SFWMD evaluating region

As part of its ongoing comprehensive land assessment, the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) is beginning an evaluation of agency lands in the West Coast Assessment Region, which includes parts of Lee, Collier, Hendry and Glades counties.

The West Coast region is the fourth of five geographic areas being reviewed in the assessment of approximately 750,000 acres of fee-owned lands — properties in which the District has full ownership rights. As part of a broader effort to maximize its resources to meet mission-critical responsibilities, the District is conducting

Inland Birding Fun: Black-and-White Warbler (BAWW)

Black-and-white Warblers are a migratory species that breed from April to June in the northern and eastern United States, Newfoundland and Canada. These birds do not normally breed in Florida. They have an extensive winter range that extends from Florida to Venezuela and Colombia. This species is one of the earliest warblers to arrive and leave their wintering grounds.

This small black and white striped warbler is easy to identify. The male has strongly contrasting black-and-white stripes on its head and under parts. It has black wings with two white wingbars, a white eye stripe, and white eyering. The legs, lores, ear patch, and throat are black. The underparts have bold black streaks. The adult female is striped on the crown and under parts with a moderate contrast between black and white. Its cheeks, chin and throat are dull white or gray. The under parts are mostly white, with gray streaks. Juveniles have plumage similar to the adult female. Black-and-white warblers have an unusually long hind toe and claw on each foot, which allows them to move up and down securely in any direction on tree bark.

Its song is a series of very high, two-syllable phrases, resembling the sound of a squeaky wheel, "wee-see-wee-see-wee-see". Their call is a sharp "stick" and their flight call a high hissing "fsss".

During the winter, they are found in a variety of habitats, but they breed in mature and mixed forests. The old name for this species was the "Black-and-white Creeper," because they creep along larger branches in search of insects which they pick out of crevices or under the bark with their long thin bill. They also glean from leaves. Their diet consists of caterpillars, adult insects and spiders. For a warbler, they are unusually aggressive and will sometimes attack other bird species.

Black-and-white Warblers build their nests on the ground at the base of a tree or stump. This nest is an open cup of dry leaves, grass, bark, and pine needles. It is lined with fine grasses, horsehair, down, or moss.

The female lays four to six white eggs, which are speckled with brown and light purple. She incubates the eggs until they hatch in 10 to 12

days. Both adults feed the young. The young birds leave the nest in eight to 12 days. They are unable to fly, but use their wings to scurry across the ground.

Religion Column

Family And Roots; Personally, Nationally, Spiritually

The countryside was dotted with old farmhouses in the region where I began my first ministry. Often in the corners of the grounds, you could see a single-wide or double-wide mobile home, equipped with a swing-set, a wading pool, or a slide in the nearby yard. Other buildings also dotted the property: sheds, a barn, a shop. Directions were usually given in terms of local landmarks: turn left when you see the mailbox with the flowers painted on it, where the asphalt road becomes gravel and you can see the yellow house in the distance.

People had practical solutions to their lives: fix it if it's broken, save discarded things because they may be useful in the future, buy a big pump for the well, not just the smallest one to do the job. On my first trip to Europe, I looked up my family name in the local phone book and called around. Most people were polite but not interested in meeting me. One young man spoke of hearing from his grandfather about an uncle, who went to the U.S. The young man was going

to visit his grandfather that weekend and asked if I would like to go? Of course!

A few days later, I wound up in the countryside, where a box of old letters tied with string were taken from a dusty closet. No, this was not the grandfather of my family, but we must be related somehow. It was from this farmhouse in the countryside—with knob-and-tube electrical wiring, where cooking was done on a woodstove, where the screen door was falling off its hinges, where chickens clucked and crowded in the yard, where unquestioned hospitality was shown toward me, a stranger—it is at this farmhouse, where I began to feel, "I am a part of this," where I understood better, the farmhouses and extended families back home.

There stood the silent powerful witness: This is who you are, this is what you came out of, these are your roots, these are the things at the heart of your life. It is no wonder the Bible is full of genealogies; they are the witnesses to, "This is who we are, this is from where we have come." Each name, each generation, tells a story and contributes to the foundation of the whole family that has built the faith on which we stand. Matthew's gospel opens with an account of the lineage of Jesus: the patriarchs, the Old Testament names, the characters for better and for worse, that have all contributed to saying, "Jesus is the one who was to come."

Mark, beginning with John the Baptist, prepared the way with prophesies and the proclamation that He is the one to fulfill it all. Luke began with what is foretold and how it all comes to pass as God has intended from the beginning in Zechariah's song. John's gospel began with the very origins of creation and said it was destined that the Word would become flesh and John would be the last to tell of His coming.

Our Biblical and spiritual heritage tells us collectively "This is who we are as God's people" and getting to know the family is finding ourselves at the same time. The roots of our faith are the roots of our own identities and who God intends for us to be.

Recently, the tragedy at the Boston Marathon brought out a resurgence of "We are a strong people, we will recover, we will not be defeated, this is who we are!" These prideful and patriotic emotions are truly heartwarming to see. It

is from the forging of one people, through generations of lives together, through our national genealogies and common visions, and our sharing and remembering, that give us unshakeable roots and endless hope. I pray that we may be faithful in our generation and give these same qualities to those who will follow us. "We are the people of His pasture and the Sheep of His hand, Oh that today you would hearken to His voice (Psalm 95).






The Youth Tour students have the opportunity to explore the beauty and history of our nation's capitol, stand upon some of



the assessment to ensure that each parcel owned by the agency is being put to its most effective use.

To gather all relevant information for a thorough analysis, the District is seeking public feedback on the use of its lands within the West Coast region. Stakeholders and the general public can examine detailed land portfolios and submit comments on specific properties through May 28 at www.sfwmd.gov/landassessment. In addition, a regional public workshop will be held at the SFWMD Lower West Coast Service Center in Fort Myers on May 22.

At the same time that the public comment period is opening for the West Coast region, the assessment of three other regions is progressing.

For the Kissimmee/Okeechobee region,

SFWMD is developing staff recommendations for lands for the region, which includes the Upper and Lower Kissimmee basins and the Lake Okeechobee watershed. Recommendations will be based on nearly 200 public comments, feedback received during a pair of March public workshops, input from SFWMD subject matter experts and a variety of land-related data. All submitted comments are available for review on the land assessment website.

In the staff recommendations for each region in the land assessment, current uses of District lands will remain in place for parcels that are determined to contribute fully to the agency's core mission of balancing and improving flood control, water quality, natural systems and water supply.

To submit public comments either on lands in the West Coast Assessment Region or draft staff recommendations in the Upper Lakes Assessment Region, visit www.sfwmd.gov/landassessment.



Except for those who have already successfully completed the online portion of the course, attendance on both days is required for certification. Students who have completed the online course only need to attend the second day. They will need to bring the final Web report, which does not have to be notarized.

Students will learn about hunting laws, safe gun handling and hunter ethics/responsibility, among other topics, before taking the final test. The course also includes live-firing instruction on a shooting range.

The class will be held at the Everglades Youth Camp, J.W. Corbett Wildlife Management Area, 12100 Seminole Pratt Whitney Road, West Palm Beach, FL 33412. (GPS will not work for this location.)

Participants can sign up at MyFWC.com/HunterSafety or by calling the FWC's South Region Office at 561-625-5122. A link to the online part of the course and a statewide schedule of hunter safety classes are available at MyFWC.com/HunterSafety.

Anyone born on or after June 1, 1975, must pass an approved hunter safety course before purchasing a Florida hunting license. Parents or legal guardians must accompany children under

16 years of age to all classes. To participate in live-fire exercises, children under 18 years old must present a parental release form signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Moore Haven man convicted of murder

Ocala—Jolgar Desir, 26, of Moore Haven, was convicted April 28 of murder in connection with the death of Robert "Tony" Jamerson in Marion County.

Jamerson, 43, was shot at his home in Orange Lake on Aug. 1, 2009. His younger brother, Terrence was also shot, but survived.

According to testimony given at the trial, authorities believe Desir was one of two other men who went to the home looking for narcotics. The second man believed to have been involved in the shootings has not been caught, according to reports.

Desir was also charged with attempted murder, home invasion robbery with a fire-

arm and kidnapping with a firearm in connection with the case.

Prosecutors indicated they would not seek the death penalty.

Sentencing has been set for Friday, May 3, at 7:30 a.m. in front of Circuit Judge Sandra Edwards-Stephens.

Rancher honored by Audubon Society

Everglades Foundation board member Nathaniel Reed implored the audience to take decisive steps to protect our lake's health. Audubon Florida's Executive Director Eric Draper, Hendry Glades Audubon President Margaret England, Ernie Barnett from the SFWMD, Col. Dodd of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and Okeechobee County Commissioner Bryant Culpepper all

spoke to the importance of Lake Okeechobee for the region and for the communities surrounding the big lake.
