"My heart is just touched by the warmth of the community," Yakes told the crowd who came out to support the artists, the Gulfport Merchant's Association and the city. Beach Club Wins Right to Short-term Rental

Despite resident outcry and an argument from the district's commissioner, the St. Pete Beach city commission voted four to one to grant the Beach Club at Pass-a-Grille a land use and zoning change that will allow increased density and short-term rentals.

The eight unit condominium already operates outside the law, offering short-term rentals. The vote, the first of two, will make this legal for this building only. The building is a half-block outside

While Councilman Henderson pushed for later meetings, Banno said she prefers before dinner so she can "have dinner with my family."



Gulfport Fresh Market Sets Records

GULFPORT- The Gulfport Tuesday Fresh Market has set a new record in the number of vendors participating each week. The Fresh Market is now in its sixth year of operations, beginning in 2006 with a handful of vendors. Now in the height of "snowbird season," the Fresh Market regularly features over 60 vendor booths with a wide variety of choices,

making it one of the largest weekly open-air markets in Tampa Bay. Attendance at the Market has also reached record numbers during the "snowbird" season, with over 3,000 visitors each Tuesday swelling the sidewalks of Beach Blvd.

Fresh produce is a mainstay at the Market, including locally grown and family-farmed offerings. Thirty other vendors offer gourmet, artisan, ethnic, fresh and prepared foods of all sorts. The line-up also includes

garden plants and fresh flowers, hand-made bath and body products, pet treats, hand-made jewelry and other crafts. Services offered during the Market include expert knife and tool sharpening and chair massage. A number of artists and artisans typically work on their own creations during the event while market-goers watch. Local musician entertain in two separate locations during the Market.

Market-goers typically visit Gulfport's other attractions on Market days, including the many shops and restaurants in and near the Fresh Market area in Gulfport's Waterfront District. Parking is free and all businesses in the Waterfront village are independently owned and operated.

While most other markets in Florida close for the summer, the Gulfport Tuesday Fresh Market is a year-round event with a wide array of independent "Mom and Pop" shops opening for business on the streets once a week. 



"Whatever we set it I'll likely have a conflict at some point." - Councilman Sam Henderson, about the workshop schedule







Sunshine Law Refresher for Gulfport Council

With a new council seated around the workshop table, Gulfport city attorney Andy Salzman offered a refresher course in "Government in the Sunshine" law. Councilmembers also have a handbook and the opportunity to take a course on dealing with serving as an elected official.

Among other things, Salzman told the council a lack of public notice, public access or minutes taken at meetings constitutes a Sunshine Violation. Violations carry criminal charges and civil penalties.

"More importantly, you have to redo the whole act again, so the city incurs time, cost and embarrassment," Salzman said.

He also cautioned the council against what he called "the appearance of impropriety."

"You're in a small town. There's the appearance of impropriety... the two of you are neighbors, the two of you are friends. You're talking, somebody overhears a word, and that's a controversial issue that comes up [...] You all can be put in a bad light when you really have done

nothing wrong," he said.

The solution?

"Do not talk about things you're going to conceivably vote on," he told the council. "Does that mean you can't go to a neighborhood meeting together? Absolutely not, but what you avoid is saying how you're going to vote on a particular issue."

Council also should be careful, he said, they aren't "using somebody as a conduit," or passing – intentionally or inadvertently – information between a third person.

He advised the council they could e-mail each other as long as they, "just don't say how you're going to vote on a situation."

Social media, the attorney cautioned, posed a new problem.

"The problem that we're having is that there are too many media outlets ... and we're not sure what is a public record," he said.

"My first thing to you would be 'do not have a Facebook,'" Salzman said.

"You weren't saying no Facebook, you were saying no discussion," Councilwoman Jennifer Salmon told

him. Salzman amended this to say "if you have a Facebook, do not give your opinion... you just have to avoid it. You absolutely have to avoid it."

He told the council to give anything that could be a public record to the city clerk, the designated custodian of public record. However, he cautioned the council, "the law does not allow for any time delay for public record," so if a person requested a record that the clerk didn't yet have, the city could find itself in violation of the law.

"I want to protect you, I want to protect the city, I want to protect the integrity of what you do," he finished.





Get Your Beer at Merry Pier

PASS-A-GRILLE – While Merry Pier has long sold package beer and wine, Tuesday night the city commission amended the lease to allow customers to drink the beer and wine on site.

“What we’re trying to accomplish is to allow people to come and buy a single beer out of cooler and just enjoy it on the dock,” Nancy Davidek, Merry Pier management, said. She said the Pier had no plans to hire servers or create a bar environment; rather, she wanted to allow fishermen or tour boat patrons to drink a beer while fishing or after their Shell Key trips.

The city leases Merry Pier to a private company. Commissioner Bev Garnett, who represents Pass-a-Grille, said she hoped

the city would have the right to revisit the permission if the alcohol became a problem.

Only Mayor Steve McFarlin did not support this.

“There’s bars everywhere down there,” he said of Pass-a-Grille. “I just don’t see the need. You put alcohol down there, you don’t know what’s going to happen.”

Commissioner Garnett pointed out that the city allowed Paradise Grill to sell beer and wine. The city has a similar lease situation with the two snack bars on the beach. Davidek said she wanted to allow the fishing charter customer to have a beer while waiting for the crew to clean the day’s catch.

The mayor also cited kids as a reason not to sell alcohol.

“We’ve got to keep our kids in mind.

Something’s got to be sacred,” he said.

“I see your point, but a lot of time it’s the parents of the kids who are asking if they can have a beer.”

the two artists to create pieces for the downtown.

In past years the GMA donated some of the Geckofest proceeds to a local charity. This year, members opted to do something for Gulfport instead.

“We wanted to give something back to the community, and the reason it’s at that end of the street is that we felt that it signified the beginning of the Waterfront District,” Gulfport Merchant Association president Leslie Gilchrist said. In October the Gulfport Merchant’s Association asked the two artists for designs; Saturday afternoon, the artists presented the finished work to the public.

Pach’s piece, on the north side of the street, is a study in glass and steel. Strunk’s work, across Beach Boulevard on the south side, has an industrial metal motif.

Both artists work in Gulfport, although the GMA initially approached Pach for the public art.

“We chose the artist because Owen is very involved in the Waterfront District, and he actually led us to Frank,” she added. “They’re amazing.”

Pach called the public art “Leslie’s legacy,” but she denied credit, saying that while she suggested finding a way to get public art on display for the city, the entire Merchant’s Association deserved the praise for the two pieces.

“It wasn’t anything I did by myself. Everyone embraced it right away,” she said. Both Pach and Strunk maintain studios in Gulfport.

Pach, who works out of Artist’s Alley alongside Schork-Munsell studios and other artists, says not since he lived in Ybor City years ago did he feel so warmly about a community.

“I haven’t been anywhere else it felt so good to be,” Pach told the crowd Saturday night. He also praised fellow artist, Strunk, calling him “a great inspiration and a great friend.”

Strunk, who works out of an industrial bay just off 49th Street, also spoke about Gulfport.

“I love Gulfport. I love what it’s about. I love working here. I’ve never found any place else with the spirit of Gulfport,” he said.



St. Pete Beach Traffic Couplet, Simplified

Thursday evening the city of St. Pete Beach held a public workshop about the proposed couplet that would circle Corey Avenue. During the workshop residents and businesses had the chance to study different facets of the traffic plan and ask questions.

Based on the city's traffic plan for Corey, interviews with Senior Planner Catherine Hartley, and the information from the workshop, the Gabber created a simplified graphic of the proposed traffic flow along the couplet.

the district of Pass-a-Grille that allows this.

“Basically there’s no real change in the use,” Senior Planner Catherine Hartley explained. “There’s no impact to services. The traffic impact is negligible [and] the building is already there.”

Cortland Realty Partners II owns five units and claims they purchased the units at 701 Gulf Way with the understanding they could operate

them as short term rentals. Cortland Realty Partners II bought the five units “in a distress sale” according to attorney Deborah Martohue, and didn’t realize they couldn’t rent the units short term until they received a violation for doing so.

Deborah Martohue, donated to both Commissioner Lorraine Huhn and Vice Mayor Marvin Shavlan’s campaigns.

Cortland Realty Partners II owns five units; Anthony and Angelina Verna, Clayton and Jamie Skagen, and Michael and Marian Hobbins

each own one.

The Beach Club used to include 11 units; about five or six years ago a renovation reduced the number of units to eight.

By a vote of four to one, the Planning Board recommended approval in January, with the condition that the units may not be rented for less than a week at a time.

David Howard, who lives next to the Club, said that he took issue with the city planning board, who he said misled the residents.

“We were led to believe we would have another chance at another planning board meeting before it came here,” he said “specifically by Ron Holehouse, who you appointed, thank you... No disrespect intended.”

He scoffed at the idea that the owners didn’t know they didn’t have appropriate zoning.

“You’re really going to go and spend three million dollars without checking the zoning? Nobody in their right mind would do that,” Howard said.

Finally, he pointed out that the owners didn’t live in the city.

“The owners are not here. The registered voters on that street are here,” he said. “Please, please, please, listen to us. This is what the full-time residents who are in town want.”

Former commissioner and Pass-a-Grille resident Harry Metz also spoke against the change. Although he and Commissioner Garnett often disagree, they both came down on the same side of this issue.

"Again, the residents are going to suffer...because of another bad investment from an out-of-towner," he told the commission.

"The applicant tonight would like to make this a complicated issue," Pass-a-Grille resident Dane Bean said after Martohue's lengthy presentation, "but if you take what you're supposed to consider... Those criteria are neutral or negative [on this issue.]"

He, too, said the voters and residents near the Club didn't want the change.

"Only when you have a compelling reason to disregard the voter's wishes should you put your judgment above our judgment. These people are not entitled to this... They are asking for a special privilege," he added.

Hartley told the commission the city would likely not be able to regulate the one-week rental stipulation put in place by the planning board.

Commissioner Bev Garnett, the Pass-a-Grille representative, spoke about the importance of preserving the area's character and not allowing gradual redevelopment district encroachment on the residential area.

Vice Mayor Marvin Shavlan asked Hartley's opinion.

"From a comprehensive planning standpoint, you're not looking at an impact," she told him. "There was one criteria that talked about a need, and no one has submitted any evidence that pointed at a need."

"It's always the person from District Four opposing the changes in Pass-a-Grille," Commissioner Bev Garnett said. The planning board also voted 4 - 1, although the dissenting vote came from Will Jacoby, a District One resident.

"One day we're all going to wake up and say, 'Pass-a-Who?'" Commissioner Garnett said.



Points On Pets

Matty's Hero

According to SafeKids.org, about 230 children die every year in "backover" or "frontover" accidents: accidents in which they are run over by a car, usually driven by a family member or close friend, and often in their own driveway. Imagine what that number is for dogs and cats. Then imagine what the aftermath looks like. Here's a glimpse:

Kona, a Labrador mix, was 8 weeks old when my husband, Ron, and I brought her home. She was my first puppy, and I adored her!

On Memorial Day of 2005, Ron and I and the dogs -- Kona and our 5-year-old Rottweiler, KC -- were out front enjoying a beautiful day. I was washing my car; he was washing his work van.

Unknown to us, Kona had fallen asleep under the wheel of Ron's van. When he went to move the van, he ran over her. I heard her cry out, and I screamed, too. Ron panicked and rolled the van back over her again. It was pandemonium at that point. I grabbed Kona, who was already going into shock, and Ron got a blanket. He and I rushed our puppy to our vet. They couldn't help her, so we took her to a clinic.

The doctor told us Kona's back left leg was broken in three places. Her tail was broken at the base and would have to be removed. The possibility of her ever being able to control her bowels was slim to none. We knew he was trying to tell us that there was no hope for Kona. Ron was guilt-ridden. I could not stop crying. Ron told the doctor to save her.

When we took her home, she had a metal rod in her leg. We had to keep her in a pen. A 5-month-old puppy. Can you imagine? My husband built her a really nice pen, and we kept it clean and free of feces. She had many meds that needed to be administered throughout the day and night. Needless to say, our lives were completely centered on Kona.

We got through the months of rehab,

and her bowels were functioning perfectly. We were so happy! Then a strange skin infection appeared on her rear hip. To make a long story short, she needed surgery to cut out the infection: She had more than 200 stitches and gained the nickname FrankenPuppy, but she recovered from that, as well.

When you see Kona run, you would never know the awful events that plagued her life and ours when she was a puppy. She is a living miracle. We never regretted the expense or the time involved in getting her through it all.

The best way to prevent "frontover" and "backover" accidents is to be aware that they happen. Check under and around your car before moving it. Know where your dog is at all times. Keep him out of the street and away from the driveway. Use a lead in

the front yard. Keep him on a leash. Fence in the front yard, separating it from the driveway and the road. Or decide that the front yard is off limits to the dog.

Kona is one of the lucky ones. Lucky in life, lucky in love. Not everyone has the financial resources, and there are times when there is no way around that. But it's also true that not everyone is willing to stand by through thick and thin, in sickness and in health.

Often, when I share a letter from a reader, it's an example of what not to do. But this letter is an example of pet ownership at its best: total commitment, unflinching responsibility and wholehearted dedication to the health and well-being of the animals that enrich our lives.

Decisions, Decisions, Decisions

This week, let's take a look at how legal transfers of control and decision-making work.

Guardianship

This is a legal process in which the court places an individual or agency in control of someone else's affairs. Since establishing a guardianship requires action by the Court system, it can be expensive and cumbersome. In addition, guardianship reduces an individual's legal rights to those of a minor.

Conservatorship

This is a type of guardianship that applies only to a person's property and not his or her personal matters. As such, its scope is less restrictive, and the individual involved retains many of his or her legal rights.

Durable Power of Attorney

By establishing a power of attorney, you authorize someone else to act in your behalf. You can give very limited powers, such as authorizing someone to sell property for you, or very broad powers, such as paying bills, making investment decisions, or making all decisions for you.

A durable power of attorney remains in force even if the person who establishes it becomes incompetent. While a power of attorney is generally established to ensure that your affairs will be handled for you, it must be durable to be effective in the event of your incapacity. Any power of attorney, including a durable one, becomes null and void when either the person granting it or the person to whom it is granted dies.

You should be sure to specify exactly what functions are to be covered by the durable power of attorney. For example, medical decisions, investment choices and property care can be named specifically.

Of course, a durable power of attorney should be given only to someone you trust implicitly to act in your best interest. You should

consult an attorney for the specific requirement of a durable power of attorney.



"How do we go about the process of electing a vice mayor? Because we've done the rotation, we've seen people sit in it for years, we've gone through the motions [...] It feels like we don't have this process," Councilman Sam Henderson asked.

After discussing options such as rotating through the wards and calling on the senior councilmember to serve, Councilman Henderson questioned the necessity of the position.

"Other than attending events when you're not available, other than the fact that it's in the charter, do we need to have a vice mayor?" he asked, adding "I feel like it's being used to hit somebody over the head with to say who's vice mayor."

He also asked Mayor Mike Yakes how much value he put in the position.

"I don't find it an overtasked job," the mayor replied. "The last couple of months, quite frankly, have become very personal with me and somewhat upsetting over the emphasis placed [on the vice mayorship] because it affects me to the fact of, 'Am I going to survive?'"

"You know what?" he continued, "How do you like people looking at you like, 'You've been a good mayor but I don't know if I'll see you again?'"

The mayor did praise anyone willing to assume the role of vice mayor.

"I admire anyone who steps up to the plate for extra responsibilities for the city. Not for me, not for them," he said. He indicated the city needed a vice mayor.

"Somebody's gonna help, and you know what? I'm not selfish. I don't care who it is," he said.

Energy Assistance Available for Seniors

Senior citizens may be eligible for \$600 to help pay power bills through the Emergency Energy Assistance Program.

To receive assistance, county residents who are age 60 or older must have a crisis with a delinquent notice from the utility company or a

notice that power has been shut off. They may also qualify for a voucher for heaters and blankets. In hot weather, they may qualify to receive repairs to a cooling unit or a voucher for a fan.

Funded by the Area Agency on Aging of Pasco/Pinellas Inc., the program enables eligible seniors to receive help up to twice a year during each high-demand season. Pinellas County Health and Human Services staff members screen applicants to determine if they meet income limits: 150 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, a limit of \$16,355 a

year on a household of one. For two people, the income limit is \$22,065. There is an addition of \$5,730 for each additional household member.





Featuring the Eden Valley Region of Australia

Eden Valley is a wine region South of Australia. It occupies the Barossa Valley, one of the most qualitatively significant wine-growing areas of the world. The region derives its name from the small town of Eden

Valley – known as the Garden of Grapes and Gums.
