The early melons sold well and the Georgia crop being late, the later ones have been bringing fairly good prices. Contrary to the rule of former years, the buyers have come to the growers, and consequently the latter have received their money on the ground, and while sometimes the price was not as high as might have been obtained by shipping, no risk was taken.

The vegetable crop, too, has been above the average, and with a promising general crop and the biggest cotton crop in years, the country should be reasonably prosperous.

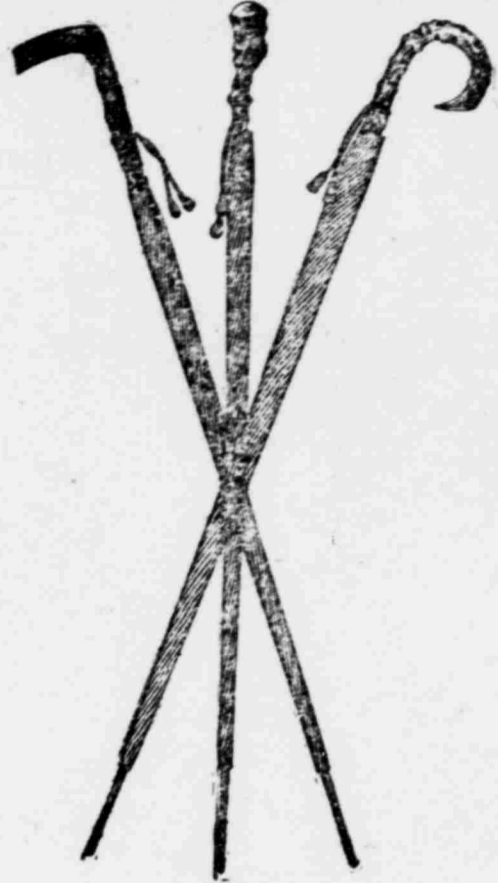
