INSTRUCTIONS

How to Qualify to Become Voters in the Primary Election.

All persons from other States who will have resided in this State one year, and in Marion County six months prior to April 11, 1904, are entitled to register.

Any person who has never heretofore registered in this county must register with the district supervisor of registration at the central office at the courthouse, and obtain a registration certificate.

Any citizen of this state who has moved in to Marion County and who will have resided in this county six months prior to April 11, 1904 (the last day for registration), must register with the district supervisor of registration in the district in which he now resides, or with the supervisor of registration at the courthouse.

In case of the removal of a person from one district to another district in this county, such person must, in person, notify the supervisor of registration at the courthouse of such change of residence and obtain a certificate of transfer, which is given without cost.

It is also necessary to pay poll taxes for the years 1902 and 1903 not later than April 29, 1904; provided that no person who has not been in this state one year previous to any general election or who has arrived at the age of twenty-one years during 1902 shall be required to pay more than one year's poll taxes, and shall obtain a non-liability certificate for the year 1902.

All persons who have arrived at the age of twenty-one years after January 1, 1903, or are fifty-five years of age and over, or who have lost a limb in battle, are exempt from the payment of any poll taxes, and should obtain a non-liability certificate for 1902 and 1903, from the supervisor of registration.

No person can participate in the primary election, to be held May 19, 1904, unless he is properly registered in the election district in which he now lives, and has paid his poll taxes for 1902 and 1903, except in cases noted above.
