, the elixir for long life. Now all we have to do is take a pill and we can live longer.

But while these findings are surely a step toward the ultimate goal of a long and healthy life, they are far from groundbreaking. The Institute for Aging Research reported just two years ago that women under 5 feet 2 inches and 105 pounds are more likely to live longer than any other demographic. Thus, there seems to

be at least some link to low weight and long life.

The late 20th century technological boom helped advance anti-aging research methods and expanded the field of biogerontology dealing with age-related issues. But the real increase in anti-aging attention comes as baby boomers seek geriatric care.

With nearly one in five Americans older than 65, the demand for longevity never has been higher. And while it may be true that each advancement in biogerontology brings a new hope for the millions of Americans in this age group, it remains a product of a burgeoning senior section.

It is a product of our society — human nature — to seek long life. According to Genesis, Hebrew patriarch Methuselah was said to live 969 years. Juan Ponce de Leon discovered the fountain of youth in 1513 that fostered a youth-preserving mineral water. And James Hilton's Shangri-La cultivated health, happiness and, of course, long life. We even look at the Hunza Valley of Pakistan and the Vilcabamba of Ecuador, where people are said to live as long as 120 years, as examples of genetic age retardation. In the last two years alone, the United States has poured in more than \$1.5 billion in anti-aging research funding.

Yet I for one believe that there is a complement to everything. With youth, comes age. With time, there is space. And with birth, there is death. There are constants that impact our lives that a pill cannot change. Aging remains a subtle, no doubt vital, part of our progression to this mortality. We spend all of our time trying to avoid death when truth be told, we don't even know when death happens.

Now can somebody please feed those poor starving monkeys?

When the drills concluded and the players were treated to a post-camp meal, Powell was surrounded at all times by multiple UF staff members, and two whisked him away to a side room in The Swamp after he left the field.

Powell has received scholarship offers from UF as well as Notre Dame, Tennessee, Auburn and seven Pacific-10 Conference

Georgia coach, players split on game's location

HOOVER, Ala. — The future home of the UF-UGA rivalry is still in doubt, and Georgia coach Mark Richt is finished giving his opinion on the subject.

Richt made waves earlier this year when he said playing the game in Jacksonville — where the Gators have won 16 of the last 19 — is not a neutral atmosphere, citing distance and weather as reasons.

At Southeastern Conference Media Days on Thursday, he took a different track in hopes of avoiding controversy.

"This is what I want to do: I want to focus on winning that game," Richt said. "That's all I want to focus on when it comes to that game."

When asked if that meant he didn't care where the game is played, Richt smiled and repeated himself.

"I really just want to focus on trying to win that game. That's my goal from here on in. That will be my pat answer from here on in."

The current deal between the two schools will expire following the 2010 game, and they have yet to sign a new contract dictating where their annual rivalry game will be played.

Richt favors a rotation between neutral sites in Jacksonville and Atlanta, something the Atlanta Sports Council has tried to accomplish in the past.

UF coach Urban Meyer wants to keep the game in Jacksonville, but he said he didn't know where the two schools stood in terms of reaching a

deal.

"I just love that game," he said. "I love the atmosphere. It's one of the unique ones in college football."

The Bulldogs in attendance Thursday were just as split on the issue as the crowd in Jacksonville Municipal Stadium.

Defensive tackle Jeff Owens, who tailgated and watched the game as a fan last year because of injury, says he'd like to see a rotating schedule.

Quarterback Joe Cox wants to keep the status quo.

"I really don't care because either way, the stadium is going to be half

red and half blue-and-orange," Cox said. "If it's in Atlanta, I guess people just want to see more Georgia fans outside the stadium.

It really doesn't matter once you get inside because it's 50-50.

"I like playing in Florida because it's pretty good weather, and it's a fun game to go to."

As Cox said, crowd demographics wouldn't change much between the current site and the Georgia Dome, but attendance would fall.

The dome held 75,892 for the SEC Championship Game last year, while 84,649 attended the UF-Georgia matchup in Jacksonville.

From the conference's perspective, the site of one of its biggest rivalry games is secondary.

"It's a great conference rivalry, so the game itself is what matters," SEC commissioner Mike Slive said. "Where it gets played is really completely in the hands of the institutions."

Bowden hopes to keep 14 wins

■ **THE FSU FOOTBALL COACH WANTS TO KEEP PACE WITH JOE PATERNO.**

GREENSBORO, N.C. — Bobby Bowden is approaching his 80th birthday, and he's asking for quite the present.

The soon-to-be octogenarian hopes to hang on to the 14 victories the NCAA wants to remove from his record due to an academic cheating scandal.

"I'm still thinking they'll come to their senses," the Florida State coach said Monday with a laugh during the Atlantic Coast Conference's media days.

The 79-year-old Bowden continued to express his desire to remain in a chase with Penn State's Joe Paterno to become the winningest coach in major college football. Bowden enters his 34th season in Tallahassee with 382 career wins - one fewer than Paterno.

"They're just going to kill a good dadgum competition if they take those games away," Bowden said. Reporters, he added, "don't have a darned thing to write about if they take those games away. They might do it. I hope they don't."

At the heart of the dispute is whether the NCAA should take wins from Bowden and other coaches and athletes who had no role in a scandal that involved 61 athletes who allegedly cheated on an online music history test several seasons ago.

Florida State filed a 20-page appeal earlier this month, arguing that the penalty is too harsh and that even if the Seminoles' program should lose victories, the individual records of coaches and players should not suffer.

"I'm going to tell (the school) to fight like you-know-what," Bowden said. "I'm going to tell them to fight it (with) all we're worth, and I'd fight it if I could, but there's nothing I can do. But if we don't win it, I'll accept it."

"As soon as we spotted (cheating), we turned ourselves in (and) suspended them immediately," he added. "Now, are they going to open up a can of worms here? Does that mean when 'So-and-So State' has a kid, middle of the season, gets caught cheating, they found out he cheated three weeks ago, they've got to go back and forfeit all those games he played in? ... That'll happen at every school in the United States of America."

Paterno said Monday at the Big Ten media day it was "ridiculous" that the NCAA was considering stripping Bowden of the victories.

"Bobby played with what he had and he won with what he had," Paterno said. "It bothers me a little bit that the NCAA would use him almost as a scapegoat for all of things that went on at Florida State. ... I hope they let him keep his wins."

Some of Bowden's ACC rivals weren't sure what to make of the veteran coach's sticky situation.

North Carolina coach Butch Davis - whose rivalry with Bowden dates back to his time as an assistant at Miami in the mid-1980s and head coach there in the '90s - steered clear of saying too much about it.

"It's never come up in casual conversation with any of the other coaches, and I think probably the thing is that everybody's like, 'That's Bobby and Florida State's situation,'" Davis said. "And none of us know."

Said Miami's Randy Shannon: "We're all coaches, and we're part of the coaching family. Everybody goes through it. When it hits you, you have to weather the storm and get back in control of it."

Bowden turns 80 on Nov. 8 - the day after the Seminoles play son Tommy's former team, Clemson. The family's patriarch insisted he hasn't resigned himself to losing those wins - or the chase with Paterno.

"It won't bother me one bit. I don't live and die over stuff like that," Bowden said.



## Tebow steals spotlight at Media Days

HOOVER, Ala. — Just as he did last year at Southeastern Conference Media Days, UF quarterback Tim Tebow answered questions from the podium, a spot usually reserved for coaches.

Only Tebow used it more like a pulpit.

For 20 minutes, the UF signal caller discussed topics ranging from his decision to stay for his senior year to his religious beliefs.

But before anyone could fire off a question, Tebow addressed the biggest mystery floating around the conference: Which coach left Tebow off his preseason All-SEC First-Team ballot?

"I'm glad to be here. No, I do not know who did not vote for me. I've gotten that question a lot," he said.



### Football

Many questions in Hoover last week focused on Tebow, as nearly every player and coach was asked about him.

UF coach Urban Meyer and Mississippi State's Dan Mullen were asked to divulge Tebow's annoying habits, and players were asked whether he's the toughest opponent they have ever faced.


Needless to say, the attention just intensified when Tebow arrived, with seemingly no topic off limits.

During a radio interview Thursday, Tebow was asked whether he's waiting until marriage to have sex, to which he responded, "Yes, I am."

When another reporter couldn't find the right words for a follow-up, Tebow interjected, "I think you're stunned right now. You can't even ask a question. ... I was ready for that question, but I don't think y'all were."

Since his days at Nease High, Tebow has become a very comfortable public speaker. His speech after the loss to Mississippi last season quickly became legend (another hot topic at Media Days), and he looked at ease on Thursday.

Operations Jamie Speronis who filled out the ballot and that he signed off on the list afterward.

# Top 10 Burning Questions for 2009-10

## How will women's lacrosse be received in Gainesville?

Come spring, there will be a new sport on campus to capture your attention.

UF students, we present... women's lacrosse.

Yep, that's right, while the sport was formally announced years ago, we are now finally 207 days from the Gators' season opener — Feb. 20 against Jacksonville.

**#8** This, of course, begs the burning question: How will women's lacrosse be received in Gainesville?

The groundwork for the sport (really, it's like building a completely new program, since it needed a new stadium and there was no men's equivalent already on campus) has been laid since June 14, 2006, when Athletics Director Jeremy Foley announced the newest varsity sport was coming to Gainesville.

The sport is certainly gaining popularity nationwide. The NCAA has sanctioned a collegiate champion in women's lacrosse since 1982, and the sport divided

itself into the traditional Division I, II and III subdivisions in 2001.

Success has had a decidedly northeast flavor, however. All four Division I champions (Maryland, Princeton twice, Virginia and Northwestern five times) have come from that region of the country, where lacrosse is similar in popularity to sports like baseball, basketball and football in the South.

There will be no easy transition for the Gators, as they are joining the American Lacrosse Conference, a seven-team league containing fellow Southeastern Conference schools Vanderbilt and South Carolina as well as five-time reigning national champion Northwestern.

When UF takes the field for its season opener in February — there will likely be some exhibition matches in the fall, still to be announced — it will be 13 years since the Gators had an inaugural season (there was softball's debut in 1997 and before that soccer in 1995).

And those two teams are evidence that if you win early, the fans will come. The soccer team won a championship in its fourth season and the softball team earned an NCAA Tournament ap-

pearance in its second year.

With UF flourishing in so many non-revenue sports, on-the-field success usually determines what program will get the added carry-over support from the traditional Gators football and men's basketball fan.

On that end, surface knowledge shows UF has done its homework.

Foley, known for his ability to hire great up-and-coming coaches,

tapped National Lacrosse Hall of Fame member Amanda O'Leary to head the UF women's lacrosse program. O'Leary came to UF after coaching at Yale for 14 years. When she left, she ranked fifth among active coaches in career winning percentage (.714), and Foley brought her to Gainesville in June 2007 in order to give her plenty of time to lay the groundwork.

O'Leary's first recruiting class,

24 women strong, will make its way onto campus in the fall and includes seven players named to the US Lacrosse High School All-America Team as juniors.

So the Gators have a beautiful stadium, a well-established coach and a young but talented crop of players.

Now, the question remains: How long until the program finds success, and more importantly, how many people will care?

Ball Coach, and he was everything I wanted him to be — reluctantly charming, bitingly sarcastic and completely unapologetic.

Spurrier is what's good about football.

He says what he wants and means what he says.

Just when you think he's about to explain the complexities of the 3-4 defense, he offers up the kind of off-the-wall comment that leaves the room crippled with laughter.

When asked about defensive coordinator

Lorenzo Ward, the coach gave this assessment:

"He's a good guy. Loves to play golf," Spurrier said. "We've had a bunch of golf games together. I've actually got about four or five coaches on the staff that love to play golf. I don't know what that means. He's a

pretty good stick."

So maybe he doesn't go over his pre-season ballots with a fine-tooth comb, but on entertainment value alone, he's worth the price of admission.

If we're lucky, maybe we'll all get another hole-in-one next year.

## Burton helps convince Brown to commit at FNL

Mack Brown didn't work out or participate in any drills Friday night, but he drew everyone's attention just by saying a few words.

Brown, a four-star running back prospect from Lithonia (Ga.) Martin Luther King High, became the 16th oral commitment of the Gators' 2010 recruiting class at UF's fifth annual Friday Night Lights camp.

Brown made his intentions known to coach Urban Meyer and the UF staff following the camp.

"I talked to Florida coaches more than I talked to any other coaches, so that was the biggest thing for me," Brown said. "They showed me a lot of stuff about what they're going to do next year with (UF quarterback John) Brantley, so it'll be more of an I-forma-

tion team."

The 5-foot-11, 185-pound running back chose UF over Georgia, a decision he thinks may earn him a hard time from his friends who root for the nearby Bulldogs.

According to Rivals.com, Brown is the sixth-best running back in the country and the No. 56 overall prospect. He said he anticipates competing with other UF running backs for playing time and compared himself to Minnesota Vikings running back Adrian Peterson, adding that he tries to set the bar high.

"I work hard, and God blessed me with a lot of talent," Brown said. "I love competition."

Although Brown's verbal commitment was the biggest story of the night, more than 200 recruits tried to make a name for themselves in The Swamp in front of UF coaches and players.

"There were a lot of great athletes out here," said UF 2010 oral

commit Trey Burton. "I think (Friday) was a really good night for recruiting."

Burton didn't participate in any drills with the other players, but he stuck to his role as unofficial recruiter, a job he has played to perfection in helping piece together UF's 2010 recruiting class.

Burton, a quarterback out of Venice High, met Brown at Friday Night Lights last year, when Meyer expressed an interest in pursuing the running back. Burton and Brown became friends quickly, and the two frequently send text messages to each other.

"When Tebow was a senior in high school, that's what he did — he went and got Percy," Burton said. "So it comes with the position. Whether you like it or not, you still have to do it. I think doing this will definitely help us win, and I'm the worst loser ever."

With UF's offense likely to undergo many changes once Tim

Tebow graduates and Brantley takes over at quarterback, Burton thinks he and Brown will work well together in the new scheme.

"He can do everything. He can line up in the I — he's just an all-around running back," Burton said. "I think we're going to have an awesome option game when he gets up here with me and I running it."

As Ben Hill Griffin Stadium's impressive new video boards showed highlight reels of UF's 2008 season — a running scoreboard of every game on one side and the final boxscore of last season's UF-FSU game on the other — Burton added that he was ready to get out on the field and play.

But Meyer knew his combo recruit/recruiter could be put to better use, so he told him to work on convincing some players to orally commit to UF rather than participate in passing drills. His efforts paid off with Brown, who

Burton shadowed for much of the night.

Already determined to become a Gator and play for Meyer, Burton said he was aware of the rumors that his possible future coach might leave for Notre Dame.

"I knew he wasn't going anywhere," Burton said. "As soon as that came out, I got an e-mail (from Meyer) saying he wasn't going anywhere, so I wasn't worried about that."

## QB discusses fighting complacency

At times, the interview session bordered on a sermon, with Tebow seeming to dispatch advice to those in the room about how to avoid complacency.

"So many times in every aspect of life, people are worried about getting by," Tebow said. "You're worried about, 'I can't wait to get done with this so I have my free time. I can't wait to get this interview done with Tim Tebow so I can get it over with, instead of worrying about how it can be the best it can be.' In so many different ways, that's people's mindset."

Tebow also discussed the positives and negatives of his fame, including the never-ending media and fan attention that he says makes it difficult to do simple things like eat at a restaurant in peace.

"But also you think about it, because of that, because of the articles that y'all have

written and because of the articles that people continue to write, it's not only backlash from it, but there's also a lot of positive," he said.

loss and sparking the now-famous postgame speech from Tebow. Long before that, UF coach Urban Meyer recruited Snead to come play quarterback for the Gators even though he was in the same class as Tebow. In "Meat Market," a book about football recruiting by ESPN's Bruce Feldman, Snead said that Meyer told him Tebow was going to play linebacker and that Snead would be able to come in and play quarterback. Snead was understandably skeptical and de-committed from UF after Tebow committed.

**2. SEC VS. BIG 12 DEBATE**—The Big 12 has been gaining ground on the Southeastern Conference for league supremacy in recent years, and some experts feel as though there is a new power. Snead is able to offer an interesting perspective,

as he played in both conferences and went on record in Hoover as saying he believes the SEC is the best conference in college football, in part due to the better defenses. Also, Snead led Ole Miss to a 47-34 victory over Texas Tech in the Cotton Bowl last season in one of two bowl victories for the SEC against the Big 12.

**1. THE HEISMAN TROPHY**—Perhaps no storyline is more enduring throughout the season than the Heisman Trophy race. Snead is getting most of the preseason love as the fourth contestant for this year's award, behind the three-headed monster of Sam Bradford, McCoy and Tebow. Snead said he landed at Ole Miss because he didn't feel UF or Texas had a place for him. If Snead makes it to New York as a Heisman finalist, he will be sharing the stage and the evening with the two guys who chased him out of town.

# Top 10 Burning Questions for 2009-10

## How will the softball team respond to departures?

The UF softball team reached new heights during the last two seasons. Behind the arm of pitcher Stacey Nelson, the Gators went a combined 133-10 in 2008 and 2009, reaching the Women's College World Series both years.

But Nelson has thrown her last pitch as a Gator. Kim Waleszonia, UF's all-time hits leader, won't be back on the field in 2010. Same goes for Ali Gardiner, Kristina Hilberth and the rest of the 2009 senior class.

That presents the question: How will the softball team respond this season after losing such a talented group of seniors, especially Nelson?

Fortunately for UF coach Tim Walton, the heart of his lineup will return in 2010. Rising senior Francesca Enea will likely enter the season as one of the nation's top-rated hitters, and she will be joined by Kelsey Bruder, Megan Bush and Corrie Brooks. Those four combined for 61 home runs and 237 RBI in 2009.

Add a healthy Tiffany DeFelice,

who was hampered by a wrist injury during her sophomore year after an outstanding freshman year, and the Gators likely won't face many problems they can't hit their way out of.

In addition to the returning power hitters, rising junior Aja Paculba made a smooth transition to the leadoff spot, where Waleszonia batted her first three years at UF. Paculba is one of the Gators' most versatile hitters, and her skill on the basepaths will only improve.

Despite the talented veteran core, Walton was forced by injuries to develop some of his younger players. Rising sophomores Alicia Sisco and Michelle Moultrie saw time in the outfield and at the plate last season, and they will likely find their roles significantly increased in 2010.

Although the majority of the lineup is returning and the new players gained experience in 2009, the team will be reliant upon rising junior Stephanie Brombacher in the circle this season. She was statistically one of the nation's best pitchers as a backup last year. Brombacher pushed her undefeated career record to 42-0 with 22 wins last season. She put up a 0.84 ERA and struck out 190 batters in 158.2 innings pitched.

But she will be the unquestioned No. 1 in 2010, and that could poten-
