Pahokee Planting Seeds of Hope

Pahokee High School and University of Michigan alums erect community garden

Vincent Smith and Brandin Hawthorne have always wanted to give back to their hometown.

Less than a year after graduating from the University of Michigan, the former Pahokee football standouts came up with a plan to erect a community garden for the city's residents.

With assistance from the Pahokee Housing Authority (PHA) and the Pahokee Deliverance Christian Center (PDCC), Smith and Hawthorne began their special project in August and have made significant progress

over the past several weeks.

"We want to provide our community with fresh fruits and vegetables," Smith said. "We want to do something positive for our people and provide them with a healthy opportunity."

So far, the tandem has planted an assortment of sunflower seeds, plantains and sugar cane in the garden, which is located on a lot between the PHA and PDCC facilities. The creation can be viewed by taking a ride through South Lake Avenue in the

Bridging the Gap

Pahokee residents voice concerns about relationship with PBSO

Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) officials met with Pahokee residents on Sept. 25 in a town hall meeting to discuss the growing concern of violence and the department's lack of concern and commitment for the area.

Residents were concerned that crime is becoming a daily occurrence, but Chief Deputy Michael Gauger said, according to their statistics, crime is actually down.

He explained that from January to September 2008, they received over 14,500 calls with 1,357 of those calls being crime-related. The year-

to-date calls were around 18,000 with only 657 of them being crime related, which translates to a 52 percent decrease in the city's crime rate.

"We have a long ways to go, but the Pahokee we have today has taken a lot of work," said Major Tony Araujo.

Lieutenant Rey Alonso echoed the Chief's statistics and reports that the city has seen only two robberies in 2013, as opposed to the 25 in 2008.

"Year-to-date we have had three, possibly four, homicides," he said. "One murder is too many; three is

Glades Day Defeats Agape Christian in 26-6 Win

Glades Day has been surprisingly good this season.

Without All-American running back Kelvin Taylor (now a freshman at the University of Florida) and head coach Pete Walker (now at Clewiston High School), it was supposed to be a down year for the Gators. There was even talk that the seven-time state champions would not even make the playoffs this season.

After five games played, Glades Day has proven its doubters wrong and is the Muck's only undefeated high school football team at 5-0.

On Friday, Sept. 27, Glades Day

put on a defensive performance to remember against Agape Christian (Orlando) in its 26-6 home win, limiting the opposition to a total of three yards.

How did that happen?

Glades Day limited Agape Christian quarterback Cameron Stroud to three-of-six passing for 41 yards and a nine-yard touchdown run in the third quarter -- the Gators were up 21-6 at that point -- while Agape's Jarvis Voles went two-of-seven passing for six yards.

Glades Day's front seven completely locked down Agape Christian's running game, as the Orlando team finished with -47 yards on the ground.

"Anytime you hold a team to just three yards, you have to be proud of it," Glades Day Head Coach Eric Pitts said. "It doesn't happen very often."

Glades Day junior linebacker Titus Johnson recovered a fumble at the Agape 10-yard run and ran it in for a touchdown, which gave his team a 7-0 lead in the first quarter.

Covenant Villas

First there was Hurricane Wilma in 2005, and then the economic downturn: two major factors in the gradual deterioration of apartments at Covenant Villas, a 144-unit rental apartment community in Belle Glade. Now, thanks to the recent award of \$500,000 in federal funding by the Board of County Commissioners, major renovations can get underway.

The rehabilitation project was selected to receive U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnerships Program loan financing through a competitive bid process issued by the Department of Economic Sustainability.

The owner, manager and developer of the project was NOAH Development Corp., a nonprofit organization with a 25-year history of helping to provide decent, affordable rental homes to low-income residents of Belle Glade, including residents with special needs, farm workers and the elderly. Cash flow from rents has diminished over recent years, limiting NOAH's ability to undertake maintenance and repairs. As a result, more than 80 units at Covenant Villas are now vacant. This funding will enable NOAH to reconstruct the dilapidated units and get them rented, which will increase cash reserves and enable NOAH to make the remaining needed repairs.

"Safe and decent affordable housing is particularly critical for the Glades, which suffers from high poverty and unemployment," said District 6 County Commissioner Jess Santamaria. "This project furthers the county's commitment to improve housing conditions and overall quality of life issues."

Enhanced Contractor Enrollment

PZB's New Program Speeds Up Contractor Enrollment County-wide.

The Palm Beach County Planning, Zoning and Building (PZB) Department is making it easier for construction contractors to do business throughout Palm Beach County.

Currently, contractors must enroll with the county to work in unincorporated areas. They must also enroll with individual municipalities to work in incorporated areas. That's a lot of time and paperwork and could also mean a lot of money.

To speed things up, contractors who enroll with Palm Beach County will now have their information available to participating municipalities without having to re-enroll. Member cities have the option of accessing the information through the county's website, or they can employ an automated process to obtain information. Initially, 12 municipalities are taking part in the program, and others are expected to sign on soon. Attention Hunters

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission would like to announce that they will be issuing permits for two wild hog control hunts on Fisheating Creek Wildlife Management Area, west of U.S. 27, to residents of Glades and Hendry counties.

The two hog control hunts will be held on Oct. 26 and 27, and Nov. 2 and 3. There will be 25 permits issued for each hunt. Permits will be available on a first-come, first-served basis to individuals 16 years of age or older. Permit distribution will take place at the Fisheating Creek WMA check-station at the FEC Campground in Palmdale on Saturday, Oct. 19, beginning at 10 a.m. Individuals must be present to receive a permit; permits cannot be picked up by another individual.

Permittees will be allowed to take wild hogs with no size or bag limit. The use of dogs is prohibited. Firearms will be limited to a shotgun with #1 buckshot or larger.

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

years, and we felt she deserved to be given back to by her community and that is what we are here for," said Mr. Key.



Palm Tran Announces New Fares and Route Improvements

Effective Oct. 7, Palm Beach County's public transportation system, Palm Tran, will implement a new fare structure for all its services, as well as make improvements to nine popular routes. These changes to the transit system were approved by the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing on Aug. 13 as part of the Fiscal Year 2013/14 budget process.

It has been five years since Palm Tran's last fare increase. The service improvements include adding earlier and/or later service to five routes

(4, 20, 31, 40 and 64), improving the frequency of Route 62 on weekdays to every 20 minutes and extending Route 73 to serve the new Bethesda Hospital West.

These changes, as recommended by Palm Tran's Service Board, are intended to improve service and service reliability.

In the Fiscal Year 2013, Palm Tran averaged 40,000 passenger trips every weekday. For bus route and schedule information, please call the customer service department at 561-841-4287.

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

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

heart of Pahokee.

"This project just came from our hearts," Smith said. "We're not looking to gain anything from it."

The close friends received the lot from Willie Hickman Jr., a pastor at PDCC and their former coach when they played for the Pahokee Baby Blue Devils as youngsters.

PHA Director Julia Hale has also played an integral role in the project, as she and her organization helped them go through the proper channels in order to gain approval for the movement's launch.

Urban GreenWorks, a planting company based in Miami, provided the plants for the garden and has worked closely with Smith and Hawthorne in their endeavor.

"We have a lot of agriculture in our area, so it just made sense to team up with a company that has experience in building community gardens," Smith said.

Urban GreenWorks provides environmental

projects and food security programming to a variety of communities in South Florida, including Liberty City, Little Haiti and Opa Locka in Miami.

The Pahokee community garden is the first of its kind in Palm Beach County.

"The concept of this program is for the community to become a food producer," said James

Jiler, executive director for Urban GreenWorks. "This is a model of how much food you can develop in a small space. Organic foods are considered to be expensive to purchase, but with the fertile soil this area has, it can be developed here. It's the first time we've taken our work from the city to a rural area. We're looking forward to help

make it a success."

A host of trees, shrubs and tropical foods will be grown over a period of time, according to Jiler.

"The community is going to be the ones who build it and take care of it," Jiler said. "If this one works out, then we can see a garden of this magnitude being produced in another part of Pahokee or even Belle Glade."

Pahokee City Commissioner Diane Walker has also been a solid supporter of the community garden project.

"It's awesome that they came back home to provide some social services to our citizens," Walker said. "It's refreshing to see a group of young men taking the time out of their schedules to care for the community. They should be commended for venturing out to make the city of Pahokee a better place." The community garden project is ongoing, and will continue with a series of planting and gate-painting opportunities that will be available to students from Canal Point Elementary, Pahokee Elementary, Pahokee Middle School and Pahokee High School in the near future. 

Average retail gasoline prices in Florida have fallen 5.4 cents per gallon in the past week, averaging \$3.33/g yesterday, according to GasBuddy's daily survey of 8,237 gas outlets in Florida. This compares with the national average that has fallen 5.8 cents per gallon in the last week to \$3.43/g, according to gasoline price website GasBuddy.com.

Including the change in gas prices in Florida during the past week, prices yesterday were 35.7 cents per gallon lower than the same day one year ago and are 22.2 cents per gallon lower than a month ago. The national average has decreased 18.8 cents per gallon during the last month and stands 36.6 cents per gallon lower than this day one year ago.



crazy. Someone knows who committed these crimes.”

Some residents voiced concerns that deputies are addressing them with a tone of arrogance when interacting with the public in traffic stops or calls. The residents felt that because the deputies are from the coast they do not seem to appreciate the lifestyle or circumstances of the Glades and asked officials to be more diligent about hiring local officers.

Lt. Alonso stated that PBSO makes every effort to hire officers from the Glades and the officers that are in Pahokee are there because they have chosen to be assigned to the area.

“Out of 12 deputies, only three have ever left.

One became a pilot, another for medical reasons and the last for training because there was not enough crime here for him to train. ... The rest are here because they want to be and are very involved in the community,” said Lt. Alonso, pointing out an off-duty deputy who requested per-

Major Araujo also assured the residents that the officers want to be in the city of Pahokee and that many of them are involved in various community projects.

one night and saw a woman handing items to a male from an abandoned home. Although deputies responded to the call, they could not properly handle the situation because they could not determine whose property the home was.

After much investigation, it was determined that the home was bank-owned and the suspects were arrested and pled guilty to burglary. Ms. Anderson explained that the woman began making harassing statements and gestures towards her when she saw her around town.

Ms. Anderson informed a deputy who quickly resolved the matter by informing the woman that harassing witnesses was a crime and she would be arrested if any further incidents occurred.

Lt. Alonso requested the residents become more involved with the deputies and in the community. He assured them that he would address many of their concerns and asked them to come forward with tips in unsolved cases.

“We will be addressing the loitering complaints and stepping up patrols for the business owners,” said Lt. Alonso. “We are committed to the community. We are here to stay.”

The course and all materials are free, but a commitment for the entire five-week course is required. Seating is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.


