Was Filed Against One Hundred and Twenty Texas Milling Companies.

Austin, Tex., Nov. 9.—An anti-trust suit was filed this afternoon by the attorney general in the district against the 120 Texas milling companies, alleged to be in conspiracy in restraint of the trade. The state claims that the defendant companies have violated both the 1899 and the 1903 acts, and asks for penalties against each defendant in the sum of \$75,000, for the alleged violation of the act of 1899, and \$56,250 for violations of the act of 1903. The state also asks for judgment of the forfeiture of the charter rights and franchises of each domestic corporation and cancelling the permit to each foreign corporation and for an injunction perpetually enjoining the defendants from transacting any further business in the state.

Texas Treasury Pinched.

Austin, Tex., Nov. 9.—The refusal of the state depository banks to supply the necessary cash, has forced the state treasurer to suspend payment of state warrants, all the available cash in the hands of the treasurer having become exhausted. In the different depositories the state has on deposit \$1,504,637, amply secured by approved securities and personal bonds. Several of the banks have offered to furnish exchange for the amounts deposited by the treasurer, but declare they cannot supply the actual cash.

Killed for a Quarter.

One negro killed another at Wisconsin on the night of October 26 over 25 cents, the first killing the history of Wisconsin.

George Greene, colored, was fatally shot in the head by another negro, January Adams. It is said that negroes were gambling in a shanty on the place and one of them owed George Greene 25 cents, which he went there to collect. The man who owed him refused to pay the debt; then Adams paid same. Afterwards several hot words were passed between Greene and Adams. Adams, later in the night, about 2 o'clock, met and shot Greene in the head. Greene had threatened his life and said that he (Greene) was determined to kill him (Adams) that night. Greene had been drinking.

He did not die immediately, but was taken to his house on Sunday and lived until Friday, 3 o'clock p. m., and was buried Saturday. Adams is in jail at Brooksville.
