### BOTHA BROUGHT TO BOOK

British Capture Biggest Boer General and 300 Soldiers, with Cannon and Cattle

London, Feb. 28.—The war office received cable advices from Lord Kitchener today, stating that Gen. French had succeeded in capturing three hundred Boers and their guns. This result was brought about by a trap laid by Gen. French for the Boer invaders of Cape Colony.

Influenced by this reverse and Gen. De Wet's repulse, Gen. Botha, the Boer commander-in-chief, surrendered to Lord Kitchener.

### FLORIDA SHERIFFS

In response to a call made by Sheriff P. H. Nugent, a dozen of the sheriffs of the state met at Gainesville Tuesday. As the attendance was too small the meeting adjourned to meet in Jacksonville, March 14, to which every sheriff of the state is invited, also chiefs of police and marshals of cities.

The object of the meeting was to formulate plans to assist each other in the chase and arrest of criminals and to attempt to better the criminal laws of the state by an appeal to the next legislature. More stringent laws against carrying concealed weapons and gambling is desired, with severer penalties than now exist.
