## Planning Board rejects treatment center

ST. LUCIE COUNTY - The St. Lucie County Planning & Zoning Commission voted 7-1 Aug. 16 to recommend the County Commission reject a South Hutchinson Island rezoning request by a group of Palm Beach developers who want to build an upscale alcohol and drug abuse treatment center in the area.

The developers had their eyes on a 22.4 acre on the east side of Ocean Drive that's currently zoned Hutchinson Island Residential District just south of the planned Anacostia Place housing development. In addition to the rezoning request, the developers had asked for a conditional use permit to construct the 220-bed facility.

Attorney Lee Dobbins of the Fort Pierce law firm Dean Mead represented the applicant in the hearing and said the proposed \$80 million facility would be similar to California's Hazelden Betty Ford Center.

"The Atlantic will be a state-of-the-art beachfront addiction and wellness center for adults and adolescents with world-class resort amenities," he said. "The Atlantic will provide a quality of care for drug and alcohol addiction but will take that quality of care to a new level with resort amenities: gourmet meals, swimming pools, spas and rooftop gardens. # Three vie for Republican nomination for U.S. Rep

Hometown News is asking all primary race candidates to answer the same questions in order to give readers the information needed to make their best informed choices for the upcoming Martin County and St. Lucie County primary elections.

There are three candidates in the Republican primary race for the U.S. Representative District 18 seat: Dave Cummings, Mark Freeman and sitting Congressman Brian Mast.

## Dave Cummings



Cummings

**What is your full name and age?**

Dave Cummings, 45

**Where do you reside?**

I reside in St. Lucie County, Fla.

**Do you have family ties locally?**

Yes. I am a Florida native who grew up on the Treasure Coast, and our district is my home to this day. My family goes back several generations as pioneers of Old Florida. My grandfather was stationed at Camp Blanding where he met my grandmother in St. Augustine. All of my great uncles also served in World War II from Florida. My uncle Julian Pfaff retired as a colonel with the Florida National Guard.

*My mother served as a postulant nun and then a novitiate as a Sister of Saint Joseph at the Saint Joseph College of Florida (where the Tuckaho Mansion now sits). She left the novitiate before making final vows. My Aunt Marie Nader is a Florida fashion icon and was a legendary designer during Florida's glamour age and continued all the way through her retirement when she sold her exclusive dress shop, the Amavon on King Street in St. Augustine, now the site of the Casa Monica Hotel. She just celebrated her 103rd birthday.*

**What are your professional qualifications?**

I served in the U.S. military as an infantryman for four years and in the U.S. Special Forces for two years. I put myself through college with the GI Bill and worked as a police officer and later a special investigator at the federal level.

After college I worked as a phone rep in the financial industry, leaving eight years later as an assistant vice-president and banking officer for Fortune 500 banks to start my current businesses in insurance and real estate investing.

I am licensed as an "all-lines" insurance adjuster in 15 states and can also operate under an "umbrella license" of various insurance companies and firms. I perform insurance and damage assessments for everything ranging from residential and commercial buildings, to vehicles, crops, boats, aircraft, and catastrophe and ecological disasters.

**What is the biggest issue concerning your community right now and if elected,**

**how do you plan on solving that issue?**

I am very concerned about the problems that have continued in the area for decades, despite "fly by night" politicians who move to the area to run for office and then leave after being replaced. Neither Democrats nor Republicans have sufficiently addressed the toxic algae dumps which have turned the waterways black, killing fish, birds, dozens of manatees and damaging fragile ecosystems in our estuaries. I am also concerned with the toll illegal immigration has had on the state, in particular working wages and deaths on our roadways caused by illegal immigrants.






### Savings bonds

# Dealing with the Dealer Fee

Hopefully by now, all but my newest readers know about the infamous “Dealer Fee”. If you don’t know, it’s a hidden price increase on the car you purchase disguised to look like a federal, state, or local tax or fee. It’s 100% profit to the dealer. “Dealer Fee” is the generic name for this disguised profit, but it goes by many names such as doc fee, dealer prep fee, services fee, administrative fee, electronic filing fee, e-filing fee, tag agency fee, pre-delivery fee, etc. The names are only limited by car dealers’ imaginations. Almost all car dealers in Florida charge a Dealer Fee. The dealer fees range from around \$600 to as high as \$2,000.

This is the Florida law that is supposed to regulate the Dealer Fee: “The advertised price must include all fees or charges that the customer must pay excluding state and local taxes.” The law also requires that the Dealer Fee must be disclosed to the buyer as follows: “This charge represents costs and profits to the dealer for items such as inspecting, cleaning, and adjusting vehicles and preparing documents related to the sale.”

This law is very weak and virtually never enforced. When enforced, it isn’t enforced

by the letter of the law; it is done to “accommodate” the car dealers. The law is “weak” because it requires only that the dealer fee be included in the “advertised” price. The word “advertised” is narrowly interpreted to mean one specific car shown in an online, Facebook, TV, radio, or print ad. But what about getting a price on the phone, online, or from the salesman? You don’t find out about the Dealer Fee until you’re in the business office signing a bunch of papers. The dealers get around advertisements very easily by including a “number” in the fine print. This number is their stock number that designates one specific car. When you respond to the ad, this car is no longer available (sales people are usually not paid a commission for selling the “ad car”). The advertisement might say “many more identical cars are available.” It’s true that identical cars are available for sale, but they are not available for sale at the sale price because they are not the advertised stock number car. If you buy one of those “exact same cars” you will pay from \$700 to \$2,000 more.

The reason I’m told that the law is rarely enforced is that the Florida Attorney General’s office is understaffed and too



busy enforcing other Florida laws. I’m also told that Florida car buyers don’t file very many complaints against car dealers for violating the Dealer Fee law. I don’t believe that there can be too many other infractions of the law that take more money annually from consumers than dealer fees take from car buyers. Just one car dealer selling 1,000 cars a year and charging a \$1,000 dealer fee is taking a \$1 million annually from car buyers. Most car dealers in South Florida sell lot more than 1,000 cars annually and many charge more than \$1,000 dealer fee. I believe that the reason more complaints aren’t filed on the dealer fee is because most car buyers don’t know that they are being duped. They either don’t notice the fee or assume it’s an official federal or state fee. Dealer often tell their customers that all dealers charge it and that it’s required by law.

The Attorney General also “accommodates” the dealers by not interpreting the law the way it was intended. For example, the law says that the dealer fee must be included in the advertised price. The Florida Senate has ruled that the law requires that the fee be “included” rather than “specifically delineated.” But the Attorney General allows car dealers to advertise car prices without including their dealer fee in the price if they mention their dealer fee in the fine print. They also allow car dealers to simply state in the fine print that they have a Dealer Fee but not even mention the amount. To me they are simply allowing the car dealers to break the law. The Florida Auto Dealers Association (FADA) is the powerful lobbying arm for Florida car dealers. It’s almost impossible for a Florida Attorney General to be elected without the support of car dealers and the FADA.

Lastly, the required disclosure of the Dealer Fee on the vehicle buyer’s order or invoice is confusing, misleading, and

incorrect: “This charge represents costs and profits to the dealer for items such as inspecting, cleaning, and adjusting vehicles and preparing documents related to the sale.” It should not say “costs” because any cost that you pass along to the customer in the price of a product is pure profit. A dealer can pass along his utility bills, sales commissions and advertising if he wants to and call it a “dealer fee”. It should not say “inspecting, cleaning, and adjusting vehicles” because all car dealers are reimbursed by the manufacturer for “inspecting, cleaning, and adjusting vehicles”.

So, what should you do when you are confronted by a car dealer with the “Dealer Fee”? Besides “LEAVE”, here are some suggestions that may help you:

(1) Make it clear from the very beginning that all prices you discuss must be “out-the-door” prices. This way you don’t care if the dealer fee added up front because you will shop and compare their bottom line price with at least 3 competing car dealers. Ideally you should require that they include tax and tag in that price. If you don’t they might try to slip in something they call the “electronic filing fee” or “e filing fee” and trick you into believing it’s part of the license tag and registration.

(2) The dealer will often tell you that all car dealers charge Dealer Fees and that they are required by law to add the dealer fee on every car they sell. Simply tell them that you know this is not true and you can cite me and other car dealers like CarMax who do not charge a dealer fee. Print out a copy of this article, show it to them, and tell them that you know that there is no law that says he must charge you a dealer fee.

(3) As long as you and the dealer understand that the out-the-door price is the price you will shop and compare with his competition, you don’t need to be

The idea is to create a quality of care, a standard of care that is not normally seen with addiction treatment centers.”

In addition, Mr. Dobbins highlighted the differences between the proposed treatment hospital and the neighborhood sober homes that have gained notoriety in South Florida, particularly in the fact that patients would not be driving themselves to the hospital.

“The Atlantic is not a sober home, and will not use any sober homes,” he said. “A lot of the problems we’ve seen in other places involve sober homes, which are homes in residential areas where people live while they’re being treated under little or no supervision and are transported to and from the place where they are treated. This is a very different model. Patients would be checked in, and they would stay onsite the entire time throughout their entire treatment.”

St. Lucie County Senior Planner Kori Benton recommended approval of the project with 24 conditions, explaining that the developer had lowered the height of two structures proposed for the facility in order to limit visual impacts from either State Road A1A or the neighboring property owners.

“You’ll see a lot of symmetry in the proposed development, which consists of four buildings, two on either side with staggered heights that are symmetrical in nature and centered around an arrival area that has two main access points for patients and visitors at the facility,” he said. “Collectively the development plan represents 214,288 square feet in finished area.”

Several P&Z Board members expressed

concerns about evacuating so many patients without cars off the island during emergency situations such as hurricanes or a nuclear power alert from the nearby power plant. Mr. Dobbins said the patients would either be taken to the closest similar treatment facility or to hotels out of the evacuation zone, but his explanation failed to satisfy Commissioner Sean Mitchell.

“When we met last month and you said you were going to take them seven hours away to another facility, I had hoped that you would have been more in-depth this evening and have a much more comprehensive plan than what you’re presenting,” the latter said.

Mr. Dobbins insisted it was still too premature for such plans.

“I understand, but the reality is they [the developers] really can’t answer those questions until they’re at the stage where they’re ready to enter into those contracts, and they’re not ready to do that until they at least have site plan approval and are a little bit farther down the road,” he said.

Since so many island residents had expressed concerns about security on the island and the beach, Mr. Dobbs also highlighted the planned security features at the hospital.

“First of all the patients at the Atlantic are either private pay or they have good insurance, and they would not be sheriff drop-offs or people referred from the jail,” he said. “Patients cannot leave until they’re discharged. This isn’t just about keeping patients in, it’s about protecting them from people coming into the property. All the doors would be locked and there would be cameras and motion detectors along the perimeter. Beach access would be via an electronic gate.”

Several members of the public spoke during the hearing, with most of them expressing opposition to the planned treatment hospital. Fort Pierce attorney Harold Melville said he represented the Sea Oats Homeowners Association, Anacostia and the Diamond Sands Homeowners Association, all of whose members opposed the project.

“The reason they’re opposing it is that locating a hospital of any kind is not correct,” he said. “It’s the wrong use to be put in the middle of a residential neighborhood.”

South Hutchinson Island resident Joseph Cobo concurred with that assessment.

“We bought residence up here because we wanted a paradise island and this is what we have,” he said. “A lot of our citizens in Ocean Village love our island, and I think we need to protect our community.”

Another Ocean Village resident, Jennifer Golder, worried about longer-lasting effects from the potential rezoning to Planned Non-Residential Development District.

“It’s very nice that these people are going to build this facility, but what are the options for us if this facility should not get all the patients?” she asked. “What happens if it belies up? Then you have a piece of property that’s in a commercial use, and what’s going to go in then? You can’t reverse the zoning, so now you’re stuck with a commercial property and you don’t know what’s going to go in there.”

Aside from economic development leaders, only a couple residents spoke out in favor of the proposed treatment facility. Nick Girolamo said the approximately 200 future employees of the hospital would help contribute to an over-strained tax base.

“I believe the Atlantic is an important part of us growing and we’re known in St. Lucie

County for healthcare -- Tradition Medical Center, St. Lucie Medical Center, Lawnwood -- and we need tax money,” he said.

Fort Pierce resident Henry Duarte said he heard the worries of island residents but insisted the area needed to grow.

“I would be for changing the zoning laws, because change is needed,” he said. “Just because it’s been one way for so long doesn’t mean it should never change. This is not a jail center or a toxic waste center; this is a high end rehabilitation center, and a perfect example of meeting the needs of the people and meeting the needs of the county.”

Board Member Craig Mundt, however, said building condos on the site would also contribute to the local economy right before making the motion to recommend denial of the application.

“If you had condominiums on that site, each of those would have a taxable value and their residents would spend their income in St. Lucie County,” he said. “We appreciate the jobs and everything else, but if we have residents, they pay their taxes and they spend their dollars here also.”

His fellow Commission Member James David Clasby Jr. said he expected to “ruffle some feathers” right before seconding the motion.

“I don’t know that I’ve heard yet the justification for changing this over to an institutional-like use from a residential,” he said. “It’s almost like the discussions we’ve had are assuming we’re going to approve the zoning change, but I don’t know that I’ve heard enough yet to convince me that its congruent with the surrounding area.”

Board Member James A. Taylor III cast the lone dissenting vote on the motion to recommend denial of the application but did not elaborate during the meeting.

concerned whether there is a dealer fee showing on the vehicle buyer's order. To be competitive, the dealer can simply reduce the price by the amount of his Dealer Fee and the bottom line is what you are comparing.

(4) Be aware that dealers usually do not pay their sales people a commission on the amount of their dealer fee. In fact, dealers often misinform their sales people just like they do their customers. The salesman who tells you that the all dealers charge Dealer Fees and that the law requires everyone pay a dealer fee may believe it. Sale people who understand that the Dealer Fee is simply profit to the dealer will be resentful of not being paid their 25% commission on it. A \$1,000 dealer fee costs the salesman \$250 in commission.

(5) When you respond to an advertisement at a specific price for a specific model car, object when the dealer adds the dealer fee. Unfortunately, the law

allows him the loophole of claiming that the ad car is a different stock number, but you might be able to shame him into taking off the dealer fee. If you raise a "big enough stink", the dealer would be smart to take off the dealer fee than claim that technicality, especially if you were to advise the local TV station or newspaper.

(6) [www.TrueCar.com](http://www.TrueCar.com) is the one third party buying source which requires its certified dealers to give you a final price excluding only GOVERNMENT fees only...sales tax and license plate/registration. This prohibits the dealer from adding dealer fees and dealer installed accessories. Consumer Reports, American Express, USAA, GEICO, and other blue-chip companies use TrueCar.

I hope that these suggestions help you and I hope that you will file a complaint with the Florida Attorney General, Pam Bondi. If enough consumers (who are also voters) let our elected officials know how they feel about the Dealer Fee, it will bring positive results. # Sometimes, time means nothing

I was backing up some data a while back to an external USB drive, when I noticed a behavior that is not uncommon at all.

As I began backing up the contents of a rather bloated documents folder (several hundred gigabytes worth of data), during the copy process I noticed the “estimated time remaining” figure was jumping all over the place.

It started out saying something like 48 minutes remaining, and then jumped down to 30, 18 and then 11 minutes.

As I watched the file copy process progress, I noticed the estimated time remaining figure stayed at 11 minutes for more than an hour. The progress bar was moving slowly to the right, and just as I thought the file transfer was just about over, the progress bar jumped back about a third of the way across.

The time remaining figure jumped to a whopping 25,464,387 minutes. Consulting my trusty calculator watch, I figured that 25,464,387 minutes was the equivalent of 17,683 days or 48 years. No, that couldn't be right.

As I watched, the number bounced around some, dropping from the incredibly high 25 million mark and dropping to more manageable numbers, such as 45 minutes, 28 and once again 11 minutes and there it stayed for another 45 minutes.

I finally got fed up with watching (it's like watching paint dry) and shut off the monitor, so I don't know when it actually finished. But when I came back to it in

the morning, the file copy was complete. And it didn't take 48 years. But it got me thinking; what is this estimated time remaining business all about, and can that figure ever be trusted?

I've certainly seen that behavior before with other file copy operations, downloads from the internet, CD burning and other similar procedures, and I've always taken that number with a grain of salt, but that 25 million figure caught my attention. What is going on with this picture?

Well, in order to understand why that number fluctuates so wildly, it's necessary to keep in mind that, on any given computer, what's happening at any given moment is not necessarily the way things are going to happen in the next moment. So the “estimated” part of “estimated time remaining” is just that an estimate based on the conditions taken at that particular time slice. And what happens, from second-to-second is those conditions are changing. Rapidly.

What that means is when the computer starts a file transfer, it grabs hold of a chunk of data and looks to see how much bandwidth is available. Then it bases its estimate of how long it will take on that. But that estimate does not take into


account things such as the overhead activity between the device and the computer and how much of the buffer is still available, etc., you know, lots of other technical things that are happening at the same time as the data transfer.

Let me rephrase it like this: As soon as the file transfer starts, all the figures the computer based its' estimate on change, because of the dynamic way computers do things.

What that boils down to is the estimated time for transfer is rarely accurate, because the conditions are constantly changing and can't be relied on, especially when it predicts that it will take 48 years.

One question that is bound to come up is: “Is this strictly a Windows issue?” and to that I would have to say no. I've observed the same behavior on my Macs as well as other operating systems.

So that, in a nutshell, is an explanation for the never-accurate estimated time remaining issue that I'm sure we've all experienced at one time or another.



I would personally like to see them do away with the estimated time figure and just stick with a graphical progress meter. That would make a whole lot more sense than the arbitrary numbers we get now, and they are easier to read at a glance.

Women brought home the gold in Salt Lake City in 2002, and the four-man USA-1 team won gold in Vancouver in 2010. It was the first time an American four-man team placed first since 1948.

# Visit one of Florida's oldest courses in Clewiston

Many of us are familiar with the famous golf trail that is in Alabama. How many of you are aware that Florida, too, has a golf trail? The Florida Historic Golf Trail includes 53 golf courses from the Florida Panhandle to the Keys, each built between 1897 and 1949.

Florida's golf history is one of the oldest in the nation, with a number of its earliest courses being created as the development of railroads and hotels came to the state.

The Florida Historic Golf Trail celebrates this early heritage and features golf courses around the state that are still accessible to public play. Some of the courses have retained much of their historic character, while others have been tweaked or redesigned.

One of the oldest courses on the Trail sits on the southwest corner of Lake

Okeechobee. Clewiston Golf Club originally was commissioned by the City of Clewiston in 1928. Construction of the first nine holes, designed by Stiles and Van Kleek, was started in 1929 and opened for play in early 1930.

The course was built to answer the demand from the public for a place to play golf. Before the course was built, golfers played a short, five-hole layout in Civic Center Park in the middle of the town.

While the course was designed to be 18 holes, the location of the second nine was

being used as the city's airfield and it wasn't until the 1960s that the final nine was completed.

If you've ever been around Lake Okeechobee, you will know that most of the land is flat. The land that Clewiston Golf Club sits on was no exception. Captain F. Deanne Duff was in charge of the original construction and used dirt pulled from water hazards to make elevated, rolling greens complexes and elevated tee boxes.

In addition to being a great place for golfers to play after work and on weekends, the course became a source of income for the local school children, who earned money caddying and selling the balls they would collect from the water hazards.

The course no longer has caddies, but it still has water; elevated, rolling greens, and now a lot of mature trees.

I teed it up here this past weekend and had a splendid time. The course has four sets of tees and plays as short as 3,837 yards to as long as 6,444 yards. My group chose a set that came in at just under 5,800- yards long.

You may think that to be a bit short. On a couple holes it may have been, but more often than not, we found ourselves having to shape shots and work the ball around the course. Every hole has a place in the fairway that makes for an easier approach and it isn't always the most obvious.

I must tell you that you need to avoid the rough. Keep the ball in the fairway or you just may find a lie that you will not like. The ball seems to like to sit down in the rough and there were times when my club simply didn't want to cut through it.

The greens are very different than what I am used to. They sit like large bowls with plenty of break to them. If you miss, you will likely be chipping to a surface that you cannot see. The speed of the greens was not lightning fast, but that was namely because of the rain the course has seen. Besides, I would hate to have a downhill putt on these greens if they were much faster.

While the par-5s are not long by any measure, they do require an exact approach, especially if you plan to get on the green in two.

My favorite hole on the course is No. 12. This par-4 requires a slight fad off the tee and your approach is to a green guarded by water right and a bunker left. It's one of the more tricky greens on the course as well.

Clewiston Golf Course is easy to walk, you won't find a building, other than the clubhouse, any where on the course, and your round will remind you of days gone by. If you are lucky, you may just run into one of the city's retired mayors who works at the course. He may even treat you to a few great stories about the town and its history. My day was a most wonderful experience.

## MARYLAND CRAB CAKES

Serves 6-8

### Ingredients

- 1 pound crabmeat
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1 teaspoon yellow mustard
- 1/2-cup mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter
- 1/2-cup diced onion
- 1/2-cup red bell pepper diced
- 1 teaspoon hot sauce
- 1/2-teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1 teaspoon sea salt
- 1 teaspoon crab seasoning (Old Bay)
- 1/2-cup fresh crackers mashed fine
- 1 cup panko breading
- 1/2-cup mashed potatoes (optional)

### Directions

Sauté onions and red peppers in butter until translucent, add to crabmeat in mixing bowl. Add beaten egg and remaining ingredients. Mix lightly. Form the crab cake mixture into the desired size. Bread with panko breading and place in the refrigerator for an hour prior to frying.

Fry in skillet with vegetable oil on medium to high heat (about 1/2-inch of oil in bottom of skillet). Fry on one side until golden brown and turn over on other side to get the same golden brown color.

## FRIED GREEN TOMATOES WITH BLUE CHEESE DRESSING

Serves 6-8

### Ingredients

- 6 green tomatoes, in 1/2-inch thick slices
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 1-1/2 cup peanut oil (or vegetable oil)
- 2 cups white cornmeal
- 1 cup flour
- 1 tablespoon salt
- 2 teaspoons black pepper
- 1 teaspoon Cajun spice seasoning
- Pinch of basil
- Pinch of oregano
- Pinch of cilantro
- Pinch of thyme
- Dash of nutmeg

Salt and pepper to taste

### Directions

Season tomatoes with salt and pepper; place slices in buttermilk for 1 hour. Mix cornmeal, flour, salt and pepper, Cajun spice seasoning, and spices. Dredge tomato slices in mixture. Heat oil in heavy gauged pan at 275-300° F. Place tomatoes in hot oil for 3-4 minutes on each side, or until golden brown and tender to touch. Place on lined pan to drain. Keep warm.

## BLUE CHEESE DRESSING

### Ingredients

- 1/2 cup heavy cream
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- Few ounces very good blue cheese (or Gorgonzola), crumbled
- 1 cup good mayonnaise
- 1 teaspoon hot sauce
- Salt and pepper to taste

### Directions

Place all ingredients in a bowl and mix well.






