Boating tragedy spurs mechanic to carry on

MELBOURNE — On Jan. 10, 1998, a cap-sized air-boat turned the lives of a local family upside down. The boat turned over due to an uncontrolled torque as it turned, throwing Donald Jones Jr., Donald Jones, Sr., and other family members into the water. Dennis Jones, who was living in Houston at the time of the accident, recounts stories from that day.

"My father went to save a girl," Mr. Jones said. "She lived and she was treated for hypothermia. There was a lot of rain, a lot of coolness that Jan. 10. My dad got out there and, you know, they have hats and gloves — it's cold out. So, my brother saw my dad having problems and he stripped everything off and he went after my father."

He continued, "The focus was not on my brother, who was helping my dad, it became about the help that was coming from the bridge

that was right there. They were pulling [out] my nephew, my nephews' cousin and my mother. They didn't know my dad and brother were underwater at that point."

Sadly, Donald Sr. and Donald Jr. didn't make it out of the water alive. However, they were the only family members who perished that day.

The death of his father and brother spurred Mr. Jones to take over the business his brother started. Trans II Services, Inc is at 6955 W. NASA Blvd., in Melbourne. Unlike larger auto-body shops, Mr. Jones is often the sole mechanic. When customers bring in their vehicles, they get to speak directly to the person who'll be working on it. It's a level of personal touch that's rare in a business that can often be daunting in prices and repairs.

"I closed up shop in Texas and brought my family here to take care of his boats, the cars, his house. I'm still dealing with some of that 20 years later," Mr. Jones said. "It was a chance to

Nana's House opens thrift cottage

BREVARD COUNTY — For 11 years, Nana's House has strived to improve the lives of Brevard County's neglected, abused, needy or abandoned children (the words behind 'Nana' in Nana's House), and with the generous help of the community, it has already seen progress being made.

In 2015, the Christian-based nonprofit broke ground on the construction site of its gated community. These days, four of the eight homes have been filled with foster families taking care of up to five children per household. The last four houses are expected to be completed in the next few weeks.

Founder and Executive Director Kim Frodge has credited many companies and volunteers for their help in building up the community. Through Nana's House thrift cottages, 100 percent of the proceeds have gone to supporting the gated community and its house parents.

In early September, the nonprofit celebrated the opening of a new thrift cottage at 4490 S. Babcock St., Melbourne. An additional location is already open in Malabar.

"We need a lot more volunteers for our thrift stores to work in the store, sort and clean items, pick up donations weekly, customer service, etc.," Mrs. Frodge said. "We need both men and women!"

During the grand opening of the Melbourne thrift cottage, Melbourne Mayor Kathy Meehan attended the ribbon cutting, along with representatives of the Melbourne Chamber of Commerce.

Mrs. Frodge added that Pastor Mark Balmer of Calvary Chapel Melbourne stopped by to make a dedication of the new building.

Nana's House is currently interviewing residents to fulfill other roles such as an on-site manager and mainte-



nance person for its gated community, as well as house parents for its recently completed homes.

“There are too many children being neglected and abused, and they need a safe and loving home,” Mrs. Frodge said. “Children come to us from various situations. Some have been neglected and abused; some, their parents are homeless and don’t want their children homeless; some parents are going to jail and have no one else to take care of their children; and some parents are on drugs and can’t take care of their children.”

She continued, “There are also some

grandparents that are raising their grandchildren and become ill and can’t do it anymore. The bottom line is they are all in need of a safe and loving home, and that’s what we provide in a loving, Christian family environment.”

In November, Mrs. Frodge said she plans to start construction of the gated community’s last residential building of two apartments at 1,600- square feet.

Framers are still needed to aid in the construction process, and can contact Mrs. Frodge for more information at (321) 724-5111.

The Melbourne thrift cottage is open from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday.

start over again and bring the family closer.”

“My whole family were car people,” Mr. Jones said. “I grew up working on old Mercury’s and Fords...I remember helping him put engines in. My uncle owned a gas station that had a lot of old cars. As I helped him later in life it was mostly cars of the 70s.”

Mr. Jones recalls helping his father work on older model cars, as far back as 1946 model Mercury’s. Mr. Jones worked for a number of auto mechanics, some large and some local, before relocating to Melbourne.

Mr. Jones knowledge of automobiles continues to grow as automobiles evolve. However, much of the same concepts he learned from his father apply today.

“There are a lot of things that remain

the same with cars,” Mr. Jones said. “You see a steering wheel, you see doors, you see tires, one of the biggest changes is in the electronics. So, now when I work on cars you see you may not have a component problem, you may have a flash problem, you may have a charging problem.”

To ensure customers get the most value for their visit, Mr. Jones frequently exchanges services with other autobody shops like AMCOs and calls various wholesale mechanic suppliers to find the most reasonably priced, quality parts. Mr. Jones explains that due to the high volume of locals servicing their cars at Trans II, there isn’t much competition.

Traffic boxes to feature art with local themes

BREVARD COUNTY — A new project in North Brevard will go outside the box to highlight local artists while contributing to what has been recognized as the area's economic and cultural renaissance.

A collaboration between the North Brevard Art League, the Greater Titusville Renaissance and the Titusville Community Redevelopment Agency, the project, Art Outside the Box, will install artwork on eight Florida Department Transportation traffic control boxes situated along Washington and Hopkins Avenues between Grace and South Streets.

"Titusville's beautification projects are much appreciated by residents and tourists alike, and wrapping these electrical boxes is a wonderful opportunity to further this effort," said the art league's president, Diane DeShong Cannon, who was one of two project coordinators.

The league recently held a competition that was open to the group's members, as well as artists who are not members but live north of S.R. 528, in order to select the art that will be featured on the boxes. The competition required artwork to

reflect the area's history, nature or involvement with space exploration.

The eight selected works - originally of photography, watercolor, acrylic and mixed media - will be printed on vinyl wraps and placed on the boxes throughout October, pending approval from FDOT.

The project partners anticipate formal-

ly recognizing the installations during a street party in early November.

After changing its name from Titusville Art League a year and a half ago, this project is the league's first of many to come that will focus on new goals involving community outreach and artist engagement, Ms. Cannon noted.

"[North Brevard Art League] has been

an integral part of the community for 54 years, but we are so excited to become more visible to Titusville residents, visitors and the surrounding counties by sponsoring such a visual format for our area artists," Ms. Cannon said.

Hurricane rescues prompt pet adoption special

BREVARD COUNTY — Residents looking to adopt a pet have a few days left to take advantage of SPCA of Brevard's adoption special on all adult animals – and by doing so, they will not only give an animal a home; they will also help make room for animals rescued from the path of Hurricane Florence.

Until Sept. 30, it is \$20 to adopt any pet 6 months and older at SPCA of Brevard's adoption center, 6035 Sisson Road in Titusville.

"Low adoption fees are an awesome bonus to adopting a pet - especially since that fee includes spay or neuter, vaccines, and microchip," said SPCA of Brevard's public relations coordinator, Susan Naylor.

"Beyond that, adopting a pet from us now is clearing a kennel for a new pet [whose] life might be at risk at another facility," Ms. Naylor continued. "So, by adopting, you're giving a great dog or cat a home and saving the life of another one

who needs your new pet's kennel space."

The week of Sept. 10, the organization rescued 11 dogs and 11 cats from Suwanee County Animal Services in McAlpin, FL.

The dogs had been transported there from various shelters in South Carolina. The cats had already been housed at Suwanee County Animal Services prior to Hurricane Florence, but were brought to Brevard in case more room would be needed for stray pets being rescued from the Carolinas, or for pets from families whose homes were destroyed.

Then, on Sept. 20, SPCA of Brevard staff members traveled directly to South Carolina to pick up 11 more dogs that had been in a shelter before the storm – dogs that would have been euthanized there in order to make space for more intakes.

At the same time, many pets at SPCA's shelter still need homes.

As of Sept. 18, at least 100 of the animals at SPCA of Brevard had been in the shelter for two months or longer.



With cooler temps come colorful Fall gardens

With cooler temperatures (hopefully soon) and the fall season just around the corner, many of us want to start introducing color back into our yards. A popular variety that is now widely available at most garden centers is Geraniums. Annual Geraniums are very popular for their wide range of brilliant, colorful flowers plus their foliage is also very attractive.

The types and varieties of these colorful plants vary widely from cultivars that grow six inches high to some that grow to be several feet tall. Geraniums need a bright location with at least a couple of hours of direct sun in order to thrive. These wonderful plants also need to be planted in well-drained soil otherwise the plants will be prone to fungus infection and disease.

After planting your colorful treasures, you will want to water them abundantly the first few days, taking care to be sure they drain between watering. Water regularly thereafter still ensuring the plants drain and the soil to dry out between watering intervals. When you water your plants, try to avoid getting water on the leaves of the plant as this can lead to possible disease problems. Do not plant geraniums where they will receive their water from a sprinkler system.

Geraniums are heavy feeders and if not fertilized properly, their leaves may yellow and drop. There are several options you can use for fertilizer such as a slow release fertilizer or a water-soluble fertilizer. The slow release fertilizer will need less intervention on your part as some products such as Osmocote and Dynamite feed for as long as six months. Water-soluble fertilizers such as Miracle Gro provide a more immediate fix but will require more frequent feedings about every two to three weeks. The water-soluble feeding solutions are quite safe and there is little chance of burning your plants.

There are a couple of things you can do to prolong how many flowers your plants will produce. Probably the single most important solution is to pinch the spent flowers off the stems on a regular basis. This will ensure a season beautiful color. Pinching also has the advantage of helping to produce well-branched and full plants. A good rule of thumb when choosing your treasures is to pick plants that not only have abundant flowers but that have lots of tight buds also. Look for dark green foliage with not a lot of yellow leaves or yellowing at the tips of the leaves.

Today's garden tip: If you are growing Crotons in a container inside your home, yellowing, dropping leaves can often be a problem. To avoid or reverse this problem, there are several things that can help. First of all, you should try to keep your plants at a fairly constant temperature. These tropical plants also enjoy a humid, moist climate so misting the plant will help raise the humidity levels around the leaves for optimal growth. Water your plants on a regular basis with tepid water and keep the soil evenly moist. Be sure to provide bright light near a window otherwise the plant may shed leaves if the area is too dark. Also be sure to fertilize once a month with a water-soluble fertilizer. With a little care and TLC, your colorful crotons will thrive for many years to come and will add a delicate tropical fare to your décor.

Eggs amazing food source, often misunderstood

Just for the record, I don't really care, but I love eggs and I think you should, too.

The chicken was probably domesticated for its eggs from a jungle fowl around 3200 B.C. according to Indian history. Egyptian and Chinese records indicate fowl were laying eggs for man in 1400 B.C., and Europe has had domesticated hens since 600 B.C. I find this interesting because the jungle fowl was not raised for meat, but for their eggs, creating one of our first sustainable food sources.

Eggs are such an amazing food source and often times misunderstood. Let me try to clear up a few facts. Eggs contain the highest quality of protein you can buy. The protein from eggs has an almost perfect mix of essential amino acid for humans to build tissue. It is compared to the nutrition of mother's milk.

Egg yolks are one of the few foods that contain natural vitamin D. Egg whites and egg yolks contain 3 grams of protein each. One egg white contains 15 calories and one egg yolk has 60 calories.

New clinical studies show dietary cholesterol found in eggs has a modest effect on blood cholesterol. The 2015-2020 Dietary Guidelines have removed the 300 mg dietary cholesterol limit, referencing the fact all available evidence suggests there is no relationship between consumption of dietary cholesterol and levels of blood cholesterol.

If you want to keep calories down, eat egg whites.

Generally brown eggs are more expensive than white eggs, but that is not an indica-

tion of quality. Chickens that lay brown eggs are bigger than chickens that lay white eggs. It costs more to feed these chickens, resulting in a more expensive egg.

Egg cartons will advertise the type of eggs you are buying, so let's look at some of the hype.

Since 1950, the FDA has required that all eggs are hormone free.

Cage free means a chicken has 120 square inches to move about, but is still indoors with not much room. Free range means chickens have the ability to go outdoors and come in at night, but often times not all chickens will roam outside.

Pasture-raised hens will feed outdoors in pastures, consuming a more nutrient-dense diet with an increase in micronutrient values. Certain antioxidant carotenoids like lutein and beta-carotene in yolks can be up to 100 times higher.

I personally believe the type of feed chickens eat will affect the taste of eggs. My suggestion is to try different eggs to make a plain omelet and compare tastes.

Now here are some fun facts. Chickens have earlobes, and if the color is white, the eggs will be white. If the earlobes are red or brown, the eggs will be brown.

All eggs are not the same size in your egg

carton either. Rather than requiring a specific size and weight for individual eggs, the USDA has guidelines for egg weights per dozen.

You can tell if an egg is cooked in the shell by spinning it. A cooked egg will spin like a top and raw eggs will not.

The US produces 75 billion eggs a year, which is 10 percent of the world's supply. So now you're an expert on eggs.

Oh, by the way, to cook hard boiled eggs, place eggs in a one quart pot, cover with water, bring to a boil and take off the heat. Let the eggs cool. Perfect every time!

Try this egg recipe that is great tasting and nutritious.

EGGS FRITTATA

Yield: 6 servings

Ingredients

- 8 large eggs, beaten
- 1 ounce Parmesan cheese, grated
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- Pinch salt
- 1 teaspoon butter and 1 teaspoon olive oil
- 1/4-cup half and half
- 1/2-cup chopped red pepper
- 1/2-cup chopped tomato
- 1/2-cup chopped red onions



1/2-cup chopped country ham

Directions

Preheat oven to bake setting. In medium size bowl, using a fork, blend milk and eggs together, add Parmesan, pepper, tomato, ham and salt. Add butter and oil to an egg pan and melt over medium heat. Pour egg mixture into pan and stir with rubber spatula. Cook for 2 to 3 minutes or until the egg mixture has set slightly. Place pan into oven and bake for 3 to 4 minutes at 325 degrees until lightly browned and fluffy. (Optional: before baking, sprinkle with half-cup cheddar cheese).

Remove from pan and cut into 6 servings. Serve immediately.






