

## Counting the days Crestview mom awaits soldier's homecoming

Crestview resident Susan Appelberg is counting down the days until her son's expected Aug. 9 homecoming.

Her son, Cpl. Andrew Appelberg, has been deployed with the U.S. Army's 552nd Military

Police Company, nicknamed Deuce, which returned to Schofield Barracks in Honolulu last month from a deployment in Afghanistan that began in July 2010.

Susan cried as she spoke about her son.

"He is my best friend," she said as she dabbed away tears. "I had him when I was 19, and he

knows everything about me — every mistake, every happiness, every moment of our lives we grew up together."

Susan is already preparing for her son's homecoming. She plans to hang 21 American flags across the front of her

# Local leaders explore behind the scenes at elections office

For most voters, the electoral process is fairly simple. They go to a polling place, show some ID, blacken some ovals, pop the ballot in the tabulator and they're done. But the mechanics behind the process are not that simple.

Area elected officials, legislative staff members, representatives of political parties and voter organizations, and the media took an in-depth tour of the electoral process during "Behind the Booth Experiences" at the Okaloosa County Supervisor

# Pharmacy company opens in Crestview

One of the largest institutional pharmacy companies in the country has partnered with pharmacist Robert Dunn to open a Crestview location that will serve patients in long-term care facilities in Northwest Florida.

Dunn is president of Guardian Pharmacy of Northwest Florida, which opened its Crestview location off of James Lee Boulevard in May.

Parent company Guardian Pharmacy LLC serves more than 35,000 patients nationwide and more than 7,000 in 235 long-term care homes in Daytona Beach, Jacksonville, Pompano Beach and Tampa.

Dunn, who moved from Birmingham, Ala., employs eight people at the Crestview location, including pharmacists, pharmacy technicians and billers.

"I believe that by this time in 2012, we will have 15-20 employees in place and our contract numbers will be doubled as we serve patients," Dunn said. "I am really pleased to have located in Crestview. This is an appealing business plan, and the equity/ownership piece is my driving force to provide committed quality customer care. I have the autonomy to treat customers the way that they want to be treated."

Guardian Pharmacy streamlines communication between facilities and the pharmacy and works with them individually to design a service that improves residential care, according to the company's website.

The new Crestview business will work with long-term care facilities and their patients from Pensacola to Tallahassee, Dunn said.

"Our pharmaceutical work could easily be increased from our Crestview location to south Alabama," Dunn said. "Our delivery to residential facilities in Dothan, Enterprise, over into Brewton and the Mobile, Daphne and Fairhope areas are all possible. We were the last piece of the geographical puzzle to

home, with her son's deployment flag and the Army flag prominently displayed among yellow ribbons and a banner that reads, "Welcome home Corp. Andrew Appelberg, son-father-hero. Job well done."

During his deployment, Andrew trained members of the Afghan police force.

Andrew, who led more than 600 missions during his deployment, told his mother that one of his roughest days was when an Afghan child who had spoken with members of the U.S. military was found hanged. It is believed the Taliban murdered the child, who they apparently assumed was giving away secrets.

On another day, an Afghan man who thought the U.S. presence in his country was unfounded, spit on Andrew, Susan said.

"There were several times that he called before a mission and you could almost hear him making peace with the idea of losing his life over there," Susan said, her tears flowing freely. "He'd say things like, 'I had a wonderful childhood,' and I knew what he was saying in unspoken words, and it broke my heart."

"My mom job was over when he went over there. He has made quite the man in my eyes. His

father, who never cries, has been in tears over the deployment. We are all ready for him to be home."

Andrew, who turns 23 in September, graduated from Crestview High School four years ago. He enlisted soon after he married and found out his wife was pregnant.

Andrew's son, Talan, who is 3, often visits Susan and her husband, Kenny.

"When you ask him where his daddy is, he

says, 'Daddy is in Afghan; he's helping,' and you have no idea how much those words touch my heart."

"I just can't tell you how proud we are of him," she said. "We have heard from him almost weekly through Facebook, Skype, email or phone, but we knew where he was, and as a mom, that is overwhelming."

"There was a five-day period in December when

I heard nothing from him, and then when I did, he made me promise not to watch the news. Now I know that there had been six deaths near him."

She found solace through a Facebook page, "Mothers of Deployed Soldiers," and "Daddy Dolls," an organization that sent Talan a pillow with his father's picture on it, which depicts Andrew in uniform, with his hands forming a heart over his heart.

Susan talked about packages she sent Andrew during his deployment. He enjoyed passing out candy, pencils, crayons, pens and paper to the children in Afghanistan, she said. Other packages included items that his deployed buddies needed. She talked about another mother who sent an electric fan, delivered to her son's tent, and another who shipped bottled water.

And she talked about how proud she is of her son.

"He has always been a servant of the public," Susan said. "He was a volunteer firefighter with the Dorcas Fire Department and loved it."

After a month home with his family this fall, Andrew will leave for his appointment to the U.S. Military Academy at West Point.

meet patient needs in north Florida."

The company's target market includes assisted living and skilled nursing facilities, behavioral health groups and correctional institutions throughout the state.

Dunn said the average resident of a long-term care facility takes 10 medications a day, each given at a specific time of day, and that the health care provider must then chart or document the medication.

"So a 100-bed facility would have 1,000 pills a day, and packaging becomes a logistical issue," Dunn said. "Our dispensary uses a bingo card system with pills locked into individual plastic bubbles on a sheet that allows the pill to be pushed through on one side.

This system answers many needs in a busy facility."

Even though the looming addition of a Florida A&M University pharmacy school in downtown Crestview area will supply more highly skilled labor to the area, Dunn said that was not a factor in his decision to locate to the city.

"Although it did not influence my decision, it will certainly enhance us," he said.

Crestview Mayor David Cadle said the new business is a welcome addition to the city.

"The city of Crestview is a welcoming place for new business, and we look forward to many more entrepreneurs setting up shop in the fastest-growing city in the Florida Panhandle," Cadle said.

of Elections office July 21 and 22.

Supervisor of Elections Paul Lux hosted the event. Elections staff members and volunteer poll workers presented each stage of an election, from voter registration through vote tabulation and certification, including a mock polling place complete with "voters."

Some of the information proved eye-opening. Attendees learned that

once a citizen registers to vote, because of Florida's strict Sunshine Laws, his or her address, party affiliation and voting record (though not his actual ballot selections) are public property. No matter how someone might tire of campaign bulk mail, that's one deluge that can't be stemmed.

Attendees learned voters can check and update their voter registration information at [\[okaloosa.com\]\(http://okaloosa.com\), a database shared by other Florida elections offices but not by other states.](http://www.govote-</a></p>

"The responsibility with keeping your address current lies with you, the voter," Lux said.

Elections information technology manager Darrell Tate took the groups into the spacious vault, where tabulation equipment, records and a secured computer not connected to the Internet are kept behind five levels of physical security and two password-protected levels.

"If there's a hurricane, this is the place to be," Tate joked, adding, "Just make sure the fan's on."

Tate, who designs the ballots used in elections, explained that official ballot wording is often received at the last minute. State directives mandate ballot fonts and type sizes. Tate said he dreads candidates with long names because shrinking or con-

densing type is forbidden.

Before an election, reams of test ballots are fed through the tabulation equipment during public logic and accuracy tests. Results are printed and secured in case a candidate wishes to contest the results of vote tabulations.

"We do a ton of testing here," Tate said. "It would be hard for me to describe how much testing we do."

By redesigning absentee ballots to fit into smaller envelopes, the office has reduced postage. Printing charges were reduced by producing absentee ballots in-house, dropping the cost from 28 cents per ballot to 11 cents. In the past, elections staff would have to estimate how many ballots might be needed, and frequently over-ordered.

"There was a lot of waste," chief deputy of operations Shirley Young said. "Now we know there's going to be 970 ballots needed, so we print

970," using the figure as an example.

In a shift in voting trends, up to 60 percent of the electorate vote early or absentee, Lux said. As more voters vote at their own convenience, his staff is investigating creating "vote centers," open from the early voting period through election day.

People would stop by the most convenient vote center while running other errands, Lux explained. For one election, it might be the vote center closest to their bank or grocery store; for another election, voters might stop by a center near their doctor's office.

"We're going to see less precincts and less polling places," Lux said.

"The idea is you go to vote when and where it's convenient to you," Young said.

Lux said he hopes the idea is implemented within the next five years. Having

"eight, 10 or 12" vote centers compared with the current 52 county polling places would mean his office could purchase fewer of the new state-mandated voting machines needed by 2016, Lux said.

"We might only have to buy 20 pieces of new equipment versus 70 pieces," Lux said.

Innovations such as these make Okaloosa County's elections system a model for other Florida supervisors of elections, Lux's staff said. In fact, poll worker instructor Jane Linahan said local poll workers stopped attending out-of-county training conferences.

"At the conferences, they're teaching things we were doing 15 years ago," she said, adding professionalism, accuracy and innovation are the department's goals. "I tell my poll workers I never want to be on CNN, and I don't want to see you there, either."

# Tax collector's office relocates

## New office is spacious, offers more services

The new location of the Okaloosa County Tax Collector's Office opened July 18 at the Brackin Building, formerly the First National Bank of Crestview building on Wilson Street.

The spacious former downtown branch of FNBC was transformed by county Public Works staff to offer a large waiting area with padded benches and 11 service stations, nine of which offer customer services. The other two stations are administrative.

Upon arrival, customers select the service(s) they need at a touch-screen terminal that issues their wait number ticket. During the first week at the tax collector's new office, Crestview resident James Carothers was being assisted by clerk Kenua Moore.

"I'm impressed with the set-up," Carothers said, adding his wait had been minimal before the digital voice called out his number and Moore's window number.

Services at the new office include titles, vehicle registrations (license plates), driver licenses, state IDs and learner permits. Other services include business taxes, hunting and fishing licenses and parking placards. Residents also can take their driving road test at the office.

The new office offers later hours on Wednesdays to

accommodate people who are unable to visit during daytime hours. The office is open Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 8:30 a.m. until 5 p.m. and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Wednesdays.

The tax collector's office has also taken over driver license services, which are offered until 5 p.m. Wednesdays and 4 p.m. the rest of the week.

Road test appointments may be made between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays; and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Wednesdays.

"The new office is very convenient and efficient," said manager Anita Morrell. "We've had a lot of compliments from customers on how well it looks and how fast the time-in, time-out is."

## Volunteers raise dogs that provide independence to disabled

Opening a door, picking a key ring up or turning lights on and off — simple gestures that are at times difficult for those in a wheelchair. Specially trained assistance dogs can help people with disabilities to overcome these everyday life challenges.

Canine Companions for Independence (CCI) has been raising some of these four-pawed lifesavers for 36 years. Today, 200 puppies are in the hands of puppy raisers in the Southeast region, which serves Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina, Mississippi, Alabama and Louisiana.

The organization has been

active in Crestview for 11 years.

Assistance dogs cannot be properly trained before they reach 18 months. Before that age, they are left to volunteer puppy raisers who teach the dogs basic commands, such as remaining quiet.

The dogs also have to be acclimated to various real-life situations. To accomplish that, puppy raisers take the dogs to places like supermarkets or to their church. The whole training process depends on these first months of socialization.

"Some dogs that haven't been socialized have issues; they can be afraid of dark, vacuum cleaners, dishwashers or mirrors," said Margaret Ager, executive director of the CCI.

### CANINE COMPANIONS FOR INDEPENDENCE

Specially trained dogs can help those who are disabled live more independent lives. Canine Companions for Independence needs volunteers to help raise puppies that will later be trained. Those interested in volunteering to raise an assistance dog can download an application at [www.cci.org](http://www.cci.org) or call Marietta Birdsell in Crestview at 689-1640.

During the socialization period, puppy raisers take all the responsibility for the dogs, including vet care.

"It's a huge commitment," said Crestview resident Marietta Birdsell, who has been raising the dog in her care, Stevenson, for four months.

The commitment is worth the

effort, she added.

"We often refer to our dogs as little miracles because they do really change people lives, and you can't put a price on that," Birdsell said.

It costs about \$45,000 to breed, raise and train an assistance dog, which will be given to the recipient for free. The only expense for

the disabled person receiving an assistance dog is the cost to transport the animal to and from Orlando, where the dog will receive the last part of its training.

Some dog lovers think it might be hard to split with a dog you've been living with for months.

"But we get to play with puppies all the time," said Niceville resident Elisa Bailey, another volunteer puppy raiser. "In February, I turned one in and I had one waiting for me at my house."

New technologies also provide an opportunity for puppy raisers to keep in touch with the person who received the dog, for updates on how it is doing.

"It's like adding a new member to the family," Bailey said.





**Consider redoing old weedy lawn**

I've seen people use herbicides to control weeds in an old, declining lawn. Then, with all the weeds gone, the lawn's owner suddenly realized that he or she had no lawn left.

within a lawn. Compacted soil results in less water and oxygen getting to the lawn roots and less than favorable growing conditions for the roots.

**• Nutrient imbalances:**

Routine fertilization can result in some fertilizer elements building up to excessive levels, while other elements may be lacking. It's common to find high levels of phosphorus in older lawns. Phosphorus does not leach readily even in our sandy soils. Other elements such as potassium leach readily. Over time, we'll end up with too much of some nutrients and too little of others, which contribute to growth difficulties and possible decline in our lawns.

**• Tree competition:**

Trees and larger shrubs can compete with a lawn. As a tree gets larger with time, it becomes more competitive with lawn grass. The tree's demand for water and

nutrients increases as it becomes larger. Its root area becomes more extensive and it progressively produces more shade. Lawns usually thin significantly in association with older, large trees and shrubs.

**• The number of root pests may slowly build to damaging levels as a lawn ages.** Some common examples include nematodes (microscopic roundworms), soil inhabiting fungi such as Gaeumannomyces and ground pearls (a scale insect found in soil).

**• Improper lawn maintenance practices** may be a contributing factor in the decline of an older lawn. Common contributing factors to a lawn's demise include routinely mowing too low, excessive fertilization and irrigating incorrectly.

Sometimes herbicides are only a "band aid" approach when dealing with an old, mismanaged lawn.

Sometimes the best solution is to start over. Many older, thinning, declining, weedy lawns need to be reestablished. As lawns decline and thin, the weeds move in.

When you reach the point where there is less than 60 percent desirable cover, reestablishment should be considered.

In the process of redoing a lawn, attempt to determine why the lawn declined and correct mismanagement practices that were contributing factors in the lawn's demise.

Common causes for lawn decline are:

**• Soil compaction:** Mowing equipment, vehicles and foot traffic (from adults, children and pets) all result in the soil becoming compacted





# U.S. is driver-friendly

**NOTE:** After his first month in the U.S., the News Bulletin's summer intern from France shares one of his biggest impressions of our country.

Many things are slightly different here in Crestview from what I've been used to back in France. However, one thing has particularly struck me since I arrived — the dependence on individual cars for transportation.

Actually, I started to realize that even before I landed from France. I was supposed to arrive in Pensacola's airport. Since I didn't want my hosts to bother themselves with a two-hour drive, I, innocently enough, emailed them, "Don't worry about me, I'll catch a train or a bus to get to Crestview."

They rapidly answered me that there was no problem, that they would come and pick me up, and that, anyway, I couldn't have possibly taken any train ...

At the moment, I thanked them and didn't really realize what these ellipsis dots meant: Your public transportation network is not as extended as it is in Europe. And this is an understatement!

Over the weeks, I started to realize that you don't actually need buses or trains as much as we do on the other side

of the Atlantic Ocean.

The city in which I live, Marseille, is a good example, I think. Greeks from Phocaea founded it as a trading port in 600 B.C., which makes it the oldest city in France. Back then, traffic regulation was not a matter of concern, as you can imagine.

Century after century, its port activity made Marseille grow, regardless of circulation issues, until it became the second-biggest city in France. And today, this city is the less convenient for driving in the country. The streets are narrow, the parking spots very rare and traffic jams continuous. In these conditions, trust me, you don't want to take your car out.

And if you do dare take a shot at driving, you've got to know that the SUVs you folks are driving couldn't even fit in most of the tiny streets of the city downtown! So yes, we French people are driving these small Peugeots that might make you smile. But you can see why we cannot afford to have anything else: We are lacking space!

From what I've seen so far, driving in the U.S. is so much more convenient than in Europe, not to mention cheaper. I had to pay €3,000, or about \$4,300, to get my driver license. I'm not sure anymore that you need public transportation. Your cities look like they've been designed for driving.

But buses and trams can still be handy when your car is broken or gas prices are skyrocketing ...



# Gators try out SpeedTracs training system

**BAKER** — The Baker football team recently had the opportunity to test one of the latest innovations in athletic training when the Florida Army National Guard hosted a demonstration of the SpeedTracs training system.

"The SpeedTracs speed training system guys came in and did a demo in affiliation with the Army," said Gator football coach and athletic director Matt Brunson. "It gives our guys the experience with SpeedTracs, and it gives us a chance to see it and maybe purchase one some day."

"It's supposed to be explosive speed training. Guys are getting their distance work, speed training, working their vertical jump and hip

flexibility trying to do hamstring stretches."

SpeedTracs is a speed training program that uses resistance equipment and a software program to tailor exercise programs for different sports.

Mercer West of SpeedTracs said about 125-130 schools in the Southeast are using the program.

Among those schools are Choctawhatchee and Niceville in Okaloosa County and Navarre and Gulf Breeze in Santa Rosa County.

West said Gulf Breeze has seen significant improvement in overall team speed since getting SpeedTracs.

"Gulf Breeze got this system back at the beginning of the summer," West said. "After six weeks of

"When you look at the quarterback position, we have three guys that we feel are very capable of running the team," Pettis said.


Rising junior Dakota Dean emerged from spring practice as the starting quarterback, but a recent transfer, T.J. Culligan, who comes to Crestview from North

Kathy Combest didn't know how many players to expect for her first middle school volleyball camp as the Crestview volleyball coach, but she was hoping for more than the 15 that attended the two-day camp.

"We were kind of disappointed in the turnout, but then we got to thinking Kim (Harrison, the assistant coach) and I started in the game late," Combest said. "We didn't get to talk to the kids before school got out."

"I know when we did a camp (at Baker), we let them know beforehand (before school was out). We let them turn in their forms beforehand, and they knew and planned it ahead of time."

Combest and Harrison used the middle school camp to teach players the basics of volleyball.

"We are working on more of the fundamentals and basics for everything they do," she said. "I wanted to change where they received the ball — lower, so they can direct the ball better. That was one of my goals."

"We are working on different passing (techniques) and how to block a hard driven ball and pass it to where you want it. I notice the biggest thing with these younger kids is they don't work their arms and legs together. We are trying to incorporate that (coordination of arms and legs) to get muscle memory because if you do it enough where muscle memory takes over, it makes you use your legs."

Combest praised the efforts of the coaching staffs at Davidson and Shoal River middle schools and said she could tell the players have been well coached.



Throughout the camp, players from Davidson and Shoal River were placed together as Combest and Harrison went about putting things in place for when the girls will be teammates.



a 12-week training program, more than 12 of their kids improved their times dramatically in the 40 (yard dash).

"It's injury prevention with the fast twitch muscles that you don't get to use in the weight room. That's what it's all about."

West said SpeedTracs picks up where the weight

room leaves off, and it not only is a system that works speed and agility, but it also helps with injury prevention.

"It's all about resistance training," he said. "The idea is if you work hard with resistance training, when you take them off your natural movements are going to be better, so everything we are doing

translates beautifully to the football field."

SpeedTracs can accommodate as many as 64 athletes at a time between machinery and individual recommendation and training. It can be programmed for exercises that are specifically geared to certain sports or even a physical education class.

Brunson said he has heard plenty of good things about SpeedTracs, and he was impressed with the up-close look of his team using the system.

"The kids are doing great, but the proof will be when they get done," he said. "We see how fit they are and if they are sore."

Pettis credited Tyler Henderson, Parker, Smith, Bethune, Campagne and Rebolz as being some of the top defenders.

"We like our skill people," Pettis said. "The thing is how it will come together."

## Father/daughters exhibit enchants library patrons

Take a couple of adorable — and talented — moppets, mix in an outgoing, environmentally responsible dad, toss in a bunch of found substrates and repurposed media and you've got Moore Family Folk Art, the exhibit currently on the wall at the Crestview Public Library.

Alan Moore and his daughters Isabella, 10, and Emma, 8, the two eldest of the family's five children, have filled the exhibit wall with nine new pieces in a variety of media, most of it warm and rustic. Colors are vibrant, imagery is cheerful and playful, and the effect is a joy to behold.

"They're kind of like when I was a kid; they've always been creative," Alan Moore said. "We have a little schoolroom at the house. They're always cutting up construction paper and stealing our tape. We never have enough Scotch tape at home."

Some of the execution conjures feelings of Vincent Van Gogh had he been a folk artist and less prone to melancholy. There's a pair of geese courting beneath a swirl of stars, clouds and a crescent moon. Rainbows and the summer sun, a patriotic flag motif and a boy flying his kite as his dog observes bring smiles and a sense of contentment to the viewer.

"They like doing folk art like I do," Moore said. "We have five children, and there's limited time in life, so I wanted to make sure my hobbies include the children."

Moore said his older son, Aiden, 5, the older of the three brothers, who also include Liam (3) and Kian (4 months), is already showing an interest in making art.

"Aiden, he's gotten in the mix," Moore said. "He'll paint a couple things here and there and we've sold them at art shows. But he hasn't really joined us in the festivals yet. They're kind of long days for him."

Though the execution of Moore Family Folk Art is childlike in its innocence, there's nothing childish about it. As Isabella and Emma work their creative magic, dad Alan notes that they are learning to care for the environment they will inherit by recycling found materials into works of art.

Moore Family Folk Art has hung in galleries and appeared in art shows, festivals and crafts fairs throughout the Panhandle region. The new pieces the trio created for the display at the library will brighten any viewer's day. "I really don't do solo stuff anymore," Moore said. "We do our art together."






