## Tigers Destroy Vipers in High-Energy Playoff Game

This was it. The Tigers' first playoff match of the season. Their hard work all season resulted in having the home field advantage against Space Coast High's Vipers.

The atmosphere in Cane Field was nothing short of electrifying. Minutes before the game, fans filed down to the field to cheer the Tigers on as they made their appearance before the game began, and fans on both sides weren't shy in letting themselves be heard, whether they were cheering on a good play, or deriding a referee's decision.

The Tigers wasted no time in letting the Vipers know this was no ordinary ball game. The Vipers had the

ball first this time around, but couldn't get very far before the Tigers' defense overwhelmed them, forcing them to punt.

Once the Tigers had the ball, they made a mad dash for the end zone. Derry West started the drive off excellently, with a 26-yard run, and after players like Daion Banks helped move the ball forward, West capped it off with a 4-yard rush for a touchdown. The extra point was good, and with 7:10 left in the quarter, the Tigers got the lead, 7-0.

The Vipers were up on the offensive again, but the Tigers weren't going to give them a chance to even the score. They blocked passes, tackled players, did everything in their power to keep the Vipers from scoring.

After forcing the Vipers to punt again, the Tigers' Tyrone Washington returned it for a touchdown immediately, with 6:16 left in the quarter. After another successful extra point, they were up 14-0.

The Tigers kept up their defensive onslaught, with players like Luke Bradford and Derrick Jackson hurting Space Coast's offense through sacks, tackles, and more blocked passes.

After yet another turnover, the Tigers were starting from the 50-yard line. They weren't intimidated; far from it. In their first play, Derrick Jackson received an expert pass from Da-

# SFWMD Boosts Water Storage Project North of Lake Okeechobee

Restoration site will store and treat stormwater runoff before it enters the big lake

On Nov. 14, the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) approved an investment to advance a restoration project in Highlands County that will store water and reduce nutrients and stormwater runoff before it enters Lake Okeechobee.

"Expanding water storage and treatment are essential across the entire South Florida ecosystem," said SFWMD Chairman Daniel O'Keefe. "Each project we move forward brings us closer to attaining benefits for Lake Okeechobee, the coastal estuaries and our vital communities."

Strategically located in a 19,000-acre watershed northwest of the lake, the project comprises three shallow above-ground impoundments, totaling approximately 1,200 acres. The impoundments will hold stormwater that would otherwise flow directly into canals leading to Lake Okeechobee.

The \$2 million investment approved today — along with

funding by project partners that include the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), Istokpoga Marsh Watershed Improvement District, Highlands County and Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services — advances the project to the next step: final design and construction of the first impoundment.

"This is a continuation of efforts by the Department and the South Florida Water Management District to restore Lake Okeechobee and the Everglades with the support of Governor Scott," said DEP Secretary Herschel T. Vinyard Jr. "Additional water storage and cleaner water are critical to the restoration of Lake Okeechobee."

At 308 acres filled 3.5 feet deep, the first impoundment will hold approximately 900 acre-feet of water.

This is equivalent to about 450 Olympic-size swimming pools, or about 100 American football fields without end zones, covered with nine feet

of water.

Scientific study and computer modeling have shown the project, combined with the use of best management practices on local farms, could reduce 70 percent of the phosphorus

and 60 percent of the local stormwater runoff flowing into the Harney Pond Canal, which flows into Lake Okeechobee and ultimately the Everglades.

By storing and treating water bound for the lake, the project

helps meet key objectives of the Northern Everglades and Estuaries Protection Program.

The program is designed to improve the quality, quantity, timing and distribution of water into Lake Okeechobee and the

Caloosahatchee and St. Lucie watersheds by building on and consolidating numerous restoration efforts into a broader approach focused on restoring the entire Northern Everglades system.

vis Witt, good for 41 yards. With only 9 yards to go for a touchdown, West again made a beeline for the end zone. He was stopped a yard short, however, but quickly made the yard needed to score. After another successful extra point, the score was 21-0, and the Tigers were far from finished with the Vipers.

The Vipers were on the offensive again, but it wasn't long before the Tigers' Luke Bradford intercepted a pass and made a mad dash for a touchdown, only to be stopped a yard short. Derry West again muscled his way past the Vipers' defense, furthering the Tigers' lead. The extra point was good yet again, leaving the score 28-0, with two-and-a-half minutes left in the first quarter.

Again, the Vipers found themselves on the offensive, and again, one of the Tigers' own was to make an interception. This time around, Angelo Tolbert picked off a pass, and sprinted past the Vipers' defense, running the 33 yards needed to reach the goal line with a minute to go in the first quarter.

After the extra point, the Tigers had a 35-point lead over the Vipers going into the second quarter. This was a beating the likes of which the Vipers had never received.

Once the second quarter got going, the Vipers began to fight back. They pushed the Tigers back a few yards and made some good blocks, but the Tigers weren't fazed. Lenorris Gaines caught a 30-yard pass from Witt, putting the Tigers 3 yards away from scoring yet again.

Kyree Marshall was called on to close that three-yard gap, and close it he did. Another successful kick later, and it was clear the Tigers weren't letting up, with a score of 42-0.

The Vipers' offense was still in bad shape, and they didn't have the ball for long before punting, but they again showed the Tigers that they weren't going to be making scoring plays so easily anymore. They blocked passes, pushed players back, and made some hard tackles, but the Tigers still found it in them to move closer to the end zone, bit by bit.

With eight seconds to go in the first half, and four yards to go for a touchdown, the Tigers' Tyrone Washington made the rushing play needed to score. The score was 49-0 after another extra point attempt.

Once the third quarter got started, the Vipers began to show that they weren't going to be pushed around any longer. The Tigers had the ball first, but after they punted, the Vipers made the most of their situation.

Eight minutes to go in the third quarter, and Alec Danserau catches a 45-yard pass from Nick Rittenhouse, good for a touchdown. The PAT was good, leaving the score 49-7.

The Vipers continued playing hard, going so far as to recover their own kickoff. They again had their sights set on the end zone, and with 6:43 left in the quarter, Devon Cannon picked off a pass, good for 20 yards and another Viper touchdown. After the PAT, it was 49-14.

The rest of the third quarter was a back-and-forth between the teams, and the Vipers, while unable to close the gap in points, were attacking the second half with a newfound fervor.

Unfortunately for them, the Tigers had the same idea once the fourth quarter began.

Both teams finally seemed evenly matched for each other as the fourth quarter got going. The Tigers faced some resistance as they inched towards the end zone, but after five minutes of struggle, the Tigers' Tyrone Washington made a two-yard rush for a touchdown, and after the PAT, the score was 56-14.

The Vipers' Nathan Miller was retired due to an injury, unfortunately, soon after the Tigers' touchdown.

However, the Vipers were still determined to make another touchdown, and with 2:07 left in the game, Nick Rittenhouse made it all the way, and with another PAT, the score was 56-21.

Josh Rojas finished off the night's game on a high note, recovering the subsequent kickoff for a 51-yard touchdown, and after the extra point, the final score was 63-21, leaving the Tigers victorious.

Despite the loss, Space Coast's head coach, Jake Owens, was full of praise for his team. "I'm proud of these boys. We went from a program that hadn't won very much since 2008 to having our most wins in a season. I'm proud to be the

head coach, and these boys have nothing to be ashamed of. They did a great job."

Joe Roth, defensive coordinator for the Tigers, was glad that "it was a great team effort. It was our first home playoff win 2007, and I'm very proud of all of them. They all played great." However, he wanted to stress that they would start preparing for their next playoff match almost immediately.

Head Coach for the Tigers, Pete Walker, was also ecstatic. "We came out, and we played the best football we've played all year," he said. "And this is the time of year you wanna be doing that."

The Clewiston Tigers' next match will be against Cocoa High's Tigers, at Cocoa High School, on November 22.

# Health Care District Marks 25 Years of Keeping Glades Community Healthy

Nov. 8 marked 25 years since the voters of Palm Beach County approved a referendum to establish a health care district "...to provide a source of funding for indigent and medically needy residents and to maximize the health and well being of Palm Beach County residents by providing comprehensive planning, funding, and coordination of health care service delivery." More than two decades later, the Health Care District of Palm Beach County has matured into a model safety net system for innovative health care delivery.

"The Health Care District was launched with a challenging and noble mission," said Carol A. Roberts, chair of the Health Care District Board of Commissioners. "Over the last 25 years, we are proud to have partnered with public and private community providers and organizations to build a strong safety net that ensures access to quality health care services for thousands of Palm Beach County residents."

Since 1991, Palm Beach County's nationally recognized Trauma System has provided life-saving care to more than 3,000 people a year who suffer traumatic injuries. To date, more than 54,000 people have benefitted from this integrated system of care funded and overseen by the Health Care District, which includes two Trauma Centers and the Health Care District's two Trauma Hawk aeromedical helicopters. In 1993, the Health Care District

began offering health coverage plans for eligible residents who cannot afford private health insurance and who don't qualify for other government health care programs.

For more than 15 years, over 200 school nurses have staffed health rooms in 167 schools in Palm Beach County, caring for 174,000 students each year. Residents of rural, western Palm Beach County receive quality health care services at Lakeside Medical Center, the only acute-care hospital in the Glades agricultural region. The Health Care District operates the

Edward J. Healey Rehabilitation and Nursing Center in Riviera Beach, which provides skilled nursing and rehabilitation for residents who need 24-hour care as a result of debilitating illness or traumatic injury.

This year, the Health Care District began providing adult and pediatric services at the C. L. Brumback Primary Care Clinics located in four Florida Health Palm Beach County (formerly the Palm Beach County Health Department) health centers in Belle Glade, Lantana, Delray Beach and West Palm Beach.

"The Health Care District's mission from the beginning has been to fill gaps in community health care without duplicating programs offered at the state and federal levels," said Ronald J. Wiewora, MD, MPH, the Health Care District's chief executive officer and chief medical officer. "Now, 25 years later, we are proud to say that the Health Care District has evolved into a unique safety net system that benefits Palm Beach County residents of all ages and from all walks of life."

The Health Care District is governed by a volunteer seven-member

Board of Commissioners.

Board members include Carol A. Roberts, chair; Philip H. Ward III, vice-chair; Brian R. Lohmann, secretary; Nancy C. Banner, Esq.; Delray Beach City Commissioner Angeleta Gray; Leslie B. Daniels; and Alina M. Alonso, MD, the director of Florida Health Palm Beach County. The Health Care District Board is responsible for governing a complex organization with more than 1,000 employees. The Health Care District's annual budget is supported by property tax revenue, grants and other program revenue.



# Florida Gas Price

Average retail gasoline prices in Florida have risen 4.6 cents per gallon in the past week, averaging \$3.22/g Sunday, according to GasBuddy's daily survey of 8,237 gas outlets in Florida. This compares with the national average that has increased 1.6 cents per gallon in the last week to \$3.21/g, according to gasoline price website GasBuddy.com.

Including the change in gas prices in Florida during the past week, prices yesterday were 9.9 cents per gallon lower than the same day one year ago and are 9.2 cents per gallon lower than a month ago. The national average has decreased 16.3 cents per gallon during the last

month and stands 22.5 cents per gallon lower than this day one year ago.

"Surprisingly, the decreases we've seen in the national average have all but dried up," said GasBuddy.com Senior Petroleum Analyst Patrick DeHaan. "I admit, it's a bit of a head scratcher to have seen wholesale gasoline prices perk up last week, and it's a bit premature to say we've seen the end of decreases in gas prices for the time being, so I'm hopeful that an uptick in the national average is merely temporary, but then again, this year has featured trends in prices that have all been earlier than expected," DeHaan said.

J.D. also enjoyed salt-water fishing and scuba diving. Nonetheless, deer hunting was one of his passions, and he would travel to Alabama and Mississippi each year to deer hunt while visiting with family. While in Clewiston, J.D. could usually be found getting his morning coffee, enjoying food and company at Dixie Fried Chicken, shopping at the pawn shop, tinkering with engines, or fishing in a canal somewhere. While a Christian and a believer for most of his life, his faith was often tested. During his wife's battle with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis, J.D. re-committed to his walk with the Lord while attending the Clewiston Church of God. He later joined the Pioneer Baptist Church and enjoyed the ministry of Pedro Cabrera and his church family.

J.D. was preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Diane and Della; two brothers, Bob Jones and Buddy Oswalt; and his wife, Patricia.

As a matter of fact, the domesticated turkey has been described as being "as brainless as a baseball." Even drinking can put a strain on turkey intelligence. Many aren't smart enough to close their mouths in the rain. If a turkey is outside looking up to the sky in a heavy rain, it can drown. No one wants to be a turkey.

At least the turkey has an excuse for being "bird-brained." There is less excuse for us human beings. Take the nine lepers Luke writes about in Luke 17. Jesus had healed them from a disgusting, painful and unsightly skin disease. It was a tremendous gift that made it possible for them to re-enter society and reunite with their families. # Twice the Risk

## Non-hispanic black Americans twice as likely to be diagnosed with diabetes

During the month of November, the nation is recognizing Diabetes Awareness Month. As the seventh leading cause of death in the United States, approximately 18.8 million Americans of all ages, or 8.3 percent of the population, have been diagnosed with diabetes as of 2010; another seven million Americans have been undiagnosed and an estimated 79 million American adults aged 20 years or older have prediabetes, according to data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

In Hendry County, the numbers are higher. Approximately 12 percent of Hendry County residents have been diagnosed with diabetes as of 2010, 3.7 percent higher than the national average and 1.6 percent higher than the state of Florida, according to the Florida Department of Health (FDH).

Broken down even further, the numbers show that non-hispanic black residents of Hendry County are almost twice as likely to be diagnosed with diabetes than non-hispanic white residents. Approximately 21.9 percent of non-hispanic black residents in Hendry County have been diagnosed with diabetes as of 2010, whereas 10.1 percent of non-hispanic white residents have been diagnosed, according to data from FDH. Compared to the state of Florida, there are about 8.8 percent more non-hispanic black residents that have been diagnosed with diabetes in Hendry County than in other counties.

According to Mary Ruth Prouty, program manager with Florida Community Health Centers, the considerable difference between non-hispanic white and non-hispanic black residents in Hendry County is not inconsistent with national statistics. Prouty said for every six white Americans who have diabetes there are 10 black Americans who have diabetes. Non-hispanic black Ameri-

cans are also more likely to go blind, have amputations and suffer kidney failure as a result of their diabetes. Prouty said these complications arise from not being diagnosed early enough and from not maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

Many Americans' attitudes towards diabetes may be impacting their health, said Prouty, as they may assume that because their parents had diabetes, they will eventually be diagnosed and there is nothing they can do to prevent it. Prouty explained that diabetes prevention has come along way in the past 30 years.

"Diabetes was considered to be a disease that was going to happen to people quite often and there wasn't a lot you could do about it -- but there is. It's about losing the [extra] weight and being more physically active," said Prouty, explaining that losing just five to 10 percent of one's body weight is enough to prevent or control diabetes. Educating those who have diabetes or are at risk of developing diabetes is crucial,

says Prouty. In Hendry County, diabetes education classes are offered monthly, free of charge.

"Many people have not taken diabetes education classes and the fact that we offer them for free -- it's sad that no one is utilizing them," said Prouty.

According to Prouty, 57 percent of people who have diabetes in Hendry County have never taken a diabetes education class. Prouty explained that education classes are significant because diabetes is a "do it yourself disease" -- the more you know, the more able you will be to manage your own health. The only catch, Prouty explained, is people must be willing to make lifestyle changes.

"Lots of people are able to live long, healthy and productive lives with diabetes, but they have to be taught and live the lifestyle," said Prouty.

Hendry Regional Medical Center offers free diabetes education classes each month on Wednesdays and Thursdays starting at 6 p.m.

# Ordinance Changes Governing False Alarms

The Clewiston Police and Fire Departments would like to inform citizens and business owners about the ordinance changes governing false alarms. In years past, residents and businesses that utilize alarm systems were allowed to have 10 false alarms per year without being charged. The current ordinance, which recently took effect, states that alarm users are only allowed three false alarms per year. Any alarm users that have four or more false alarms will incur a \$50 fine per alarm for up to 10 alarms. Any alarm users that have 11 or more false alarms will result in a \$100 fine per alarm.

cy service agency will make that determination at the time of the alarm call. Each alarm call generates a record that gets documented through the police department and is kept in a database for future review.

What constitutes a false alarm? Many reasons can contribute to a false alarm. Here are a few examples: weather related, motion sensor triggered by a pet, not properly closing the doors or windows, improper passcode, etc. The city of Clewiston will bill for each false alarm beyond the third occurrence, except in situations where an actual event has taken place, such as, but not limited to, intruders, broken window, fire or when medical attention is rendered.

If weather conditions are the direct result in the alarm being triggered, the city of Clewiston will excuse the event. The responding emergen-

resident know Clewiston Police responded for a false alarm. Residents have the right to appeal any false alarm to the Clewiston Police Department within 30 days of the alarm activation. Upon the third false alarm at one location, a letter will be mailed indicating that any future false alarm at the location will result in a fine. At the end of the fiscal year (September 30), a bill will be generated and mailed out to the locations that have four or more false alarms.

For further information or questions regarding the alarms, please contact Lieutenant Chad Pelham of the Clewiston Police Department at 863-983-1474.

Officers that responded to the alarm location will investigate the reason the alarm was activated. If there is no inclement weather, signs of an intruder, broken window, smoke, person in need of medical attention or any other evidence that would warrant an alarm activation, the officer will hang a door hanger to let the



# CDC Accredited for Emergency Management

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) received accreditation from the Emergency Management Accreditation Program's (EMAP) for its excellence in emergency management. The CDC is the first federal agency to attain full accreditation of its emergency management program.

"CDC's emergency management program has seen the nation through flu emergencies, multi-state foodborne outbreaks, hurricanes and more," said CDC Director Tom Frieden, M.D., M.P.H. "CDC is the first federal agency to attain full accreditation of its emergency management program."

Accreditation means a program has completed the six-step EMAP process, including a self-assessment, an on-site appraisal and a committee review.

The on-site assessment and follow-up report includes a summary of compliance against 64 EMAP standards set out in the Emergency Management Standard. Included in the EMAP standards are program management; administration and finance; laws and authorities; operational planning; exercises, evaluations and corrective action; and crisis communication, public education and information.

"Accreditation is a serious accomplishment for CDC and the emergency management community we support," said Ali S. Khan, M.D., M.P.H., director of the Office of Public Health Preparedness and Response. "Preparing for and responding to emergencies of any kind – natural disasters, bioterrorism events, chemical terrorism or pandemics – is a core function of public health. Everyone at CDC has a hand, at one point in time, in emergency management and

execution."

Since 1997, EMAP's independent assessors and program review committee evaluates local, state and national emergency management programs to ensure they meet nationally set standards for emergency management, and promote

consistent quality of emergency management programs.

The cost of accreditation is \$50,000 and is valid for five years. In the United States, 31 states, the District of Columbia, and 14 cities and counties are accredited.

the tax collector regarding special assessments for East County Rec. The agreement would give the county and city until March 2014 to decide whether or not to establish an MSBU for all citizens within the East County Rec area, which includes the city of Clewiston, as well as Harlem, Montura and other unincorporated areas in eastern Hendry County. The MSBU would be used to pay for recreational activities operated and supported by East County Rec and is intended to take some of the financial burden of recreation off the residents of Clewiston; in other words, East County Rec should mean lower taxes for city residents but higher taxes for county residents.

Commissioner James Pittman voiced concerns over the agreement, saying he would like to see how East County Rec operates on the money the program already has -- namely, the \$140,000 contribution from the county.

"We just started one month ago. ... I'd like to see how it's going to run and work for a year, and maybe next year we would have a better idea of the actual cost. ... I just think we're a little premature," said Commissioner Pittman.

Mayor Phillip Roland agreed with Commissioner Pittman's point that it is too early to establish an MSBU. However, Mayor Roland explained that this agreement, if adopted, would not "tie [the city's] hands." The agreement would simply pave the way for a future MSBU, should the city and county vote to adopt one.

City Attorney Charles Schoech clarified that the agreement was "a pre-requisite," and if it were not approved at the meeting, the city would have to wait until 2015 to collect any money from residents for East County Rec.

Commissioner Julio Rodriguez, a member of the East County Rec Board, said the agreement was "basically just laying the ground work," and he does not see "the harm in adopting it." He did, however, acknowledge that the MSBU would not be an "easy sell at the end of the day."

Commissioner Mali Gardner then weighed in on the discussion, saying this is the first time the school board, the city and the county were discussing recreation together and made a motion to approve the agreement. Commissioner Rick Miller seconded the motion and commissioners voted 4-1 to approve the agreement, with Com-

missioner Pittman voting against it.

Commissioners then voted on two related agenda items, which Attorney Schoech called the second and third "leg of the stool."

The second leg was an agreement between the county, city and property appraiser, which commissioners voted 4-1 to approve. Commissioner Pittman had the same qualms against this agenda item as he did the last, and used a simple "ditto" as his argument.

Commissioners completed the stool by voting 4-1 to advertise for a public hearing regarding the East County Rec MSBU in January 2014; Commissioner Pittman again voted against the item. The commissioners' decision leads the way towards establishing an MSBU for East County Rec, and further discussion, whether for or against the MSBU, is promised over the next few months. As the conversation over East County Rec ended, commissioners turned their focus to a bid for paving city streets in 2014.

Public Works Director Sean Scheffler suggested the bid be awarded to Weekley Asphalt, the lowest bidder, and commissioners approved the bid award with a 5-0 vote.

The project has an estimated financial impact of \$182,695. Commissioners also voted to approve tokens of appreciation for city employees, which have been a tradition since 1977. Commissioner Gardner lauded the program and the city's ability to continue it even though "times have not been easy for everyone in the community." The tokens, financial gifts of between \$100 and \$200 depending on individual employee's length of employment, are awarded to both part-time and full-time employees, as well as volunteer fireman and police auxiliary.

Before the meeting adjourned, Library Director Ava Barrett shared good news about the Hendry County Library System: on top of the recent \$50,000 grant awarded to Hendry County's Library System by the Southwest Florida Community Foundation, an additional \$20,000 has been awarded to the libraries to further the programs now being implemented as a result of the first grant. The additional money was given by the Hendry County Education Task Force.

Continuing the high spirits, and in light of the upcoming Thanksgiving holiday, Commissioner Gardner gave the city's directors an offering of thanks.

"I just want everyone to know what a heart of gratitude I have," said Commissioner Gardner, addressing the directors. "I am in deep gratitude of the work you do, day in and day out."

After the presentation, commissioners voted to reorganize the board, reappointing Commissioner Turner as chair and appointing Commissioner Janet Taylor as vice chair. Commissioner Swindle was also asked to continue former Commissioner Al Perry's roles on varying boards, including the Economic Development Council Board.

Commissioners also voted to award the Hendry County Jail Inmate Medical Service contract to Hendry Regional Medical Center.

Before commissioners approved the consent agenda, one item was pulled and discussed due to possible ethics violations.

Mary Ann Martin, owner of Roland and Mary Ann Martin's Marina, is a member of the Tourism Development Council (TDC) Board. Roland Martin Marina was awarded a \$1.55 million grant from the TDC, but because Martin is a board member, a conflict of interest arose. County Attorney Mark Lapp explained that commissioners could waive the conflict of interest with a two-thirds vote. After a short discussion about the ethical implications of a board member's business receiving grant money, commissioners voted 5-0 to allow Roland Martin Marina to accept the grant money. Chairman Karson Turner also made it a point to clarify that the BOCC was

not implying that Martin was benefiting personally from the grant.

Next, Kati Sherrard, project manager for the Florida Department of Transportation, gave a short presentation about a proposed weigh station to be built on U.S. 27 near the S.R. 80 interchange. According to Sherrard, the weigh station would "prolong the lifespan of the road structure" and "achieve a higher level of compliance." The station would be operated by an officer and would only be open when the officer was present. Sherrard said she anticipates the project design would be completed by spring 2014 and construction would begin in summer 2014. A public hearing is planned for January 2014 to discuss the project.

After Sherrard's presentation, commissioners voted in favor of conducting a public hearing about the proposed East Hendry County Recreation MSBU in January 2014. On Nov. 18, city commissioners also voted in favor of the public hearing.

Before their meeting adjourned, commissioners took the time to welcome Commissioner Swindle to the board.

Commissioner Don Davis joked with Commissioner Swindle, saying there are a few members of the board he needs to "watch out for."

Chairman Turner welcomed Commissioner Swindle to "the club," and Commissioner Taylor said she thinks Commissioner Swindle will "fit right in."



# Inland Birding: Tropical Kingbird

Tropical Kingbirds are a common breeding bird of the American tropics. Their normal northern range reaches the United States in south Texas and southern Arizona. Their winters are usually spent in Mexico, or as far south as South America, but they will wander widely and are found occasionally in Florida.

This medium-sized songbird has a long, dark, forked tail and a fairly large bill. Their wingspan is nearly four-and-three-quarter inches wide. Its head is pale gray with contrasting darker cheeks and a patch of reddish orange on its crown. It has grayish-olive upperparts, a pale throat, darker upper breast and a bright yellow lower breast. Tropical Kingbird's plumage is not greatly affected by seasonal change. Juvenile Tropical Kingbirds' upperparts are more brown than those of an adult Kingbird; juveniles also have paler edges on their wings.

Tropical Kingbirds are similar in appearance to Couch's Kingbirds, but can be distinguished by their call. Tropical Kingbirds communicate primarily through vocalizations and will make a high-pitched twittered trill throughout the day. They sing a song known as the Dawn Song, which they will start before sunrise, before most birds begin to sing. The Dawn Song is not repeated until the next morning.

Tropical Kingbirds prefer living near open woodlands in close proximity to a pond or flowing stream, avoiding densely forested areas. Their diet consists mainly of flying insects. Its fruit diet consists of seeded fruits and berries.

Tropical Kingbirds' timing for nesting varies from place to place. Their nest is an open cup, usually located on a horizontal branch in the mid-story or canopy of a tree. The male may show aggressive behavior when defending its territory during the breeding season. The breeding pair only has one brood per season. The female lays a clutch of two to four buff-colored eggs in one or two days, which she incubates for 15 to 16 days. Both the male and female feed the nestlings insects and berries. These young birds fledge when they are about 18 or 19 days old, however, the parents will continue to feed the young for at least another two weeks.

Wintering songbirds are returning to inland Florida. They are most active in the early morning,

but can be observed foraging throughout most of the day. A solitary Tropical Kingbird returned to STA-5, located 27 miles south of Clewiston, for the second year last month. Scissor-tailed Flycatchers and Kingbirds have returned to County Road 835 near Deer Fence Road, about three to four miles north of the C.R. 835/833 intersection in Hendry County. Local birds, including juvenile Snail Kites, are being observed near Lake Okeechobee and inland wetlands.

Walking or bicycling access is available during daylight hours at STA-5 Friday, Saturday and Monday from the last week in November through the first week in February. Check the Great Florida Birding and Wildlife Trail website for directions to birding hotspots in inland Florida.
