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Fire Burns Through Montura

Residents were evacuated as the fire continued to burn 75 acres

Residents of Montura Ranch Estate's Brida Street were asked to evacuate their homes in the evening of May 28 as a brush fire moved through the area, burning approximately 75 total acres, according to Clewiston Fire Chief Rob Hunton.

The fire started around 2 p.m. on Wednesday, May 28 and saw about 60 fire fighters from more than five different agencies helping to fight the flames, which took nearly seven hours to contain 100 percent, said Chief Hunton.

Residents who evacuated from their homes were directed to the Montura Ranch Clubhouse, and were allowed back into their homes before nightfall. Though the fire burned through a residential area, Chief Hunton said the fire did not destroy any structures and no one was injured. The Division of Forestry is currently investigating the cause of the fire, which remains undetermined.

The Woman Who Left Her Christmas Lights Burning

She was aware of the stares and whispers she probably received from people driving by who wondered why, in June, she still had a large tree blazing with Christmas lights in her front yard.

In her defense, she certainly wasn't prepared to leave the tree lit with shimmering lights year-round, each night, from dusk until midnight.

"I know Christmas is over. People ride by and wonder why they're on. It doesn't change anything, but it's my way of being close to him. It was sudden, and I'm still having a hard time," said Patricia Pearcy, who began leaving the tree lit each night shortly after April 8, 2013.

More than a year after her husband's passing, Patricia has found a way to feel closer to the man she loved by leaving a tree wrapped in lights lit each night.

"He liked to put lights up on the tree. He never would let me put the lights up," said Patricia. "I wanted him to know that the lights are always on."

Patricia's late husband, Charles E. Pearcy, was a Vietnam veteran and a quiet, compassionate man who Patricia said kept to himself. The two would have been married 35 years this month.

"He was proud to be a Vietnam veteran and to have served his country. I wasn't with him when he served, but he told me stories. He talked about it when we watched war movies," said Patricia.

Charles spent many a night watching his favorite movies in the shed he dubbed his "man cave." Decked in sports memorabilia and equipped with a cushy sofa and mini fridge, Charles' man cave was his escape and place to relax.

"He was a quiet person. He loved the people at the VFW. He participat-

ed in a lot of their activities. He was a helpful, compassionate man. He treated me good."

"The night we met, I talked to him like I knew him forever. I told him stuff I didn't even know I told him. We got along. He was a good person. And he had a bigger afro then than he did in that picture," said Patricia, pointing at a 70s-era family portrait hanging on the wall behind where she sat.

Charles was taken from Patricia suddenly and without warning. Suffering a heart attack and undergoing surgery from which he woke, Patricia

A 'Dear John' Letter Worth Sharing

Is there any son or daughter in this world who is not thrilled by the declaration of, "I'm proud of you," from a parent? I know how it was for me. Few things in my life have ever touched me as much as the words my dad shared with me in the first letter I ever received from him. In many ways, it helped bring the "Prodigal" back home. My dad is gone now, but the blessing of that letter lives on. It's a 28-year-old "Dear John" letter worth sharing.

I had my mind made up, and did not care to be confused by the facts. I was critical of your friends, and thus alienated you and never really re-established a close bond with you. I regret that now, and if I had the opportunity to re-run that part of the race, I would move up to scouts when you did, to try to gain back the son that I had 'lost' with a few hasty words.

"You are in the correct field. From the time you were in senior high, I began to see the po-

tential, and it really came out while you were in college. I felt that ministry was where you belonged, but I was not the one to whom you came for advice in those days. I will admit that I was quite pleased when you finally made the decision to enter the ministry, and I am very proud of you and your accomplishment in dedicating yourself to a life of service to others. You will never know the sense of pride we felt at your ordination. Your mother stood and walked alone for the first time after the accident, and held her head high the whole way down the aisle. That event inspired her to do what very few believed could be done.

"Your accomplishments in school, in scouts, and now as a person, have been sources of pride to us which you

will recognize when you have children of your own. The greatest gift any parent can receive is to have a child do well, and the highest feelings of ecstasy are realized in the accomplishments of your offspring. When you do well, we glory.

"Keep up your good works, son, and hold the hand of Him whom you have vowed to follow. Your earthly parents love you very much, and are very proud of you. Your Heavenly Father must be even more so. Love, Dad."

I hope each of you parents is smart enough to tell your children how proud you are of them. But not just parents -- grandparents, aunts, uncles, teachers, coaches, friends, neighbors and everyone else! Just as God said to Jesus, "You are my beloved son. 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Locking Restrictions to be Implemented on Okeechobee

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Jacksonville District has announced restrictions on lock operations on the Okeechobee Waterway due to falling water levels on Lake Okeechobee. Effective Thursday, June 5, locking operations at the W.P. Franklin Lock & Dam near Fort Myers and the St. Lucie Lock & Dam near Stuart will be conducted every two hours from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily. This action is the result of the water level at Lake Okeechobee falling below 12.5 feet. "This is standard operating procedure whenever the lake falls below 12.5 feet" said Steve Dunham, Chief of the Corps' South Florida Operations Office. "We encourage boaters to be aware of the lake level and consider that drafts will continue to decrease if the lake drops more in coming weeks." The updated schedule means that lockages will occur at Franklin and St. Lucie at 7 a.m., 9 a.m., 11 a.m., 1 p.m., 3 p.m., 5 p.m., and 7 p.m. Operations at the other three locks,

Ortona, Moore Haven, and Port Mayaca, will continue on demand between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Should the lake drop below 11.5 feet, additional reductions in service will be necessary.

was on her way home from the hospital after visiting with Charles when she received the call from the nurse.

"When he woke up from surgery, I told him everything was going to be OK. But he looked at me and shook his head 'no.' I knew he didn't want me to stay. I feel guilty, but I also knew he wouldn't want me to. I just didn't get to say goodbye," said Patricia. "I go to the cemetery and tell him about the grandbabies and our sons. I have two lights up there that I try to keep burning."

Charles worked for nearly 20 years in the

maintenance department of the Army Corps of Engineers. He was loved by all he worked with, said Patricia, and had a carpentry shop dedicated in his name at the Army Corps campus. Patricia said Charles' former coworkers wave at his shop every morning on their way into work to say "hello" to their old friend.

"I never thought I'd be in this situation. Nobody does, nobody knows. I try to tell everyone to enjoy people while you have them. I don't take anything for granted now," Patricia said.

Patricia knows that time heals all and said she is just "waiting for that time" to come. In the meantime, she is leaving the lights on for her one true love.

"It may not sound like anything to anybody else, but it's important to me and it's special. It's my way of having him around," she said.



Fever in Children

If you're a parent, you've probably experienced this scenario: You wake up in the middle of the night to find your child flushed, hot and sweaty. Your little one's forehead feels warm. You immediately suspect a fever, but are unsure of what to do next. Should you get out the thermometer or call the emergency room?

In healthy kids, typically, fevers don't indicate anything serious. Although it can be frightening when your child's temperature rises, on the average, a fever causes no harm and can sometimes be a good thing – it's often the body's way of fighting infections – both bacterial and viral.

Fever occurs when the body's internal thermostat raises the body temperature above its normal level. A normal temperature is about 98.6 F, when taken orally (by mouth). Temperatures taken rectally (by rectum) usually run one degree higher than those taken orally.

What Causes Fever?

It's important to remember that fever by itself is not an illness. It's usually a symptom of an underlying problem. Fever has several potential causes:

Infection: Most fevers are caused by infection or other illnesses. Fever helps the body fight infections by stimulating natural defense mechanisms.

- **Overdressing:** Infants, especially newborns, may get fevers if they're over-bundled or in a hot environment because they don't regulate their body temperature as well as older children. However, because fevers in newborns can indicate serious infections, even infants who are overdressed must be evaluated by a doctor if they have a fever.

- **Immunizations:** Babies and children sometimes get low-grade fevers after getting vaccinated.

- **Teething:** Although teething may cause a slight rise in body temperature, it's probably not the cause if a child's temperature is higher than 100 F.

When Is It Serious?

In the past, doctors advised treating a fever on the basis of temperature alone. Now, however, they recommend considering both the temperature and the child's overall condition.

Kids whose temperatures are lower than 102 F often don't require medication, unless they're uncomfortable. There's one important exception to this rule: If you have an infant three months or younger with a rectal temperature of 100.4 F or higher, call your doctor or go to the emergency room immediately. Even a slight fever can be a sign of a potentially serious infection in very young infants.

If your child is between three months and three years old and has a fever of 102.2 F or higher, call a physician to see if your child needs to be seen. For older children, take behavior and activity levels into consideration. Your child is probably NOT serious if he/she is still interested in playing, eating and drinking well, is alert and smiling, has normal skin color and looks well when temperature comes down.

Don't worry too much if your child has a fever, but doesn't want to eat. This is common with infections that cause fever. More important-

ly, make certain your child drinks and urinates normally.

How Can I Know If My Child Has a Fever?

Sometimes a gentle kiss on the forehead or a hand placed lightly on your child's skin is enough to give you a hint that your child has a fever. The most reliable method is using a thermometer. Your child has a fever if his/her temperature is at or above one of these levels: 100.4 F measured rectally; 99.5 F measured orally; or 99 F measured under the arm.

Because fevers may rise and fall, a child with a fever might experience chills, as the body tries to generate additional heat and as its temperature begins to rise. The child may sweat as the body releases extra heat when the temperature begins to drop.

Sometimes, kids with fever breathe faster than usual and may have a higher heart rate. You should call the doctor if your child is having difficulty breathing, is breathing faster than normal, or continues to breathe fast after the fever comes down.

Helping Your Child to Feel Better

Here are ways to alleviate symptoms that accompany a fever, which makes your child feel uncomfortable or fussy:

Give acetaminophen or ibuprofen, based on the package recommendation for age or weight. If you don't know the recommended dosage, or if your child is younger than two years, call the doctor to find out how much to give. Remember that fever medication will usually temporarily bring a temperature down, but it will not return it to normal – and it won't treat the underlying reason for the fever. Never give aspirin to a child, due to its association with Reye syndrome, a rare and potentially fatal disease. Infants who are under two months old should not be given medication for fever without being evaluated by a doctor. If your child has any medical problems, check with a physician to see which medication is best to use.

Giving a sponge bath can make your child more comfortable and help bring the fever down. Use only lukewarm water; cool water may cause shivering, which actually raises the body temperature. Never use alcohol (it can cause poisoning when absorbed through the skin). Never use ice packs/cold baths (they can cause chills that may raise body temperature).

- Dress your child in lightweight clothing and cover with a light sheet or blanket. Overdressing and over-bundling can prevent body heat from escaping and can cause temperature to rise.

- Offer plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration – a fever will cause a child to lose fluids more rapidly.

- If your child is also vomiting and/or has diarrhea, ask the doctor if you should give an electrolyte (rehydration) solution made especially for kids.

- If your child wants to eat – let him/her, but don't force eating.

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What do you like to do for fun? I like to spend time with my family. We enjoy cooking and going to church.

Do you have children? I have one son. His name is Cort and he is two years old.



When to Call a Doctor

The exact temperature that should trigger a call to the doctor depends on the age of the child, the illness, and whether the child has other symptoms associated with the fever. (If your child has a rash with the fever, take him/her to the nearest emergency room as quickly as possible.)

Call a doctor if you have:

- an infant younger than three months with a temperature of 100.4 F or higher.

- an older child with a temperature higher than 102.2 F.

Call a doctor if an older child has a fever of less than 102.2 F but also:

- refuses fluids or seems too ill to drink adequately

- has persistent diarrhea or repeated vomiting

• has any sign of dehydration (urinating less than usual, not having tears when crying, less alert and less active than usual)

- has a specific complaint (sore throat, earache, etc.)

• still has a fever after 24 hours in kids (younger than two years) or 72 hours (in kids two years or older)

Trust your instincts – if you suspect your child is sick – you're probably right. You know your child better than anyone.
