# Robbery takes place in Norman tunnel

A 19-year-old man was beaten and robbed in the tunnel under Southwest 13th Street connecting Norman Hall and the Yulee area early Monday.

The victim recalls that three white men were also in the tunnel at the time he was hit in the back of his head about 3 a.m., accord-

ing to a University Police Department press release.

The investigation is ongoing as of Monday, UPD Lt. Alton McDilda said, and the police will be increasing patrols in the Norman and Yulee areas.

The victim, who is not a student, called police about 8 a.m., McDilda said.

"He came to us five hours [after the crime]," McDilda said. "He did not show any

signs of inebriation or anything like that."

The victim may have become unconscious when the crime happened, he said.

"He didn't complain of any injuries other than he got hit in the back of the head," McDilda said. "There weren't any visible wounds."

The University Police Department sent emergency text message and e-mail notifica-

tions Monday morning to UF students, faculty and staff.

"The possessions we're not releasing at this time," McDilda said. "The estimates, I couldn't ballpark it right now to tell you the truth."

The robber or robbers may face charges of strong-arm robbery, a felony. Anyone who knows anything about the incident should contact the UPD office at 352-392-1111.

# Tombstones pay tribute to soldiers

■ VOLUNTEERS POSTED 5,473 TOMBSTONES.

Cardboard tombstones, embroidered cloths and anti-war signs decorated Northwest Eighth Avenue on Memorial Day as Gainesville's chapter of Veterans for Peace honored the lives of service men and women who have died in Afghanistan and Iraq since 2001.

A display of 5,473 cardboard tombstones, one for every soldier killed in the wars, lined both sides of Northwest Eighth Avenue on Monday. Visitors and volunteers placed flags on the tombstones of soldiers they knew personally. This year, members of Veterans for Peace, a national organization that opposes war as a legitimate means of conflict resolu-

tion, and volunteers from their sister group, CodePink, had to plant some tombstones alongside the north side of the road because there was no more room on the south side.

Scott Camil, who is the coordinator for the Gainesville chapter, said this was the fourth year that the group has set up the memorial and doesn't know what they'll do if they run out of space in the future.

"You'd think it wouldn't come to that," he said, "that we would realize before then that this [war] is not working."

Camil said the group received mostly support from passers-by, but he was upset after he learned that about 100 tombstones had been dug out early Sunday morning and were thrown into the woods.

Volunteers did not see those

# UF's ultimate Frisbee takes national championship

## The team beat Minnesota's Carleton College 15-12

Squishy the Gerbil might be UF's least-known mascot.

This is probably because Florida Ultimate's A-Team just bought him on Friday as

it began the USA Ultimate College Championships series in Madison, Wis.

Squishy brought good luck, as Florida defeated Carleton College 15-12 in the tournament finals Monday afternoon, giving the team the national championship.

Florida won six of seven games over the

weekend, culminating in the victory over Carleton College.

"We never were really tested by any other team," said senior team member and captain Chris Gibson. "They are kind of our rivals, and we didn't even get to play until this match."

The Florida Ultimate stayed calm throughout the game, even facing a team whose school "put[s] a Frisbee in every student's preview bag," he said.

Florida was seeded No. 4 with a 15-game win streak going into the tournament; before the weekend, they were 32-5.

The team was led, in part, by fifth-year

## Wisconsin man accused of taping young children on Florida nude beach

EVANSVILLE, Wis. (AP) — A Wisconsin man is accused of secretly videotaping young children at a Florida nude beach.

Sheriff's officials released a statement Monday saying the man is scheduled to make an initial court appearance Tuesday in Rock County.

Florida authorities say the 42-year-old had been seen recording the children Friday. Wisconsin detectives got a search warrant that same day and searched his Evans-

ville home.

They allegedly found child pornography and multiple camera systems. They arrested the man Sunday night on 62 tentative charges of possession of child pornography.

Evansville is about 25 miles south of Madison.

The statement didn't say where in Florida the beach was. A telephone message left with the sheriff was not immediately returned.



# State-funding cut hits Shands hard

The \$9.7-million cut in state funding for Shands at UF, which was approved by Gov. Charlie Crist on Friday, will likely adversely affect Florida's under- and uninsured patients, according to a Shands press release.

"Elimination of this critical revenue source for Shands at UF was totally unexpected," said Shands HealthCare CEO Tim Goldfarb in the release. "It is vital to supporting our responsibility to care for Florida's most vulnerable and neediest residents."

Shands at UF will likely lose

an additional \$12 million in federal funding through the Medicaid match program, according to the release.

A safety-net hospital provides care to low-income, uninsured or vulnerable populations, according to the National Association of Public Hospitals and Health Systems' website.

As one of 14 safety-net hospitals in the state, Shands "is among the largest Medicaid and charity care providers in Florida and we have a strong sense of commitment to serve those with little or no insurance," Goldfarb said.

# Storms' impact on oil unknown

VENICE, La. — As hurricane season begins, the oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico takes weather experts into uncharted waters.

The Gulf is a superhighway for hurricanes that form or explode over pools of hot water, then usually move north or west toward the coast. The site of the sunken rig is along the general path of some of the worst storms ever recorded, including Hurricane Camille, which wiped out the Mississippi coast in 1969, and Hurricane Katrina in 2005.

The season officially starts today, and while scientists seem to agree that the sprawling slick isn't likely to affect the formation of a storm, the real worry is that a hurricane might turn the millions of gallons of floating crude into a crashing black surf.

Some fear a combination of damaging winds and large waves pushing oil deeper into estuaries and wetlands and coating miles of coast in a sticky mess.

And the worst effects of an oil-soaked storm surge might not be felt for years: If oil is pushed deep into coastal marshes that act as a natural speed bump for storm surges, areas including New Orleans could be more vulnerable to bad storms for a long time. Experts say there are few, if any, studies on the scenario.

In this "untreated water ... it's tough to theorize about what would happen," said Joe Bastardi, chief long-range hurricane forecaster with AccuWeather.com.

The lone precedent, experts agree, is the summer of 1979, when storms hampered efforts to contain a spill from a Mexican rig called Ixtoc 1 that eventually dumped 140 million gallons off the Yucatan Peninsula. Hurricane Henri, a Category 1 storm, damaged a 310-ton steel cap de-

signed to stop the leak that would become the worst peacetime spill. While oil from that spill coated beaches in Texas and Mexico, tropical storms and unseasonable cold fronts that year helped reverse offshore currents earlier than normal and drive oil away from the coast. Storms also helped disperse oil, Bastardi said.

"That's what I think would happen this time," he said. "I'm sure a hurricane would do a great deal of diluting the oil, spreading it out where the concentrations would be much less damaging."

At least 19 million gallons, according to the latest estimates, have leaked from the seabottom 5,000 feet below the surface since April 20. Bastardi said the storms themselves remain the chief threat.

"If a Category 3 hurricane is headed to the Texas Gulf Coast — and this is simply theoretical — I wouldn't be worried as much about damage from the oil, as the damage from the hurricane," Bastardi said.

# UF students build solar house for competition

UF students built a house, tore it down and are now building it again.

A team of 31 UF students constructed the solar-powered house to compete with 19 universities from around the world in the Solar Decathlon Europe competition in Spain.

The project was led by the Rinker School of Building Construction and the College of Journalism and Communications.

Eleven students are in Spain reconstructing the house for the competition, which will be held from June 18 to June 27 in Madrid. The other 20 students will arrive later this week to finish the details of the house, said Paige Mainor, a team member.

The 800-square-foot house was built at the UF Solar Energy Park in Gainesville with help of more than 125 UF students from four colleges, said Kathryn Watson, a communications director for the project.

In April, the house was dismantled and shipped in five containers to Madrid, where some of the students began reconstruction, said Maruja Torres-Antonini, the project's co-principal investigator.

During the competition, contestants will be judged in 10 categories, ranging from architectural quality to comfort levels. There is no monetary prize, but winners will receive "eternal glory," along with honor and positive attention for their school, Watson said.

The construction of the house built in Gainesville cost less than \$500,000, Torres-Antonini said. Student Government also donated \$7,200 in April to the group so more students could make the trip, according to Alligator archives.

After the competition, the house will be disassembled and shipped back to Gainesville. It will then become a permanent display at the Florida Museum of Natural History.

# Gainesville biomass plant approved

## ■ CONSTRUCTION ON THE PLANT WILL BEGIN IN DECEMBER.

The Florida Public Service Commission approved a plan on Thursday to build a 100-megawatt biomass plant at the Gainesville Regional Utilities facility in Deerhaven.

The plant is a joint-effort between GRU and American Renewables, an energy plant developing company.

"The PSC has taken an important step to-

day toward significantly expanding Florida's commitment to renewable energy," said Jim Gordon, American Renewables chief executive officer, in a press release. "The Gainesville Renewable Energy Center will bring reliable, cost-effective renewable energy to GRU customers and spur significant economic development in North Central Florida."

GRU and American Renewables are entering into a 30-year energy contract under which American Renewables will build, own and operate the facility, according to the release.

GRU will buy and use 100 percent of the

plant's energy output, which will be generated by burning local leftovers from logging residue and wood processing plants.

The biomass plant will help keep GRU's facilities updated, as well as protect customers from rising fuel costs while providing long-term savings, said GRU General Manager Bob Hunzinger in the release. At first, customers may see a small increase in their bills, although it is expected that biomass energy will soon become less expensive than fossil-fuel alternatives, the release stated.

Construction is set to begin in December, although customers will not be directly influenced until late 2013, the release stated.

senior and captain Brodie Smith, who was the runner-up this year for the Callahan Award, which goes to the most valuable player in the nation.

"That award didn't really matter to me," Smith said.

Sophomore Alan Baird, one of the team's three underclassmen at nationals, agreed.

"We didn't want it to affect us this year, whether he wanted it or not," Baird said.

The team is kind of like a miniature sports fraternity, said senior Cole Sullivan.

During the school year, five of the teammates live together in a house dubbed "The Glory Hole." During the weeks between the end of spring semester and the tournament in Madison, more of the team piled in.

"We just lined up," Gibson said. "We stacked extra mattresses next to mine in the living room. All we did was play Frisbee and live at the Glory Hole," said Gibson.

Whether it was the gerbil, the gaming, the cozy sleeping quarters or just the frequent practices, something was working for the team.

"It was the best three weeks you can possibly have when you are sleeping on the floor, when you are sharing it with three people and [there's] no air conditioning," Baird said.

Despite setbacks such as losing seniors like Smith, as well as coach Jonathan Windham, who moved away from Gainesville in April, the players are optimistic for next year.

Unlike Baird and Sullivan, Squishy the Gerbil is probably not looking forward to next year's season. The same day that team members bought him, they put him in a plastic gerbil ball and took him along while they played a game of disc golf.

"We put the ball inside this bush, so he could stay there until we were done with our playing," Gibson said. When the team returned from the game, the top of the ball was off and Squishy was gone. Gibson listed three possibilities: an animal got to Squishy, another person liberated him, or he "was really athletic and opened it himself."

Next year, with or without an escape-prone rodent for a mascot, the team expects further success.

"We're a program," Baird said, "not a team. We're a dynasty."

who removed the tombstones, he said.

Veterans for Peace member Denny Bellesheim, who served two years in North Korea from 1966 to 1968, said he worries about what kind of world his grandchildren will inherit.

The memorial also displayed the Peace Ribbon, a banner of more than 50 handmade cloth panels em-

## Crist vetoes \$9.7 million for Shands funding

Things just got a little more difficult for the under-insured and uninsured.

Gov. Charlie Crist pushed through the \$70.2 billion state budget on Friday after cutting out \$371 million in projects and spending, including \$9.7 million in funding for Shands at UF. The money was cut from programs that would help the hospital care for patients who cannot afford treatment.

The cut is going to directly affect the people who need the funding the most. People who cannot afford medical care are not going to magically find a way to come up with another \$9.7 million.

These cuts are going to force some tough decisions to be made by the Shands higher-ups. They may have to restrict the number of people who can get care or where people must live in order to be eligible for free or reduced-cost care.

This is a position no doctor wants to be in. They are committed to helping everyone possible remain healthy and live a full life, but this cut in funding makes that an impossibility.

Shands is the leading teaching hospital in the state, and everyone should have the opportunity to take advantage of the services offered if they need.

The newly independent Charlie Crist should be ashamed of himself. If he was not already facing some dire straits politically we would have to advocate against him in his upcoming race for the U.S. Senate.

Students only have one more month to smoke on campus before it is officially banned. Let the countdown begin.



## Facebook should not share user info

Like most college students, I am quite tied to my Facebook account and have put much of my life on the ever-growing social network. # Gators send 16 to NCAA Outdoor Championships

■ NCAA OUTDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS  
BEGIN JUNE 9 IN EUGENE, ORE.

While Willy Wonka's Golden Tickets may have been hard to come by, the Gators track and field teams collected their tickets to the NCAA Outdoor Championships as easy as stealing candy from a baby.

The Gators enjoyed a successful weekend in Greensboro, N.C., at the NCAA Preliminary Round, advancing 16 athletes and qualifying for 21 spots.

The Gators will head to Eugene, Ore., with a strong contingent on a mission to bring more championships back to Gainesville.

"We talked before we got here about doing our job at this meet and getting as many of our scorers through to the NCAA meet as possible," UF coach Mike Holloway said. "I thought we did a great job this

weekend."

The NCAA Outdoor Championships take place June 9-12 and all of the Gators' top athletes will have a chance to win a title.

The No. 1 ranked men's team had nine Gators qualify for seven events.

Christian Taylor, the Southeastern Conference Field Athlete of the Year, continued his field dominance and advanced in both the long jump and triple jump. Team-mate Omar Craddock also qualified in the triple jump.

Four of the fastest men's sprinters in the country – Jeff Demps, Terrell Wilks, Calvin Smith and Tony McQuay – all advanced to Eugene.

Demps advanced in the 100-meter dash, Wilks qualified for both the 100- and 200-meter dash while Smith and McQuay will each represent Florida in the 400-meter dash.

Both of Florida's top-ranked relay teams also advanced to the championships.

"A lot of times when you come in as the favorite, or you are expected to do certain things, you have a tendency to get complacent," Holloway said. "I thought everybody did a wonderful job and that was a byproduct of our focus."

The defending NCAA Champion 4x100-meter relay team, anchored by Demps, notched the top qualifying time with a season-best time of 38.81. The 4x400-meter relay team, which entered the meet with the fastest time in the world so far this season, also clinched a spot in the finals.

The men's team also saw its leading shot putter, Kemal Mesic, and decathlete Gray Horn qualify for the finals.

The one surprise on the men's side was freshman Josh Izewski, who entered the East Preliminaries as the 48th and final qualifier, but he placed 12th in the men's 10,000-meter run to claim the final spot that advanced to Eugene.

The No. 6 ranked women's team also

had an excellent meet.

It had seven athletes qualify for six events.


Shot putters Mariam Kevkhishvili, Kee-ly Medeiros and Fidela James all punched their tickets to Eugene.

Charlotte Browning, the top women's 1,500-meter runner in the SEC, advanced to Eugene while Julie Northrup, the second-fastest women's steeplechase athlete in school history, also qualified for the finals.

The East Preliminaries top women's javelin thrower, Evelien Dekkers, advanced to the championships by placing first in her event.

The SEC's top women's field athlete Shara Proctor matched her Gators men's counterpart, Taylor, also advancing to Eugene in the long jump and triple jump.

"The things we want to do in two weeks started Thursday," Holloway said. "If we hadn't done our jobs this weekend, we wouldn't be able to score points in two weeks."

## Gators sweep Arizona State to advance to WCWS

■ UF WILL TAKE ON UCLA THURSDAY AT 3:30 P.M.

It appears that juniors Kelsey Bruder and Stephanie Brombacher have developed a formula for winning in the NCAA Tournament.

For the fourth time in the last five games, Bruder got the first RBIs and Brombacher made them count as No. 4 Florida (48-8) defeated No. 13 Arizona State (44-17) 5-2 on Sunday to advance to its third consecutive Women's College World Series.

"To get to the (WCWS) once is a really good team, to get there again is a little better team, and to make it a third time you start to build a program," coach Tim Walton said. "I think we've established that we have a good foundation here and we've got a great program."

Bruder once again propelled the Gators' offense, this time putting UF on the board with a two-run home run in the third before adding a solo shot in the fifth to stretch the lead to four.

The right fielder is now 10 for 15 with four home runs and 10 RBIs in the team's five NCAA Tournament games this season.

"I can't say I'm doing anything different than I have been all season," Bruder said. "It's just clicking for me right now."

Bruder's run production has been immensely helpful to the team due not only to its magnitude, but also its timeliness.

Six of Bruder's 10 RBIs have represented the first runs of a game, as she has been responsible for opening the scoring with an extra-base hit four times in the last five matchups.

"I've said this time and time again it's easier to pitch when you have a lead," Bruder said. "If we can jump on them early it just makes Stephanie (Brombacher)'s job easier."

Whether it's due to pitching from ahead or being in a groove, Brombacher has been making it look easy the last two weeks.

Florida's ace surrendered just a single earned run in Sunday's

## UF to host NCAA Regional

Despite not winning their conference tournament, the Gators received some good news Monday.

No. 4 Florida (42-15) received the No. 3 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament and will host Florida Atlantic (35-22), Oregon State (31-22) and Bethune-Cookman (35-20) in the Gainesville Regional this weekend.

"We kind of figured we would be one of the eight (seeds), and I think that was our goal in the beginning of the season so we can host regionals and super regionals," coach Kevin O'Sullivan said.

UF will begin play Friday at 7 p.m. against Bethune-Cookman in McKethan Stadium.

The Gators hope they fare a little better in the regional than they did in the Southeastern Conference Tournament, in which they were eliminated by Alabama (37-21) Saturday.

Despite conference officials' decision to

shorten each of the day's games to seven innings because of weather and time logistics concerns, it felt like the game still wasn't short enough for UF, which likely had a national seed locked up before the tourney.

The Gators, which had been on the road for 11 days, fell 5-2 to crowd-favorite Alabama

in the shortened game, eliminating them from the double-elimination tournament.

Alabama pitcher Adam Morgan thrived off UF's inpatient approach at the plate. He benefited from six first-pitch outs and 12 fly

ball outs.

After giving up six runs in his first appearance against Florida on May 7, the left-hander lasted the full seven innings Saturday and only allowed two runs.

"He pitched up and down in the zone

and mixed his pitches well," senior Matt den Dekker said. "We didn't adjust and hit a lot of fly ball outs and gave him too many easy outs."

But UF pitcher Tommy Toledo didn't help his own cause against the Crimson Tide.

The redshirt sophomore threw a pickoff attempt over first baseman Preston Tucker's head in the first, allowing Alabama's Josh Rutledge to advance from first to third. The shortstop later scored an unearned run off a sacrifice fly to give his team the early 1-0 lead.

Toledo, who made just his fourth appearance Saturday since returning from injury, continued to struggle from there until he was pulled in the fourth after pitching UF into a 5-0 deficit. He conceded five runs and allowed eight base runners in 3.2 innings of work.

"I don't think he got hit awfully hard," O'Sullivan said. "There were a couple of things that occurred during the game that happened because he hasn't been out there in a while, but I'm encouraged with the way he threw the ball."

The five-run deficit was too much for Florida to overcome, despite an encouraging per-

formance from the bullpen.

The most impressive outing came from reliever Nick Maronde who had given up six earned runs in his last 2.2 innings before Saturday, when he struck out the side in the fifth.

The Gators even made some light of the left-hander's control issues with a sarcastic applause from the dugout after Maronde threw seven straight strikes.

"We've been working awfully hard with (Maronde)," O'Sullivan. "He's very talented and it's not unusual that a good player goes through some tough times. That's a huge, huge positive for us going into next weekend."

The bullpen's performance kept the game within striking distance, but UF's offense could not figure out Morgan.
