# Council OKs 'Flea Across Florida'

**CHIPLEY** — The City Council approved a request to close North and South Railroad Avenues for Flea Across Florida in September.

The annual event will be held the weekend of Sept. 14-16 and is called "Florida's Longest Yard Sale."

Chipley resident Bar-

bara James told the council the event would be open to individuals or groups as well as businesses, and spaces could be rented along the route to set up booths.

"It is a flea market that goes from Live Oak to Pensacola," she said. "Churches, school clubs, individuals — anyone can come out and set up a booth to take part in the event," she said.

The event is being spon-

sored locally by the Merchants of Historic Chipley, and will be held from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday Sept. 15.

Vendor fee is \$35 and electricity is available for \$10, according to the website, [fleaacrossflorida.com](http://fleaacrossflorida.com). The event is a family friendly event and no objectionable messages or symbols on clothing items or signage, explicit objects or paraphernalia may be dis-

played or offered for sale during this event.

The council approved the appointment of Curtis Carter to a four-year term as Chipley Housing Authority Resident Commissioner. His term is retroactive to May 8 and will expire on April 13, 2016.

The council also approved a resolution allowing the application for pedestrian sidewalk grants along U.S. Highway 77

from Brickyard Road to Walmart. The grants are being sought as part of the Department of Transportation Safety Funding program.

Dorothy Harper of Chipley also addressed the council and said that Police Chief Kevin Crews and City Administrator Dan Miner had not contacted her to discuss her allegations that

## Representative visits with local supporters

**CHIPLEY** — State Rep. Marti Coley, R-Marianna, was in Chipley Tuesday visiting supporters during a fundraising breakfast at the Washington County Agricultural Center.

Coley is seeking re-election to the 7th District seat she has held since 2005. Due to redistricting, she will be representing Washington and Holmes Counties, if she gets re-elected in November.

The 5th and 7th Districts have been combined, and Rep. Brad Drake, R-Eucheeana, said by way of introduction, that he decided to step aside so Coley could continue representing the region. "Marti and I are friends," Drake said, "and I want our district to have the most effective representation."

Drake thanked the audience for sup-

porting him during his time in Tallahassee. "Washington County has been very good to me, and I want to thank you all for supporting me and allowing me to serve you as your representative."

In southern Florida where districts were combined, there was often fighting, Drake said, but that wasn't going to happen in northwest Florida. "She is a good fit, and she has served for seven years as a representative," Drake said. "She is an awesome representative, friend and champion."

"What I lack in political experience, I make up for in hard work," Coley said. "I want rural Florida to have a strong voice in Tallahassee." It is hard to believe, but the opinions of rural Panhandle Florida can outweigh the designs of southern Florida, Coley said, citing the failed septic tank legislation as an example.

"I had to work very hard to fight that 'one

size fits all' mentality," Coley said. "I told Sen. Don Gaetz that if the septic tank legislation passed, I didn't think I would be able to go home. That is how strongly people up here felt about that bill."

Coley said her focus is on being responsible with the tax dollars. "The government has to live within its means," she said. "We have to look at it and say, 'this is how much we have. How can we best spend it to help the citizens of Florida?'"

Coley said for the next two years she will fight for a business-friendly climate in Florida. "I support business absolutely," she said. "It is good for the state. A strong economy means stronger schools. This past year we added an extra billion dollars to the education budget for state schools."

Agriculture must also remain a focus of

## Board hires new transportation director

**CHIPLEY** — The Washington County School Board had a full agenda Monday, which included hiring a new director of transportation, maintenance, facilities and operations and tabling for discussion some leave of absence requests.

Mike Park was approved by the board to fill the director's position, replacing James W. Lee, who was serving as the district's interim transportation director.

When Park was approved for the position, he thanked the board for the opportunity. "I will do my

best not to let you down," he said.

Park's name came up before his action item on the agenda when DeWayne Carter of the Vernon Athletic Boosters Club approached the board seeking help in repairing the sprinkler system at the VHS baseball fields. The original system was put in on a "shoestring budget," Carter said.

"I suggest Mike Park, our new facility director, go out and take a look at it," Board Member Vann Brock said.

Estimates on repairing the sprinkler system are about \$10,000, and Carter said the system would most likely need to be replaced entirely.

"We're not asking you for all of it, but we could use some help," Carter said. "The system now is just terrible."

The Booster Club will hold a fundraising golf tournament for Vernon Athletics at 11 a.m. on July 20 at Sunny Hills, and the club is still seeking teams to play in the event and hole sponsors.

The board also discussed requests for extended leaves of absence from four teachers. The district allows professional service contract employees to take up to one year's unpaid leave of absence for illness, personal reasons, maternity, military service or the Peace Corps, Dr. Sandra Cook said, and the board

has on occasion extended the leave of absence to up to two years.

Employees are not guaranteed their old job back, but they are given preference in hiring for positions for which they are eligible and qualified, said Pat Collins, director of administrative services.

"I'm not comfortable with the idea of employees taking a leave of absence so they can take a job somewhere else," said Board Member Terry Ellis. "Consistency is a problem, and we can't keep our staff in place with a revolving door."

"On behalf of the students, I think we need to have continuity in the classroom," he added.

"We have to do what is best for the children," said Board Member Sue Roberts. "They do need that continuity."

The board tabled the requests of Kerri Brown and Anne Chenault for further discussion, but approved the requests of Mallory Corbin and Amber Peel, with the understanding that they were maternity requests.

The board also scheduled the end of the fiscal year school board meetings, with the first being set for 5:05 p.m. on July 24 and the second for 5:05 p.m. July 30. The board will hold its final budget approval meeting at the regular September meeting set for 5 p.m. on Sept. 10.

## Chipola student wins \$20,000 scholarship

**DETROIT**— Chipola College graduate Adriane Guettler of Chipley has been awarded \$20,000 scholarship from the Buick Achievers Scholarship Program.

Guettler is a certified academic tutor and works in the Chipola Academic Center for Excellence (ACE). Bonnie Smith, Director of the ACE, says, "Adriane is a great student and a great person.

In addition to maintaining a perfect academic record, she has helped many students with their studies as a tutor in the ACE." Smith, who works closely with Chipola's top students, says Guettler's \$20,000 scholarship may be the largest ever awarded to a Chipola student.

Guettler's interests outside of school include designing, building, and finishing wooden furniture; gardening and riding dirt bikes.

## Enable positive change

Those who help others engage in bad habits are often called “enablers.” Whether directly helping someone commit criminal or irresponsible acts, turning a blind eye to recurring issues or putting up with destructive behavior, enablers become part of the problem.

But maybe the idea of enabling can be turned around.

In the same way that it's possible to enable someone's moral lapses, it's also possible to enable good actions. The term “enabling” is rarely used in a complimentary manner. Nonetheless, it might be time to think about it in a positive way.

If somebody is struggling with a problem, you can enable that person in a positive sense by providing support. Let's say that someone is battling addiction. If you

were to encourage that person to continue engaging in addictive behavior, you'd be an enabler in the negative sense. But what if you gave that same person hope and positive encouragement?

What if you could help people transform their lives? Well, you can. Every time you enable others to succeed, you're helping improve both their lives and yours.

I'm not saying that you should develop a self-righteous attitude and go around preaching at others. In fact, that's the absolute last thing this world needs. An overly critical attitude can actually drive people toward making bad choices. That's true for children as well as adults. Often, when a child exhibits bad behavior, you don't have to look very far to find a critical, negative, nagging parent. There's no heartbreak like that

of a child who feels that he or she will never be good enough to please a domineering, nitpicking adult. That feeling of worthlessness can carry over to adulthood, and so can a sense of resentment against those who exhibit a hostile, critical attitude. Preaching at people about their drinking can actually drive them to drink. Holier-than-thou behavior is a major turn-off. Nobody likes a nag.

If you've ever tried to overcome a problem yourself, you're probably aware that it can make a world of difference just to have some support. In a similar way, your support can give inspiration to others. Instead of griping at people about their behavior, which merely causes resentment, try supporting them.

One type of support involves promoting positive choices and alternatives. Sometimes people become so overwhelmed by their problems that they don't

fully realize all of the options available to them. You might, by simply suggesting a positive course of action, hold the key to solving another person's problem. Another way of lending support is to become someone's cheerleader. Be a one-person fan club. Provide constant encouragement. Give praise for victories, even small ones. Let them know that you believe in them. People can do nearly anything if they know they've got someone looking out for their best interests. There are times when people lack the self-esteem to try improving themselves, but will try to improve for the sake of others who support them. Later, after they've conquered their problem, they'll often develop the ability to improve for themselves as well as for their supporters.

The next time you meet someone who's struggling with a problem, become an enabler. Who can you encourage today?




