Golf Course's Hidden Worth

Charitable tournaments an 'unseen benefit' to community, says City Manager

"People don't care for it because they don't understand the value of it," said Fred Thomas of Clewiston's Public Golf Course. Thomas is a member of the Golf Course Advisory Board and an advocate for the 94-year-old course.

The public course came under scrutiny in recent months, as City Commissioners hashed through the 2013/14 budget. The course, funded by the city and its tax-payers, racked up \$706,882 in expenses during fiscal year 2013 and only brought in \$334,291 in revenue. This revelation

had some residents wondering if the course were worth the financial trouble.

"If something is losing money, get rid of it. End of discussion," commented one Clewiston resident about the golf course.

But supporters of the course say there are benefits the course brings to the city that are not apparent or reflected in its revenues.

One of those benefits is the many charitable tournaments that take place throughout the year at the course.

Attention Hunters

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission would like to announce that they will be issuing permits for two wild hog control hunts on Fisheating Creek Wildlife Management Area, west of U.S. 27, to residents of Glades and Hendry counties.

The two hog control hunts will be held on Oct. 26 and 27, and Nov. 2 and 3. There will be 25 permits issued for each hunt. Permits will be

available on a first-come, first-served basis to individuals 16 years of age or older. Permit distribution will take place at the Fisheating Creek WMA check-station at the FEC Campground in Palmdale on Saturday, Oct. 19, beginning at 10 a.m. Individuals must be present to receive a permit; permits cannot be picked up by another individual. only will the play be a cultural opportunity for the residents of Clewiston and the surrounding areas, but the proceeds from the ticket sales will be used towards funding other nonprofit efforts in the city of Clewiston and its next-door-neighbor, Harlem.

Henry's production company specializes in using plays, such as "Distorted Love," to help raise money for nonprofit organizations, community organizations, and churches.

Henry first came to Clewiston after resident Gloria Bovell contacted her for help.

"Gloria reached out to us and told us that there is nothing here to help the women in the community. So we drove up and saw the community," said Henry.

Henry met with County Commissioner Janet Taylor while she was in town and told

Commissioner Taylor what she and her organization -- in association with The Center for Dreams, Inc., another nonprofit

organization based out of Tampa and run by Henry -- were in town to accomplish. In Henry's words, Commissioner Taylor

was "excited."

Commissioner Taylor is currently trying to get a new women's center off the ground in Clewiston. According to Henry's conversations with Commissioner Taylor, meetings are being held each month with poor turnout.

It is the hope of Bovell and Commissioner Taylor to work with Henry to establish a nonprofit in Clewiston similar to The Center for Dreams, which provides social services to veterans, seniors and struggling families. Currently, The Center for Dreams is working to provide housing for disabled veterans whose family can no longer care for them, as well as helping seniors pay for utility bills they cannot afford.

If the plan to establish a nonprofit comes to fruition, other services would be provided in Clewiston, as well. Business development courses, job training classes and life skill classes are a few of those services the three hope to provide.

Henry said there is a lot of business development that is needed in the community, noting the closed movie theater and lack of similar amenities, especially in Harlem.

Henry said the first step is to get to the community involved to figure out what it needs. She plans to do that with a questionnaire, which would ask the community what they believe is needed, not what Henry or any other outside agency thinks the community needs.

"We're coming in as outsiders," began Henry. "The questionnaire would ask what services do you think you need. We don't want to come in and say this is what we think you need. But from a social services and business development standpoint, we can help."

Henry went on to emphasize the importance of self-sufficiency for small communities, especially in light of the recent government shutdown. People still need food, they still need milk for their babies independent of government programs, said Henry.

"We go to cities to show that you need to stop relying on the government. ... Go to training classes to learn how. Start your own business if there's no business hiring. Start a small catering business, a car detailing

business," said Henry, adding that the people her nonprofit organization targets "can do it" and "want to do it," they just "don't have the know-how."

According to Henry, her organization is "coming in with the know-how."

"There were more tournaments this last year than I've ever seen," said Thomas.

Those tournaments are hosted by the golf course, but the proceeds go towards the charities or scholarships the tournament is supporting. The tournaments are held throughout the year, but during the winter months, the golf course hosts on average two per month, according to Thomas.

One of those tournaments include the Tiger Boosters, which raises money for Hendry County athletic programs. Last year, the tournament raised about \$15,000, according to City Manager Al Perry.

The athletes were introduced before the tournament began, to give a face to the charity the golfers were supporting. The athletes then spent the rest of the day serving drinks and food during the event.

Clewiston's Elks Lodge has held a tournament at the golf course for the past nine years to raise money for its \$4,000 scholarship; Rotary Club also sponsors a scholarship tournament.

Other charitable tournaments include those sponsored by the American Red Cross, New Harvest Church, the Glades County Boosters, and one in support of an annual mission trip to Nicaragua for doctors and nurses of Hendry Regional Medical Center.

Thomas and City Manager Perry explained that though the golf course hosts the tournaments, it does not necessarily benefit from them financially. But that may be changing soon.

"The organizations are successful enough that it's only fair that the course make some

money, too," said City Manager Perry.

Discussion at the Golf Course Advisory Boards last meeting on Sept. 17 included charging a small fee for the organizations to use the course for their tournaments. Though, board members did not want the fee to be so high that it would discourage use of the course or take away from the charities themselves.

property taxes, as well.

Both Thomas and City Manager Perry suggested that if the golf course were shut down, many snow birds would not return to Clewiston, which would hurt other local businesses, as well.

"If it wasn't for that golf course, half of our RV parks would be empty," said City Manager

There was even talk about waiving the fee if the organization purchased enough merchandise from the courses' pro shop.

Fee or no fee, it would not be nearly enough to bring the course out of its deficit.

And if the charities the course supports is not enough to convince critics that the golf course is a "necessary part of the community," as Thomas suggested, perhaps another benefit of the course will suffice: the attraction of the golf course for winter tourists.

According to Thomas, a lot of extra revenue comes from the snow birds, who migrate to their wintering grounds in Clewiston for two main recreational activities: fishing and golfing.

"Some [snow birds] don't even fish, and some have houses here all year round," said Thomas, alluding to the fact that those snow birds with year-round houses are contributing to

Perry.

If critics are still not convinced that the "unseen benefit" of the golf course is reason enough to keep it open, Thomas and City Manager Perry invite them to take advantage of the course's beautiful facility for themselves.

Not only can residents play nine- or 18-hole rounds during the day, the course also offers a lighted driving range to de-stress after work, practice their swing or bring the kids for a fun night out.

If the course is closed, simply go to the police station for a few tokens to activate the lights at the driving range.

the Crusaders' confidence.

Anthony Taylor fumbled the kickoff recovery and chose not to run. Going into the second quarter, their progress was not as good as it could have been. They were on the 37-yard line and despite numerous penalties being called on the Tigers, were unable to make it very far. As defensive coordinator Joe Roth put it, "We shut down their offense early on in the game."

The Tigers' offense was far from being shut down in this quarter, however. After recovering a punt, Angelo Tolbert was able to make it all the way, rushing for over 70 yards and furthering the Tigers' lead. Again, they made the extra point, and again, forced a turnover after kicking off to the Crusaders.

That wasn't enough for the Tigers, however. After West and Jarvirius Bradford carried for 14 and four yards, respectively, and a penalty moved them 15 yards closer to a touchdown, Maurice Murphy made it to the end zone and Brandon Torres was able to make the extra point yet again.

The score was now 21-0.

The Tigers started the second half off somewhat sloppily. They kept the Crusaders at bay, but with eight-and-a-half minutes left in the quarter, Michael White was able to make a touchdown for the Crusaders, rushing for 28 yards.

Head Coach Pete Walker was especially critical of the Tigers' performance leading up to the Crusaders' touchdown.

"We can't give them momentum. ... We have to have that killer instinct and kick the intensity up a notch, and we didn't see that," he said, addressing the team after the game.

The fourth quarter brought with it new intensity in the Tigers' game. Within the first three minutes, the Tigers were within reach of another touchdown, but fumbled before they could make it all the way. The Crusaders, too, seemed to be picking up, but were unable to score another touchdown, much less even the score or gain the lead.

The Crusaders' Head Coach, Mike Sonneborn, considered each team's performance on special teams "the difference in the game," although "both teams ran well."

Coaches Walker and Roth for the Tigers disagreed with his sentiments. They placed more

importance on the Tigers' ability to stop most attempts by the Crusaders to make a touchdown.

Regarding individual players, defensive players were lauded this week. Tony Calloway, especially, drew much praise.

"It was Calloway's best game so far this season, by far," said Roth.

"[Calloway] was outstanding on defense," added Walker.

Walker went on to state that Joe Hernandez also had a great game, with his offensive line performance being graded a 77 percent. West, again, had a great game, both offensively and defensively. Overall, the team's first-half performance was seen as good by the coaches, unlike their second-half performance.

Speaking to the team as a whole, Walker

stated, "We gotta focus on playing four quarters of intense football, not just two." Roth agreed, saying, "We need them to play at that level consistently."

The Tigers' next game is against the Avon Park Red Devils, their first district game of the season. Coach Roth calls it a "must-win game."

"We set our goals [becoming a district team] and we have to meet them," said Coach Roth.

In preparation for the next game, Coach Roth stressed the importance of "focusing on the fundamentals, and little things again."

Coach Walker agreed, adding, "Practice is going to be very physical again."

The Tigers are going to need all the support they can get in Avon Park. The game will take place on Oct. 4 at Avon Park High School.






