For this stalt the board wants none but the best doetors who can be had. Constant eftort will be made to keep the standard so high that membership on thle statt will be conaldered a sig mal honor by the mont emlnent phyal

The plan is that members of the viaiting statt shall visit the hospltal from time to time to finspect conattions there, to examine pattents, make consgentions, and in various manresident phyalclans for the better ment of patients at the hospltal.
