It was thought the raising of the \$1000 would be an easy matter in the long run.

Mr. Syd. L. Carter strenuously refused to be named as president, so Attorney W. H. Hampton was named.

Mr. Miller moved that the association take a page in the T.-U. and C. to exploit Gainesville's winsome and irresistible capital attractions, but judicious Editor McCreary amended Miller's resolution that nothing be done along this line until a sufficient amount was collected to enter the race. The amendment was adopted.

A finance committee was then authorized to be appointed by the president and the meeting adjourned until next Tuesday.

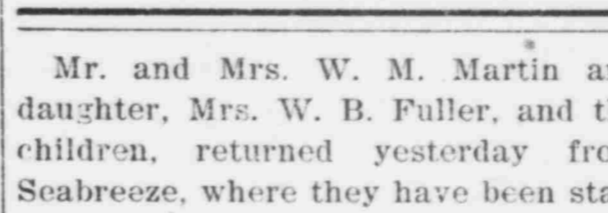

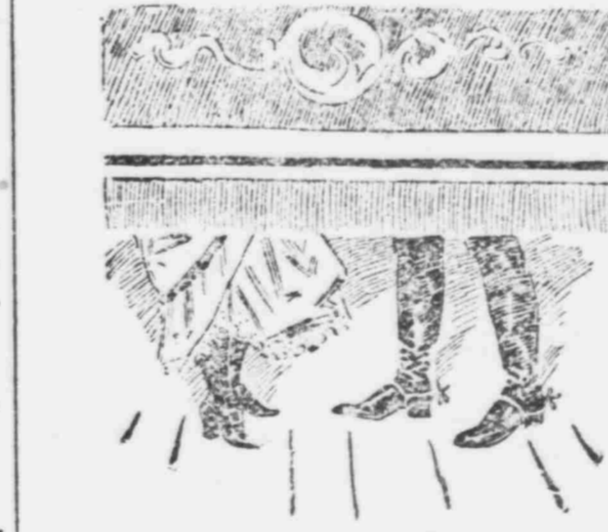

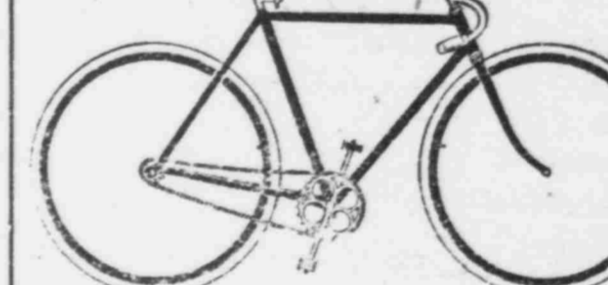
