Victims Bound in Home Invasion Robbery

Suspects impersonated police before allegedly robbing victims in Montura, HCSO reports

The Hendry County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) is investigating a home invasion robbery that occurred in Montura Ranch Estates on Monday, March 10 at around 11:30 p.m.

Just days after HCSO arrested two suspects in an earlier attempted burglary in Montura, the second home was broken into, HCSO is reporting.

According to a press release from

HCSO, deputies responded to the area of Hacienda Street in Montura after a resident called to report that he had just been robbed.

When deputies arrived at the home, the resident stated that three

City Re-approves Contract with Scott Martin

Comm. questions effectiveness of Martin contract in meeting

Kristine Petersen was formally sworn in as interim city commissioner at the last regular meeting held on March 17 in Clewiston's City Hall.

Marketing Dollars at Work

Commissioner Petersen seemed relaxed during her first meeting on the board and took opportunities to speak her mind about certain issues being discussed at the night's meeting.

One such issue was the city's commitment to contributing \$20,000

towards Clewiston resident Scott Martin's television show, The Scott Martin Challenge.

The city and the county both contribute to the show each year with the stipulation that Martin "plug" the city and Lake Okeechobee during the program.

A portion of the money had already been budgeted and approved by the commission during the fall budget talks. On Monday, the commission was asked to approve the rest of the \$20,000.

"I have a couple of questions about this," began Commissioner Petersen as she flipped through the pages of the contract. "A couple of years ago,

we were paying \$15,000 and I'm not quite sure how we got to \$20,000. ... I just want to make sure we're very diligent with what we're doing with this money."

Commissioner Petersen's question prompted a somewhat lengthy discussion about the contract and its impor-

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Inland Birding: Killdeer

Killdeer breed from Newfoundland, the south rim of the Hudson Bay, as well as southern Yukon and Northwest Territories south to central Mexico and the Gulf Coast states. Most breeding in Florida occurs from March through July. The fall migration of Killdeer in Florida is normally July through November, and spring migration occurs mainly in March and April.

Killdeer are a medium-sized slender and lanky plover with a long, pointed tail and long wings. Adults have a brown back and wings, a white belly and a white breast with two black bands.

Their rump is an orange-buff. The face and cap are brown with a white forehead and they have an orange-red eye ring. They have many calls which range from sharp "dee" to a nervous, babbling thrill.

They frequently use a "broken wing act" to distract predators from their nest, which is a shallow scrape, usually in bare sand or gravel, camouflaged with stones and blades of grass. When the predator is far from the precious nest, the killdeer suddenly "heals" and flies away.

Both parents share responsibility for the eggs, which usually hatch at 24 to 28 days. The chicks, which have almost the identical markings as the adults, are able to see and forage soon after

hatching. They usually fledge at 25 days old.

Although Killdeer are considered shorebirds, they often live far from water and can be seen and heard in fields.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HENDRY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE HENDRY COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 1-53, ZONING, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 1-53-6.13 AIRPORTS, SECTION 1-53-3 ZONING DISTRICTS, TABLE 53-1, AND SECTION 1-53-4 DIMENSIONAL AND DENSITY REGULATIONS, TABLE 53-2; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS OF LAW; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, INCLUSION IN CODE, AND SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A public hearing on the ordinance will be held before the Board of County Commissioners on March 25, 2014, at 5:05 p.m. in the Hendry County Courthouse, Commission Chambers, 25 East Hickpochee Avenue, LaBelle, Florida, to consider the recommendation of the Local Planning Agency and to discuss the ordinance. A second public hearing on the ordinance will be held before the Board of County Commissioners on April 8, 2014, at 5:05 p.m. in the Clewiston City Hall, Commission Chambers, 115 West Ventura Avenue, Clewiston, Florida, to consider the recommendation of the Local Planning Agency, to discuss the ordinance and to consider adopting the ordinance.




new businesses will bring over 50 new jobs to the area.



David and Goliath: Then and Now

The well-known story about the battle between David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17) brought a commentary from one source that caught my attention. He proffered that "the smart money would have been on David" among the crowds that were standing around to witness the fight between the seasoned and giant warrior and the small Israeli boy with no armor. His comment piqued my curiosity and I read further; he made a good point. David did not let Goliath define the fight that was to be.

David instead chose his own way of fighting against the seasoned warrior. His gift of a tunic and sword from Saul was rejected (1 Samuel 17:39); that was how the Philistine was going to fight, but he would not be the one to choose the weapons. Instead, five stones and a sling would bring Goliath down. David knew his weapons and how best to use them -- that makes all the difference. The motivations of the two also cannot be ignored. For Goliath, it was "simply another day at the office" (or battlefield in this case), and he would have fought the fight and then moved

on to the next one (1 Samuel 17:33).

For David, it was a matter of country, his people and his God that was at stake. "It's not the size of the dog in the fight, but the size of the fight in the dog," according to one aphorism; and that was the case here to change the odds. One physician pointed out that giant-sized persons tend to be clumsy, slow in motion (1 Samuel 17:4), and Samson was weighed down by armor, estimated to be about 125 pounds (ibid, v7) so that he needed a shield-bearer to go ahead of him. This will be a contest between a rapid, mobile, speedy contestant who can hit and run and then hit again, versus the lumbering giant who is slow, sluggish, hardly mobile -- the lumbering tank against the well-placed RPG.

In the downfall of Eve (Genesis 3), Satan causes Eve not to believe in herself, about what God has really said to her. He contradicts Eve and appeals to her senses (i.e. feelings) rather than her knowledge of God. David succumbs to none of these things. He knows his weapons; he accurately gauges his enemy, correctly assesses his strengths and weaknesses, he is committed to what he is doing at a very significant and profound level and he determines how the contest will take place. In our spiritual (and sometimes worldly) warfare, it is important to know our weapons and not let those who would defeat us

determine how the battles will take place.

I may not buy into your point of view, your way of looking at things, but my way may be no less valid than yours. I may listen to your persuasive arguments but that doesn't mean I have no viewpoint of my own. If I believe in what I am doing or saying, I will stand my ground. I will not be sent away in defeat with self-doubts or succumb to doing things that I think are wrong. I will make the best use of the resources at my command -- scriptures, reason, tradition, faith that has stood the test of time -- and in secular matters, likewise, the best resources I can gather. If I feel like the underdog, it will not matter, I will do my best and lay it on the line.

The Biblical accounts of what took place in times gone by are not merely, in my opinion, historical records, they have much to teach us. They were about real life then, they are about real life now. They are also a source of encouragement when we feel overwhelmed and want to give up. Sometimes it takes more than a cursory reading, but searching for what God may be saying is well worth it all. If you're doing God's work, if you're right, if you're not afraid: don't give up. God will sustain and victory will come.

cussed the possible dates, Commissioner Don Davis suggested the city of Clewiston relinquish their control of the city's parks to the Clewiston Recreation Board, just as the city of LaBelle did for the West County Recreation agreement.

"I don't think it's going to work unless the city of Clewiston relinquish their deal on their parks out here and turn it over to the rec board. And that will satisfy everybody. Let the rec board run the recreation. Then they won't have to put any more money in their parks, and that's it," said Commissioner Davis.

Chairman Karson Turner agreed, but both commissioners admitted it was up to the city of Clewiston, so April 8 was settled on as the possible date for the two commissions to meet.

Commissioners moved forward with the meeting, pushing back a discussion on a proposed MSTU for the Hendry County library system as the library board needed more time before bringing the proposition before the board.

County Administrator Charles Chapman then received approval from the commission for a ratification regarding the county's customer service standards and cost recovery analysis programs.

Chapman drafted guidelines for the county's

employees to follow concerning customer service, so that visitors of Hendry County feel welcomed by a friendly, knowledgeable staff.

Chapman also received approval to put in place a new fee structure, which would place higher tax subsidies on services that benefit the entire community and lower tax subsidies on services that benefit individual interests. In other words, services such as building permits, which have a higher individual than community benefit, would be financed using less tax money than a service that benefits the community as a whole, such as road maintenance.

Following the county administrator's staff report, Public Works Director Shane Parker discussed the ongoing maintenance of the Fort Denaud Bridge in LaBelle, which is currently inoperable due to a broken motor.

Parker asked the commission to allow his department to use more than \$10,000 to not only fix the broken motor, but also to buy a new motor.

With a second motor, Parker said, his crew could switch out the two motors and have the bridge up and running again in a matter of hours, should the original motor break again.

Commissioners voted to approve Parker's request and the meeting was adjourned thereafter.

The next Board of County Commissioners regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 25 in the LaBelle commission chambers.

tance to the city and county.

The commissioners agreed that Martin does a good job marketing Clewiston and Lake Okeechobee on the show, as well as during other events, such as the recent FLW fishing tournament, where Martin took the opportunity to market the lake during the televised weigh-in.

Commissioner Mali Gardner joined the conversation, saying she has watched the shows and believes they are positively affecting the community, but conceded that it would be beneficial to see how well the city's marketing dollars are working.

"They're great shows, but I just don't know if we need a more, I guess, formal accountability," said Commissioner Gardner. "But I've seen the program, I think it's worth it."

Commissioner Gardner made a motion to approve the contract with Scott Martin, but asked that the city manager meet with Martin to get feedback on the marketing aspect of the show.

After a short pause, Commissioner Julio Rodriguez seconded the motion and commissioners voted 4-0 (Commissioner James Pittman was not present) to approve the contract.

Update on Pension Plan

Gloria Rosen, who works for the city's new pension plan provider, Securian, was at the meeting to provide commissioners with an update on the progress of the new plan. The city entered into a contract with Securian last year

after terminating their contract with their old pension plan provider, Principal.

The city's pension fund had been frozen for a months before they made the switch.

Rosen had been working closely with commissioners and city employees during the transition, and her report at the night's meeting was received with optimism from the commissioners. The city's fund is on the upswing, and, in the words of Commissioner Rodriguez, the city is in "much better shape" now than it was previously.

Rosen will be making such updates quarterly to keep the commission and city employees informed on the progress of the fund.

Miscellaneous Items

Commissioners voted to approve the appointment of Luis Vallejo to the Community Redevelopment Agency's Advisory Committee.

Commissioners voted to approve a service agreement with Robbie Rush, who has been working as the Clewiston Golf Course's Golf Pro for the past several months under an informal contract.

This provides the city and Rush with a formal contract and binds him to the services under that contract until May 31, 2014, to be renewed annually by commission discretion.

Commissioners voted to approve a professional services agreement with Johnson Engineering, Inc. to update the city's water supply facilities -- a requirement from the South Florida Water Management District's Lower West Coast Water Supply Plan. The next city commission meeting will be held on April 21 in the Clewiston City Commission Chambers at 5 p.m.

Volunteer Income Tax Program

One couple who recently used VITA was told they were getting an \$8,000 refund. The wife began to cry and told the preparer about her recent operation and the accompanying medical bills which have prevented them from paying their mortgage. Now, they can catch up on their mortgage and pay their medical bills.

Volunteers at United Way Houses and other locations have prepared thousands of tax returns for area residents in the last five years. Volunteer tax preparers come from many walks of life and include college students, retired accountants and others who all receive training and certification from the IRS.

Their service to the community helps people

of low to middle income file their taxes for free and with the speedy e-file returns. The preparers check for potential tax deductions which are often overlooked and available to lower- to middle-income persons, such as the earned income tax credit and others.

Households making less than \$57,000 can have their taxes done for free at one of the 12 locations.

men donning dark clothing and face masks ran up to him while he was outside his home, pointing a gun at him and yelling, "Police!" The three men then allegedly forced the resident inside his home and handcuffed him, the victim reported.

The victim told deputies that while he was handcuffed, he was struck in the head by one of the men and was forced to lay face down on the floor.

A second person was also inside the home during the time of the alleged robbery. That per-

son was able to run out of the house before being caught by the men and brought back inside, where the men allegedly bound her with cords found inside the home, the release stated.

The men reportedly went through the home taking money and jewelry, before leaving in the victim's 2007 Toyota Corolla, which was later recovered.

Norovirus and How to Treat Symptoms

Norovirus is commonly called the “stomach flu,” though it is not related to any flu viruses. Noroviruses are found in the stool or vomit of infected people. Norovirus is highly contagious and may cause vomiting, diarrhea and stomach cramps. Anyone can be infected and get sick with noroviruses. Symptoms usually start within 24 to 48 hours and most people begin to feel better within one or two days and have no long-term health effects.

NOTE: People with Norovirus illness are contagious from the moment they begin feeling sick until at least three days after they recover. But, some people may be contagious for even lon-

ger.

There is no vaccine to prevent Norovirus infection and there is no drug to treat people who get sick from the virus. Antibiotics will not help if you have Norovirus illness. This is because antibiotics fight against bacteria, not viruses.

Norovirus can spread quickly from person to person in crowded, closed places. People can become infected with the virus in several ways including:

- Touching surfaces or objects contaminated with the virus, and then placing their hands in their mouth.

- Eating food or drinking liquids that have been contaminated with the virus, usually from the food handler not washing their hands properly.

- Eating food or drinking liquids that are contaminated with Norovirus when someone gets stool or vomit on their hands, and then touches the food or drink.

- Having direct contact with another person who is infected and showing symptoms, for example, caring for someone who is infected or sharing food or eating utensils with someone who is infected.

The best way to reduce chances of getting Norovirus is by following some simple tips:

- Wash hands frequently, especially after going to the bathroom, changing diapers, before eating and prior to preparing food.

- Carefully wash fruits and vegetables and cook foods completely before eating them.

- Clean and disinfect contaminated surfaces

immediately after an episode of illness by using bleach-based household cleaners.

- Immediately remove and wash clothing or linens that may be contaminated with the virus after an episode of illness (use hot water and soap).

- Flush or discard any vomit and/or stool in the toilet and clean the surrounding area.

People who have symptoms of vomiting or diarrhea should not prepare or handle food until they are completely free of symptoms and for at least three days after all symptoms are gone.

Suite of West Coast Projects Benefit Caloosahatchee Basin

Increased water storage and treatment also help to protect estuary

The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) held its monthly Governing Board meeting this month in Fort Myers and received an update on water resource projects to benefit the Caloosahatchee River and estuary.

The public meeting is part of a practice to conduct District business away from West Palm Beach headquarters several times a year, giving local residents increased opportunities to interact with the Board.

As part of the public meeting, SFWMD staff provided an update on key projects that are currently operating or underway to benefit the region.

Together, the projects are aimed at improving water quality and water storage throughout the Caloosahatchee basin, which will improve conditions in the coastal estuary, as well. Project descriptions and implementation status are listed below:

Nicodemus Slough

Reduces excess freshwater flows to the estu-

ary and provides 34,000 acre-feet of storage.

Clearing is complete, the main canal excavation is underway and the main pump is being manufactured.

Lake Hicpochee North

Provides shallow water storage of about 1,917 acre-feet and hydrologic restoration to portions of the lake.

Preliminary surveying and geo-technical investigations are completed. Engineering design began in December 2013.

C-43 West Basin Storage Reservoir

Reduces nutrients flowing to the Caloosahatchee River and improves the salinity balance in the estuary by storing water on the site. Capacity at the reservoir will be 170,000 acre-feet.

Design and environmental assessments are complete and construction is pending Congressional authorization. The site is currently being utilized to store excess water that would otherwise flow to the river and estuary.

Four Corners

Provides water storage and treatment improvements in Hendry County and stores 300 acre-feet of water in the Bob Janes Preserve in Lee County.

Design and permitting of the Hendry County flowway is scheduled to be complete in May. The Lee County component is complete and operating.

Lehigh Headwaters – Mirror Lakes

Rehydrates Mirror Lakes Preserve with 1,000 acre-feet of storage, restores flow south of State Road 82 with 500 acre-feet of storage and moves water to the Estero watershed with 2,000 acre-feet of storage.

Mirror Lakes preserve work is complete; other work is ongoing in a cooperative effort with multiple agencies and partners.

Lehigh Headwaters – Southwest Weirs

Reduces phosphorus and nitrogen flowing to the river; provides 1,000 acre-feet of storage.

Permits have been acquired and construction is set to begin in October.

Charlotte Harbor Flatwoods

Restores more natural flows to Charlotte Harbor, stores and treats water, recharges ground water supplies and improves wildlife habitat.

Work is ongoing in a cooperative effort with multiple agencies and partners.

North Six-Mile Cypress Preserve

Provides 1,400 acre-feet of storage and restores historic sheet flow.

Permits are being finalized and construction is set to be complete in June.

Southern CREW Wetland Restoration

Restores the hydrology and ecology of 4,150 acres.

Design is complete and permitting has been initiated.

Picayune Strand Restoration

Restores and enhances 72,000 acres of wetlands and improves the water quality of coastal estuaries.

Pump stations are under construction and the Manatee Mitigation Feature is in design.
