## Teacher organizes effort to send books to students in Bahamas

MARTIN COUNTY — Where there were once mismatched, mildewed and incomplete texts on student's desks in Eleuthera, Bahamas will now sit gently used, updated and complete sets of learning materials thanks to efforts from a Martin County teacher.

With changes to the Common Core curriculum and new books to go along with it, there were suddenly

hundreds of books, only a few years old, which no longer had any purpose.

Tiffany Reddick wasn't the only one desirous of keeping those materials out of a landfill, but she was the one who offered a solution.

Twice she has gone on mission trips over summer break to the Bahamas and served at a local primary school. She noticed while cleaning out the school's library that their books were old and in poor repair. She knew Martin County

Schools would be receiving new ones soon, so she asked if the Eleuthera schools could benefit from Martin County's old ones.

"It seemed criminal to throw all those books out," Ms. Reddick said.

The answer was a resounding yes. So, when she returned home this summer, she brought the proposal

to the administration at

## Family perseveres through adversity

STUART — Since 2010, through all the ups and downs, good times and bad, the thing that has held the Bicknell family together is their incredible love for each other.

In 2010 Barry and Kathy Bicknell's youngest son, Casey, was in an accident at the Palm Beach International Raceway. The car Casey was driving on the drag strip track went out of control and crashed, leaving him in a coma for six months.

The traumatic brain injury he sustained required brain surgery and neurologists warned the Bicknell family that Casey may never recover,

but they refused to give up hope.

They took him to a hospital in Atlanta that specializes in treating his condition and against all odds Casey returned to consciousness.

Mr. Bicknell knew he couldn't sit idly by and let Casey fight to recover on his own, so he retired from banking, took a nursing course to learn how to care for Casey at home, and took him to the Florida Institute for Neurological Rehabilitation, where he has been for the last three years.

Statistics state that most families in their situation crumble under the pressure of such a hardship, but not the Bicknells. "I think if this family's

love wasn't this strong, we wouldn't stand a chance," Mr. Bicknell said.

He admits it's been tough, but his family has risen to the challenge.

Mr. Bicknell spends his weekdays in Wauchula at FINR, staying in a mobile home apartment at night and helping Casey with his therapy during the day. Mrs. Bicknell remains in Stuart, working as a pharmaceutical representative for the steady income and insurance coverage. Their older daughter Brittany is preparing to graduate with a bachelor's of science in nursing.

"On the family standpoint we're quite fractured," Mr. Bicknell said, but he doesn't want Casey

## Donation brings project to middle school

A \$20,000 donation from a local philanthropist made it possible for Tykes and Teens to finally bring Project Northland to Indiantown Middle School.

It's the same alcohol and drug prevention program already implemented in the other four middle schools in Martin County.

Since 2008, Indiantown Middle School has been the only Martin County Middle School without such a pro-

gram. Tykes and Teens, a nonprofit organization dedicated to serving area children and their families, heads up programs in the other schools, but never had funding for Indiantown, until now.

"We're really excited to be able to expand the program to the western end of the community," said Darcy Flieri, Tykes and Teens Director of Prevention.

The donation for Project Northland, a comprehensive prevention program designed to modify community attitudes toward youth

substance use, came from Elisabeth Lahti. Her name is synonymous with charitable giving in Martin County where the library in Indiantown bears her name.

"She is a generous and wonderfully kind individual," said Paula Hundt, Tykes and Teens director of development.

It was Ms. Hundt who spoke to Lahti last year and introduced her to Project Northland. When she explained that Indiantown had a need that a lack of funding wouldn't allow Tykes

and Teens to fill, Ms. Lahti jumped at the chance to help.

The \$20,000 will go toward purchasing books in several languages, educating teachers and providing funding so the students can take part in community-wide projects like the Project Northland Poster Contest.

The program will only be implemented in the sixth grade this year, but will continue into the seventh and eighth grades in the next two years. The students will explore myths of underage drinking, learn to say no to

drugs and alcohol and research the effects of alcohol on the teen brain.

"Every young person can benefit from having the correct information," Ms. Hundt said. "We think it's a great start for the children and look forward to growing the classes each year."

Ms. Flieri said the \$20,000 will go quite a way toward providing the students with materials and counseling, but Tykes and Teens is always looking for new donors and

ber in the fine print. This is the stock number of the advertised car and is the dealer's defense for having only one car at that low price. Even if you are able to read the fine print, seeing something like "#6339A" is not something that would give anyone a clue that this means there's only one car available at this price.

I've written many articles about the infamous "Dealer Fee." There's another very common trick that most dealers use that is equally prevalent and deceptive, called dealer installed options.

Dealer installed options are products that have very low cost and value that have huge markups. Typically they are preinstalled on all of the dealer's cars in inventory, with the exception of a few "ad cars." These ad cars are ordered in small quantities, stripped of factory accessories and often without even an automatic transmission. They are typically ordered in the least desirable color and trim. The advertised car also either pays no commission to the salesman or a very small one. Typically only one car is available and when you ask to see it, the salesman will tell you it's been sold.

The advertisement will sometimes say, "Many cars are available at similar prices" or words to the effect that there is more than one, but they are all priced higher than the one car advertised. The dealers will put a stock num-

passed along to the car buyer for more profit to the dealer. The bottom line is that the car advertised for \$14,988 really cost \$15,985, almost a thousand dollars more!

What I've described above is the rule, not the exception, with most South Florida car dealers. The only way to avoid this sort of thing is to insist on a bottom line price. The only charge you should pay in addition to an advertised or quoted price is state sales tax and fees for the license tag and registration. You can check with the Florida Department of Motor Vehicles to confirm what a tag and registration costs. Costs the dealer may claim he incurs for obtaining these like "electronic filing fee" and "tag agency fee" are bogus charges which simply reimburse the dealer for his normal operating expenses. When you pay a dealer for his expenses, you are paying him a higher price and profit on the car. The law requires that this be disclosed as a dealer fee and included in all advertised prices.

As far as "dealer installed options" go, the safest bet is just don't buy them. Make it clear from the beginning that you insist that all options or accessories be factory installed. If a dealer won't agree to this, don't buy a car from him. If there is an option the factory doesn't offer that you want to buy, be extra careful to compare prices on that option with others who offer the same thing. The only rea-

son dealers install options on cars is because they can mark them up exorbitantly as in the "900 percent" example above. Remember, dealer-installed options are not warranted by the manufacturer of the car and their quality is not as high.

By getting at least three out-the-door prices on the exact same year, make, model car you want with identical MSRPs you are assured of getting a good price. Don't be fooled by "dealer list" which many dealers quote you to make you think it's the manufacturer's suggested retail price, MSRP.

Do the same thing with getting the best price on your trade-in and the best rate on your financing. Shop your trade-in like you want to sell it without buying another car. Be sure you check interest rates with your bank or credit union and another bank just to be sure.

to feel like he's been abandoned, so they make it work.

Every weekend Mr. Bicknell brings Casey home in their wheelchair accessible van so they can spend time together as a family. He believes it offers his son a sense of normalcy, being in his own home, in his room. They play together, laugh together, and swap hugs and kisses, just like any other

family.

"I want him to know that his family loves him," Mr. Bicknell said. "When we're home we feel like a family together."

Casey may be bound to a wheelchair, but he still loves playing in the pool, going to the beach and spending time in the great outdoors. Just hearing his laughter, seeing him smile, and feeling his embrace warms the Bicknells hearts.

Casey continues to make slow but steady progress. At

one time the blinking of an eye brought hope, but now he fist bumps his family and is even beginning to learn to walk again with the help of nurses and parallel bars.

"It's the love that has really given us the strength to continue and to push on," Mr. Bicknell said.

This Valentine's Day weekend he's looking forward to spending some quality time with his family and wife, sharing the love that has held them together and kept them going through everything.

The Bicknells want to convert their garage into a gym so Casey can continue his rehabilitation at home. They are hosting Casey's Hope Golf and Dinner Benefit with Auction and Jimmy Dee Entertainment on Saturday, Feb. 22, 2014 at Yacht and Country Club in Stuart. ## The reason you see so many icons

One of the questions that I am asked frequently has to do with the icons on the typical Windows desktop. "Aren't they slowing things down? I never use most of them; can't we get rid of them?"

Most of the icons on the average desktop are not slowing the computer down at all but are actually more like "speed dial" buttons on a phone. Most desktop icons are just shortcuts to programs buried deeper in the system and are on the desktop so you don't have to navigate through all sorts of menus to launch a program.

If you look at the icons on your desktop, you may notice that some icons have a little arrow in a little white box at the lower left corner of the icon. The arrow itself is kind of curvy and will point to the top right corner of the icon. You may also notice that other icons (like the Computer icon, the User folder icon, the Recycle Bin, etc.) do not have the little arrow. There is a big difference between the two types of icons - the icons with the little arrows are actually just shortcuts and not the actual program (or file). Shortcuts are really, really tiny and don't slow the computer down at all.

"But what about the icons that don't have the little arrow? Are they safe to get rid of?" That question is a little harder to answer. You see, any icon on your computer that does not have the little shortcut indicator is either a user file or a system file and messing with it can cause problems. Icons on your desktop that are not shortcuts are either files that have been saved on the desktop or system files that have been set there by the operating system, and care should be taken when manipulating them.

Another point that I want to make is that people have different ideas as to what the phrase "get rid of" means! When someone asks me to get rid of all of the unused icons on their desktop what they are invariably asking me to do is to delete them. If you have been reading my column for any length of time then you know how I feel about deleting things from your computer - it's not something I do casually. In fact I have a saying, "if I were king I'd have the delete button stricken from the keyboard!" My idea of

cleaning a Windows desktop by "getting rid of" a bunch of stuff is not to delete everything but leans more in line with the phrase "out of sight, out of mind." People will watch with a puzzled look on their face as I create yet another icon on their desktop (a new folder), name it something like "Desktop Clutter" and then drag all of the unused icons into the new folder. Then, once the desktop is down to just the icons that actually get used, I drag the Desktop Clutter folder and drop it into the Users folder.

Then I usually spend the next ten minutes of so explaining why I went through all that trouble rather than just deleting everything. My explanation really boils down to habit. One of the worst habits people get into with their machines is the habit of deleting stuff every time they tidy up. Sure it's great to have a tidy desktop but if you are in the habit of casually deleting stuff then eventually you are going to delete something you actually need. Even worse is the habit some people have of emptying the recycle bin every time they delete something. That's just a disaster waiting to happen.

My philosophy is "out of sight, out of mind." Tidying up my system by sweeping a bunch of unused shortcuts (and actual files for that matter) into a folder and then moving the folder out of sight ensures that if I accidentally do "get rid of something" that I need, I can recover it easily enough by digging into the folder where I moved it.

Does this mean that I am completely against deleting everything? Of course not. Some things are indeed trash and I have no problem deleting them. I just have a real problem with the habit of deleting things with barely a second thought. I've seen too many people delete their way into too many problems.





Crystal Lake Elementary where she is a fourth grade teacher. They jumped right on board.

"It was just a matter of taking resources that would have otherwise ended up in the garbage and sending them to somewhere they could be used," Ms. Reddick said.

She contacted the Ministry of Education in the Bahamas and Missionary Flights International who agreed to transport the textbooks over several trips to the area. There was plenty to move because when Hidden Oaks Elementary heard about it they wanted in on it, too.

Now there are five pallets containing more than 1,000 math, science, history and reading materials headed to Eleuthera ready to be put to use.

But while Ms. Reddick was glad her proposal was such a hit, it was never about the publicity for her; it was about helping people.

"I wasn't doing it for any other reason than I knew they needed textbooks and we have textbooks to get rid

of," Ms. Reddick said.

It's about setting an example for her three children, too.

"We've always tried to live by two rules: love God and love others...It's what we're supposed to do," Ms. Reddick said. "This was a way that I could help."

There are plenty more left-over books, and more schools in the district want in on the action, but Ms. Reddick and school administrators are trying to come up with other places to send them, as Eleuthera schools can only take so many. Ms. Reddick simply doesn't want to see them go to waste.

"There are opportunities out there for us to make a difference and I think we should take them," Ms. Reddick said. "It's about our schools helping other schools."

# Creating more garden serenity

A great way to start fixing up your outdoor space for spring is to install a backyard or deck fountain. There are many types of fountains you can utilize and you are only limited by your imagination. You can buy a ready-made fountain kit, which are available at most home improvement stores, or you can opt to build one yourself.

Fountains can add charm

and character to almost any landscape. The sound of running water has long been a great way to create a relaxing space you can enjoy, especially after a hard day at the office. To me, one of the most relaxing experiences is eating dinner on our deck at twilight while viewing and listening to our rock waterfall fountain. It gives our deck a feel like you are eating at a quaint Key West restaurant.

The first thing to think about is where you want to locate your fountain. If you have a deck, this is a great location and the added advantage is that an electric outlet is close at hand. If you decide to install your fountain in your yard, you will need to have a power source installed to operate your fountain. You will need to run your electric cable through impact resistant plastic conduit laid in a trench in soil or sand. It is recommended you have the power source installed by a qualified electrician.

There are also solar pumps that are available if you install your fountain in a full sun environment.

The next thing you need to consider is what type of fountain or pond you want to install. You can use a kit or you can buy your pump and tubing separate and get creative. You can use an old galvanized tub, an old hand water pump or almost any container that can hold water. I have even seen fountains made from flowerpots. My favorite is a fountain made from rocks or a simulated rock fountain made from resin.

Most fountain pumps are similar in the way they operate however there are several sizes available depending on how much water flow you will need. Submersible pumps are safe to use if they are

properly installed and operated. Once you have all your parts, simply build your fountain, install the pump and tubing and you are ready to enjoy! Your fountain pumps will last for many years if you take care not to run your pumps when the water levels are too low.

Now that you have your fountain installed, the next step is to create your landscaping design around the fountain. Most fountains will look best if they are nestled inside a canopy of tropicals. There are a number of choices you can use to create your space including areca palms, rubber plants, marginatas, and majesty palms. If you are using a rock or other type of waterfall fountain, you might want to place a few of the higher areca palms or majesty palms in the rear part of the fountain then use some mid-height tropicals such as marginata or the plants on the side areas of the fountain. You can then use some liriopse, mondo grass, or another choice of low growing plants around the front of the fountain. This type of setup will create a step effect with the higher plants to the rear of the fountain and lower plants toward the front of the fountain. This effect is really intense if you install your fountain in a corner area on your deck. If you install your fountain in your yard, you can surround it with seasonal flowers to create a great space to get away from the daily stresses of everyday life.

In short, you can make your project as simple or as involved as you want but the end result will be satisfying no matter which course you take. So go ahead and dig in today and start relaxing tomorrow!
