MELBOURNE — The city of Melbourne will soon welcome a new deputy city manager, following a several-month search.

Shannon Lewis was named the city's new deputy manager after being selected from a pool of highly qualified candidates from around the country.

"I am appreciative and excited about the opportunity to join the team in Melbourne," she said. "I am impressed with the community, the staff and the proactive nature of the

city and look forward to helping advance the city's priorities, goals and economic development efforts."

Ms. Lewis will begin working in her new position in mid-September, officials said.

Ms Lewis served as a leader in municipal government for more than 16 years. Most recently, she was the assistant city manager for the city of Port Orange, where she served on the senior management team and had direct oversight of the community development,

## Church helps children, families prepare for school

BREVARD — School is back in full swing for both public and private school students.

Thousands of students throughout the county are equipped with new backpacks, pens and pencils, composition books, rulers and all sorts of other school supplies; however, some of these students would not have the necessary supplies to help kick-off a successful school year without the tremendous help of one local

church.

On Saturday, Aug. 9, for the fourth year in a row, Center Pointe Church in Palm Bay hosted its "Back 2 School Festival."

The free event allowed underprivileged students to receive free school supplies, as well as dental and eye screenings, haircuts, scoliosis checks and sports physicals. Attendees also enjoyed free food, crafts and family fun.

Sue Walker, Back 2 School event coordinator and wife of Pastor Tom Walker, said Center

Pointe Church started hosting the essential event in the wake of the serious economic downfall that the Space Coast faced.

"As a church, we wanted to do something to help make a difference," Mrs. Walker said. "Parents were already facing so much — job loss, loss of homes and more — and getting their kids prepared for school was one more burden on them."

In its first year, Center Pointe Church's Back 2 School festival was a major success.

"We had no idea if anyone would come," Mrs. Walker said.

"We added doctors and a dentist, who were able to provide medical screenings to students, all free."

# Organization presses on with no-kill animal sanctuary

BREVARD — An avid animal supporter, Katherine Johnson has worked diligently to help improve the lives of animals in need.

Soon, her dreams of creating a no-kill animal sanctuary will become an actuality.

"The journey to this point has been difficult," the president and founder of Friends for Animals Sanctuary, Inc. said. "We have learned a tremendous amount, and we are so proud of how far we have come in such a short time."

For more than a year, Mrs. Johnson has spent many stressful days searching for the perfect piece of land.

This land is needed for the development of Brevard County's only no-kill animal sanctuary, a place where stray and unwanted animals can roam and live without being put to death.

"Our sanctuary will be designed like a

campus, so that the animals are free to move around in their habitats versus being cramped in cages," she said. "We so desperately need this sanctuary, and we believe Brevard County residents will help us to get it built. We have met so many gracious people and hope we can one day say all of Brevard County is 'no-kill.'"

To raise funding for this sanctuary, the organization has held fundraisers and other public donation events, along with its Thrift Shoppe.

"It will take an abundance of volunteers and money to get all three phases of the sanctuary built," Mrs. Johnson said. "We will have numerous buildings sized appropriately for each type of animal, and we will also have a large grazing area for larger animals."

But, as she said, the search has not been without its hindrances. Often, when Mrs. Johnson and her organization would find a piece of land that seemingly was perfect, there would be zoning

restrictions that would not allow the organization to build upon it.

Other land would also be out of the organization's price range, but, now, none of that seems to matter.

"We are currently in rezoning on 17 acres off S.R. 520 and Range Road in Cocoa," she said. "This is a great central location that will service the whole of Brevard County for adoption and education purposes."

Now, with her hard work nearing completion, it seems the sanctuary will be designed to do what it was always intended for: to save lives and educate the public.

"We will be focusing on helping to bring Brevard County to a no-kill status by pulling animals from the two county shelters before we accept any owner-surrendered animals," Mrs. Johnson said. "One of our other biggest goals is to bring education to the youth in Brevard by field trip adventures on our property. We will also be working with the Girl

Scouts and Boy Scouts, along with the 4H clubs."

Along with the development of the sanctuary, Mrs. Johnson said that the organization has restarted its foster/adoption program, which has already helped rescue many dogs from various shelters.

"We continue to search for foster homes, so that we can save many more," she said about the rescued dogs.

Those interested in opening their homes to a rescue animal can contact Diana Depinto at (631) 624-3211.

Friends for Animals Sanctuary was founded in September 2011. Since then, the organization has been rescuing animals from local shelters and placing them into foster care, while searching for adoptive homes.

# Melbourne city attorney announces resignation

MELBOURNE — Melbourne City Attorney Paul Gougelman announced his resignation from the City of Melbourne, as well as from several other municipalities, earlier this month.

His resignation is effective Nov. 1.

"It has truly been an honor to work with Mr. Gougelman for the past 10 years," said Kathy Meehan, mayor of Melbourne, in a press statement. "He has been an outstanding leader, attorney and adviser for many working in the city."

Mr. Gougelman said he plans to return to work in the private sector in Ft. Lauderdale, after serving the city for 27 years.

He has been the city attorney for Melbourne since 1996.

"The opportunity to serve has been

incredible," Mr. Gougelman said in an email. "I think good things for the community have been accomplished during my time here; the most important of which was to avoid the expense of litigation and to keep the city out of court."

During his time with the city, Mr. Gougelman created an in-house attorney office, which reduced costs for taxpayers, city officials said.

Mr. Gougelman has also served as town attorney for Indialantic and Melbourne Beach for the past 20 years, and he is general counsel for the Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization, Space Coast League of Cities and Florida Metropolitan Planning Organization Advisory Council.

"Mr. Gougelman is a gifted attorney and a dedicated public servant," Mayor Meehan said in a press statement. "He has always been guided by what he believes is best for our community and the city. We will miss him greatly. I wish him much success, as he returns to private law."

Officials with the towns of Indialantic and Melbourne Beach said they are also conducting searches to replace

Mr. Gougelman.

"He's going to be missed," said James Titcomb, interim town manager for Melbourne Beach. "He is such a nice guy and a bright attorney. It will be big shoes to fill."

At a recent Melbourne City Council meeting, the council authorized the city manager and city attorney to formulate a plan for the creation of a selection committee to assist in conducting a search for a new city attorney and to bring the plan to the Council at its Sept. 11 meeting.

During the meeting, Councilman Mike Nowlin and Councilwoman Betty Moore expressed an interest in appointing one of the assistant city attorneys as the new city attorney.

The Council then authorized the city manager and city attorney to immediately advertise the position of city attorney.

# EFSC recruits for 911 Public Safety Telecom academy

## Nighttime program to begin in September

BREVARD — Those, who are looking to study for a career in public safety, but only have time in the evenings to attend class, will have the opportunity to do so this September.

Eastern Florida State College will offer a part-time 911 Public Safety Telecommunicator night academy, starting on Monday, Sept. 29. The academy will host classes on Monday through Thursday from 6 to 10 p.m.

and Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

"This is a great opportunity for those, who are transitioning between careers," said Tonia Graham, Public Safety Coordinator at EFSC.

"The academy offered at EFSC is taught by highly trained and qualified professionals working in the 911 field," Mrs. Graham said. "The starting

salary for a 911 Public Telecommunicator is in the \$11 to \$14 per hour range."

Eastern Florida State College will offer a part-time 911 Public Safety Telecommunicator night academy starting on Monday, Sept. 29.

Classes for the academy will run Monday through Thursday from 6 to 10 p.m. and Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Application deadline for the program is Thursday, Sept. 4.

The festival has further exploded in popularity amongst the south Brevard community. Mrs. Walker said that in its first year of operation, Center Pointe Church distributed 1,000 backpacks and featured 10 hair stylists on-hand to give free haircuts.

Now in its fourth year, the Back 2 School Festival distributed 2,300 backpacks and had 30 hair stylists and barbers on-site for free haircuts.

"We added doctors and a dentist, who were able to provide medical screenings to students, all free," Mrs. Walker said. "That first year, we had 200 volunteers, but this year, it took more than 500 volunteers to make this event successful. We think through every detail in order to make the day run smoothly, all at no cost to patrons."

Because of the thoughtfulness and selflessness of hundreds of Good Samaritans, 2,300 Brevard school children received backpacks full of composition books, pencils, pencil boxes, glue, erasers, colored pencils, spiral notebook paper and pencil sharpeners.

Students were able to select from a variety of backpacks.

"There were different styles, sizes

and colors," Mrs. Walker said. "You could not imagine the smiles on their faces and how their eyes lit up when the children realized they got to select their very own backpack from a large selection."

Mrs. Walker estimated that more than 6,000 people attended this year's event.

"The lines were long — more than a half mile — and yet, when the doors opened at 9 a.m., everyone had their backpack by 10:30 a.m.," Mrs. Walker added. "People were so surprised to see how quickly the line moved once the doors were open."

In addition to free health screenings, haircuts and school supplies, children and families enjoyed a range of entertainment, including face painting, sand art, balloon animals and three large bounce houses; there was also free hot dogs, snow cones, snacks and drinks.

On behalf of Center Pointe Church, Mrs. Walker said that she hopes the families within the community felt important and special.

"By providing a fun-filled day like this, we hope we were able to help ease the minds of some children, who might have been fearful about going back to school," she added. "We hope it helps parents focus on spending time with their families enjoying the beautiful day, without the burden of expense.



# Seniors 'R' Us: If you build it, they will come

To service the burgeoning number of elderly consumers, stores and departments for seniors will soon emerge as part of America's new retail landscape, says Jo Ann Tilghman, founder of Granny Jo Products.

If you walk into any department store and ask the nearest salesperson to point the way to the "Infant Section" or the "Misses Section," chances are you will get a pleasant smile and some simple directions. But walk into that same store and ask the same salesperson how to get to the "Seniors Department," and watch the confusion flood over their face.

Why? Asked if she sees senior superstores appearing on the retail horizon, Ms. Tilghman nods in affirmation.

"A dedicated 'Seniors' retail outlet, intelligently stocked with items that seniors really found useful would be the first place most of us would go to buy gifts for aging friends and relatives," Ms. Tilghman said. "If the aisles and racks were properly spaced to allow access by shoppers using walkers and motorized carts, a 'Seniors R Us' could be the hotspot for the town's senior community. Include a few investment seminars, weekly indoor gardening workshops and an occasional antique/classic car show, and your problem would be not how to attract senior shoppers to the store, but how to provide them all with parking."







# Controlling snakes and some hurricane tips

I think one of the most feared and less known about creature in our gardens and yards is a slinky creature known as a snake. Most common garden snakes are not poisonous and are actually beneficial to your yard or garden. Some people actually find them as welcome visitors as they help control bugs and rodents.

However, most people have a natural fear of snakes and would prefer they set up house elsewhere. There is no actual repellent that I know of that really works however there are steps you can take to make your garden less inviting to them. One thing snakes love to do is to sun themselves. Since they are cold-blooded reptiles, you will often see them curled up on stones in your garden trying to catch a few rays. Removing the stones, especially if they are in a sunny place, may help to discourage them from hanging around. Snakes also love to hide in

cool damp places like cinder blocks and stonewalls. This type of scenario may help be an attractant to your garden. They also will be attracted by saucers or pots that are not being used especially if they have water in them. I have also heard of snakes hiding in gopher tunnels so removing them from your yard may help deter them. Remember, most snakes are your friends and they usually will try to stay as far away from you as possible. Sometimes, however, an unexpected encounter can be inevitable.

With the tropics reaching the peak season, please remember to check your yard for hidden dangers and to be

sure to review your plans on how to best hurricane proof your yard. One point to consider when checking your property is to look for areas that are known flood plains in your yard. If you have such an area and a large tree happens to reside in the middle of the flood plain, it has a risk of toppling. When the ground around a tree becomes saturated with moisture, the area around the tree will become very unstable. This instability coupled with the high winds of a tropical system can cause even a normally stable tree to topple. This inspection is especially important if the tree resides next to a structure. In this case, properly pruning your tree may not only save your tree, but it might also save your home from the damage of a downed tree. Also be aware of any diseased or decaying trees as these can also cause a hazard.

The next step you should take is to take a tour of your yard and make a list of items that would be dangerous to leave lying around. This list should include patio furniture, loose garden ornaments, small potted plants, yard torches, arbors and even your gas grill. If you have a shed or gazebo, you

might want to add extra tie downs to be sure they stay put and don't wind up in Kansas. You can start early by limiting what you keep out in your yard during the peak months of August and September.

If you own a swimming pool, you can throw all your patio furniture into the pool to help keep it from traveling across the state.

If you are a nature lover, most likely you have a bird feeder hanging in your yard. Now is the time to do some housekeeping so your feathered friends have a safe and clean place to eat. Clean your bird feeder with a mixture of 1 part bleach to 9 parts water. Be sure to remove all droppings from the perches and throw away any old food that might be moldy and refill it with fresh treats. Be sure to rinse the feeder well after treating it with the bleach solution. This will ensure your birds will have a disease free environment in which to dine.

# Don't wait for warnings to pile up yard waste

As we near the peak of the 2014 hurricane season, Brevard County residents are reminded that now is the opportune time to trim bushes, trees and palms for yard waste pickup.

By having yard debris hauled off well in advance of a storm, residents will help avoid piling tree limbs up at the curb when it's too late for pickup to occur. This also helps avoid problems once a storm hits of debris becoming airborne or getting into storm drains and blocking the free

flow of runoff.

Residents often wait until storm warnings have been issued to tend to overgrowth and potential storm damage that might result from limbs falling onto their property or homes.

As routine preparation for hurricane season, property owners are advised to visually inspect their home and property and to make any repairs necessary. Check the roof for loose shingles; the gutters and drains to ensure proper drainage; and the trees for loose branches.

Residents are also encouraged to become familiar with the drainage

system in their neighborhoods: where the stormwater drains are located, where there could be problems, who is responsible for maintenance and how to contact them. To help reduce flooding, residents should make sure storm drains are free of debris, so water can drain freely.

Blockages should be reported to the appropriate authority: the homeowners' association, the city's Public Works Department or the Brevard County Public Works Department.

- North area – from the Volusia

County line south to Gus Hipp/Roy Wall Boulevard on the mainland, call (321) 264-5084.

- Central area – All of Merritt Island and south to the Pineda Causeway on the beaches, call (321) 455-1389.

- South Area – from Gus Hipp/Roy Wall Boulevard to the Indian River Countyline on the mainland, and from Pineda Causeway south to the Sebastian Inlet on the beaches, call (321) 255-4310.

### Process for Bidding on Tax Certificate

**Q** What is the process for bidding on a tax certificate?  
**A** nswer: To bid on a tax certificate for a property where the taxes are delinquent, bidders must deposit 10% of the outstanding tax balance for that particular tax year with the tax collector. Auctions are now conducted online. Bidders will not be bidding on the amount of the tax, because all bidders will be required to pay the full amount of the tax if they win. Instead the bidders are bidding down from high to low the amount of interest they will be willing to receive on the tax lien certificate if they are the winning bidder. The tax certificate will go to the bidder willing to accept the lowest rate of interest.

The interest rates start at 18% per year, the highest interest rate legally allowed by Florida law, and go lower from there. No matter how low the bid, the lowest actual rate of return is 5% for the first year. The winning bidder must pay the rest of the outstanding balance for the purchase of the tax certificate on the day the auction has ended. If the winning bidder does not pay the balance, the tax certificate is usually auctioned again.


