## MINERS REFUSE TERMS

Satisfied With Their Strength, the Representatives of the Strikers Decline to Call Off the Strike

Scranton, Pa., Oct. 13.—Seven hundred delegates, representing the United Mine Workers, met here today in response to the call of President Mitchell, to consider the acceptance of the offer of 10 per cent. increase in wages made by the operators.

The convention failed to call off the strike at today's sessions, and the general sentiment seems to be strongly against accepting the offer of an increase.

The leaders of the convention are insisting that further demands and concessions be stipulated before a cessation of the strike is permitted. The miners seem conscious of their power, and are disposed to make the operators come to strictest terms before going back to work.

It can be safely said that the present convention will refuse to make a settlement, and that the strike will continue until some other terms are proposed.
