## WCSO seeks info on mower theft

**CHIPLEY** — The Washington County Sheriff's Office is requesting help from residents to help identify a suspect wanted in connection with a break-in resulting in theft between 4 and 5 a.m. Aug. 25 at Lane's Outdoor Equipment.

According to the sheriff's office report, the suspect was caught on camera cutting the lock off the gate and loading an orange and gray 16-horsepower B&S Intex 42-inch zero-turn Husqvarna lawn mower onto a metal framed trailer.

The suspect is described as a white male, 5-foot-8 to 6 feet in height, weighing between 200 and 230 pounds, with a goatee, wearing a white long-sleeved shirt and jeans and headed southbound on Highway 277/Judge Perry Wells Highway.

WCSO is offering up to a \$1,000 reward for information leading to the suspect. If anyone has any information regarding the identity of the suspect or information regarding the theft at Lane's Outdoor Equipment, contact WCSO at 638-TIPS (8477).

Think you recognize that voice at the other end of the line? Well, it might not be who you think it is. That's what a couple of Washington County residents recently learned when they received calls from a young person claiming to be their grandchild.

The first one went like this:

Young male caller: "Grandpa, this is your oldest grandson."

Mr. Jones: "Edward?"

Young male caller: "Yes, grandpa, I need some Help."

The call went on from there to ask for \$3,000.

The second call went like this:

Young female caller: "Grandma, do you know who this is?"

Mrs. Williams: "Elizabeth?"

Caller: "Yes, grandma. I've been in a car accident in Vancouver and need \$3,200 so I can repair my

car and return home." Thankfully no money was lost. However, the caller was able to easily obtain the victims' grandchildren's names and engage them in conversation. Both seniors were lucky; they were unable to send any money.

"This is the perfect opportunity to thank everyone who is helping the Washington County Sheriff's Office warn people about the frauds and scams out there by holding seminars and posting fraud alerts on their bulletin boards, websites and in their newsletters," said Washington County Sheriff Bobby Haddock. ### CHANGE IN FEES AT WEEKI WACHEE

Just in time for the extended holiday weekend, the Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) Florida Park Service will no longer charge a separate fee for entrance into

Buccaneer Bay Water Park at Weeki Wachee Springs State Park.

The change in fees will be made effective Friday, Sept. 2, and continue indefinitely.

"We are excited to announce this change, which will increase the availability of recreational opportunities for visitors to Weeki Wachee Springs State Park," said Florida Park Service Director Donald Forgiore. "Eliminating the water park fee enhances the affordability of the entire park for Florida's citizens and visitors."

Entrance into all of Weeki Wachee Springs State Park is now only \$13 per person for adults, \$8 for children ages 6-12 and free for children under 6. Family Annual Entrance Pass holders

will continue to receive free entrance for two adults into the park. The spring's area of the park

will remain open year-round, with no additional fee; however, Buccaneer Bay's water slides will be closed for use during regular off-season dates. The water slides will remain available Saturdays and Sundays through the end of September and reopen in March.

Florida's most recent addition to the Florida state park system, Weeki Wachee Springs, was acquired by the state in November 2008. The attraction,

established in 1946, turned the spring into an underwater mermaid show, which garnered increased attention and fame into the 1960s. As one of Florida's 33 first-magnitude springs, Weeki Wachee is a valuable natural and cultural resource.

AAF is headquartered in Washington, D.C., and is the oldest national advertising trade association, representing 40,000 professionals in the advertising industry. It has a national network of 200 local/regional clubs across the U.S. and, through its 226 college chapters, provides about 6,000 advertising students with real-world experiences and recruitment connections to corporate America. In addition, there are more than 100 corporate members representing the nation's leading brands and businesses.

At the Emerald Coast Chapter level, the primary missions are education and providing a networking platform to bring advertising firms into contact with existing and potential clients. This is important at the local level, where advertising agencies tend to be small and specialized, so that collaboration is possible to take on larger projects and keep the work within the local market.
