Petitions to rescind utility tax come up short

Deerfield Beach – A last-ditch effort by members of the Rescind Utility Tax movement fell short this week. Petitions turned in to the Broward County Supervisor of Elections were found insufficient to force a referendum on the tax.

Of the 1,317 signatures submitted for certification, 546 were deemed invalid by the supervisor's office. Needed to request an election were 1,200.

Poitier's conviction may be the end of her long public role

Deerfield Beach – Sylvia Poitier's 40-year political career likely ended this week with her conviction on four counts of falsifying public records. Poitier, 76, was found guilty Wednesday. A sentencing hearing is set for Nov. 30 at 10 a.m. Maximum penalty for her misdemeanors is one

year in jail and \$1,000 fine per count. Or she could receive probation, house arrest or community service. She has no prior convictions.

The jury deliberated only 90 minutes before finding the former Broward County Commissioner and Deerfield Beach City Commissioner guilty of hiding the fact her brother

Beachfront towers get commission approval

Second hearing on 120-unit condo project is Tuesday

Pompano Beach- Commissioners last week gave the nod to developers of two 17-story beachfront condominiums despite objections from residents who say the structures will block their views, air and light.

In moving the project along, the commission followed staff and planning and zoning board recommendations and rezoned the three-acre tract from a category that allowed 25 residential units per acre to residential planned urban development, or RPUD. The new zoning increases the density on the parcel, but allows for design flexibility that developer representatives say will have less impact on

City ready to discuss civic/cultural center with theater

Lionel Ferguson had loaned the West Deerfield Beach Businessman Association \$46,000 to pay the taxes on 24, low-income living units. When it came time to vote the Association community block grant funds, Poitier stated other conflicts of interest, but did not acknowledge that she had interceded for the Association and had persuaded Ferguson to come up the needed funds.

"This poor man is out \$46,000," Mayor Peggy

Noland said.

Poitier was arrested in April, a month after handily winning re-election in District 2. A few months prior to that, Mayor Noland had called for Poitier to resign based on information that had come out in a review of city financial records.

Poitier refused to step down, but when arrested and charged with five counts of falsifying public records, was suspended by the governor.

Of Poitier's conviction, Mayor Noland said, "She did something wrong and she got convicted. The public

is not putting up with these shenanigans any longer."

Poitier had several dozen supporters in the courtroom throughout her two- and- a-half- day trial. Among them was resident Terry Scott who said Thursday, "I am staying 100 percent behind Commissioner Poitier. She is not guilty of any of the four charges. I do not believe the jury gave her a fair trial." Scott said he was "really surprised" at the verdict and that her other "long time supporters are just as surprised."

Scott said "a great

percentage of District 2 would agree with my comments."

The person who may be at last resting easy is Commissioner Ben Preston, elected in June to fill Poitier's position. Had she been found not guilty, she would have been returned to the dais by the governor.

"I had resolved myself to whatever the legal system said, I would abide by it," Preston said on Thursday.

Now that he has almost three years left in his term, Preston said he can go forward with his priorities two of which are making

his district attractive to new businesses, and getting kids in programs that will keep them out of trouble.

He is making plans to take a number of children to a movie being released in January about the Tuskegee Airmen, an elite squad of black pilots that made their mark in WWII. "I want the kids to know their history," he said.

Poitier's attorney Johnny McCray Jr., said he will ask Judge Melinda Broad to overturn the conviction. If that fails, he will file an appeal.

Federal agencies offer low-cost loans due to recent rain damage

Broward County – Damage resulting from the heavy rains between Oct. 28 and Oct. 31 have left homeowners, renters and business owners with significant repairs. But help is already here.

Because the damage did not fall under the criteria of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, or FEMA, Gov. Rick Scott has tapped the Small Business Administration, a federal agency, to assist rain victims.

SBA has opened offices at The Mills Pond Park Community Center, 2201 NW 9 Ave., Fort Lauderdale to process damage applications.

Low-cost loans will be available to those persons who can validate their claims of damage.

Michael Lampton, director of affairs of the SBA Office of Disaster Assistance, said the offices will be open through Nov. 22 and if needed, days of operation will be extended.

Loans for homeowners, up to \$200,000 will be issued at a rate of 2.063 percent.

Renters may seek loans for up to \$40,000 at the same rate. Loans for non-profit businesses that were damaged are 3 percent. Business owners may seek loans of up to \$2 million at a rate of 4 percent.

Deadlines for loans relating to property damages are Jan. 13. Loans regarding economic loss must be filed by Aug. 14.

Stuff the turkey, not the pet

Dr. Tim Johnston, veterinarian, Broward County Animal Care and Adoption, reminds all pet owners to keep their dogs and cats safe during the holiday weekend.

“So much of Thanksgiving centers around food and eating that people often are tempted to feed a traditional Thanksgiving meal — complete with turkey and stuffing — to their pets. However, such a meal can get your dog or cat very sick or can even be lethal,” cautions Dr. Johnston.

Instead, the veterinarian offers ten important safety tips to ensure that your pet stays healthy and safe.

Keep your pet on its regular feeding schedule. Whatever time you normally feed your pet, stay with that routine.

Feed your pet its regular food. Giving pets Thanksgiving scraps can cause abdominal pain, diarrhea and vomiting.

Do not feed your pet any part of the turkey. While people may think that turkey is safe, often the seasoning from the turkey drippings, along with the skin and gravy can cause pancreatitis — inflammation of the pancreas. Do not give your pet bones! Turkey bones are particularly dangerous since they can splinter and cause intestinal damage.

Secure the garbage pail! Table scraps, food wrappings, bones and other items can be tempting to your pet. Even simple items like aluminum foil and the string from the turkey can be consumed since your pet will smell



Mrs. Adderly-Gillis' time in Pompano Beach began when she was 22. She lived with her sister Elizabeth in a house that lacked indoor plumbing until the early 1950's.

It was the large community admiration that grew over the years that brought this day, the park and these people together.

Mrs. Adderly-Gillis is remembered for using her family boat after the 1948 flood to rescue people from their homes.

She baked communion bread for the members of Bethel A.M.E. Church for 40 years. She served in many capacities for the church including serving on the board of trustees.

Hazel Armbrister, moderator of the dedication recalled Adderly-Gillis' famous hats. Commissioner Woody Poitier welcomed

Adderly-Gillis' life, as it was unveiled at the dedication, was not one of

"She had a direct line to the Master," said Dorothy Gay, a friend of the family.

the food and seasonings on such items. Be sure that all trash containers, both inside the house and outside, are securely closed so that animals cannot tear through the garbage for a private Thanksgiving feast.

Keep your pet in another room during dinnertime, so that they cannot sit and beg at the table. In addition, guests will not be tempted to give them any food.

Do not give pets chocolate! Chocolate is toxic and can affect the heart and nervous system.

Do not give your pet alcohol or eggnog to drink. Alcohol can cause coma and death in animals. Eggnog is extremely rich and can cause diarrhea.

Do make sure that your pet has plenty of fresh water at all times.

Most important, make sure that your pet is wearing proper identification. Pets

can easily escape through the front or patio doors when guests come to your home. Remember that all dogs and cats within Broward County must be licensed and wear the license tag on their collar. This is the best to ensure that your pet is reunited with you if he or she becomes lost during the Thanksgiving holiday.

Broward County's Animal Care and Adoption Center is dedicated to providing shelter for lost and surrendered animals as well as the successful adoption of pets. The agency also coordinates the licensing of dogs and cats and provides rabies vaccinations in order to encourage a healthier pet population.

Among their gravest concerns on the list of more than 50 questions Commissioner Weiss presented them last month, was a conflict of interest issue raised when it was learned that the Authority's architect Kim Dellastatious was married to the president of Ridge Construction, a company that did work for the Authority.

Davis and her staff defended Ridge's work saying it was better quality and cheaper than others had provided. She agreed that the two would not work on the same projects in the future, but Commissioner Weiss disagreed saying, "Anytime

you put a husband and wife together, it raises suspicions." Weiss said he will bring that issue up again.

Others on the board found no fault with Davis using Ridge. "I don't think a good contractor should be penalized . . . why tie the hands of the administration?" Commissioner Joan Maurice said.

Commissioner Ernestine Gray said, "It is hard to get people to work on public housing. Why should we penalize this person?"

Commissioner Joan Maurice said, "I don't see misuse of funds. Some mistakes may have been made. Big deal. We'll fix them.

"This board will support you and your staff," she told Davis. "We're here to help

you. Let's end this thing."

Commissioner Weiss also had questions about attorney Bill Crawford's long stint as the Authority's legal counsel. Crawford served for many years without his position going out to bid. In 2010, he was awarded a contract through the bid process. "I think it should be put out to bid again immediately," Weiss said.

The questions, some

lengthy and involved, delved into Davis' relationships with various vendors, internal control procedures, HUD's procurement review, the Palms Townhomes, housing managed, but not owned, by the Authority and public records requests. Davis had prepared a written response which she read page-by-page to the commissioners. At the end of each questioned topic, the commission went on

record as being satisfied with Davis's explanations.

When challenged by a board member, Commissioner Weiss admitted that the questions he produced had been provided him by local blogger Chaz Stevens and fired housing authority employee, Leslie Hall.

"My obligation is to bring every public concern forward," Commissioner Weiss said.

Located at the sandy end of 14th St. Causeway, at the Lighthouse Cove resort, the newly opened Seaside Grill owners invite locals and tourists alike to experience its friendly ambiance, tasty fare and soothing vistas.

Brainchild of Pittsburgh transplant Bret Hughes, this bright and airy *trattoria*, with murals by local artist Mark Vose, has been earning substantial plaudits from visiting patrons.

"I honestly think we have the best food on the beach," says Hughes, a former Kettle Chip executive. And the view is beautiful - especially at night when there is a full moon."

This menu is a true South Florida/Caribbean blend with up a host of tantalizing specialties that will satisfy a wide array of palettes.

Seafood aficionados will appreciate the barely breaded lump crab cakes with mango chutney, the flour tortilla fish tacos, the sautéed mussels in garlic white wine sauce, the homemade smoked fish dip, the seared sesame tuna or the fried calamari with Fra Diabolo.

"Our fire jerk shrimp is definitely my favorite," says GM Brian Dewar, a Jamaican native who was in charge of the iconic Joe's Riverside Grill for 17 years before bringing his managerial talents to the Seaside. "But we also have other great appetizers like pulled pork sliders. Our warm goat cheese plate with sundried tomatoes, pesto and roasted garlic is excellent."

Soups and salads such as the Bahamian Conch Chowder made from the original Spanish Wells recipe or the mouthwatering Tropical Jerk chicken salad with citrus vinaigrette will be favorites. "The Buffalo chicken salad is really quite good," says Hughes who is also quite fond of the many satisfying sandwiches such as the Blackened Mahi Mahi, the Grilled Vegetable Wrap, the Clubhouse Classic and, of course, succulent burgers like the juicy 10-ounce hand-formed Black Angus beach burger with melted cheese and applewood smoked bacon.

neighboring buildings.

The tract, at 1116 N. Ocean Boulevard, is owned by The Related Group, one of the country's largest builders and managers of residential units. The company has nine condominium buildings in Hollywood and Miami, a location at CitiPlace in West Palm Beach and a project "on hold" for the old Hyde Park site at 500 E. Las Olas Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale.

Their attorney, Debbie Orshesky, said her client has worked with its nearest neighbor Century Plaza to achieve a mitigation agreement. Plaza resident Ed Stanton said this week the condo board has accepted \$82,500 from the developers to compensate residents for construction noise and inconvenience. Of that amount, the condo attorneys get almost half for negotiating the number, Stanton said.

A retired attorney, Stanton tried to put city staff and Orshesky through a cross examination aimed at showing that there is no hardship to justify the rezoning. Under the city code, properties with the RPUD classification, must be at least five acres, or show a hardship that makes development difficult. Stanton said Orshesky has shown "no evidence whatever" that there are unusual circumstances connected to the property. Later, he told the Pelican that he and other residents of his building would file a lawsuit against the city on the grounds it did not meet the legal requirements of a rezoning. "There is no evidence to justify the waiver," he said.

Stanton, who lives on the eighth floor of Century Plaza in a corner unit, said construction of the 17-story towers would block his water and horizon views as well as lower the real estate value of his home. Stanton said the shape of Related's rectangular parcel did not create the necessary hardship, but Orshesky responded that there are other conditions that justify the rezoning including the difficulty of developing land surrounded by other buildings.

Century Plaza is located south of the proposed project. To the north is a proposed eight-story hotel recently approved by the city.

Stanton also questioned building setbacks especially from his building, the closest to one of the towers.

Drawings presented by the project architect showed light lines between the 160-foot towers, underground parking and lush, native landscaping.

The building footprints will cover 37 percent of the parcel rather than the 60 percent allowed under the old zoning, he said.

In response to both Stanton and Maureen Mangan, a resident of NE 12 Street who said the new development will take away her sunrise, City Commissioner Barry Dockswell said, "We are looking for something with less impact than what was allowed there."

The old RM-25 zone would have permitted 25 units per acre, for a total of 75. The current plan calls for 130 living units in the two towers.

Second reading of the rezoning ordinance is set for Tuesday, Nov. 22.

Jean Robb, co-chair of the petition drive, said Wednesday, she had hired a consultant to check the petitions for precinct accuracy, one of the

flaws when the initial drive ended September 30. This time, 38 petitions stated incorrect precincts and four had no precinct numbers. "I find it difficult to believe that we had 38 incorrect precincts. I have asked for a copy of the 546

signatures that were invalidated," Robb said.

Another 13 petitions had no signatures at all. But the largest number of invalid signatures was due to the fact 303 voters had already signed the petitions. "When we had a total of 15 days to amend our petition, we had no way to determine whether the signer had signed before," Robb said.

In her first effort, Robb turned in 5,614 signatures of registered voters of which 2,720 were found to be invalid. She says poorly defined precinct maps resulted in workers attaching the wrong precinct to the petitions. Her aim had been to collect 4,200 valid signatures, 10 percent of the voters registered here in the last election.

"We will be looking at the next election for representatives who will repeal this abusive tax," Robb said.

The public service tax, commonly referred to as a utility tax, was enacted last summer and went into effect at the start of the city's fiscal year, October 1. It places a 10 percent charge on water and power usage and is in place in almost all Broward County cities to supplement ad valorem tax revenues.

2012 Nissan Murano Cabriolet: Different is appealing

“Beauty is in the eye of the beholder,” goes the old adage.

In the automotive world where manufacturers work to design vehicles that are visually appealing around the world, it is the truly gutsy company like Nissan that takes chances rolling out cars like the Cube, the JUKE, the Leaf and the wonderfully fast GT-R.

But when the 2012 Nissan Murano Cross Cabriolet first

came to my attention, it was an article in the June 25, 2011 edition of the Wall Street Journal where Dan Neil said of the two-door convertible, “Some cars may strike your fancy and others not, but it’s a rare product that is really crazy-awful...”

The 2012 Nissan Murano Cross Cabriolet is unique to say the least. When I first saw it, I admit to being caught off guard. It has the familiar Murano front end and grill, but then it starts to morph into something unexpected of the very popular four-door SUV.



With a price tag of just under \$50,000 you expect a lot and you get it even though it is available in only one loaded trim level. The Murano Cabriolet comes standard with 20-inch alloy wheels, automatic xenon headlights, fog lights, heated mirrors, a fully powered soft top and keyless ignition/entry.

First of all I notice the hard top roof is gone. It has been replaced with a fabric constructed convertible top that is mechanically stowed in the trunk.

Next, two of the four doors have vanished and since the roof has disappeared so have the “b” posts between. As you walk around the Murano Cross Cabriolet, you notice

that this convertible sits higher than the standard rag top. Walk around back and the roomy storage area, a

signature the SUV Murano, is still be there, but it is hidden in a very roomy trunk. Open the side door and it looks like a fully loaded luxury Murano and as a convertible it has a vast amount of passenger room both front and back.

I took a Murano Cross Cabriolet on my Sunday morning rounds, which always ends with a trip to Publix.

On this particular Sunday I witnessed the validation of the old adage about beauty and the beholders eye. When I parked, a husband and wife walked up to me asked me what was I driving and where could they get one, I thought they were joking. No, they were actually giddy about it. Then I was just about to the door when a friend that had seen me in the parking lot approached me to inquire about the "fun looking car."

When I finished my shopping I returned to the parking lot to find another couple, this one visiting from Maryland, who finished their line of questioning asking if the Murano Cabriolet was available in their home state.

Over the next couple of days the looks and inquires continued to be a common occurrence. While the attention it generated was cool, it did make me rethink my taste in automotive design as I had been leaning toward being a member of the Dan Neil camp.

Under the skin it is still a

Murano powered by a 3.5-liter V6 that produces 265 horsepower and 248 pound-feet of torque. All-wheel drive and a continuously variable automatic transmission (CVT) are standard.

Also standard are antilock brakes, traction and stability control, pop-up roll bars, front seat side airbags and door-mounted curtain-style side airbags.

In the cockpit, it gets automatic dual-zone climate

control, cruise control, a rearview camera, an eight-way power driver seat with power lumbar adjustment, heated front seats, leather upholstery, and a power-operated tilt-and-telescoping steering wheel.

Additional standard electronic features include a navigation system with real-time traffic updates, Bluetooth phone and audio connectivity, plus a seven-speaker Bose sound system with CD player, satellite radio and iPod connections.

The daytime bite for swords has been consistent this week with reports of 4 to 8 bites during a trip with all above average fish.

Weekly reports of sailfish bite change hourly from red hot to mediocre.

Dolphin have been showing up a little more this last week from schoolies to 30 pounders. They have been in close as shallow as 30 feet to depths of 800 feet,

So if you're catching Spanish mackerel or ballyhoo, have something always ready for them if they happen to show up this close to the beach.

Wahoo fishing has been excellent trolling on the reef and out to 500 feet with J.

Camm artificials at 8 to 11 knots. Fish have been ranging from 20 to 60 pounds and reports of some fish dumping entire spools of line off the reels



or two weeks. This method has a 98 to 99 percent cure rate which is wonderful. The patient leaves this office reassured that all malignant tissue has been removed.”

Advice to All Florida Residents

The American Academy of Dermatology recommends a full body check every one to two years for men and women under 45 if there is no history of skin cancer. For those over 45, we suggest an annual check up unless there is a history of cancer. Then it is wise to see a dermatologist every six months.

Sr. says, “Because our weather is so warm and humid, nail fungus is often a problem which we treat topically and orally.

People in Florida, where the sun is a major player, have to be very careful. Use SPF30 sun screen on all exposed skin every day. When possible cover skin with clothing and wear a hat. There are articles of clothing and hats that are manufactured with extra protection built into the fabric. Sr. says, “Anyone who works outdoors or is foolish enough to still sun bathe for hours is especially at risk and should

be very aware of how to prevent skin trouble.

Jr. explains. “The SPF number refers to the burning rays, or UVB rays, of the sun, but be aware that you are not being protected against UVA rays, a major contributor to wrinkling skin, pigmentation of the skin and skin cancer. The best we can suggest is a broad spectrum sun screen which offers the most protection available.” He adds, “Be sure to talk with your doctor about the medicines you are taking as many of the popular

medications make a person sun sensitive. If this is the case, take extra precautions.”

Sr. shakes his head and says, “And there’s a man made problem. Beware tanning booths or tables. They are very dangerous. We are already seeing an increase in Melanomas in young people who have a history of using these beds. With a sigh he adds, “We wish we could legislate good common sense into users of these beds, but this is not possible.”

Because of HIPPA regula-

tions which protect patients’ privacy, the doctors Breza were unable to let Pelican readers hear from some of their patients. Breza Sr. says, “I’m proud to have patients who have been coming to me for many years. I have snowbirds who wait for their annual skin check up until they come to Florida to see me. Just this morning, I did a surgery on a snowbird who came in with his biopsy in hand. The dermatologist he used up north did not do surgery, so he waited until he

came to Florida to have me do it.”

The doctors see patients Monday to Friday from 7:30 to 5:30, and they always fit in emergencies. Call 954-337-8180 for an appointment.



filed.

District 1: Incumbent Barry Dockswell, 64, was first elected in March 2008. He was vice president of Citrix Systems from 1990-1998.

District 3: Incumbent Rex Hardin, 51, is employed at Cypress Printing Center in Pompano Beach. He was first elected in 1998 for two years and then elected again in

2007.

District 5: Incumbent and Vice Mayor George Brummer turned 81 on Nov. 15. He was an actuary for 30 years in executive and managerial capacities with life insurance companies and actuarial consulting firms retained by insurance companies and employee benefit clients. For more than 15 years he published "Currents," a community publication for Palm-Aire neighborhoods.

Brummer was elected to the District 5 seat in a special election in June 2003. He was re-elected without opposition in March 2004, 2006 and 2008 and against opposition in 2010. He is serving as the city's vice mayor for the fourth time.

Terms are for two years and eight months since the city is moving from March to November elections.

Lauderdale-By-The-Sea

In Lauderdale-By-The-Sea voters will elect a mayor and two commissioners.

Mayor: Incumbent Roseann Minnet, 52, is seeing her third two-year term as mayor. She is the owner of a lighting design company, Lightseeker, Inc. and has been in the lighting design industry for more than 25 years.

Seat 3: Mark H. Brown, 59, is the former executive editor of the local ByTheSeaFuture newspaper.

Edmund F. Malkoon, 36, is a licensed insurance agent and Realtor. He served on the town's Master Plan Steering Committee.

Seat 4: Incumbent Alexander Stuart Dodd is seeking his second four-year term as commissioner. The 63-year-old marine engineer currently serves as vice mayor.

Seat 4, Cindy Geesey filed to run against Stuart Dodd. She is a former editor of *ByTheSeaFuture* newspaper.

Hillsboro Beach

In Hillsboro Beach, voters had one official candidate at presstime Thursday, former commissioner Dick Maggiore who qualified on Wednesday. Maggiore, 65, owner of the Tipperary Pub in Deerfield Beach, served for three months in 2010/11 filling out the term of Lee Bennett who resigned in October 2010. He ran for reelection last March and came in behind Mayor Dan Dodge and commissioners Claire Schubert and Javier Garcia.

Commissioner Jim Lambert, 44, appointed in October to fill the expiring term of Celinda Sawtelle, picked up his election package. He is owner of Ole Ole Restaurant and president of a financial company.

Also on the ballot is the seat held by Commissioner Rhea Weiss. Weiss, 82, was elected two years ago and said this week she would not comment on her intention to run or not to run.

Lighthouse Point

In Lighthouse Point, three seats held by incumbent commissioners Tom Hasis, Mike Long and Susie Gordon, will be on the ballot. Hasis' seat is challenged by Earl Maucker, retired *Sun Sentinel* Managing Editor. Gordon's seat is challenged by Broward County Teacher Becky Lysengen.

Maucker served as com-

missioner by Mayor Fred Shorr's appointment from January to March 2011 to fill the remaining time for Lighthouse Point Commissioner Chip LaMarca, who was elected as Broward County Commissioner that year. Lysengen ran unsuccessfully against current Commissioner Glenn Troast for the city commission in 2010.

According to the city clerk, no one else has requested election packets.

Wilton Manors

In Wilton Manors, voters will answer three ballot questions. Two questions will ask voters if they want to have commissioners and volunteer board members remain under the state ethics code as opposed to adopting the newly framed Broward County code. The third question will ask voters if they want to "abolish and transfer the city's police department." A yes vote would mean that if the city considered abolishing the department to consider contracting with Broward Sheriff's Office for police services, the city would be required to put that question to the voters to approve.


